Strength of Schedule

Eight opponents are currently ranked in the ITA Collegiate Tennis Rankings (New Mexico, Boise State, Utah, Texas Tech, Oregon, Stanford, San Diego, Pepperdine).

Home Court Advantage

The team will finish with a .500 or better record at home this season regardless of Friday's result. The Cougars have reached player at BYU-Hawaii that mark every season since at least 2000.
