• **THE SERIES**. BYU and Utah State are meeting for the 90th time since 1922. The Cougars won the last matchup, a 42-14 victory in Logan to take back the Old Wagon Wheel after it spent back-to-back years with the Aggies for the first time since it spent four consecutive years in Logan from 1971-74. BYU has dominated the last 25 matchups, going 20-5. The game has been more evenly matched recently, with the last four contests split at 2-2 under head coach Kalani Sitake.

- **THE OLD WAGON WHEEL.** The Old Wagon Wheel became a part of the BYU-Utah State rivalry in 1948. Awarded by the Blue Key fraternities of the two schools, the Aggies took it home the first year after a 20-7 defeat of the Cougars. Since 1948 when the Old Wagon Wheel became a part of the rivalry, BYU owns a 41-25 record.
- FRIDAY NIGHT LIGHTS. BYU is playing its first Friday game of the year against the Aggies. BYU has won four consecutive Friday games and is 7-3 under Kalani Sitake in Friday games.
- IN THE TOP 15. After three Pac-12 wins, two wins over ranked teams and another win last week, BYU came in at No. 13 in the AP Top 25 and No. 15 in the Coaches Poll this week. The Cougars are 13-2 under Kalani Sitake when ranked.
- **BIG 12.** On Friday, Sept. 10, 2021, BYU accepted an offical invitation to join the Big 12 Conference in all sports. The Cougars joined Cincinnati, Houston and UCF as the four new members. BYU is expected to play its first season in the Power 5 conference in 2023. The Cougars have a record of 84-48 since becoming an independent in 2011. (Read more)
- **TURNOVER MARGIN.** The Cougars are +6 in turnovers through four games, picking up eight and giving up only two. BYU has won 18 consecutive games when even or ahead in the turnover battle.
- WINNING. BYU is 15-1 since the beginning of the 2020 season. Only No. 1 Alabama has more wins (16) since 2020. BYU is one of 26 remaining undefeated FBS teams. BYU is on a six-game winning streak, with two wins to end the 2020 season and a 4-0 start to 2021. The Cougars have opened 4-0 in back-to-back seasons for the first time in program history. BYU has only had six 5-0 starts in its history (1979, 1981, 1984, 2001, 2008, 2020).
- **STAYING IN FRONT.** BYU is one of 6 teams who have yet to trail at any time in a game to start the 2021 season. The Cougars have scored first in every game and have been tied only once after their first score (7-7, ASU). BYU is 26-6 under Kalani Sitake when scoring first.

#### INDEPENDENCE: YEAR ELEVEN

After finishing the 2020 season 11-1, BYU enters its 11th season as an independent. This season, the Cougars play seven teams from Power 5 conferences, including three to start the year. BYU will face five teams from the Pac-12 in Arizona, Utah, Arizona State, Washington State and USC. The Cougars will also match up with Baylor of the Big 12 and Virginia of the ACC. In addition to those Power 5 matchups, BYU also plays in-state foe Utah State along with Mountain West power Boise State. The Cougars will host USF of the American and Idaho State from the FCS.

#### LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's winning percentage at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 14 among teams playing in their current stadium. *Stadium record: 250-80 (.758)*

#### MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates more than 400 missions around the world in over 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. More than 53,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 65 percent of the current team has served a mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. More than 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) are currently serving in the mission field.

#### HONOR CODE

BYU's Honor Code helps maintain this learning environment. Initiated by students in 1949, the Honor Code emphasizes being honest, living a chaste and virtuous life, abstaining from alcohol and tobacco, using clean language, and following other values in line with the doctrines of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.

#### POLYNESIAN PIPELINE

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. About 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Fesi Sitake Harvey Unga, Nu'u Tafisi, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You, Al Pupunu and Vince Feula.

#### #1 Keanu Hill, WR, R-Fr.

Hill is a big-bodied receiver that played in eight games in 2020 and caught four passes for 70 yards and one touchdown. Hill caught a 33-yard pass against Utah.

#### #5 Chris Jackson, WR, Jr.

The junior college transfer caught two passes for 20 yards against Arizona.

#### #7 Hinckley Ropati, RB, So.

Another junior college transfer, Ropati missed the 2020 season with injury but will be expected to have a role in the backfield for 2021.

#### #12 Puka Nacua, WR, So.

The Washington transfer played in 11 games for the Huskies over two seasons, recording 16 receptions for 319 yards and three touchdowns. Nacua had his best game as a Cougar with a career-best 102 yards on four catches, including a 55-yarder against USF.

#### #13 Masen Wake, TE/FB, So.

Played in all 12 games and started six in 2020. Had eight receptions for 114 yards and one touchdown while adding five carries for 15 yards and another score. Had a career-high five receptions and 24 yards including a 5-yard TD against USF.

#### #16 Baylor Romney, QB, R-So.

• COACHING EXPERIENCE. The BYU offensive staff has nearly 100 years of coaching experience. Offensive line coach Darrell Funk has the most with more than 30 years. Tight ends coach Steve Clark has been coaching since 1994 and passing game coordinator Aaron Roderick has 22 years in the profession. Funk, Roderick, Clark and wide receivers coach Fesi Sitake have all been coordinators at the college level.

• TWO BY TWO. BYU features a pair of tight ends, a pair of running backs, and a pair of receivers poised to make a huge impact. Tight ends Isaac Rex and Dallin Holker could be a matchup nightmare. Rex, the 6-foot-6, 247-pound red zone threat caught 12 touchdowns last season while the speedy Holker caught 19 passes for 235 yards as a true freshman before a church mission. Running backs Tyler Allgeier and Lopini Katoa have combined for more than 3,000 rushing yards and have 34 rushing touchdowns. Wideouts Gunner Romney and Nei'l Pau'u have posted more than 2,700 receiving yards and 20 touchdowns.

Against Arizona State, BYU capitalized on four turnovers. It was the most turnovers BYU has forced this season. The Cougars tallied two interceptions and two forced fumbles in the game.

The BYU defense has created 8 turnovers on the year to help the team earn a No. 9 ranking in turnover margin (1.5). 8 BYU has made four interceptions with four fumble recoveries through four games while the offense has only given up two interceptions.

BYU has 9 sacks, averaging 2.25 sacks per game. The Cougar defense has also interupted opponents in their backfield with 24 tackles for loss on the year, averaging 8 per gaame.

The Cougars are holding opponents to under 20 points a game at 19.2 after four games. Despite being the only team in 19.2 the country to face three straight Power 5 conference teams to open the season, BYU held all three (Arizona, Utah, Arizona State) to 17 points or less.

**42.8** BYU's red zone defense is only allowing opponents to convert touchdowns 42.8 percent of the time it enters the red zone. In 14 red zone attempts, BYU opponents have scored six touchdowns. Opponents have been held to four field goals inside the red zone and on four other occasions kept off the scoreboard entirely.

## COACH SITAKE/COACHES NOTES - 13

**KALANI SITAKE** HEAD COACH YEARS AT BYU 6th year at BYU YEARS OVERALL 6th year as head coach, 21 years in coaching

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) enters his sixth season overseeing the BYU football program in 2021.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program. Sitake is the first former player under Edwards to be named head coach at BYU.

Named BYU's head coach on December 19, 2015, Sitake returned to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven seasons a defensive coordinator and four years as an assistant head coach. He came to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in 2015 under head coach Gary Andersen. Sitake spent the prior 10 seasons at the University of Utah under head coach Kyle Whittingham. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012. He coached 12 all-conference honorees at Utah, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014).

During his career. Sitake has helped mentor 28 NFL Draft picks. including No. 2 overall pick Zach Wilson in the 2021 NFL Draft by the New York Jets. Sitake also coached BYU linebackers Sione Takitaki and Fred Warner and running back Jamaal Williams. Takitaki was a third-round pick of the Cleveland Browns in this year's draft and Warner was one of the league's top rookies after being taken in the third round in 2018 by the San Francisco 49ers.

Sitake has coached in 12 bowl games during his career and has been

on the winning side in 10 of those 12 contests, including a 3-1 mark as a head coach. BYU is coming off a 49-23 win in the 2020 Boca Raton Bowl over UCF.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002 under Gary Crowton. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

He began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards. A team captain as a senior, Sitake's last game as a player was also the last game coached by the legendary Edwards, who was a great mentor for Sitake.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake is the nation's first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. Sitake and his wife Timberly have three children. Skve. Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
