- The 2011-12 season marks BYU's first as a member of the West Coast Conference and a new television partnership with BYUtv and ESPN that will give fans unprecedented access to BYU basketball. ESPN will broadcast eight BYU games and BYUtv is currently scheduled to televise 17 games.
- Under Dave Rose, BYU is 4-2 in its season openers, including wins in it's last four openers: 74-34 at Long Beach State in 2007, 75-65 vs. Long Beach State in 2008, 70-60 vs. Bradley in 2009 and 83-56 vs. Fresno State in 2010.
- Under Dave Rose, BYU is 5-1 in its road openers, including wins in the last four seasons. Last season, BYU defeated Creighton 77-65 in its first true road game. The Cougars also won two neutral site games before the Creighton game.
- The Cougars return three starters from last season's 32-5 team, including Brandon Davies (11.1 ppg, 6.2 rpg), Noah Hartsock (8.6 ppg, 5.9 rpg) and Charles Abouo (7.2 ppg, 4.8 rpg).
- BYU basketball coach Dave Rose has led the Cougars to their most successful six-year stretch in program history. He is second in program history in wins (159), first in winning percentage (.779) and has led the Cougars to five-straight NCAA Tournament berths and four conference titles in the last five seasons.
- BYU along with Butler, Kansas and Pittsburgh is one of only four NCAA Division I programs that has won at least 25 games in each of the last five seasons. Only eight teams have acheived the mark in each of the last four seasons, including BYU and WCC foes Gonzaga and Saint Mary's.

BYU will play its 2011-12 home opener on Tuesday, Nov. 15, against BYU-Hawaii. Follow the game live via GameTracker on www.byucougars.com and listen live on the radio beginning with the pregame show at 6 p.m. MT on KSL Newsradio 102.7 FM and 1160 AM out of Salt Lake City or via the Internet at KSL.com. The game will be televised live on BYUtv and BYUtv.org

BYU participated in one open scrimmage and two exhibition games in the preseason. See the recaps below.

Cougar Tipoff

Senior Noah Hartsock scored 24 points and grabbed 13 rebounds and led the Blue Team to a 74-71 victory over the White Team in the Cougar Tipoff on Wednesday Night at the Marriott Center. The White Team went on 11-0 run and tied the score 65-65 with 1:41 left but the Blue Team had more down the stretch and went on to pick up the three-point win. The 2011-12 Cougar team was divided into two squads, seeing a pretty even matchup with three players on each team scoring in double figures. Hartsock led all scorers with 24 and senior Charles Abouo scored 19 points. Junior Stephen Rogers led the way for the White Team, scoring 20 points and junior Brandon Davies scored 19 points.

BYU 91, Midwestern State 74

Four players scored in double figures and the BYU basketball team defeated Midwestern State 91-74 in an exhibition game Saturday night at the Marriott Center. Junior Stephen Rogers scored 16 points to lead the way and junior Brandon Davies added a double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds. Seniors Noah Hartsock and Charles Abouo helped out with 15 points and 14 points, respectively. The senior duo also combined to grab 16 rebounds. The Cougars hit the glass hard, pulling down 59 rebounds including 21 offensive boards to Midwestern State's 39 total rebounds.

BYU 96. Dixie State 85

In a game that featured a record number of free throws and four players on each team scoring in double figures, the BYU men's basketball team defeated Dixie State 96-85 to conclude the 2011 exhibition season Friday night in the Marriott Center. Junior Brock Zylstra led BYU with 23 points on 5 of 10 shooting from the field and was 9 of 9 from the free throw line, Junior Brandon Davies contributed 20 points on 4 of 6 shooting while senior Noah Hartsock added in a double-double with 18 points and 12 rebounds. Stephen Rogers also scored 19 points on 6 of 11 shooting. BYU won the free throw battle in the contest as they unofficially tied a Marriott Center record with 47 free throw attempts. The Cougars also topped the Marriott Center record with 39 free throw makes, although neither record is official because they were accomplished in an exhibition game.

GOING GREEK

BYU men's basketball went on a 10-day, four-game tour of Greece in August. The Cougars won their first two games against the Athens All-Stars (88-56) and ASE Doukas (114-45) while also playing a friendly game against US Navy personnel on a base in Crete. While in Greece, BYU was invited to participate in the Acropolis of Athens Tournament against the Greek and Italian National Teams, both ranked among the top 10 in the world by FIBA. Against Greece, Stephen Rogers led BYU with 20 points in an 83-54 loss. Brock Zylstra exploded for 26 points and four 3-pointers in BYU's 102-63 loss to an Italian team that featured three NBA stars.

NEW HOME

In 2011-12, BYU men's basketball enters its first season as a member of the West Coast Conference. The Cougars have played each member of the league at least twice all time. Last season, BYU defeated St. Mary's 74-73 in the South Padre Island Invitational championship game and Gonzaga 89-67 in the third round of the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16. NONCONFERENCE SCHEDULE

BYU's nonconference schedule features programs from 12 different conferences and includes nine teams that played in the postseason in 2011, including three that played in the NCAA Tournament.

COACHING STAFF

For the second-straight season there was a change to the coaching staff. Former associate head coach Dave Rice, who had been with the staff since Rose became the head coach in 2005, left to take the head job at his alma mater, UNLV. Rose hired Mark Pope as an assistant coach in May 2011. Pope comes to BYU after one season as an assistant at Wake Forest. Prior to Wake Forest, Pope was the director of basketball operations at Georgia. Pope played his college ball at Washington and Kentucky. In 1996, he was a team captain and helped Kentucky win the NCAA National Championship. Pope was selected by he Indiana Pacers in the second round of the NBA draft and played seven seasons in the NBA. He played in the Eastern Conference Finals with Indiana (1998) and Milwaukee (2001).

ESPN AND BYUTV

Eight of BYU's games this season will be broadcast on the ESPN family of networks, including: vs. Oregon at EnergySolutions Arena (Dec. 3 on ESPNU), at Saint Mary's (Dec. 29 on ESPN2), vs. Santa Clara (Jan. 14 on ESPNU) vs. Saint Mary's (Jan. 28 on ESPNU), vs. Gonzaga (Feb. 2 on ESPN2), at San Francisco (Feb. 16 on ESPNU), at Santa Clara (Feb. 18 on ESPNU) and at Gonzaga (Feb. 23 on ESPN2). BYUtv will broadcast all home games not televised by ESPN. Including the two exhibition games, BYUtv is currently scheduled to broadcast 16 home men's basketball games. Broadcast plans for road games will be announced as the information becomes available.

YOUNG GUNS

The 2011-12 roster includes nine freshmen who come from several different situations. Nate Austin and Ian Harward are true freshman and are coming off two-year missions for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. Mike Boswell is also coming off a mission but completed a redshirt season prior to serving. Josh Sharp is another return missionary and he redshirted one season at Utah prior to his mission. Matt Carlino and Anson Winder both redshirted for the Cougars last season. The other three freshmen — Damarcus Harrison, Austin Nelson and Jaren Sweeney — are all true freshmen.
