BYU STORYLINES

- BYU returns to the Marriott Center for a pair of WCC home games this week against Pacific on Thursday and Saint Mary's on Saturday. The Cougars are looking to extend a five-game home winning streak.
- Guard Tyler Haws is having another prolific season scoring the basketball. He is currently first in the WCC and fourth in the country in scoring at 23.6 points per game. Haws is ranked 12th all-time at BYU in career scoring and is 33 points from breaking into the top 10. His career-high 48 points scored at Portland are tied for the most scored in a single game in NCAA Division I this season and third all-time at BYU.
- In the first half of WCC play, BYU played six of nine on the road. The Cougars will play six of nine at home in the second half.

BY THE NUMBERS

- 1.7** Matt Carlino's career steals average, second all-time in BYU history. His 142 career steals are sixth all-time and the 64 he totaled in 2012-13 as a sophomore are the fourth most in team history.
- 2** The number of players in BYU history to reach 1,000 career points as a sophomore. Danny Ainge was the first to do so and had 1,130 points in 57 games by the end of his sophomore season (1978-79). Sophomore Tyler Haws joined Ainge when he reached the 1,000 career point mark at Saint Mary's on Feb. 21, 2013.
- 4** The number of times a player in the West Coast Conference has scored 35 points or more in a single game since BYU joined the league in 2011. All four instances have been achieved by Tyler Haws: 42 vs. Virginia Tech on 12/29/12, 37 vs. Washington on 3/19/13, 35 vs. Pepperdine on 1/9/14 and 48 at Portland on 1/23/14. The last time a WCC player not named Tyler Haws scored 35 or more came on March 25, 2011 when Santa Clara's Kevin Foster scored 35 against Southern Methodist.
- 4** The number of players in the NCAA ranked in the top 125 in both rebounding and assists: BYU's Kyle Collinsworth (51st in assists, 81st in rebounding), UCLA's Kyle Anderson (6th in assists, 44th in rebounding), Saint Joseph's Halli Kanacevic (T-97th in assists and 54th in rebounding) and Vermont's Brian Voelkel (T-16th in assists and 68th in rebounding). Collinsworth, Anderson and Voelkel are the only three players in the country that average at least 5.0 assists and 8.0 rebounds per game (rankings as of 1/26/14).
- 4.7** Matt Carlino's career assist average, first all-time in BYU history. As a freshman in 2011-12, he averaged 4.6 assists and in 2012-13, he averaged 4.8. Carlino is averaging 4.6 assists per game this season and tied his career high with 11 against North Texas.
- 6** The number of career games for Tyler Haws shooting 100 percent from the free throw line with a minimum of 10 attempts, a BYU record. He hit 10 of 10 on Feb. 20, 2010 at Wyoming, 12 of 12 vs. Cal State Northridge on Nov. 24, 2012, 10 of 10 vs. Utah on Dec. 8, 2012, 10 of 10 at Weber State on Dec. 15, 2012, 14 of 14 at Loyola Marymount on March 2, 2013 and 11 of 11 vs. Wichita State on Nov. 26, 2013.
- 8** With a bid to the 2013 NIT, Dave Rose and the Cougars reached the postseason for a BYU record eighth-straight season. In his first year as head coach, Rose and the Cougars went to the 2006 NIT. That was followed by six-straight trips to the NCAA Tournament and last season's NIT bid. BYU has also won 20-plus games in each of Rose's eight seasons.
- 35** The number of consecutive games Tyler Haws has scored in double figures, a career-best streak and 8th-best in BYU history.
- 42** The number of 20-point games Haws has in his career at BYU, fifth all-time in program history. He had 25 20-point games in 2012-13, fourth all-time in a single season.
- 46** Matt Carlino became the 46th BYU player to score 1,000 career points when he reached the milestone against Santa Clara on Jan. 19, 2014, his 81st career game. He currently has 1,039 career points and is 12 from tying Scott Runia for 43rd all-time at BYU.
- 88.6** Tyler Haws' career free-throw percentage, first all-time in BYU history. He has hit 435 of 491 from the line in his career.
- 112** BYU's point total against Stanford, a 112-103 road win. The point total is the most by a BYU team under Dave Rose and the most since Feb. 25, 1993, when the Cougars scored 128 at home against Sacramento State. It also marked a BYU record for points scored against a Pac-12 team.
- 222** Dave Rose (2005 to present) is second all-time in BYU basketball history with 222 career victories, behind only the great Stan Watts, who coached the Cougars to 371 wins from 1949 to 1972 and was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 1986.
- 1,648** The number of points Tyler Haws has scored in his career, good for 12th all-time and four from tying Ken Roberts for 11th. Haws holds the BYU record for most points scored during freshman and sophomore seasons combined.

COUGARS FALL TO GONZAGA ON THE ROAD

SPOKANE, Wash. -- Tyler Haws finished with a team-high 23 points as the BYU men's basketball team fell 84-69 to Gonzaga on Saturday.

"We've brought some teams in here with some pretty good records and didn't have a chance that we had tonight," BYU basketball coach Dave Rose said. "We had a chance in the first half where we're within striking distance to come out in the second half."

Kyle Collinsworth added 13 points, seven rebounds and four assists, while Eric Mika ended with 12 points and nine rebounds. Anson Winder came off the bench to contribute seven points with Nate Austin adding six points and four rebounds.

Skyler Halford, Austin and Mika each scored to give the Cougars a 6-4 start four minutes into the game. Gonzaga went on a 13-3 run to lead 17-9 until Collinsworth spun down the lane for a layup. A 7-2 run that included a Mika hook shot and putback brought the Cougars within three with 7:56 left in the half. The Bulldogs pushed their lead back to six with under seven minutes left.

BYU answered back with a 9-3 run with Frank Bartley IV's putback layup. Collinsworth's drive to the rim and Haws' jumper to tie it at 27 at the 4:03 mark. With five seconds left in the first half, Carlino's layup cut BYU's deficit by two to make it 35-33 at the half.

Haws led the team with 12 points, while Collinsworth added five points, five rebounds and two assists. Mika also contributed six points and seven rebounds at the half.

Mika started the second half with a three-point play with Haws following it up with a layup to cut Gonzaga's lead to 43-40 at the 18:05 mark. Collinsworth's putback put BYU back within four before the Bulldogs pushed their lead to seven at 54-47. Austin recorded a block with 11:54 left, which was followed by a Haws three-point play to make it a four-point game.

Haws and Winder's trips to the charity stripe cut the deficit back to seven at 64-57 after Gonzaga had extended its lead to 12 on an 8-0 run. Collinsworth's fadeaway jumper put the game in single digits. With 4:32 remaining, Winder connected on a 3-pointer to cut the deficit to 74-65. Collinsworth made a layup with 3:02 remaining followed by Austin's third field goal with 1:29 left, but BYU couldn't overcome Gonzaga's second-half run.

"It's a tough road swing here and hopefully our guys will have a lot of fight in them when we get back," Rose said.

2013-14 STORYLINES AND NOTES

Dave Rose

BYU head coach Dave Rose has led BYU to one of the most successful runs in program history since taking over in 2005. His career record of 222-75 ranks him second in BYU history in total victories and first in winning percentage (.747). Rose has been named conference coach of the year three times, district coach of the year twice, led the Cougars to four conference titles, six NCAA Tournament appearances, two NIT appearances, six 25-win seasons and eight 20-win seasons. In 2010, he led BYU to its first NCAA Tournament win in 17 years and the Cougars have also won at least one postseason game in the three seasons since, including a spot in the Sweet 16 in 2011 and a trip to the NIT semifinals in 2013.

Kyle of all trades

In his first season since serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in Russia, Kyle Collinworth is averaging 13.9 points, 8.2 rebounds, 5.1 assists and 1.6 steals per game. He is proving to be the most versatile player in the WCC, especially in league games. Through nine WCC games (as of 1/26/14), he ranks in the top 10 in the four of the five major statistical categories: 9th in scoring, tied for 2nd in rebounding, tied for 3rd in assists and 2nd in steals. He is also top 12 in four other categories: 2nd in FG percentage, tied for 1st in offensive rebounds, 11th in assist/turnover ratio and 7th in defensive rebounds.

30 the old fashioned way

Tyler Haws scored 31 points against Loyola Marymount while hitting 9 of 19 from the field and 13 of 14 from the free throw line. He joined Brandon Davies (33 vs. Weber State on Dec. 15, 2012) as the only other player to score 30-plus points without hitting a three since Keena Young scored 34 vs. UNLV on March 10, 2007. The last BYU wing/guard to score 30 without hitting a three was Travis Hansen on Jan. 5, 2002 when he netted 30 against Pepperdine. Prior to Hansen, the last guard to score 30-plus was Marty Haws, Tyler's father, on Jan. 4, 1990 vs. Hawaii.

The mythical 5x3 and the 4x3+2

A 5x3 is when a player records at least three in each of the major statistical categories (points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks). Only one BYU player – Rafael Araujo – has recorded a 5x3 since blocks and steals were first recorded beginning with the 1977-78 season. He did so with 24 points, 9 rebounds, 3 assists, 3 blocks and 3 steals vs. Wyoming on Jan. 19, 2004. Kyle Collinworth has joined 11 other BYU players who have fallen one stat shy of a 5x3 and recorded a 4x3+2 (at least three in four of the categories plus two in the other). He had 11 points, 13 rebounds, 7 assists, 2 blocks and 5 steals at Pepperdine and 20 points, 9 rebounds, 5 assists, 3 blocks and 2 steals vs. LMU. Danny Ainge (2), Lee Cummar (6), Brandon Davies (3) and Greg Kite (2) are the only others to record more than one 4x3+2.

Fantastic freshman

Big man Eric Mika is having one of the top freshman campaigns in BYU history. He is currently ranked in the top 10 in several categories in the BYU record book, including: scoring (7th), rebounding (T-6th), field goal percentage (4th), offensive rebounds (3rd), double-figure scoring games (T-8th) and consecutive games scoring in double figures (2nd).
