- THE SERIES. BYU and Utah are meeting for the 95th time in the series. The Cougars have played the Utes more than any other program in history. Utah has won nine in a row against BYU, tied for the longest winning streak for either team. BYU won nine in a row from 1979-1987 while the Utes had another nine-game winning streak from 1929-1937. No team has ever won 10 in a row in the rivalry. The game has been decided by one score in 16 of the last 20 contests, including three of the last four with Kalani Sitake as BYU's head coach.
- CROSSOVER. Not many rivalries have as much crossover between coaching staffs and players as BYU and Utah, two schools that are just 46 miles apart. Utah head coach Kyle Whittingham was an all-conference linebacker at BYU (1978-81), earned his degree and a masters degree from the Cougars before spending nearly 30 years at Utah. BYU head coach Kalani Sitake, also a former BYU player, spent 10 years on Whittingham's staff at Utah as the assistant head coach, defensive coordinator and linebackers coach over the years before coming back to BYU as the head coach. BYU also has three staff members, Aaron Roderick, Steve Clark and Kevin Clune who have all spent time at Utah as coaches while Utah's Fred Whittingham also played for the Cougars.
- COACHED BY LAVELL. Whittingham played for hall of famer LaVell Edwards and was an all-conference linebacker at BYU from 1978-1981. Whittingham then coached at BYU from 1985-86. Sitake also played for Edwards as a fullback (1994, 97-00) and returned as a graduate assistant coach in 2002. Both head coaches credit Edwards' influence on their playing and coaching careers and his impact off the field in their lives.
- PAC-12. BYU will play five teams from the Pac-12 this season. After a win vs. Arizona in game one, the Cougars will face Utah, Arizona State, Washington State and USC.
- 9/11 TOWER CLIMB. BYU Athletics will host a Tower Climb at LaVell Edwards Stadium on Saturday, Sept. 11 at 8 a.m. to honor the lives lost in the attacks of Sept. 11, 2001. Participants will climb 2,071 steps representing the 110 stories of the World Trade Center, paying tribute to the first responders who climbed those steps, sacrificing their lives to save others. This is a non-profit event. The \$16 ticket price will cover operational costs and include t-shirts, coins and badges given to participants. Security and water stations will also be provided. The rivalry with the University of Utah returns to LaVell Edwards Stadium after a year off last season. The Cougars are looking to avoid 10 in a row to the Utes. Neither team has ever won 10 consecutive games in the 94-game history of the series.

#### 9/18 Arizona State (1-0) 8:15 p.m. ESPN

Former Western Athletic Conference foe Arizona State visits Provo for the first time since 1998 when BYU defeated the No. 14 Sun Devils 26-6 in Provo. The two teams also played 14 times as WAC members during ASU's membership from 1962-1978.



# **GO COUGS**

#### **INDEPENDENCE: YEAR ELEVEN**

After finishing the 2020 season 11-1, BYU enters its 11th season as an independent. This season, the Cougars play seven teams from Power 5 conferences, including three to start the year. BYU will face five teams from the Pac-12 in Arizona, Utah, Arizona State, Washington State and USC. The Cougars will also match up with Baylor of the Big 12 and Virginia of the ACC. In addition to those Power 5 matchups, BYU also plays in-state foe Utah State along with Mountain West power Boise State. The Cougars will host USF of the American and Idaho State from the FCS.

#### LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's winning percentage at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 14 among teams playing in their current stadium.

#### **MISSIONS**

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates more than 400 missions around the world in over 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. More than 53,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 65 percent of the current team has served a mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. More than 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) are currently serving in the mission field.

#### HONOR CODE

BYU's Honor Code helps maintain this learning environment. Initiated by students in 1949, the Honor Code emphasizes being honest, living a chaste and virtuous life, abstaining from alcohol and tobacco, using clean language, and following other values in line with the doctrines of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.

#### **POLYNESIAN PIPELINE**

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. About 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Fesi Sitake Harvey Unga, Nu'u Tafisi, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You and Vince Feula.

#### FORMER PLAYERS ON STAFF

There are 15 former BYU football players on the football and athletic administration staff. Members of the staff were part of Cougar teams that won the 1980 "Miracle Bowl," the 1984 National Championship, 1996 Cotton Bowl along with many other accolades.

#### BYU OFFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

BYU was turnover free in the opener against Arizona. The Cougars have zero turnovers in four of six season openers under head coach Kalani Sitake. BYU had five games without turnovers in 2020.

Wide receiver Neil Pau'u averaged 15.75 yards per reception against the Wildcats. His eight catches for 126 yards and two touchdowns set or tied his career bests in each category. Last year, Pau'u averaged 13.0 yards per reception.

Jaren Hall's 39-yard run against Arizona was the longest of his career and the longest rush by a BYU quarterback since Taysom Hill ran for a 39-yarder against Utah in 2016.

The Cougars have passed for 200+ yards in 28 consecutive games, the longest streak since a span of 42 consecutive games from 1993-1996. BYU had seven 300-yard games in 2020 and three 400-yard games.

#### THE BYU OFFENSE

- COACHING EXPERIENCE. The BYU offensive staff has nearly 100 years of coaching experience. Offensive line coach Darrell Funk has the most with more than 30 years. Tight ends coach Steve Clark has been coaching since 1994 and passing game coordinator Aaron Roderick has 22 years in the profession. Funk, Roderick, Clark and wide receivers coach Fesi Sitake have all been coordinators at the college level.
- TWO BY TWO. BYU features a pair of tight ends, a pair of running backs, and a pair of receivers poised to make a huge impact. Tight ends Isaac Rex and Dallin Holker could be a matchup nightmare. Rex, the 6-foot-6, 247-pound red zone threat caught 12 touchdowns last season while the speedy Holker caught 19 passes for 235 yards as a true freshman before a church mission. Running backs Tyler Allgeier and Lopini Katoa have combined for more than 2,500 rushing yards and have 31 rushing touchdowns. Wideouts Gunner Romney and Nei'l Pau'u have posted 2,390 receiving yards and 15 touchdowns.

#### BYU DEFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

Keenan Pili is currently tied for No. 1 in the nation in total tackles at 17. He is tied with only Malcolm Rodriguez of Oklahoma State. His 17 total tackles are a new career-high and were the most by a BYU player since Sione Takitaki had 19 in the 2018 Famous Idaho Potato Bowl against Western Michigan.

Four different BYU players recorded sacks against Arizona including Tyler Batty, Uriah Leiataua, Keenan Pili and Payton Wilgar. All four are ranked No. 24 in the nation and the four sacks ranks No. 11 nationally.

While ranking No. 1 in total tackles with 17 Keenan Pili also posted 10 solo stops ranking No. 2 in the nation. Malcolm Rodriguez of Oklahoma State recorded only one more solo tackle than Pili.

BYU finished the 2020 season with 8 interceptions and Hayden Livingston posted the first of 2021 against Arizona in the season opener. It was his first career interception.

KALANI SITAKE HEAD COACH YEARS AT BYU 6th year at BYU YEARS OVERALL

6th year as head coach, 21 years in coaching

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) enters his sixth season overseeing the BYU football program in 2021.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program. Sitake is the first former player under Edwards to be named head coach at BYU.

Named BYU's head coach on December 19, 2015, Sitake returned to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven seasons a defensive coordinator and four years as an assistant head coach. He came to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in 2015 under head coach Gary Andersen. Sitake spent the prior 10 seasons at the University of Utah under head coach Kyle Whittingham. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012. He coached 12 all-conference honorees at Utah, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014).

During his career, Sitake has helped mentor 28 NFL Draft picks, including No. 2 overall pick Zach Wilson in the 2021 NFL Draft by the New York Jets. Sitake also coached BYU linebackers Sione Takitaki and Fred Warner and running back Jamaal Williams. Takitaki was a third-round pick of the Cleveland Browns in this year's draft and Warner was one of the league's top rookies after being taken in the third round in 2018 by the San Francisco 49ers.

Sitake has coached in 12 bowl games during his career and has been on the winning side in 10 of those 12 contests, including a 3-1 mark as a head coach. BYU is coming off a 49-23 win in the 2020 Boca Raton Bowl over UCF.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002 under Gary Crowton. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

He began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards. A team captain as a senior, Sitake's last game as a player was also the last game coached by the legendary Edwards, who was a great mentor for Sitake.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake is the nation's first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. Sitake and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
