UAB AND BYU SQUARE OFF IN RADIANCE TECHNOLOGIES INDEPENDENCE BOWL:

Playing in the program's fifth bowl game, the UAB football team faces No. 13 BYU in the 2021 Radiance Technologies Independence Bowl on Dec. 18 in Shreveport, La. UAB has been bowl eligible all six years under the direction of Head Coach Bill Clark (2014, 2017-2021), but missed the postseason in 2014 when the program was shut down and last year after South Carolina withdrew from the Gasparilla Bowl. UAB won the program's first bowl game in 2018 with a 37-13 victory over Northern Illinois in the Boca Raton Bowl, and a win over BYU would not only be UAB's second bowl win, but just its fourth victory over a nationally ranked opponent.

UAB LANDS 23 PLAYERS ON ALL-CONFERENCE USA TEAMS:

Led by redshirt seniors Colby Ragland and Tyree Turner, the Blazers had 23 players earn All-Conference USA postseason honors. Ragland is now a two-time First Team honoree and has started 32-consecutive games on the offensive line. Ragland started the first five games of this season at left guard, and finished the final seven games at right tackle. At nose tackle, Turner was a major force in helping UAB rank 14th nationally in rush defense. Turner recorded 20 tackles, 5.0 TFL, 3.5 sacks and two forced fumbles, and his impact in the trenches went well beyond his stat line. Additionally, RB DeWayne McBride, TE Gerrit Prince, DE Alex Wright and S Grayson Cash were Second Team All-Conference USA selections (see page 11 for full list of postseason honorees).

MCBRIDE RUNS WILD IN SECOND HALF OF THE SEASON:

After compiling 395 rushing yards in his first six games, sophomore running back DeWayne McBride exploded in the second half of the season, tallying 794 of his 1,188 total rushing yards in his final six games. His 1,188 rushing yards and 12 touchdowns are both currently the fifth most in a single season at UAB. McBride ranks fourth nationally with an average of 6.75 yards per carry and is one of the best backs in the nation in yards after contact.

UAB DEFENSE ONCE AGAIN AMONGST NATION'S BEST:

The Blazers have always hung their hat on defense and 2021 was no exception. UAB enters the bowl game ranked 15th nationally in total defense (323.3). Despite missing key pieces due to season ending injuries, the Blazers still have an opportunity to finish inside the top 10 nationally. If they can do so, it would be their fourth straight year finishing top 10 nationally in total defense.

42 WINS AND COUNTING:

UAB has won 42 games since returning to action in 2017, the most wins of any C-USA team during that span. The Blazers are 42-20 overall dating back to the 2017 season and are the first team in C-USA history to win their division three years in a row (2018-2020). UAB has been dominant against league action, compiling an overall record of 30-9 vs. Conference USA and a mark of 22-5 against West divisional opponents during that span.

HEAD COACH

SIXTH SEASON AT UAB

JACKSONVILLE STATE '90

OVERALL RECORD: 59-30

AT UAB: 48-26

Bill Clark is a native of Anniston, Alabama. He graduated from Jacksonville State University in 1990 with a degree in physical education and began his football coaching career that year. His head coaching record at UAB is 48-26 and he is 59-30 as a Division I head coach.

Clark has guided the Blazers to unprecedented success in five years as head coach, including winning the Conference USA Championship in 2018 and 2020, and claiming a C-USA record three straight C-USA West Divisional titles (2018-2020). The Conference USA Championships are the first two in program history.

Not only has Clark led the program to new heights, but it has all been crafted through the most unique situation in recent college football history. Following his first year at UAB in 2014, Clark stayed as head coach through the program's shutdown and two-year hiatus.

In 2015 and 2016, Clark reconstructed a team from scratch, and when UAB returned to FBS competition in 2017 after two years away, he guided the Blazers to an 8-5 overall record and the team's first bowl appearance since 2004.

Clark was named the CBS Sports National Coach of the Year, as well as the Conference USA Coach of the Year. He was also presented the Thomas Brookshier Spirit Award by the Maxwell Football Club.

The eight wins in 2017 established a new FBS school record, until that mark was shattered just a year later.

UAB finished 2018 with a school record 11 wins. On December 1, 2018, the Blazers won their first Conference USA Championship by traveling to Murfreesboro, Tenn., and defeating Middle Tennessee 27-25 in dramatic fashion on the Blue Raiders' home field to claim the league title. UAB became the first C-USA team in league history to win a conference title game on the road.

The Blazers not only won their first C-USA Championship, but Clark guided UAB to a 37-13 win over Northern Illinois in the Cheribundi Boca Raton Bowl on Dec. 18, 2018, marking UAB's first bowl victory.

The national accolades once again poured in for Clark as he was named the 2018 FWAA Eddie Robinson National Coach of the Year, as well being named the CBS Sports National Coach of the Year for a second-consecutive year. Overall, UAB set 21 school records in 2018.

UAB finished 2019 with a record of 9-5 and appeared in its second-consecutive C-USA title game and third-consecutive bowl game. The Blazers played No. 20 Appalachian State in the R+L Carriers New Orleans Bowl.

In 2020, not only did Clark lead UAB to another C-USA title, but he did so by maneuvering through the COVID-19 pandemic. The Blazers endured the nation's longest layoff of 42 days in between games (including missing the entire month of November), but returned to the playing field on Dec. 12 to defeat Rice for the West Division crown and then topped Marshall 22-13 six days later to win the league championship.

Since returning to action in 2017, the Blazers have compiled the most wins of any team in Conference USA (34). UAB is 24-7 against league opponents during that span and 18-3 against C-USA West Division opponents.

Known as a defensive minded coach, Clark's defense has paved the way for UAB's success as the Blazers have finished Top 10 nationally in total defense each of the last three seasons.

Additionally, UAB has been extraordinary in third down situations, finishing second nationally in third down defense in 2018 (.260), third nationally in 2019 (.283), and seventh in 2020 (.298).

Offensively, the Blazers have been led by record-setting running back Spencer Brown, who finished as UAB's career leader in every rushing category. Brown's illustrious career ended in being named the Conference USA Championship Game MVP, becoming the first player in league history to earn that honor twice. Brown is the school record holder for rushing yards (4,011), rushing touchdowns (41), total touchdowns (42) and 100-yard games (19). In 2017, Brown was named UAB's first FWAA Freshman All-American in school history and his 1,329 rushing yards as a rookie were the second most in C-USA history.

Clark's momentum has galvanized a community as UAB has averaged 25,130 fans since 2017, which is 3,000 more on average than any other C-USA school. The 2017 season started in record-setting fashion as 45,212 fans poured into Legion Field to watch the season opener, a 38-7 victory over Alabama A&M, which established a new UAB attendance record.

Prior to the start of the 2017 season, the Blazers moved into their new state-of-the-art Football Operations Center which features coaches offices, meeting and film rooms, athletic training facilities, locker rooms, a weight room, a nutrition station and two full turf practice fields. One of those practice fields is under a pioneering open-air covered pavilion made possible by Legacy Community Federal Credit Union.

Legacy Credit Union announced the largest-ever sponsorship with UAB, a 20-year, \$4.2 million naming right agreement for Legacy Pavilion, and in the process, became the official credit union of UAB.

The momentum has continued as UAB Football moves into Protective Stadium in 2021. The new stadium, in the heart of downtown Birmingham, will seat approximately 45,000 fans and will be one of the nicest college football stadiums in the country.

In Clark's first season as head coach of the Blazers in 2014, he turned around a program that was 2-10 the year before into a team that finished 6-6 and earned bowl eligibility for the first time since 2004. J.J. Nelson was named the school's first Walter Camp First Team All-American.

Prior to UAB, Clark was the head coach at Jacksonville State in 2013 and led the Gamecocks to an 11-4 record, their most victories since the 1992. That number set an Ohio Valley Conference record and was also the most wins by a first-year head coach.

Jacksonville State earned an at-large berth in the FCS Playoffs and captured two victories -- including a second-round win over No. 6 McNeese State to reach the quarterfinals. The wins were the Gamecocks' first-ever in the NCAA Division I playoffs.

JSU concluded the 2013 season ranked No. 10 in the final FCS poll. The Gamecocks, who ranked sixth in the nation in FCS attendance, set 49 school records in 2013 and broke 13 OVC marks, as well as three NCAA records. JSU had two players earn All-America honors and nine selected for All-Ohio Valley Conference accolades.

Clark became Jacksonville State's head coach after five outstanding seasons at South Alabama as the Jaguars' defensive coordinator.

Clark's defense at USA finished second in the Sun Belt Conference in total defense in 2012 as the Jaguars completed their first full season of competition in the league. South Alabama posted the best record of any Division I FCS Independent in 2011 after winning the first 17 games in the program's history in 2009 and 2010.

Clark joined South Alabama in 2008 after spending nine years as head coach at Prattville (Ala.) High School where he led the Lions to national prominence. He won a pair of Class 6A State Championships as his last two teams won 30 straight games, while the 2007 squad was ranked No. 2 in USA Today's national high school poll.

Following his final season at Prattville High School, he was named the Alabama High School Athletic Association Coach of the Year and was also selected as the Schutt Southeast Regional Coach of the Year.

He first led the Lions to the Class 6A state playoffs in 2000, his second season guiding the program. Clark earned his first postseason victory a year later, helping Prattville advance to the quarterfinals.

Prattville made its first state championship game appearance under Clark in 2004, with the team allowing three touchdowns in four postseason contests, including a pair of shutouts. The Lions advanced to the quarterfinals of the 2005 playoffs before dropping a two-point decision.

Clark posted a 107-11 overall record during his tenure (90.7 percent) at Prattville.

Clark served on the staff of the Alabama-Mississippi All-Star Classic three times, including as head coach in the summer of 2007. He also served as head coach in the 2004 North-South All-Star Game. Clark began his coaching career as an assistant at Piedmont High School (1990-91) and also has coaching stints at Tuscaloosa County High School (1992-94), Coffee County (Ga.) High School (1995-96) and Dothan High School (1997-98).

Clark and his wife, Jennifer, have two children: daughter, Katie and son Jacob. His son Jacob appeared in all 27 games for UAB throughout the 2017 and 2018 seasons, and served as a graduate assistant in 2019.

TOTAL DEFENSE

In the final six games of the regular season, UAB held its opponents to a combined 1,746 total yards (291.0/game), including just 107 against Southern Miss. UAB has finished top 10 nationally in total defense each of the last three years and are moving up after their last few outings. UAB is currently 15th nationally in total defense (323.3).

GRAYSON CASH SETS SCHOOL RECORD FOR LONGEST INT RETURN

Safety Grayson Cash set a school record and tied a Conference USA record when he intercepted Florida Atlantic's N'kosi Perry and returned it 100 yards for a touchdown. His 100-yard touchdown was the longest interception return for a touchdown in program history and he is now just one of 11 players in C-USA history to have a 100-yard interception return for a touchdown.

Cash also had an interception with 1:31 left in the fourth quarter to seal the game at Marshall, giving UAB a 21-14 victory.

SWOOPES TALLIES BACK-TO-BACK INTERCEPTIONS

Junior Keondre Swoopes had back-to-back games with interceptions at Georgia and at North Texas. He and Grayson Cash are the only players on the current roster who have had interceptions in back-to-back games. Swoopes had a 61-yard interception return for a touchdown at Georgia in Week 2, and followed that up with an interception on North Texas' first offensive play in Week 3.

THIRD DOWN DEFENSE

UAB held UTEP to 3-of-13 on third down last time out. The Blazers are currently 27th nationally in third down defense (60-of-173, .347). This is a category UAB has excelled at over the years as the Blazers were 2nd in 2018, 3rd in 2019 and 7th in 2020.

MONTGOMERY, Ala. – The UAB football team dominated all three phases of the game en route to a 31-0 shutout victory over Jacksonville State on Wednesday night in the Montgomery Kickoff at the Cramton Bowl.

The Blazers outgained the Gamecocks 518-155, marking UAB's first 500-yard game since Week 3 of last season and its first shutout since 2018 (when the Blazers had three that season). Bill Clark is now 6-0 in season openers as UAB's head coach.

UAB (1-0) scored on three straight possessions starting late in the second quarter through the opening drive of the second half, building a 17-0 lead just under three minutes into the third quarter. The Blazers had 336 of their 518 yards in the second half, and overall featured a very balanced attack, throwing for 371 yards and running for 147 yards on the ground.

Redshirt senior quarterback Tyler Johnston III led the Blazers' offense with 320 passing yards and two touchdowns. Johnston III moved into tie for third all-time in UAB career touchdown passes (37) and is alone in fourth for career passing yards (4,749). The Spanish Fort native had his fifth career 300-yard passing performance this evening.

Senior safety Dy'jonn Turner paced a dominant defensive performance with six tackles and a pass breakup. UAB's defense allowed just two Jacksonville State drives to travel over 25 yards, holding the Gamecocks under 100 yards of total offense until the 2:38-mark in the third quarter. UAB had nine pass breakups total, including a game-high three by freshman Mac McWilliams.

After a scoreless first quarter, the Gamecocks downed a 61-yard punt at UAB's 3-yard line. Despite being backed up on their own goal line, the Blazers ripped off chunk plays of 10 yards, 46 yards and 30 yards to score their first points of the season.

Just four plays after redshirt junior Rajae' Johnson-Sanders hauled in a career-long 46-yard reception, the wide receiver snagged a pop pass from Johnston III for a 3-yard touchdown. Johnson-Sanders' first-career touchdown reception capped off a nine-play, 97-yard scoring drive with 4:53 left in the second quarter.

Following another defensive stop, safety Grayson Cash broke through Jacksonville State's punt protection to block and then recover the ball at the Gamecocks' 15-yard line with 2:37 remaining in the first half. Kicker Matt Quinn then converted the turnover into points with a 27-yard field goal, extending UAB's lead to 10-0 at the half.

The Blazers' defense limited the Gamecocks to just 64 yards of total offense in the first half, posting a first-half shutout in consecutive games (also blanking Marshall in the first half of the C-USA Championship Game). Jacksonville State's longest drive of the first half traveled just 17 yards with five of its six drives progressing less than 10 yards.

UAB marched down the field with its opening drive of the second half, needing just five plays to travel 75 yards to push its lead to 17-0. A 32-yard pass from Johnston III to tight end Hayden Pittman opened the scoring drive before the UAB quarterback connected with fellow tight end Gerrit Prince for a 23-yard score.

Two drives later, running back Jermaine Brown Jr. tallied his first rushing touchdown of 2021 with a 10-yard plunge, cutting to the right side and stiff-arming an opponent to accelerate into the end zone for a 24-0 lead. Brown Jr. paced the rushing offense with 78 yards.

Trea Shropshire would conclude the scoring with a 42-yard touchdown reception from quarterback Dylan Hopkins. Shropshire led the receivers five catches for 128 yards, his second consecutive 100-yard receiving game.

The Blazers recorded their first shutout since Oct. 27, 2018, when UAB blanked UTEP 19-0 in El Paso, Texas. UAB posted three shutouts in 2018, a Conference USA record.

ATHENS, Ga. – The UAB football team suffered a 56-7 loss to No. 2 Georgia on Saturday afternoon at Sanford Stadium.

UGA quarterback Stetson Bennett threw five touchdown passes in the first half and the Bulldogs threw six overall. Bennett finished the game 9-of-11 for 279 yards.

Georgia did most of its damage through the air, compiling 376 of its 539 yards via the pass.

Keondre Swoopes provided the only points for UAB with a 61-yard pick six in the fourth quarter. UAB had 174 total yards of offense with 127 of them coming on the ground.

The Blazers trailed 21-0 after the opening quarter as Georgia scored on three of its first four possessions, including touchdown passes of 73 and 89 yards from Bennett to Jermaine Burton and Brock Bowers.

DENTON, Texas – The UAB football team raced out to a 17-0 lead in the first ten minutes and never looked back en route to a 40-6 victory over North Texas on Saturday night at Apogee Stadium.

Junior quarterback Dylan Hopkins had a career night, going 6-of-7 and tallying career highs in passing yards (202) and touchdowns (three). His top target was Gerrit Prince who had three receptions for a career-best 136 yards and two touchdowns.

Will Boler (nine tackles) and Kristopher Moll (seven tackles) led the defense who allowed just 220 total yards and compiled three sacks, seven TFL, two pass breakups and an interception.

The win now improves UAB (2-1, 1-0 C-USA) to 19-3 against Conference USA West Division opponents since returning to action in 2017.

UAB turned defense into offense as Keondre Swoopes picked off Jace Ruder on North Texas' first offensive play of the game and returned it to the UNT 13 yard line. DeWayne McBride handled the rest as it took him two carries to find the end zone and gave the Blazers a 7-0 lead.

Following a 23-yard field goal by Matt Quinn, Hopkins found Prince on a 42-yard touchdown to extend UAB's lead to 17-0, which was the score after the first quarter.

Hopkins and Prince connected again on the first play of the second quarter as Prince took a short pass and turned it into a 61-yard touchdown with an impressive run after catch. Hopkins' third touchdown pass of the half came on a 38-yard strike to Trea Shropshire with 1:04 left as UAB led 30-0 at halftime.

Hopkins was 3-for-3 for 141 yards and three touchdowns in the half, while Prince had two catches for 103 yards and two touchdowns.

The Blazers added a 30-yard field goal from Quinn in the third quarter and a Larry Wooden 1-yard rush in the fourth quarter to round out the scoring. For Wooden, it was his first career touchdown as a Blazer.

UAB dominated from start to finish and ultimately outgained North Texas 402-220. The Blazers had 234 passing yards and 168 rushing yards.

The Blazers head to New Orleans next Saturday night for a non-conference game at Tulane. Kick is set for 7 p.m. CST on ESPN+.

NEW ORLEANS – The UAB football team registered a huge non-conference victory on Saturday night with a 28-21 triumph over Tulane at Yulman Stadium.

The Blazers (3-1) forced four Tulane (1-3) turnovers with two interceptions and two fumble recoveries, one of which was on Tulane's final possession which secured the victory for UAB.

Making his first start of the season, quarterback Dylan Hopkins was 19-of-27 for 240 yards, three touchdowns and one interception. Tight end Gerrit Prince had five catches for 65 yards and two touchdowns, bringing his total to five on the season, while Trea Shropshire and Jermaine Brown Jr. also found the end zone.

UAB outgained the Green Wave 433-395, and along with Hopkins' 240 passing yards the Blazers also had 193 yards on the ground. DeWayne McBride led the charge with 18 carries for 111 yards, marking his first 100-yard rushing game of the season and the third of his career.

The Blazers received the ball to start the game and engineered a 15-play drive which was capped by a six yard touchdown pass from Hopkins to Prince.

On Tulane's first possession, Starling Thomas V forced and recovered a fumble to give possession back to the Blazers. UAB once again drove straight down the field but a fumble on the goal line halted the drive.

The Blazers though, kept momentum early in the second quarter as Hopkins connected with Trea Shropshire on a 65-yard bomb with 14:11 remaining in the half. After another defensive stop, UAB's next drive featured McBride who moved the Blazers deep into Tulane territory. Prince would cap the drive with his second receiving touchdown of the game at the 7:57 mark.

However, Tulane seized momentum at the end of the half with two touchdowns, one of which came with six second left, to make the score 21-14 at halftime.

It was a defensive struggle for much of the third quarter, but the Blazers found the end zone late in the stanza on a 9-yard touchdown run by Jermaine Brown Jr., bringing the score to 28-14. Brown's touchdown was set up by Starling Thomas' first interception of the season.

With Tulane driving midway through the fourth quarter, Damon Miller came up with a his first career interception deep in UAB territory in what proved to be a game-changing play to keep the score at 28-14.

Tulane would get the ball back and found the end zone with 1:57 remaining, and the Green Wave recovered the ensuing on-sides kick.

With a chance to tie the game, the Blazer defense stepped up big once again and it was Kyle Harrell who fell on the ball after Tulane Quarterback Michael Pratt fumbled. With no timeouts remaining for Tulane, the Blazers lined up in victory formation.

BIRMINGHAM – The UAB football team suffered a 36-12 loss to Liberty in Saturday night's stadium opener at Protective Stadium.

Liberty quarterback Malik Willis sparked a second-half surge for the Flames with two rushing touchdowns and a passing score in the third quarter. Willis finished with 431 total yards and three touchdowns, accounting for 431 of Liberty's 544 yards.

The Flames scored 33 of their 36 points in the second half.

UAB (3-2) kicker Matt Quinn tallied the first points in Protective Stadium with 10:44 remaining in the first quarter, splitting the uprights for a 37-yard field goal. Quarterback Dylan Hopkins connected with tight end Gerrit Prince for completions of 22 yards and 8 yards to move the Blazers into the red zone.

Liberty (4-1) tied Saturday night's contest with 8:54 remaining in the second quarter, converting a 21-yard field goal. After Willis scrambled for a 9-yard gain to the UAB 3-yard line, the Blazers allowed just a single yard on the next three plays to force Liberty to the short field goal attempt.

UAB's offense then went three and out on its next position, giving the ball back to Liberty at its own 30-yard line. Quarterback keepsers of 20 yards and 19 yards from Willis once again positioned the Flames inside the UAB red zone with a goal-to-go situation, which is when outside linebacker Michael Fairbanks II stepped up to force a fumble on Liberty running back Joshua Mack.

Right as Mack reached for the goal line, Fairbanks II knocked the ball loose. Safety Jaylen Key picked up the ball in the end zone and returned it to the UAB 20-yard line to keep the Flames out of end zone. Key just missed out on a 100-yard return as he needed to avoid one more tackle before breaking into the open field.

With the score tied at 3-3 entering the second half, the Flames jumped out to a quick start in the third quarter, tallying touchdowns on back-to-back offensive plays to build a 17-3 lead less than five minutes into the third stanza. Willis broke free on third-and-goal for a rushing touchdown before connecting with wide receiver CJ Daniels for a 39-yard touchdown on the first play of Liberty's next offensive possession.

Liberty tacked on touchdown scores with 3:11 remaining in the third quarter and 12:45 remaining in the fourth quarter to extend its lead to 30-3.

Following a Liberty touchdown with 6:21 remaining in the final quarter, UAB's Nikia Eason Jr. blocked the extra point and Mac McWilliams returned it for two points the other way with an 83-yard return.

Blazer running back Jermaine Brown Jr. broke the century mark after his 59-yard rushing touchdown marked UAB's first touchdown in Protective Stadium with 4:53 remaining in the fourth quarter.

UAB returns to its new home Saturday with a Conference USA matchup against Florida Atlantic (3-2, 1-0 C-USA). Kickoff at Protective Stadium is scheduled for 2:30 p.m.

BIRMINGHAM – A record-setting pick six from safety Grayson Cash helped lead the UAB football team to a 31-14 victory over Florida Atlantic on Saturday afternoon at Protective Stadium.

With the Blazers holding a narrow 17-14 lead with less than a minute remaining in the first half, Cash intercepted a pass from Florida Atlantic quarterback N'kosi Perry inside UAB's own end zone and returned it 100 yards the other direction for momentum-shifting score. The Owls snapped the ball at UAB's 9-yard line before Cash drifted over to snag Perry's throw and take it the distance.

Cash's 100-yard pick six marked the longest interception return for a touchdown in program history. Former Blazer Marquis Coleman recorded a 99-yard pick six for the Green and Gold at UTEP in 2009. It also tied a C-USA record for longest interception return, becoming the 11th player in league history to do so.

The Blazers (4-2, 2-0 C-USA) dominated FAU (3-3, 1-1 C-USA) on the defensive side of the ball, recording eight sacks, 11 tackles for loss and tying a season-high with four takeaways (three interceptions, one fumble recovery). Alex Wright led the charge with seven tackles, two sacks and a forced fumble.

Quarterback Dylan Hopkins paced the offense with 173 passing yards and two touchdowns, while adding 32 rushing yards and an additional score. UAB outgained FAU 306-291 for the game.

Before Cash's game-changing interception, the Blazers built an early 14-0 lead behind a pair of turnovers in the first quarter. Hopkins led the Blazers on a 10-play, 75-yard touchdown drive to open the scoring on UAB's first drive, hitting wide receiver Samario Rudolph for a 25-yard score on third down.

After a touchback on the ensuing kickoff, Noah Wilder intercepted Perry's first pass attempt of the game to set the Blazers up in the red zone. Despite coming up empty handed due to a blocked field goal attempt, the Blazers kept Owls pinned deep in their own territory.

On FAU's second offensive play of the game, Wright forced a fumble before teammate Will Boler recovered the ball to set up the Blazers inside the Florida Atlantic red zone once again. With another short field, UAB cashed in with a 15-yard touchdown strike from Hopkins for Trea Shropshire to double its lead to 14-0 less than seven minutes into the opening quarter.

FAU fought back to tie the game on a 1-yard run from Perry in the first quarter and a 2-yard receiving touchdown from Perry to Aaron Shahriari at the 8:12 mark of the first half.

Matt Quinn tied his career-long with a 48-yard field goal to give UAB a 17-14 lead, and with FAU driving late in the half, that is when Cash changed the game to give UAB a 24-14 lead with :30 remaining before halftime.

Hopkins would add a touchdown with 2:50 remaining in the third quarter for the only points of the second half.

The Blazers are now 26-7 and seven against Conference USA opponents since returning to action in 2017 and remain at the top of the C-USA West standings at 2-0 this season.

UAB is on the road next weekend at Southern Miss. Kickoff is set for 2:30 p.m. CST on Stadium.

HATTIESBURG, Miss. – The UAB football team used a 28-point second quarter to help the Blazers run away with a 34-0 shutout victory over Southern Miss on Saturday afternoon at M.M. Roberts Stadium.

The Blazers (5-2, 3-0 C-USA) tallied their second shutout of the season and held Southern Miss (1-6, 0-3 C-USA) to just 107 total yards (32 yards passing, 75 rushing). Noah Wilder led the defensive charge with 14 tackles.

Sophomore DeWayne McBride rushed for a career-high 137 yards on 17 carries as UAB compiled 223 of its 388 total yards on the ground. Dylan Hopkins finished the game 8-of-13 for 147 yards with a passing touchdown and rushing score.

UAB also got it done on special teams as Grayson Cash blocked a punt and recovered it for a touchdown, while Matt Quinn was 2-for-2 on field goals with a career-long 52-yarder.

The win improves the Blazers to 20-3 against C-USA West Division opponents since returning to action in 2017 and keeps UAB at the top of the league standings.

The Blazers led 3-0 at the end of one quarter and outgained the Golden Eagles 103-48. With UAB facing a 4th-and-1 on the opening play of the second quarter, Hopkins used play action perfectly to find a wide open Gerrit Prince for a 34-yard touchdown. For Prince, it was his team-high sixth receiving touchdown of the season.

Highlighted by an Alex Wright sack on USM's next offensive possession, Cash then had his second massive play in as many weeks as he blocked the ensuing punt and recovered it in the end zone to give UAB a 17-0 lead with 13:45 remaining in the first half.

It was Cash's second blocked punt of the season and his second straight game with a touchdown following last week's 100-yard interception returned for a touchdown.

The Blazers kept the pedal to the floor and went 66 yards on four plays on their next possession to take a commanding 24-0 lead with 9:34 remaining. McBride had 57 of the 66 yards, including a 31-yard rushing touchdown to cap the drive.

Hopkins concluded the first half scoring with a 3-yard rush with 2:30 left, giving the Blazers a 31-0 lead at halftime. UAB outgained Southern Miss 275-62 in the half.

Matt Quinn added his career-long 52-yard field goal in the third quarter for the only scoring of the second half with 8:41 remaining.

UAB has now won eight of the last 10 games against Southern Miss and has evened the series at 5-5 in Hattiesburg.

The Blazers return to Protective Stadium next week to host Rice on Homecoming and their fifth annual Children's Harbor game. Kickoff is scheduled for 2:30 p.m. CST.

BIRMINGHAM – The UAB football team suffered a 30-24 loss to Rice in Saturday's Homecoming matchup at Protective Stadium.

The Blazers (5-3, 3-1 C-USA) scored what would have been a game-winning 40-yard touchdown with :11 remaining in the game, but the play was negated on a holding call, and UAB's last second Hail Mary was unsuccessful.

Dylan Hopkins threw for a career-high 318 yards and tied his career-high with 19 completions. Gerrit Prince hauled in four catches for 114 yards and his seventh touchdown reception of the season.

Noah Wilder led the defense with 12 tackles, while Antonio Moultrie had a career-high 10 tackles. However, Rice quarterback Wiley Green was 17-of-22 for 205 yards and three touchdowns in leading the Owls to victory.

Rice was a perfect 5-for-5 on fourth downs, cashing in from the UAB 1-yard line for a touchdown to notch their fifth fourth-down conversion of the afternoon.

Rice (3-4, 2-1 C-USA) built a 13-0 lead in the first quarter, but sophomore running back DeWayne McBride paced the UAB offense with three carries, 74 yards and two rushing touchdowns in the first 15 minutes to vault back in front.

McBride's first carry of the game went for 36 yards to set up the Blazers in the red zone. The Blazer tailback then powered through the line one play later for a 12-yard rushing touchdown to make it 13-7.

After a fumble recovery from linebacker Antonio Moultrie on the ensuing possession, McBride once again broke free for a score, taking a third-down carry on the Rice 26 for a touchdown.

Rice regained the lead with 3:23 remaining in the half on an 11-yard touchdown pass and led 20-14 at the break.

After the Blazers went three-and-out to open the second half, Rice capped off a 10-play, 65-yard drive with a touchdown score from the 1-yard line to extend its lead back to 13.

UAB quickly cut the game back to one possession when tight end Gerrit Prince, who topped 100 yards for the second time this season, hauled in a career-long 72-yard touchdown less than a minute after Rice's 10-play scoring drive, making the score 27-21.

Prince's team-high seventh touchdown reception of the season moved him into seventh place on UAB's single season receiving touchdown list.

The Owls and the Blazers traded field goals in the fourth quarter, and Matt Quinn's 33-yarder with 3:23 left made the score 30-24.

UAB got the three-and-out it needed to give the ball back to the offense with 2:10 left in the game. However, following the nullified touchdown, UAB's last second heave from its own 47 was knocked down.

The Blazers are off next weekend and return to Protective Stadium on Nov. 6 to host Louisiana Tech.

BIRMINGHAM - A monster rushing performance from sophomore running back DeWayne McBride helped lead the UAB football team to a 52-38 victory over Louisiana Tech on Saturday afternoon at Protective Stadium.

The Blazers (6-3, 4-1 C-USA) scored 24 unanswered points to turn a 21-7 deficit into a 31-21 advantage behind McBride's career-high 210 rushing yards and four rushing touchdowns. McBride's 210 rushing yards were the seventh most in school history, while his four rushing touchdowns were the second most. He also became the first UAB running back to eclipse 200 rushing yards since former Blazer Spencer Brown rushed for 209 yards at Southern Miss in 2017.

Additionally, McBride's performance moved him into 10th place for both career rushing yards (1,276) and rushing touchdowns (12) at UAB.

In total, the Blazers rushed for 296 yards on just 36 carries, averaging 8.2 yards per attempt and scored all seven of their touchdowns on the ground. UAB's 52 points is its most since the Blazers tallied 52 points in a C-USA victory over UTSA in 2018.

UAB's sixth victory of the season also secured bowl eligibility for the Blazers for the sixth straight season. The Blazers scored 45 of the game's final 62 points, limiting the Bulldogs to 10 points over the final 44 minutes of the game.

Antonio Moultrie led the defense with a career-high tying 10 tackles. UAB had two sack and eight tackles for loss, while also tallying eight pass breakups, five of which came from Starling Thomas V.

Facing a 21-7 deficit in the second quarter, UAB pulled off a successful fake punt on fourth down in its own territory to spark the comeback. Punter Kyle Greenwell gathered the snap and followed blockers up the right side for a 16-yard gain.

A 23-yard completion from quarterback Dylan Hopkins to wide receiver Trea Shropshire then set up the Blazers in the red zone, which was when McBride rumbled in from 20 yards out for his first rushing touchdown of the game to trim the deficit to 21-14.

UAB's defense then forced a quick three-and-out, and the Blazers cut into the Bulldogs' advantage once again when kicker Matt Quinn connected on a 36-yard field goal to make it a 21-17 ballgame.

With 59 seconds remaining in the half, LA Tech's defense forced a UAB punt from the Blazers' 32-yard line, but a muffed punt from Bulldog returner Smoke Harris allowed the Green and Gold to take over at the LA Tech 17-yard line with less than a minute remaining in the half. McBride once again found pay dirt, bulldozing his way into the end zone to give UAB the lead for good at 24-21.

UAB extended its lead to 31-21 in the second half when Hopkins scored on a 6-yard keeper on third-and-goal. Hopkins' score capped off a 10-play, 76-yard drive to put the Blazers up by two scores.

A short LA Tech field goal from the UAB 3-yard line trimmed the Green and Gold's lead to 31-24 with 10:27 remaining in the fourth quarter.

The Blazers, however, quickly re-established a two-score advantage when UAB needed just three plays to travel 80 yards to take a 38-24 lead. A 38-yard reception from Rajae' Johnson-Sanders, who set a career-high with 101 receiving yards, opened the drive before McBride burst free down the right sideline for a 35-yard rushing touchdown.

The Bulldogs (2-7, 1-4 C-USA) responded with a touchdown to cut the Blazers' lead to 38-31 with 6:45 remaining in the fourth quarter. McBride, however, had yet another answer as he burst through the line for a 29-yard touchdown to stretch the lead back to two touchdowns.

Running back Lucious Stanley then pushed the Blazers over the half-century mark with a 38-yard rushing touchdown to post UAB's final points of the game. LA Tech running back Marcus Williams Jr. tallied a late rushing touchdown for the Bulldogs to push the game to its final score.

The Blazers notched their 40th victory overall since returning to action in 2017 and are 40-19 overall in that span. UAB also improved to 28-8 in Conference USA and 21-4 versus West divisional opponents since 2017.

HUNTINGTON, W.Va. - A Grayson Cash interception on Marshall's final drive of the game sealed a 21-14 victory for the UAB football team over the Thundering Herd on Saturday afternoon at Joan C. Edwards Stadium in Huntington.

The Blazers (7-3, 5-1 C-USA) held the nation's eighth-ranked offense to just 269 total yards and kept the Herd (6-4, 4-2 C-USA) to 22 points under their season average of 36.0 points per game.

CD Daniels led the stout defensive effort with a team-high seven tackles, while Cash, Dy'Jonn Turner, Noah Wilder and Antonio Moultrie each had six.

Offensively, DeWayne McBride had his fourth 100-yard game of the season with 25 carries for 108 yards and two touchdowns. McBride now has 10 rushing touchdowns this season, with nine of them coming in the last four games.

Quarterback Dylan Hopkins completed 13-of-18 passes for 250 yards and added the game-winning rushing touchdown late in the third quarter. Both Gerrit Prince and Trea Shropshire had exactly 100 yards receiving, becoming the first Blazer duo to have 100 receiving yards in the same game since 2017.

The Blazers struck first as Hopkins connected with Shropshire on a 64-yard reception to set up a 3-yard touchdown run for McBride at the 12:39 mark of the opening quarter.

UAB received another big play from Hopkins to Shropshire, this time a 36-yard reception, which set up McBride's second touchdown of the game from 15 yards out to give the Blazers a 14-0 lead with 1:25 left in the quarter.

McBride's touchdown capped a 99-yard drive for the Blazers, their longest of the season, and UAB outgained Marshall 162-43 in the first quarter.

The Herd scored the only points of the second quarter on a 36-yard pass from Grant Wells to Jayden Harrison with 1:05 left in the half as UAB took a 14-7 lead into the break.

Marshall then tied the game at 14 with 4:18 in the third quarter as Wells connected with Corey Gammage Jr. on a 17-yard screen pass. However, the Blazers responded with a six play, 75-yard drive to retake a 21-14 lead with :36 remaining in the third.

The big play of the drive came on a 51-yard reception by Gerrit Prince and Hopkins then finished the drive with a 1-yard touchdown run.

UAB controlled the fourth quarter and put together a 10-minute drive which ate up the clock by converting three third-downs, two of which were receptions hauled in by Ryan Davis.

The Herd gained possession with 3:32 remaining and tried to engineer a game-tying drive, but it was Cash who once again made a huge play down the stretch to seal UAB's victory.

The Blazers won the time of possession 37:43-22:17 and outgained Marshall 338-269 overall.

UAB's win now sets up a massive showdown in San Antonio next Saturday against undefeated and nationally ranked UTSA. The Blazers are the three-time reigning C-USA West Division champs and next Saturday's game will determine the winner of the West Division.
