• **THE SERIES.** BYU and Washington State are meeting for the fifth time in the series. BYU holds a 3-1 advantage but this weekend's matchup will be the BYU Cougars first trip to Pullman after three games in Provo and one meeting in the 1981 Holiday Bowl. In the most recent game, BYU defeated the Washington State Cougars 30-6 in Mike Leach's debut as the head coach. Riley Nelson threw for 285 yards and two touchdowns while Taysom Hill made his first appearance for the Cougars and threw an 18-yard touchdown pass.

• **AGAINST THE PAC-12.** BYU is playing its fourth Pac-12 team of the year in Washington State. BYU is already 3-0 against the Conference of Champions, with wins over Arizona, Utah and Arizona State. BYU will play another Pac-12 team to close out the regular season with a game at USC on Nov. 27.

• **POWER 5 TEAMS.** BYU is playing its fifth Power 5 team of 2021 and will play seven total this year. The Cougars are 3-1 against the Power 5 this season, beating the three Pac-12 teams mentioned earlier and dropping the contest to Baylor last week. BYU will face Washington State this week and then see Virginia and USC later this season. BYU has 10 Power 5 wins under Kalani Sitake and 30 since 2003, the most of any team not playing in a Power 5 conference. BYU has never beat four Power 5 teams in a single season.

• **BIG 12.** On Friday, Sept. 10, 2021, BYU accepted an official invitation to join the Big 12 Conference in all sports. The Cougars joined Cincinnati, Houston and UCF as the four new members. BYU is expected to play its first season in the Power 5 conference in 2023. The Cougars have a record of 85-50 since becoming an independent in 2011.

The Cougars owned the trenches and powered their way to their first win in the series since 2009 with a 26-17 triumph over the Utes at LaVell Edwards Stadium. BYU led from start to finish and did not turn the ball over while forcing two against Utah.

### INDEPENDENCE: YEAR ELEVEN

After finishing the 2020 season 11-1, BYU enters its 11th season as an independent. This season, the Cougars play seven teams from Power 5 conferences, including three to start the year. BYU will face five teams from the Pac-12 in Arizona, Utah, Arizona State, Washington State and USC. The Cougars will also match up with Baylor of the Big 12 and Virginia of the ACC. In addition to those Power 5 matchups, BYU also plays in-state foe Utah State along with Mountain West power Boise State. The Cougars will host USF of the American and Idaho State from the FCS.

### LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's winning percentage at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 14 among teams playing in their current stadium.

More than 53,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 65 percent of the current team has served a mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. More than 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) are currently serving in the mission field.

### HONOR CODE

BYU's Honor Code helps maintain this learning environment. Initiated by students in 1949, the Honor Code emphasizes being honest, living a chaste and virtuous life, abstaining from alcohol and tobacco, using clean language, and following other values in line with the doctrines of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.

### POLYNESIAN PIPELINE

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. About 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Fesi Sitake Harvey Unga, Nu'u Tafisi, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You, Al Pupunu and Vince Feula.

### FORMER PLAYERS ON STAFF

There are 15 former BYU football players on the football and athletic administration staff. Members of the staff were part of Cougar teams that won the 1980 "Miracle Bowl," the 1984 National Championship, 1996 Cotton Bowl along with many other accolades.

• **COACHING EXPERIENCE.** The BYU offensive staff has nearly 100 years of coaching experience. Offensive line coach Darrell Funk has the most with more than 30 years. Tight ends coach Steve Clark has been coaching since 1994 and passing game coordinator Aaron Roderick has 22 years in the profession. Funk, Roderick, Clark and wide receivers coach Fesi Sitake have all been coordinators at the college level.

• **TWO BY TWO.** BYU features a pair of tight ends, a pair of running backs, and a pair of receivers poised to make a huge impact. Tight ends Isaac Rex and Dallin Holker could be a matchup nightmare. Rex, the 6-foot-6, 247-pound red zone threat caught 12 touchdowns last season while the speedy Holker caught 19 passes for 235 yards as a true freshman before a church mission. Running backs Tyler Allgeier and Lopini Katoa have combined for more than 3,300 rushing yards and have 39 rushing touchdowns. Wideouts Gunner Romney and Nei'l Pau'u have posted more than 3,000 receiving yards and 20 touchdowns.

**BYU DEFENSE BY THE NUMBERS**

- 12** The BYU defense has created 12 turnovers on the year to help the team earn a tie for a No. 20 ranking in turnovers gained. BYU ranks No. 26 in turnover margin at (0.71). BYU has made seven interceptions with five fumble recoveries through six games.
- 13** BYU has made 13 sacks, averaging 1.86 sacks per game. The Cougar defense has also interrupted opponents in their backfield with 35 tackles for loss on the year for 146 yards.
- 19** Ben Bywater has been filling in admirably for injured Mike linebacker starter Keanan Pili. Pili had 31 tackles in just over two games on the field before his season-ending knee injury against ASU. Bywater, who moved from Rover LB to Mike LB after the Pili injury, ranks No. 19 in the nation in solo tackles per game (5.4) and leads BYU with 58 total tackles on the year.
- 28** Malik Moore ranks 28th in the country with two interceptions in his first year as a starter. BYU has seven interceptions on the season. Moore is one of six Cougars to pick an opponent pass this year.
- 51.8** BYU's red zone defense is holding opponents to a 51.8 percent touchdowns conversion rate when they enter the red zone. In 27 red zone attempts, BYU opponents have scored 14 touchdowns. 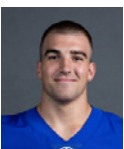

## THE BYU DEFENSE

- **COACHING EXPERIENCE.** BYU's defensive staff has more than 85 years of coaching experience. Linebackers coach Kevin Clune has 30 years while assistant head coach and safeties coach Ed Lamb is approaching 25 years on the job. Lamb and Clune, in addition to Tuaki, have experience as defensive coordinators.
- **POINTS.** BYU's defense is allowing 23.0 points per game. Despite being the only team in the country to face three straight Power 5 conference teams to open the season, BYU held all three (Arizona, Utah, Arizona State) to 17 points or less. BYU gave up a season-high 38 points at Baylor last week. Last year, BYU ranked No. 3 in the country in scoring defense, allowing just 15.3 points per game over 12 games.

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) enters his sixth season overseeing the BYU football program in 2021.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program. Sitake is the first former player under Edwards to be named head coach at BYU.

Named BYU's head coach on December 19, 2015, Sitake returned to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven seasons a defensive coordinator and four years as an assistant head coach. He came to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in 2015 under head coach Gary Andersen. Sitake spent the prior 10 seasons at the University of Utah under head coach Kyle Whittingham. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012. He coached 12 all-conference honorees at Utah, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014).

During his career, Sitake has helped mentor 28 NFL Draft picks, including No. 2 overall pick Zach Wilson in the 2021 NFL Draft by the New York Jets. Sitake also coached BYU linebackers Sione Takitaki and Fred Warner and running back Jamaal Williams. Takitaki was a third-round pick of the Cleveland Browns in this year's draft and Warner was one of the league's top rookies after being taken in the third round in 2018 by the San Francisco 49ers.

Sitake has coached in 12 bowl games during his career and has been on the winning side in 10 of those 12 contests, including a 3-1 mark as a head coach. BYU is coming off a 49-23 win in the 2020 Boca Raton Bowl over UCF.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002 under Gary Crowton. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

He began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards. A team captain as a senior, Sitake's last game as a player was also the last game coached by the legendary Edwards, who was a great mentor for Sitake.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake is the nation's first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. Sitake and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
