MEET PREVIEW

PROVO, Utah — After a close loss in Los Angeles against No. 10 UCLA, the No. 11 BYU Cougars make their way to Cedar City to face MRGC rival No. 18 Southern Utah University.

The Cougars currently hold a three-meet winning streak over the Thunderbirds. Just last Friday, the MRGC rivals battled at BYU's home opener in the Smith Fieldhouse where BYU walked away with a major advantage, 196.825-196.175, while posting a season-high score.

Additionally, at the start of the season on Jan. 9 at the Rio Tinto Best of Utah NCAA Gymnastics Meet in West Valley City, Utah, BYU placed second (195.700) to the University of Utah, with Utah State placing third and SUU fourth (194.325.)

"Right now we're on auto-pilot mode," head coach Guard Young said. "We get up, warm-up, compete and move on to the next arena. It was really nice to have a 2 p.m. meet (at UCLA) and we could sleep in before we bus it to Cedar City today."

THE COUGARS. On Wednesday, BYU faced UCLA of the Pac-12, losing by a small margin of 196.600-196.325. Heading into the final rotation, the Cougars trailed by only .075. Ending on beam, the lineup achieved the second-highest beam score of the season, a 49.225. This score stands as the 10th-best beam total in program history. A highlight included sophomore Lexi Mather celebrating a new career-high score of 9.875 on beam. Within the MRGC, senior Abbey Miner-Alder earned MRGC Floor Specialist of the Week.

THE THUNDERBIRDS. In their previous matchup against the Cougars, the Thunderbirds fell by a margin of .650. However, Karley McClain took home the all-around title, boasting a 39.375. On top of this, she stands as the MRGC Gymnast of the Week for four consecutive weeks. In the conference, SUU sits at No. 18 in the nation. The team ranks highest on the uneven bars, currently sitting at No. 12 on the apparatus.

NO. 10 UCLA TRUMPS NO. 11 BYU BY .275 IN LOS ANGELES

LOS ANGELES — A battle up until the final rotation, No. 10 UCLA edged out No. 11 BYU, 196.600-196.325, in the Pauley Pavilion on Wednesday.

"This is my first time to ever come to Pauley Pavilion for a gymnastics meet," said head coach Guard Young. "They have such a strong tradition for gymnastics and they're a powerhouse. That was a bucket list for me as a coach."

Prior to the start of the meet, the teams donned "Root Out Racism" shirts. Gathered together in unity, previous to the playing of the national anthem, both teams knelt in a circle while the announcer read the following statement:

"As a symbol of player unity across NCAA Gymnastics programs, our two programs come together tonight in support of ending racial injustices in our communities, our states and across the country. We look forward to playing a major role in this fight to end racial and social injustices. Let's stand together to show solidarity for racial equality and that enough is enough."

UCLA made the invitation for BYU to participate with them earlier this week.

"I think that it's a neat tradition that UCLA is doing this year at all of their home meets," Young said. "We are thankful that they extended the invitation to our team, and we left it up to our gymnasts to participate, and it was their choice. It led to a good, healthy discussion with my own gymnasts about racism and the struggles that minorities go through on a daily basis."

In the first rotation, BYU headed to the uneven bars where freshman Anyssa Alvarado and senior Abby Boden-Stainton notched team-high scores of 9.825. Senior Angel Zhong followed with a 9.800, tying her season-high score. The Cougars racked up a 49.000 tally, trailing the 2018 NCAA national champions by just .100.

Next up on vault, BYU's highest score came from anchor senior Abbey Miner-Alder, achieving a 9.850. This score would win Alder the vault title for the meet, tied with UCLA's Nia Dennis and Chae Campbell. Freshman Allix Mason contributed a 9.800. However, BYU's 48.925 total while UCLA tallied a 49.125 on bars widened the gap to 98.225-97.225.

The pressure of the meet set in during the second half, working in BYU's favor as its scores continued to increase. On floor, BYU provided solid routines and earned a 49.175, closing the gap to only .075 behind the Bruins. Junior Rachel Bain-Heaton set the tone by matching her season-high score of 9.825. Alder closed out the rotation, matching her career-high score of 9.925 on the apparatus to help the Cougars achieve their highest floor score this season. This score earned Alder another title of the night, tying with UCLA's Margzetta Frazier and Nia Dennis.

In the final rotation, BYU gathered its highest tally of the night and second-highest beam score of the season, a 49.225, which ranks as the 10th-best beam total in school history. Sophomore Lexi Mather celebrated a career high on beam, earning a 9.875. Achieving a 9.900 for three consecutive weeks, Stainton topped off the score and won the beam title along with UCLA's Nia Dennis. In the end, a 49.425 on floor by the Bruins would solidify their win.

"It was exciting that we were within .075 of them rounding that last rotation," Young said. "We're in striking distance of competing with the top teams in the country. We're still combatting Sadie Miner with a sprained ankle and some girls with contract tracing issues, like everyone else is this year. That always puts a wrinkle in it when we try to prepare for meets."

A former BYU national champion gymnast and Olympic silver medal winner, Young returned to his alma mater in May 2015 to take the helm of the BYU gymnastics program.

A member of the BYU Athletic Hall of Fame, Young returned to Provo from the University of Oklahoma, where he was an assistant men's gymnastics coach from 2000-05 and 2011-15. In nine seasons at OU, Young was part of four NCAA championship teams (2002, 2003, 2005, 2015) and five NCAA runner-up teams (2001, 2004, 2012, 2013, 2014).

Young's passion for gymnastics is equaled by his love for BYU. From 1996 to 2000, he was a member of the BYU men's gymnastics team, winning six All-America awards and two NCAA National Championships on the vault (1999, 2000). As a senior, Young was also the runner-up for the individual all-around at the 2000 NCAA Championships. He was inducted into the BYU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2010.

From 2000 to 2004, Young was a member of the USA Senior National Gymnastics Team, winning a team silver medal at the 2001 World Championships in Ghent, Belgium, and a team silver medal at the 2004 Olympic Games in Athens, Greece.

As a junior gymnast, he trained under OU coach Mark Williams at the Bart Conner Gymnastics Academy in Norman, Oklahoma. Young earned the 1996 junior national champion title and three junior national team berths.

Young graduated from BYU in 2001 with a Bachelor of Arts in communications with an emphasis in broadcast journalism. He and his wife, Alisha, have two boys and one daughter (Tyler, Jaxson and Hadley).

His father, Wayne Young, was a BYU gymnast from 1970-1975 and captained the 1976 USA Olympic team. Wayne later became the Cougars men's gymnastics coach from 1979-87 and was inducted into the BYU Athletic Hall of Fame in 1986. In addition, Guard's sister, Jessica Young Wycherly, was a gymnast at BYU from 1995-98.
