BYU STORYLINES

- BYU has evened its WCC record with victories over San Diego (87-53) and Pepperdine (84-72). The Cougars have a chance to move a game over .500 in WCC play for the first time when they host Loyola Marymount on Saturday.
- In his second-straight start, Skyler Halford followed his career-high 28 points vs. San Diego with 18 points vs. Pepperdine. In two starts, he is averaging 23 points and three 3-pointers.
- Sophomore guard Kyle Collinsworth is one of only three players in the nation to rank in the top 125 in both assists and rebounds per game, along with UCLA's Kyle Anderson and Vermont's Brian Voelkel. Collinsworth, Anderson and Voelkel are also the only three players in the country that average at least 5.0 assists and 8.0 rebounds.

BY THE NUMBERS

- 1.7** Matt Carlino's career steals average, second all-time in BYU history. His 129 career steals are tied for 10th all-time and the 64 he totaled in 2012-13 as a sophomore are the fourth most in team history.
- 2** The number of players in BYU history to reach 1,000 career points as a sophomore. Danny Ainge was the first to do so and had 1,130 points in 57 games by the end of his sophomore season (1978-79). Sophomore Tyler Haws joined Ainge when he reached the 1,000 career point mark at Saint Mary's on Feb. 21, 2013.
- 3** The number of players in the NCAA ranked in the top 125 in both rebounding and assists: BYU's Kyle Collinworth (32nd in assists, 78th in rebounding), UCLA's Kyle Anderson (10th in assists, 49th in rebounding) and Vermont's Brian Voelkel (29th in assists and 84th in rebounding). The three are also the only players in the country that average at least 5.0 assists and 8.0 rebounds per game (rankings as of 1/9/14).
- 4.7** Matt Carlino's career assist average, second all-time in BYU history. As a freshman in 2011-12, he averaged 4.6 assists and in 2012-13, he averaged 4.8. His 171 assists last season are the third most in team history. Carlino is averaging 4.6 assists per game this season and tied his career high with 11 against North Texas.
- 6** The number of career games for Tyler Haws shooting 100 percent from the free throw line with a minimum of 10 attempts, a BYU record. He hit 10 of 10 on Feb. 20, 2010 at Wyoming, 12 of 12 vs. Cal State Northridge on Nov. 24, 2012, 10 of 10 vs. Utah on Dec. 8, 2012, 10 of 10 at Weber State on Dec. 15, 2012, 14 of 14 at Loyola Marymount on March 2, 2013 and 11 of 11 vs. Wichita State on Nov. 26, 2013.
- 8** With a bid to the 2013 NIT, Dave Rose and the Cougars reached the postseason for a BYU record eighth-straight season. In his first year as head coach, Rose and the Cougars went to the 2006 NIT. That was followed by six-straight trips to the NCAA Tournament and last season's NIT bid. BYU has also won 20-plus games in each of Rose's eight seasons.
- 30** The number of consecutive games Tyler Haws has scored in double figures, a career-best streak and tied for 10th-best in BYU history.
- 39** The number of 20-point games Haws has in his career at BYU, fifth all-time in program history. He had 25 20-point games in 2012-13, fourth all-time in a single season.
- 83.3** BYU's 3-point percentage against Texas (10 of 12), a BYU single-game record (minimum 10 3-pointers attempted). Matt Carlino hit 5 of 7, Frank Bartley IV hit 3 of 3 and Tyler Haws hit 2 of 2.
- 88.7** Tyler Haws' career free-throw percentage, first all-time in BYU history. He has hit 394 of 444 from the line in his career.
- 90.0** Eric Mika's shooting percentage against Mount St. Mary's, tied for the BYU freshman record for field goal percentage in a game (minimum 10 attempts). The freshman from Alpine, Utah, hit 9 of 10 from the field and scored 20 points. He shares the record with Fred Roberts, who also hit 9 of 10 vs. Utah State on Dec. 6, 1978.
- 112** BYU's point total against Stanford, a 112-103 road win. The point total is the most by a BYU team under Dave Rose and the most since Feb. 25, 1993, when the Cougars scored 128 at home against Sacramento State. It also marked a BYU record for points scored against a Pac-12 team.
- 219** Dave Rose (2005 to present) is second all-time in BYU basketball history with 219 career victories, behind only the great Stan Watts, who coached the Cougars to 371 wins from 1949 to 1972 and was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 1986.
- 1,515** The number of points Tyler Haws has scored in his career, good for 14th all-time and four from tying Jonathan Tavernari for 13th. Haws holds the BYU record for most points scored during freshman and sophomore seasons combined. With 952 career points, Matt Carlino is on pace to become the next BYU player to reach 1,000 career points.

HAWS' SEASON HIGH LEADS COUGARS OVER WAVES

PROVO, Utah – Tyler Haws' season-high 35 points led the BYU men's basketball team to an 84-72 victory over the Pepperdine Waves on Thursday.

"That was quite a battle," BYU basketball coach Dave Rose said. "It was an interesting game because I think both teams prepared for a rematch of the game a few days ago and it turned out that both teams played completely different lineups than they did the first game. It was a good game that went right down to the wire and we made some big shots and stops late."

Kyle Collinworth nearly had a triple-double with 15 points, 10 rebounds and nine assists, while Skyler Halford added 18 points and a career-high six rebounds. Nate Austin ended with six points, nine rebounds and two blocks.

The Cougars (10-7, 2-2) started the first half on a 12-0 run that included consecutive 3-pointers by Halford and Haws. A strong move down the lane by Haws gave BYU the 12-0 lead at the 16:46 mark. Pepperdine (10-7, 3-2) answered back to cut BYU's lead 18-17, but BYU responded with a 6-0 run that included an Austin a putback layup and a reverse layup by Collinworth at the 7:40 mark.

With 5:46 remaining in the half, Haws made a layup to make it a three-point game after the Waves cut the lead back to one. Austin's dive to the floor led to a Haws floater to grab the two-point lead after Pepperdine tied the game at 28 apiece with 2:28 left in the half. With seven seconds remaining, Halford drove to the rim to give BYU a 33-30 lead at the half.

Haws led all players at halftime with 13 points. Halford and Collinworth each added seven points of their own.

Halford opened the second half on a solo 5-0 run with a 3-pointer and a drive to the rim to put BYU up 38-30. Austin recorded his second block of the game at the 16:24 mark, which was followed by a three-point play by Haws on a baseline drive to make it 45-40. Matt Carlino, who finished with 10 points and six assists, made his first field goal of the game from beyond the arc with 10:56 left in the game to grab the eight-point lead.

With under 10 minutes left to play, Collinworth's fadeaway jumper gave BYU the 57-48 lead. The Waves came back to make it a two-point game, but the Cougars responded with a baseline jumper by Halford and back-to-back 3-pointers by Haws to grab the 70-60 lead and to cap an 8-0 run with 3:44 remaining in the game. Out of BYU's last 19 points, Haws scored 12 to end the game.

The Cougars finished the second half with a 53.6 shooting percentage, while keeping Pepperdine to 38.7 percent. They also outrebounded the Waves 40-23, with 17 offensive rebounds, and outscored them in the paint 34-22 for the game.

2013-14 STORYLINES AND NOTES

Dave Rose

BYU head coach Dave Rose has led BYU to one of the most successful runs in program history since taking over in 2005. His career record of 219-73 ranks him second in BYU history in total victories and first in winning percentage (.750). Rose has been named conference coach of the year three times, district coach of the year twice, led the Cougars to four conference titles, six NCAA Tournament appearances, two NIT appearances, six 25-win seasons and eight 20-win seasons. In 2010, he led BYU to its first NCAA Tournament win in 17 years and the Cougars have also won at least one postseason game in the three seasons since, including a spot in the Sweet 16 in 2011 and a trip to the NIT semifinals in 2013.

Return of Kyle Collinworth

The 2013-14 season marks the return of sophomore guard Kyle Collinworth, who spent the last two years serving a mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in Russia. As a freshman in 2010-11 he averaged 5.8 points and 5.1 rebounds, 2.1 assists and 1.1 steals while shooting .481 from the field. Collinworth started 27 games on a BYU team that won a team record 32 games and advanced to the Sweet 16 of the 2011 NCAA Tournament. Collinworth is averaging 13.1 points, 8.4 rebounds, 5.6 assists and 1.5 steals this season.

Fantastic freshman

Big man Eric Mika is having one of the top freshman campaigns in BYU history. He is currently ranked in the top six in several categories in the BYU record book, including: scoring (5th), rebounding (6th), field goal percentage (2nd), offensive rebounds (T-6th), double-figure scoring games (T-10th) and consecutive games scoring in double figures (T-2nd).

Record streaks

The Cougars are looking to keep several program-record streaks intact during 2013-14. Coming into the season, Dave Rose has led the Cougars to eight-straight 20-win seasons, eight-straight postseason appearances, eight-straight seasons with 10-plus conference victories and four-straight seasons with a postseason victory.

Rose vs. the state

BYU basketball coach Dave Rose has compiled a record of 29-7 vs. in-state opponents since taking over in 2005-06. He has the best winning percentage (.806) of any coach vs. in-state teams during that time and the most wins (Utah State's Stew Morrill is second in both categories with a 27-10 record vs. in-state teams since 2005-06 for a .730 winning percentage). BYU defeated Weber State 81-72 in the season opener, defeated Utah State 85-74 at EnergySolutions Arena on Nov. 30 and lost 81-64 to Utah on Dec. 14.
