BYU STORYLINES

- Last meeting.** BYU's only meeting with UCF was in 2011, when the Cougars beat the Knights 24-17 in Provo Sept. 23. Receiver Cody Hoffman returned a kickoff for a touchdown to tie the game 17-17 in the third quarter. A muffed punt recovered by Michael Alisa set up the Cougars for the winning touchdown in the fourth quarter.
- BYU vs. AAC.** BYU is 18-2 against American Athletic Conference foes after defeating UConn 35-10 on the road and Houston 33-25 at home earlier this season.
- First meeting in Orlando.** BYU flies to Orlando for its first road meeting against the Knights Thursday.
- On the road.** BYU football has already traveled more than 7,000 miles this season. The trip to Orlando will add about 3,800 miles to the season total.
- 10 seasons.** Bronco Mendenhall is now in his 10th season as head coach of the Cougars. Mendenhall has an 86-35 record, and BYU ranks 12th in total wins nationally during his tenure.
- Beating the best.** Since 2003, BYU has 17 wins against Power 5 schools, which ranks second among non-Power 5 schools behind fellow independent Navy. BYU has the longest streak, with nine straight seasons with a P5 win.
- The Bomb Squad.** Receivers Jordan Leslie and Mitch Mathews both had 100-yard games against Utah State, with Mathews collecting a personal-best 117 yards (for 251 yards on the season) and Leslie tallying 135 yards (for 362 on the season).
- New faces.** Senior quarterback Christian Stewart will make his first start as a Cougar Thursday, taking over for starting quarterback Taysom Hill, who suffered a season-ending leg fracture against Utah State.
- Going home.** Three Cougars claim Florida as their home—Phillip Amone, Cody Bond and Hayden Griffitts.
- 4 weeks in the spotlight.** BYU's game Thursday is its fourth-straight appearance on ESPN.

POSTGAME MEDIA AVAILABILITY

After home games, postgame press conference will be conducted in the LaVell Edwards Stadium press room, located on the southeast end of the stadium next to the BYU locker room. BYU VS. UTAH STATE

In its first home loss to Utah State since 1978, No. 18/19 BYU football fell 35-20 in the annual in-state matchup Friday night at LaVell Edwards Stadium.

Cougar quarterback Taysom Hill led the offensive effort with a rushing touchdown and a career-high 178.3 efficiency rating on 8-of-11 passing for 99 yards and one passing touchdown. The junior left the game due to a season-ending fractured left leg, injured late in the second quarter.

The win marks the first time the Aggies have won in Provo since 1978, snapping a 17-game losing streak at LaVell Edwards Stadium.

Since 2008, BYU is 5-8 when its time of possession is less than 26 minutes. It held the ball for just 21:59 against the Aggies.

BYU PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- **Coming into the game, junior quarterback** Taysom Hill was one of three FBS QBs to have at least five rushing and five passing touchdowns this season. The other two are C.J. Brown from Maryland and Austin Grammer from Middle Tennessee. He added two more scores (one rush, one pass) in the first half before leaving the game with an injury. With his rushing TD, Hill tied Jamaal Williams for No. 10 on BYU's all-time rushing TD list. Hill also passed running back Brian McKenzie with 387 career rushing attempts, good for No. 10 at BYU.
- **Senior quarterback Christian Stewart** completed his first pass at BYU. He finished with 172 passing yards on 10-29 passing.
- **Junior running back Jamaal Williams rushed** for 99 yards on 17 attempts. He passed John Ogden for No. 8 at BYU in career rushing yards (2,403). He also earned the No. 7 spot in school history for career carries (460), passing Peter Van Valkenberg.
- **Senior receiver set a personal best at BYU** in receiving yards (135) and added his longest reception as a Cougar (53).
- **Junior receiver Mitch Mathews set new** personal bests with eight receptions in a game and 117 receiving yards. His previous highs were five receptions and 112 yards against Utah State in 2013. He collected his third receiving TD of the season.
- **Senior safety Craig Bills had nine tackles** to lead the team.



UCF VS. HOUSTON

The UCF Knights (2-2, 1-0) started conference play the way they ended conference play last season. With a close, exciting and dramatic finish. With UCF's 17-12 victory over the Houston Cougars (2-3, 0-1), the Knights start conference play undefeated and have won nine consecutive conference contests, dating back to last season.

"That's our goal. To win the conference," said senior line-backer Terrance Plummer. "We all played hard all night and the defense made a play it needed to make at the end."

Of course, that defensive play was made senior safety Brandon Alexander who forced a fumble through the end zone for a touchback as Houston quarterback Greg Ward Jr. dove towards the end zone. Even though the Orlando native made one of the biggest plays of the game, he had plenty of high-praise for the entire defense's performance.

Of the nine victories the Knights have all-time in the American Athletic Conference, seven have been within seven points and six have been within five points. Either way it's broken down, it's still considered a win and that's all the Knights care about.

UCF PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- **Breshad Perriman's 52-yard touchdown catch** in the third quarter extended his streak of consecutive games with a reception to 22.
- **After having to sit out the first half due to a** targeting penalty last game, Rannell Hall entered in the second half and took back the kickoff 33 yards.
- **Hall finished the night with three returns** for 83 yards. He now has 76 career kick returns, which is good for fourth all-time at UCF.
- **Thomas Niles continued his impressive ride** as a Knight. He recorded a sack in his fifth consecutive game dating back to last year. The last time a Knight accomplished that feat was Greg Jefferson from 1993-94.
- **Sophomore quarterback Justin Holman** posted a touchdown pass in his fourth straight game.
- **Holman went for 101 yards and two** touchdowns through the air, and ran for 32 yards on the ground.
- **With nine tackles, Clayton Geathers moved** into a tie for eighth all-time at UCF with 321 in his career.
- **J.J. Worton had three punt returns, giving** him 63 for his career. That ranks as a tie for third with Asante Samuel.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR FOUR

The 12-game independent slate features teams from 10 states and seven conferences, including the American Athletic, Atlantic Coast, Big 12, Pac-12, Conference USA, Mountain West and Mid-Eastern Athletic.

The Cougars will play six home games and six road contests in 2014. BYU will face teams that hail from Connecticut, Virginia, Florida, Georgia, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Idaho, Nevada and California, including seven programs—Texas, Houston, Utah State, Central Florida, Boise State, Middle Tennessee and UNLV—that qualified for a bowl game last season.

FLAG BEARERS

BYU has a tradition of selecting a player before each game to run the team flag and alumni flag. The team selects a former Cougar to carry out the alumni flag, along with the chosen current player who runs out with the current team flag. The team flag has been signed by each member of the team, while the alumni flag has been signed by former BYU payers. In 2011, the team added a special teams flag, donned by a vintage BYU logo adopted by the special teams, following the same protocol as the team flag with an exemplary special teams player being chosen to carry it each week.

TEAM CAPTAINS

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 64,045 after refurbishing the middle of the east section. The capacity now sits at 63,470 due to accommodations for wheelchair access. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's 2012 average attendance of 61,161 ranked No. 3 in the West behind only USC (87,945) and UCLA (68,481).

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates missions around the world in 145 nations speaking 164 languages. More than 88,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 406 missions around the world. Seventy-five percent of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples)—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

Eighty-eight members of the 2014 team have served church missions. Members of the team have served in 28 countries and six of the seven continents around the globe.

FIRESIDES

The BYU football team will participate in hour-long devotionals prior or team service activities the night before each game this season. The team will conduct devotionals before eight games. These devotionals are referred to as "firesides" and are intended to help players, coaches and those who attend strengthen or gain a knowledge of our purpose here on earth. Firesides typically include a musical number from members of the team and talks from selected players, along with coach Bronco Mendenhall.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- **BYU is successful when it strikes first.** Last week, the Cougars snapped a nine-game winning streak when they are the first team to score. In 2013, they finished 6-1 when scoring before their opponent. In the Bronco Mendenhall era, BYU is 64-9.
- **Go fast, go hard** has been the mantra of offensive coordinator Robert Anae. Through five games this season BYU is averaging an offensive play every 21 seconds. Last year with a new offense, the Cougars averaged 89.9 plays per game, the second most of any team in the country only behind Texas Tech. Comparatively, BYU ran 79.2 plays per game in 2012.
- **BYU has not been shut out for 129 consecutive games.** The last time the Cougars failed to score was in 2003 in a 3-0 loss to Utah. That loss was the only time BYU has not produced points since 1975. BYU has scored in the last 486 of 487 games since 1975.
- **Running back Jamaal Williams is moving up the rushing leader boards at BYU.** The junior rushed for 99 yards on 17 attempts in the loss to Utah State. In that game he passed John Ogden for No. 8 at BYU in career rushing yards (2,403). He also earned the No. 7 spot in school history for career carries (460), passing Peter Van Valkenberg.
- **Two receivers hit the century mark in receiving yards--the first time any receiver has hit that mark this season.** Jordan Leslie led the receiving corps with 135 yards on four receptions, while Mitch Mathews bolstered the team with 117 yards receiving on eight receptions and a touchdown.

THE BYU DEFENSE

- **BYU's run defense has been dominant.** The defense has allowed only 19 rushing touchdowns dating back to 2012. It allowed just five in 2012, nine in 2013 and five so far in 2014. At 98 rushing yards allowed per game, BYU ranks No. 10 in the country.
- **In the past nine seasons, BYU has finished ranked in the top 25 in various national statistical categories 61 times on defense.** Currently, BYU ranks in the top 25 in defensive rushing yards per game and in opponent punt return yard average.
- **Lengthening the field.** The Cougars have allowed just 10 rushing plays of 10 or more yards this season, right behind Alabama for No. 2 in the nation. For the 2013 season, BYU allowed opponents 154 plays of 10 yards or more to rank No. 19 in the country.
- **Shutting down the offense.** The BYU defense is tied for No. 26 for 13 total touchdowns allowed in 2014.

HEAD COACH**BRONCO MENDENHALL****YEARS AT BYU**

10th year as head coach, 12th at BYU

Entering his tenth season as head coach at Brigham Young University, Bronco Mendenhall has restored the Cougars' reputation as one of the nation's top college football programs. Taking over a BYU team that in 2005 was coming off three consecutive losing seasons, Mendenhall has guided his teams to nine straight bowl appearances, two outright conference championships before football independence in 2011, and regular national top-25 rankings.

Under Mendenhall's leadership, BYU has earned an 86-35 record to rank 12th in total wins among all FBS teams since 2005. Mendenhall also ranks 12th in winning percentage at .711 among active coaches with at least five years of FBS experience.

The Cougars finished the 2013 season with an 8-5 record after playing one of the toughest schedules in school history. BYU earned six of its eight wins over bowl teams, including then-No. 15 Texas, and faced nine bowl teams overall. Under Mendenhall BYU is one of only 12 programs to earn a bowl invitation each of the past nine years. Only Florida State (7) has achieved more than BYU's six bowl victories over that timeframe.

The Cougars set a program record with four consecutive bowl wins from 2009-12, helping Mendenhall become the first BYU head coach to win six bowls in a seven-year span. The Cougars received nine straight bowl invitations for the first time since a string of 17 consecutive bowl bids under Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards from 1978 through 1994. Mendenhall is the only coach in BYU football history to take his first nine teams to a bowl game, and is winning at the same pace as the legendary Edwards. Through his 116 games as BYU head coach, Mendenhall has a record of 82-34—almost identical to Edwards' 116-game mark of 83-32-1.

In 2006, Mendenhall was named the American Football Coaches Association Region IV Coach of the Year following an 11-2 season. In addition, the Football Writers Association of America named Mendenhall one of nine finalists for the prestigious Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year Award.

He has also served as the defensive coordinator for much of his tenure as the head coach. BYU has consistently fielded one of the nation's strongest defenses under Mendenhall's direction. Mendenhall's defense excels at keeping opponents out of the end zone, averaging a No. 20 national ranking in scoring defense over the past eight seasons, including three top-10 ratings. In 2012, the Cougars featured one of the greatest defenses in school history, allowing just 266.1 yards, including 86.9 rushing yards, and 14.0 points per game. Ranked No. 3 in total defense, No. 3 in scoring defense and No. 2 in rushing defense, the Mendenhall-coached unit held its first six opponents under 300 total yards (part of a streak of 12 consecutive such games dating back to 2011) and kept opposing offenses without a touchdown six times during the year. Adjusting to the team's up-tempo offense in 2013, BYU's defense ranked No. 12 in yards per play allowed despite defending more plays than all but four teams nationally. Only two teams that defended as many plays ranked better than the Cougars at defending their turf.

Another hallmark of Mendenhall's program has been the emphasis on balance and priorities in the many other facets of life outside of football. Reflecting that emphasis, BYU consistently received the most academic all-conference honorees each season as a conference member, while six Cougar student-athletes have earned seven Academic All-America citations under Mendenhall. Only four programs have had more Academic All-America citations during Mendenhall's tenure. In addition, BYU tops all FBS programs for the most selections to the NFF Hampshire Honor Society (3.2 GPA over college career) since the program began in 2007.

Mendenhall was elected in 2013 to the American Football Coaches Association Board of Trustees as the District 8 Representative and also serves on the Ethics Committee. He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at his alma mater, Oregon State. He later coached at Snow College, Northern Arizona, became the youngest defensive coordinator in the Pac-10 at Oregon State, then went to Louisiana Tech and New Mexico before coming to BYU as a defensive coordinator in 2003.
