BYU VS. VIRGINIA STORYLINES

- **BYU has won six consecutive season openers.** Those victories have come against Washington State (2012), Ole Miss (2011), Washington (2010), Oklahoma (2009), Northern Iowa (2008) and Arizona (2007). All but one of those season-opening wins has been over a BCS conference program.
- **This is the first meeting between BYU and UVA since 2000.** Virginia leads the series with BYU 2-1. BYU won the last meeting (in Charlottesville), 38-35, under LaVell Edwards.
- **Eleven Cougars were named to preseason watch lists,** highlighted by Preseason All-Americans Kyle Van Noy and Cody Hoffman. The 11 players were named to 14 different major award watch lists.
- **Van Noy and Hoffman received Phil Steele Preseason All-America honors** following their combined six All-America awards last season. Both were also named 2013 All-America candidates.
- **The Cougars are 7-12 against ACC foes,** with the last victory coming against Georgia Tech on the road in 2012. BYU defeated the Yellow Jackets 41-17 in October.
- **Hoffman needs three touchdowns, 538 yds and 19 receptions** to become the BYU all-time record holder in each of those categories. He needs four more 100-yard receiving games to become the BYU leader in that category and 942 yards to become the BYU all-time all-purpose yards leader.
- **Van Noy leads BYU's defense, which ranked No. 3 in total defense in 2012,** allowing an average of 266.1 yards per game. Van Noy tallied stats in every defensive category last season (the only player in D1 football to do so in 2012 and 2011).

A postgame press conference will be conducted in the LaVell Edwards Stadium press room, located on the southeast end of the stadium next to the BYU locker room. At the discretion of the visiting team, opponent interviews will be conducted in the Blue Zone, near the opponent's locker room located on northwest end of the stadium. Coach Mendenhall and select players will be available following the NCAA mandatory cooling off period. Members of the media are invited to move from the press box down to the field and to the press room four minutes prior to the ending of the game. For road games, BYU will conduct interviews outside the locker room or in a location designated by the host school.

BYU FOOTBALL 2012 SEASON REVIEW

A dominant defense led BYU to its seventh winning season in as many years as the BYU football team finished the 2012 season with eight wins, a program-best fourth consecutive bowl victory and the No. 3 defense in the nation.

With an 8-5 record, BYU claimed its sixth season with at least eight wins under Bronco Mendenhall's eight-year head coaching tenure.

Incredibly consistent all year long, BYU finished the year ranked No. 3 in total defense, allowing just 266.1 yards per game. In fact, the Cougars ended the season ranked in the top four in five major defensive categories.

BYU was No. 1 in third down conversions allowed (26.52 percent), No. 2 in rushing yards allowed (86.92 ypg), No. 2 in red zone conversions allowed (64.29 percent), No. 3 in scoring defense (14.0 ppg) and No. 4 in first downs allowed (14.7 per game).

The season was capped off by an incredible bowl game, this time the San Diego County Credit Union Poinsettia Bowl vs. familiar foe San Diego State.

BYU had four players earn All-America honors, including linebacker Kyle Van Noy, punter Riley Stephenson, wide receiver Cody Hoffman and defensive end Ezekiel Ansah. BYU also had 15 selections on Phil Steele's All-Independent teams and seven FBS All-Independent honorees.

With the return of Van Noy and Hoffman, along with several veterans and up-and-coming playmakers, the Cougars eye 2013 with optimism amidst a formidable challenge yet again.

NOTES FROM BYU'S LAST GAME

Trailing 6-3 heading into the fourth quarter, linebacker Kyle Van Noy sacked Aztec quarterback Adam Dingwell, stripping the ball and recovering it in the end zone for the touchdown. On the Aztecs' first play of the next possession Dingwell fumbled and Jordan Johnson recovered. Running back Jamaal Williams took it 14 yards for the first and only offensive touchdown of the game, giving BYU a 16-6 lead. Van Noy sealed the win with an interception and returned it 17 yards for a score, to give BYU a 23-6 bowl win.

- **Linebacker Kyle Van Noy had a huge game** with 8 tackles, 3.5 tackles for loss, 1.5 sacks, 1 forced fumble, 1 fumble recovery, 1 interception, 1 blocked punt and 2 touchdowns.
- **Punter Riley Stephenson booted eight punts for 268 yards**--six inside the 20, four inside the 5-yard line and two at the 1-yard line.
- **Wide receiver Cody Hoffman was named the Poinsettia Bowl offensive MVP.** Hoffman logged 114 yards on 10 catches.
- **Hoffman also moved into fifth all time at BYU with 2,718 career yards.** He also became just the third player in school history to record 100 receptions in a season.
- **With the victory, BYU has now won a school-best four bowl games in a row.** The Cougars have won six of their last eight bowl games.

VIRGINIA'S LAST GAME

With 3:30 left, Virginia and Virginia Tech were tied 14-14, and UVa had the ball. Junior quarterback Michael Rocco threw an interception that Tech cornerback Antone Exum returned to the UVa 24-yard line.

The Hokies then sent junior Cody Journell out to attempt a 29-yard field goal. UVa used its two timeouts -- one after the other -- hoping to unnerve Journell. Journell capitalized on his second chance, and his field goal as time expired lifted Tech to a 17-14 victory.



2012 Recap

- For the second time in their three seasons under London, the Hoos closed with an overall record of 4-8.
- The Cavaliers finished 2-6 in ACC play.
- UVa was 62nd in total offense (396.50) and 28th in total defense (144.92) during the 2012 season

2013 Preview

- The 2013 roster features 16 returning starters (seven on offense, seven on defense and two on special teams).
- Virginia has had at least 10 returning starters every year since 1998.
- Overall, UVa welcomes 39 lettermen back.
- The Cavaliers are 73-19-7 (.773) in home season openers and have won 16 of their last 19 openers in Scott Stadium.
- UVa head coach Mike London announced during a teleconference on Aug. 12 that David Watford would start against BYU in the season opener.
- Watford becomes the fourth different QB to start a game during the Mike London era at Virginia.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR THREE

BYU's 2013 schedule may be the toughest in program history. The 12-game schedule with six road games and six home games includes fellow independent Notre Dame and teams from eight different conferences, including the Atlantic Coast, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12, American Athletic, Conference USA, Mountain West and Big Sky.

BYU will face seven teams that participated in bowl games during the 2012 season, including Texas, Wisconsin, Georgia Tech, Boise State, Utah State, Nevada and Notre Dame, which played Alabama for the BCS National Championship. Four teams finished the 2012 season ranked in both the AP Top 25 and USA Today Coaches Poll, including Notre Dame (No. 4/No. 3), Utah State (16/17), Boise State (18/14) and Texas (19/18). Eight of the 12 opponents on the Cougars' 2013 schedule finished last season with a winning record, with FBS opponents combined for an 87-54 (.617) record in 2012. Four of BYU's opponents are ranked in the preseason top 25--No. 14/No.11 Notre Dame, 15/15 Texas, 19/19 Boise State and 23/23 Wisconsin.

FLAG BEARERS

BYU has a tradition of selecting a player before each game to run the team flag and alumni flag. The team selects a former Cougar to carry out the alumni flag, along with the chosen current player who runs out with the current team flag. The team flag has been signed by each member of the team, while the alumni flag has been signed by former BYU payers. In 2011, the team added a special teams flag, donned by a vintage BYU logo adopted by the special teams, following the same protocol as the team flag with an exemplary special teams player being chosen to carry it each week.

TEAM CAPTAINS

Selected by their peers, wide receiver Skyler Ridley, slot receiver JD Falslev, linebacker Uani 'Unga and safety Daniel Sorensen have been named team captains for the 2013 season. Three of the four captains started their BYU careers as walk-ons. In 2012, Ridley caught the first touchdown pass of the season and finished with 20 receptions for 206 yards and one touchdown. Falslev was second on the team with 37 receptions last season, while also returning punts and kickoffs. Sorensen is a three-year starter and led the team with three interceptions and was second on the team with 68 tackles. 'Unga recorded 28 tackles, three tackles for loss, one interception and one fumble recovery in his first year at BYU after transferring from Oregon State.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 64,045 after refurbishing the middle of the east section. The capacity now sits at 63,470 due to accommodations for wheelchair access. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's 2012 average attendance of 61,161 ranked No. 3 in the West behind only USC (87,945) and UCLA (68,481).

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates 405 missions around the world in 145 nations speaking 164 languages. More than 75,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 330 missions around the world. Seventy-five percent of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years or 18 months for women and couples—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

There are currently 57 missionaries from the football team serving in 18 different countries. Members of the current team cover five of the seven continents around the globe.

FIRESIDES CAPTAINS

The BYU football team will participate in hour-long devotionals prior or team service activities the night before each game this season. The team will conduct devotionals before eight games. These devotionals are referred to as "firesides" and are intended to help players, coaches and those who attend strengthen or gain a knowledge of our purpose here on earth. Firesides typically include a musical number from members of the team and talks from selected players, along with Bronco Mendenhall.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- **A loaded backfield** will take the pressure off sophomore QB Taysom Hill. With Doak Walker Award candidates Michael Alisa and Jamaal Williams leading the way and four other backs in Adam Hine, Paul Lasike, Algernon Brown and Iona Pritchard who will see significant playing time, the Cougars should see an increase in the running department.
- **Keep an eye out for The Hoff Show.** Wideout Cody Hoffman has an opportunity to end his Cougar career as possibly the best receiver in BYU history. He enters 2013 needing just 19 receptions, 538 yards and three touchdowns to take the top spot among the all-time leaders. As of now, Hoffman has amassed 203 receptions, 2,718 yards and 28 receiving touchdowns in his career, good for fourth, fifth and third, respectively, at BYU. Hoffman holds the record for receiving touchdowns in a game (5) and needs four 100-yard receiving games to have the most in program history.
- **Offensive staff overhaul.** BYU revamped the offensive coaching staff for the 2013 season. The new staff includes Robert Anae returning as the offensive coordinator for a second go-around with the Cougars after a two-year stint at Arizona. Joining Anae are offensive line coach Garrett Tujague, running backs coach Mark Atuaia, receivers coach Guy Holliday and quarterbacks coach Jason Beck. The new staff brings a variety of backgrounds and experience.
- **Go fast, go hard** has been the mantra of Coach Anae. With Coach Anae leading the offense again, he's brought the credo of "Go fast, go hard" to the team. Players conditioning has been ramped up with the expectation of nothing less than 100 percent on every drill, every rep and every workout.
- **New offense, new offensive line.** This year's projected five starting offensive linemen have started a combined total of 21 games, with all of those starts coming in 2012. Three of those players (Terrance Alletto, Brock Stringham and Michael Yeck) have never started a single game.
- **BYU has not been shutout for 113 consecutive games.** The last time the Cougars failed to score was in 2003 in a 3-0 loss to Utah. That loss was the only other time BYU has not produced points since 1975. BYU has scored in the last 475 of 476 games since 1975.

#4 Robertson Daniel, DB

The junior corner joins the Cougars after playing junior college at De Anza Junior College. Daniel recorded 90 tackles and six interceptions his freshman year before sitting out his sophomore year to concentrate on academics. Injuries have pushed him into the starting role at field corner.

#44 Remington Peck, DL

The graduation of Ezekiel Ansah gives way for the 6-foot-4 sophomore. Peck played in nine games as a redshirt freshman last season and recorded seven tackles and one sack. The athletic defensive end is quick off the ball and will put pressure on opposing quarterbacks each week.

#32 Mike Hague, DB

The former running back returns for a sixth year of eligibility after receiving a medical redshirt last season. Hague recorded six tackles in 2012 before his injury. The senior will see significant playing time at the boundary corner position.

#7 Skye PoVey, DB

The senior was limited to just three games last season because of a foot injury. The two-year let-terman is a strong defensive player with good instincts and a great understanding of the defensive schemes. PoVey is the brother-in-law of current defensive coordinator Nick Howell.

THE BYU DEFENSE

- **BYU finished the 2012 season ranked No. 3 in total defense.** The unit returns five starters to a defense that arguably was the best in team history. BYU finished the season No. 3 in the nation in total defense, ranking behind only Alabama and Florida State. The Cougars held opponents to an average of 266.1 yards per game, the lowest since 1974 when the Cougars held offenses to an average of 261 yards. The powerhouse held seven top-10 defensive rankings, including six top-5 rankings highlighted by the No. 1-ranked 3rd down defense and the No. 2 red zone defense.
- **One of everything, again.** After being the only Division I player to record a statistic in each of the major defensive categories in 2011, senior linebacker Kyle Van Noy repeated the same feat in 2012. The 6-foot-3, 245 pounder needed only a fumble recovery to duplicate his 2011 feat, which he did in the Poinsettia Bowl, stripping the San Diego State quarterback in the end zone and recovering that same fumble for a touchdown. The 2013 All-America candidate, who is also on the Bednarik Award, Nagurski Trophy, Butkus Award, Lombardi Award, Lott Impact Trophy, Maxwell Award and Walter Camp Award watch lists, was No. 3 in the nation in sacks (13) and No. 4 in tackles for loss (22). Van Noy led the No. 3 defensive unit in four categories, including tackles for loss (22), sacks (13), quarterback hurries (8) and forced fumbles (6) - a school record.
- **Going from outside back to inside.** Senior Spencer Hadley transitioned to the outside linebacker position last year, totaling 55 tackles and 9.0 tackles for loss. The 2013 Butkus Award candidate moves back to inside linebacker to allow Alani Fua to play outside backer. The 6-foot-1, 227 pound senior played in all 13 games and started one, against Texas, during his sophomore campaign at middle linebacker. Hadley will start alongside Fua, Kyle Van Noy and Uani 'Unga.
- **A large defensive line will help anchor the defense.** Eathyn Manumaleuna returns to the field after suffering a season-ending knee injury last year and receiving a medical redshirt. The fifth-year senior and Outland Trophy candidate has started 38 games over his four-year career at both defensive end and defensive tackle. True sophomore and Ted Hendricks candidate Bronson Kaufusi and redshirt sophomore Remington Peck join Manumaleuna on the line, as defensive ends. In the mix for extensive playing time is junior Marques Johnson who redshirted last season. Combined, the four average a commanding 6-foot-4 and 283 pounds, and will look to wreck havoc in opposing backfield's all year long.
- **Behind enemy lines.** The Cougars have tallied at least 5.0 TFL in 12 of 13 games in 2012 with a season-best 11.0 TFL against Utah. The Cougars finished the season with two consecutive 8.0 TFL performances against New Mexico State and San Diego State in the Poinsettia Bowl game. Kyle Van Noy led the defensive attack with 6.5 TFL in those games while five other players also made their mark. BYU finished the season T-No. 23 nationally in TFL, averaging 6.92 per game with 90 total.
- **Injuries are part of the game.** The defensive unit has been stung by the injury bug during the offseason and fall camp. JC transfer Trent Trammell, who was expected to fight for the starting job at boundary corner, tore his ACL during spring camp. Jordan Johnson, who started at all 13 games last season at field corner, tore his ACL during the first week of fall camp. Backup corner Adam Hogan tore three muscles in his quad during fall camp and will be out 3-4 weeks. The injuries have forced new players into the ever-important corner position, including true freshman Michael Davis who began fall camp as a wideout.

HEAD COACH BRONCO MENDENHALL

YEARS AT BYU

Entering 9th year as head coach, 11th at BYU

YEARS OVERALL

Entering 25th year

In his eight seasons as head coach at Brigham Young University, Bronco Mendenhall has restored tradition to the Cougars as one of the nation's top teams. Taking over a BYU program in 2005 that was coming off three losing seasons, Mendenhall has guided his teams to eight straight bowl invitations, two outright conference championships and regular national top-25 rankings. The Cougars finished the 2012 regular season 8-5, with a program-record fourth consecutive bowl victory, won four of their last five games and had the No. 3-ranked total defense in the nation.

Under his leadership, BYU has earned a 74-29 (.718) record to date to rank No. 12 in total wins among all teams in the nation since 2005. The Cougars have received eight straight bowl invitations for the first time since a string of 17 consecutive bowls invitations from 1978 through 1994. Mendenhall is the only coach in BYU football history that took his first eight teams to a bowl game and has the highest winning percentage of any coach in school history. He also has more wins in his first 100 contests at BYU than Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards.

Mendenhall has led BYU to bowl wins in six of the last seven seasons to become the first Cougar teams to ever win six bowls in a seven-year span and win four in a row. Nationally, no one has won more bowl games over the past eight years and BYU is one of only seven programs to win six bowl games in the last eight seasons. The Cougars have won 10 or more games in five of Mendenhall's eight seasons overall.

BYU's success under Mendenhall is also evident in the national rankings and NCAA statistics. BYU has finished ranked in the top 25 in the various national statistical categories 127 times in his eight seasons (47 offense, 58 defense, 20 special teams, 2 misc.). The Cougars have achieved 78 top-15 statistical rankings, 58 top-10 rankings and 27 top-5 rankings in that span. The Cougars have also been ranked in the top-25 polls during seven of the past eight seasons and finished ranked in five seasons, including No. 12 following the 2009 season -- the program's highest final ranking since finishing No. 5 in 1996.

Another hallmark of Mendenhall's program has been the emphasis on balance and priorities in the many other facets of life outside of football. Reflecting that emphasis, BYU consistently received the most academic all-conference honorees each season as a conference member, while six Cougar student-athletes have earned seven Academic All-America citations under Mendenhall. Only three teams have had more Academic All-America citations during Mendenhall's tenure. BYU has led all FBS programs three of the last four years for the most selections to the NFF Hampshire Honor Society (3.2 GPA over college career).

He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at his alma mater, Oregon State. He later coached at Snow College, Northern Arizona, became the youngest defensive coordinator in the Pac-10 at Oregon State and went to Louisiana Tech and New Mexico before coming to BYU as a defensive coordinator in 2003.

Hailing from Alpine, Utah, Mendenhall is married to Holly Johnston of Missoula, Mont. They have three sons, Cutter, Breaker and Raeder.

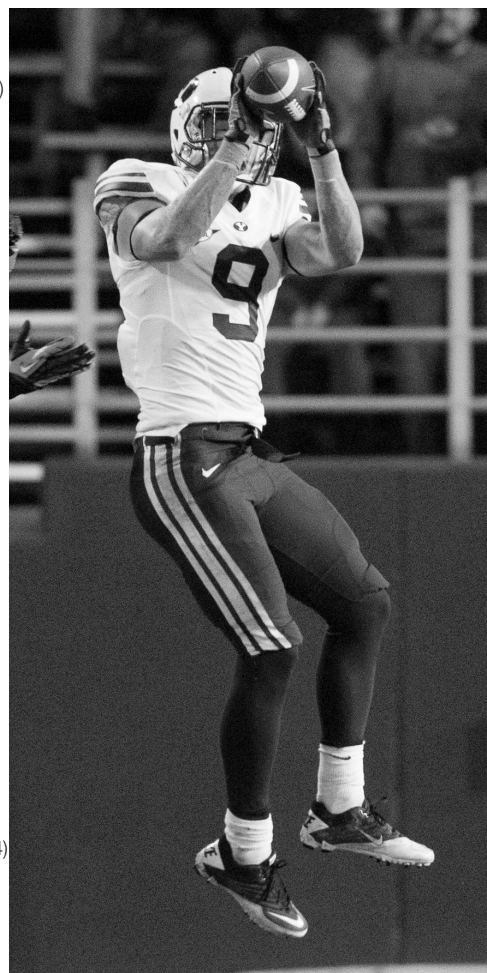
