BYU VS. UAB



• **THE SERIES.** BYU and the University of Alabama-Birmingham are meeting for the first time in football. The Cougars have a 39-12-1 record against teams from Conference USA in football.

• **INDEPENDENCE BOWL.** Established in 1976, the Independence Bowl received its name because of the nation's bicentennial celebration (1776). Throughout the first 44 years of the game's history, 71 First Round NFL Draft selections – including 2019 sixth overall pick Daniel Jones, five Pro Football Hall of Fame inductees – including 2020 inductee Jimmy Johnson, 19 College Football Hall of Famers – including 2018 honorees Frank Beamer and Mack Brown, and seven National Championship-winning coaches have participated in the Independence Bowl. It is currently the 11th oldest bowl game playing to date.

• **LOUISIANA.** BYU is playing just its third game in the Bayou state and first postseason contest. The Cougars played both previous games in the Superdome in New Orleans. Most recently, BYU played LSU in 2017 and back in 2009 matched up with Tulane.

• **BIG 12.** On Friday, Sept. 10, 2021, BYU accepted an official invitation to join the Big 12 Conference in all sports. The Cougars joined Cincinnati, Houston and UCF as the four new members. BYU is expected to play its first season in the Power 5 conference in 2023. The Cougars have a record of 86-50 since becoming an independent in 2011. ([Read more](#))

• **TOP 25.** BYU is ranked No. 13 in the latest College Football Playoff poll (released Tuesdays). The Cougars are also No. 12 in the latest AP Top 25 and No. 14 in the AFCA Coaches Poll. BYU is 18-4 under Kalani Sitake when playing as a ranked team.

• **BOWL GAMES.** BYU is in a bowl game for the 16th time in 17 seasons, and fifth in six seasons under Sitake. BYU is 3-1 under Sitake in bowl games. The Independence Bowl is BYU's 39th bowl game in school history. The Cougars 39 bowl appearances is tied for 20th in the FBS. BYU has played in more bowl games than several storied programs, including Notre Dame, UCLA, Wisconsin, Stanford, Michigan State, Virginia Tech and Utah.

• **ALL-AMERICANS.** Offensive lineman Clark Barrington earned All-America honors from the Action Sports Network (2nd Team) and Pro Football Focus (3rd Team) while his younger brother Campbell was named a freshman All-American by the Maxwell Football Club and the Athletic (2nd Team). Defensive back Jakob Robinson was also named a second-team freshman All-American selection by the Athletic.

BYU beat Arizona for the third time in six years in the season opener with a 24-16 win at Allegiant Stadium in Las Vegas. Neil Pau'u caught eight passes for 126 yards for two touchdowns while linebacker Keenan Pili had 17 total tackles.			
9/11	Utah (9-3)	W 26-17	ESPN
The Cougars owned the trenches and powered their way to their first win in the series since 2009 with a 26-17 triumph over the Utes at LaVell Edwards Stadium. BYU led from start to finish and did not turn the ball over while forcing two against Utah.			
9/18	Arizona State (8-4)	W 27-17	ESPN
BYU forced four turnovers and cashed in on several Arizona State mistakes to beat the Sun Devils 27-17 in front of another big crowd at LaVell Edwards Stadium. Jaren Hall threw two touchdown passes in the win.			
9/25	South Florida (2-10)	W 35-27	ESPN2
Baylor Romney led a fast start to the offense with 21 straight points to start the game and BYU outlasted the USF Bulls 35-27. Romney threw for 305 yards while Gunner Romney and Puka Nacua both posted 100-yard receiving games.			
10/1	at Utah State (9-3)	W 34-20	CBS Sports
Tyler Allgeier ran for 218 yards and three touchdowns as the ground game pounded Utah State all night and the Cougars ran to a 34-20 win. BYU's defense allowed just 22 rushing yards to a USU team averaging 213.5 rushing yards coming in.			
10/9	Boise State (7-5)	L 26-17	ABC
Three fumbles, an interception and two turnovers on downs doomed the Cougars in their first loss of the 2021 season. BYU couldn't finish enough drives to stay in front of fell to Boise State 26-17 in a wet and rainy game.			
10/16	at Baylor (10-2)	L 38-24	ESPN
Baylor was able to bottle up the Cougars' run game and ran past BYU 38-24 in a preview of future Big 12 matchups. Jaren Hall threw for a career-best 342 yards and Puka Nacua caught five passes for 168 yards and his first Cougar touchdown.			
10/23	at Washington St. (7-5)	W 21-19	FS1
The ground game was the answer again at WSU as Tyler Allgeier ran for a career-high 32 carries and 191 yards and two scores. Leading by two points with 4 minutes left, BYU ran Allgeier seven times in a row for three first downs to run out the clock and win.			
10/30	Virginia (6-6)	W 66-49	ESPN2
BYU's offense racked up 734 yards and beat Virginia in a wild 66-49 shootout to spoil Bronco Mendenhall's return to Provo. Tyler Allgeier ran for 266 yards and five touchdowns to tie the single-game record at BYU.			
11/6	Idaho State (1-10)	W 59-14	BYUtv
Idaho State comes south from Pocatello for a game against the Cougars after visiting LaVell Edwards Stadium in 2019. BYU is 6-0 against the FCS opponent and won the last meeting by a score of 42-10.			
11/20	at Georgia Southern (3-9)	W 34-17	ESPN+
BYU rolled up 510 yards of total offense and held the Eagles to just 268, forcing two second-half turnovers and pitching a shutout in the second half to beat Georgia Southern 34-17 in Statesboro.			
11/27	at USC (4-8)	W 35-31	ESPN
Despite being banged up on both sides of the ball, BYU gutted out a 35-31 win over the Trojans in LA. Jackson McChesney ran for the go-ahead score with 4 minutes remaining and Kaleb Hayes made a game-saving tackle to preserve the victory.

APPEARANCES

BYU has made 38 previous bowl appearances with a record of 15–21–1. The Cougars have appeared in 19 different bowl games against 34 different opponents.

BYU OFFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

- 1** BYU's biggest bowl victory came in 1984 as the No. 1 ranked Cougars rallied from a 17-10 deficit in the fourth quarter to defeat Bo Schembechler's Michigan Wolverines 24-17. The win preserved a perfect 13-0 season and kept BYU at No. 1 in both the AP and UPI Coaches polls. On Jan. 2, 1985, BYU was crowned National Champions in all the polls. It's the only time in college football history that the eventual national champion played its bowl game prior to New Years Eve.
- 3** Only three quarterbacks have lead BYU to multiple wins in bowl games. Consensus All-American Jim McMahon lead a Cougars to back-to-back Holiday Bowl wins in 1980 and 1981, while Max Hall guided the Cougars to two bowl victories in 2007 and 2009, both at the Las Vegas Bowl. Zach Wilson went a perfect 18 of 18 in the 2018 Potato Bowl victory and led the Cougars to last year's Boca Raton Bowl win in 2020.
- 4** BYU longest consecutive bowl winning streak came between 2009 to 2012. The four-straight included wins over Oregon State, UTEP, Tulsa and San Diego State. Four is also the longest losing skid in BYU bowl history, which happened twice. The first four bowl games in 1974-76-78-79 and again in 1998-99-2001-2005.
- 10** Since going independent in football in 2011, the Cougars have been invited to play in 10 bowl games over the past 11 seasons. Of the 10, the Poinsettia (2012, 2016) is the only bowl BYU played in more than once.

The junior linebacker finished the night with two touchdowns, 3.5 tackles for loss, 1.5 sacks, a forced fumble, a fumble recovery for a score, an interception returned for a touchdown, eight tackles and a blocked punt. In all, Van Noy recored an amazing 7.5 disruptive plays in the box score and scored 12 of BYU's 23 points.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR ELEVEN

After finishing the 2020 season 11-1, BYU enters its 11th season as an independent. This season, the Cougars play seven teams from Power 5 conferences, including three to start the year. BYU will face five teams from the Pac-12 in Arizona, Utah, Arizona State, Washington State and USC. The Cougars will also match up with Baylor of the Big 12 and Virginia of the ACC. In addition to those Power 5 matchups, BYU also plays in-state foe Utah State along with Mountain West power Boise State. The Cougars will host USF of the American and Idaho State from the FCS.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's winning percentage at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 1 among teams playing in their current stadium.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates more than 400 missions around the world in over 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. More than 53,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 65 percent of the current team has served a mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. More than 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) are currently serving in the mission field.

HONOR CODE

BYU's Honor Code helps maintain this learning environment. Initiated by students in 1949, the Honor Code emphasizes being honest, living a chaste and virtuous life, abstaining from alcohol and tobacco, using clean language, and following other values in line with the doctrines of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.

POLYNESIAN PIPELINE

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. About 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Fesi Sitake Harvey Unga, Nu'u Tafisi, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You, Al Pupunu and Vince Feula.

FORMER PLAYERS ON STAFF

There are 15 former BYU football players on the football and athletic administration staff. Members of the staff were part of Cougar teams that won the 1980 "Miracle Bowl," the 1984 National Championship, 1996 Cotton Bowl along with many other accolades.

- 1** Running back Tyler Allgeier is tied for No. 1 in the nation in rushing touchdowns with 20. Allgeier has multiple touchdowns in five games this year and a rushing score in 10 of 12 games. He is tied for No. 3 nationally in total touchdowns scored and tied for No. 4 in scoring at 10.0 points per game.
- 18.95** Puka Nacua ranks No. 18 nationally with 18.95 yards per reception. The big-play threat has a 35-yard reception in 6 games played and now leads the team in receiving yards with 796.
- 266** Allgeier's 266 rushing yards vs. Virginia were the third-most in a single game in BYU history and most against a P5 opponent. Jamaal Williams set the record against any opponent with 286 against Toledo in 2016 while Eldon Fortie had 272 in 1962. Allgeier also tied the school record with five rushing touchdowns in the game.
- 500+** BYU put up 734 yards of total offense on Virginia, 560 against Idaho State and 507 against Georgia Southern. The last time the Cougars had three consecutive games of 500+ yards on offense was the first three games of the 2020 season. BYU actually had four in that stretch dating back to the Hawaii bowl of 2019.
- 1,000x2** Allgeier went over 1,000 yards for the second consecutive season after his 266-yard performance against Virginia. He finished with 1,130 yards in 2020, making him just the fifth BYU player to have multiple 1,000-yard seasons. He joins current RB coach Harvey Ungs (3), Jamaal Williams (2), Curtis Brown (2) and Jamal Willis (2).

THE BYU OFFENSE

• **COACHING EXPERIENCE.** The BYU offensive staff has nearly 100 years of coaching experience. Offensive line coach Darrell Funk has the most with more than 30 years. Tight ends coach Steve Clark has been coaching since 1994 and offensive coordinator Aaron Roderick has 22 years in the profession. Funk, Roderick, Clark and passing game coordinator Fesi Sitake have all been coordinators at the college level.

• **BROTHERS DON'T SHAKE HANDS, BROTHERS GET YARDS...** Receivers Samson Nacua and Puka Nacua both had big nights against Virginia. The older of the two brothers, Samson set the tone with a 52-yard reception on BYU's first offensive play and finished the game with three receptions for 107 yards and one touchdown. Puka Nacua, who also finished with an identical 107 receiving yards. It was the first time in school history a set of brothers had 100 receiving yards in the same game. The two have combined for 64 receptions, 1,084 yards and nine touchdowns.

• **ALLGEIER IN THE RECORD BOOKS.** Tyler Allgeier has put together a season to be remembered with 249 attempts, 1,409 yards and 20 touchdowns. Allgeier needs four carries against UAB to set the single-season mark for rushing attempts in a season at BYU at 253, passing Ronney Jenkins 252 in 1998. Not out of the question but 174 yards would give him the single-season rushing yard mark at BYU, topping Luke Staley's 1,582 in 2001. A feat he accomplished earlier this year against Virginia, five touchdowns would also give him the single-season rushing touchdown record at BYU, passing Staley's 24 in 2001 as well. No one in school history in back-to-back seasons has rushed for more yards and scored more rushing touchdowns than Allgeier's 2,539 and 33 scores.

Linebackers coach Kevin Clune has 30 years while assistant head coach and safeties coach Ed Lamb is approaching 25 years on the job. Lamb and Clune, in addition to Tuaki, have experience as defensive coordinators.
- **STARTERS A PLENTY.** BYU's defense has had to use its depth in 2021. In all, 22 different players have started on the defensive side of the ball this year. - 16** Jake Oldroyd set a new BYU record at Utah State this year by extending his streak of consecutive successful field goals to 16 before suffering his first miss in the past two seasons. He was tied with Owen Pochman's for the consecutive field goals made record, which Pochman did in the 1999 season.
- 83** Against Arizona State, Ryan Rehkov set sail with an 83-yard punt for a new school record. The previous record came in 2014 when Scott Arello booted a kick 81 yards against Middle Tennessee.
- 712** With BYU scoring 66 points vs. Virginia, Jake Oldroyd set a new career high with 712 kickoff yards while equalling career marks with 11 kickoffs, 9 PATs and 9 PAT conversions. REHKOW AMONG ACADEMIC HONOREES

BYU football players Ryan Rehkov, Ben Bywater and James Empey were named to the 2021 CoSIDA Academic All-District 8 Team this season and are now being considered for Academic All-America honors.

The CoSIDA Academic All-District award recognizes the nation's top student-athletes for their combined performances on the field and in the classroom. To be eligible for nomination, student-athletes must be a starter or significant contributor and maintain a minimum 3.30 cumulative GPA.

District 8 honorees represent the states of Arizona, Utah, California, Oregon, Washington, Hawai'i and Alaska as well as Canada.

As first-team Academic All-District honorees, Empey, Rehkov and Bywater now advance to the CoSIDA Academic All-America ballot. First- and second-team Academic All-America honorees will be announced in mid-December.

Empey, who was also Academic All-District in 2019 and 2020, graduated this summer with a 3.84 GPA in finance with a minor in nonprofit management. A two-time team captain, Empey has started all 41 games he has played over his BYU career. He was a 2018 FWAA Freshman All-American and was named a 2021 preseason All-American center by both Phil Steele and Athlon Sports.

Rehkov is majoring in finance and has a 3.78 GPA. He was added to the watch list for the Ray Guy Award, awarded annually to the nation's top punter. Rehkov was honored as a Ray's 8 Award winner on Oct. 4.

Bywater is majoring in finance and has a 3.86 GPA. The linebacker from Salt Lake City leads BYU in tackles in his first season as a starter.

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) is in his sixth season overseeing the BYU football program in 2021. He signed a new contract on Friday that runs through the 2027 season.

This year he has been named a finalist for entry into the Polynesian Football Hall of Fame.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program. Sitake is the first former player under Edwards to be named head coach at BYU.

Named BYU's head coach on December 19, 2015, Sitake returned to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven seasons as a defensive coordinator and four years as an assistant head coach. He came to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in 2015 under head coach Gary Andersen. Sitake spent the prior 10 seasons at the University of Utah under head coach Kyle Whittingham. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012. He coached 12 all-conference honorees at Utah, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014).

During his career, Sitake has helped mentor 28 NFL Draft picks, including No. 2 overall pick Zach Wilson in the 2021 NFL Draft by the New York Jets. Sitake also coached BYU linebackers Sione Takitaki and Fred Warner and running back Jamaal Williams. Takitaki was a third-round pick of the Cleveland Browns in this year's draft and Warner was one of the league's top rookies after being taken in the third round in 2018 by the San Francisco 49ers.

Sitake has coached in 12 bowl games during his career and has been on the winning side in 10 of those 12 contests, including a 3-1 mark as a head coach. BYU is coming off a 49-23 win in the 2020 Boca Raton Bowl over UCF.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002 under Gary Crowton. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

He began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards. A team captain as a senior, Sitake's last game as a player was also the last game coached by the legendary Edwards, who was a great mentor for Sitake.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake is the nation's first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. Sitake and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
