### **MEET PREVIEW**

PROVO, Utah – After two road meets, No. 11 BYU will host a tri-meet in the Smith Fieldhouse against No. 21 Boise State and the Air Force Academy on Friday, Feb. 19, at 7 p.m. MST.

MRGC rival Boise State last faced BYU on Jan. 23 in Boise, Idaho. There, the Broncos walked away with a .075 advantage over the Cougars, winning 196.325-196.250. This ended BYU's three-meet winning streak against BSU.

Back in 2019, BYU and Air Force battled in a quad-meet in Colorado Springs, Colorado. The Cougars snagged first place, notching a 196.425. The Falcons earned a 194.775, coming in second place.

THE COUGARS. On Friday, BYU traveled to Cedar City, Utah, to face No. 17 Southern Utah. The Cougars celebrated a 197.075-196.550 win over their MRGC rival. A season-high team tally, BYU's score also equaled the 10th-highest score in program history. Additionally, the team achieved new season-high scores on vault (49.100), uneven bars (49.375) and floor (49.400.) Three Cougars earned MRGC accolades this week for their performances, including senior Abbey Miner-Alder, senior Abby Boden-Stainton and junior Brittney Vitkauskas.

THE BRONOCS. On Saturday, Boise State faced MRGC rival Utah State at the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum, upsetting the team 196.400-195.325. The Broncos achieved a new season-high score in the win. Freshman Emily Lopez celebrated a 9.900 score on the uneven bars, winning the event. Further, Erin Elkabchi's career-high score of 9.850 won her the floor title. Lastly, Gabriela Cavinta earned her second-career win on beam with a 9.875.

THE FALCONS. On Friday in St. Charles, Missouri, the Air Force Academy competed at the Gym Quarters Invitational. Out of six teams, the Falcons finished fifth with a 191.400. A highlight included the team achieving its highest beam score of the season, a 48.650. Junior Daija Stevenson impressed the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation with her 38.575 in the all-around, becoming Gymnast of the Week.

### NO. 11 BYU CELEBRATES 197.075-196.550 WIN OVER SUU

CEDAR CITY, Utah — No. 11 BYU triumphed over No. 18 Southern Utah, 197.075-196.550, on Friday in Cedar City, equaling the 10th-highest score in program history.

Not only is 197.075 the highest score of the season for the Cougars, the team celebrated new season-high tallies on the uneven bars, vault and floor, including four career-high marks.

"SUU really knows how to run a fun, high energy gymnastics meet," head coach Guard Young said. "They have fans who appreciate good gymnastics. It is an intimidating environment for the girls, but their fans do a great job at supporting both teams. Great team. Great meet. Hats off to them."

A major highlight occurred when senior Abbey Miner-Alder trumped current MRGC Gymnast of the Week, Karley McClain, in the all-around. McClain finished with a 39.225. Meanwhile, Alder crushed her previous career high (39.375) and notched an impressive 39.500.

Young coaches the team to come out like "lightening" and the girls did just that, earning a 49.375 on the uneven bars, the eighth highest bars score in program history. Seniors Angel Zhong and Abbey Miner-Alder both snagged 9.850 scores with Alder matching her career high. Sophomore Anyssa Alvarado and junior Abby Beeston helped the score climb with 9.875 scores. Senior Abby Boden-Stainton topped it off with her career-high score of 9.925. This would win her the uneven bars title.

Heading to the vault, BYU led by .400. The team carried its momentum into the second rotation, achieving yet another season-high total of 49.100 on the apparatus. Senior Haley Pitou and Zhong led the rotation by tying their season-high scores of 9.800. Freshman Allix Mason celebrated the first career-high score of the night, a 9.825. Alder would finish with a 9.850, the highest vault score of the meet, collecting the title alongside SUU's Morgan Alfaro and Rachel Smith.

The Cougars did not skip a beat on the floor, as they notched a 49.400, a season-high score. At this point, BYU celebrated season-high tallies on all three events and led by a wide margin of 147.875-147.275. The team boasted two more careerhigh scores from senior Jordan Danbury-Matthews, a 9.875, and junior Brittney Vitkauskas, a 9.925. Alder mimicked the 9.925, earning the pair the floor title for the night.


Starting the final rotation, the Cougars held a daunting .600 lead over the Thunderbirds. All gymnasts earned a 9.775 or higher. Freshman Sophia McClelland and sophomore Lexi Mather contributed scores of 9.850, topped off by Alder's score of 9.875. This would earn the all-arounder her third event title of the night. In the end, BYU earned a solid 49.200 on the event and its fourth consecutive win over SUU.

"I'm really happy for Abbey Miner-Alder," Young said. "With some COVID-19 protocols, she ended up coming in as an alternate on bars, which put her into the all-around. I know she was itching to get back in the all-around and that was a pretty impressive score. I'm proud of her for coming in at the last minute and winning that meet."

Coming up, the Cougars will host Boise State and Air Force Academy in a tri-meet on Friday, Feb. 19, at 7 p.m. in the Smith Fieldhouse.


### Guard YOUNG BYU Head Coach 2015-Present

A former BYU national champion gymnast and Olympic silver medal winner, Young returned to his alma mater in May 2015 to take the helm of the BYU gymnastics program.

A member of the BYU Athletic Hall of Fame, Young returne to Provo from the University of Oklahoma, where he was an assistant men's gymnastics coach from 2000-05 and 2011-15. In nine seasons at OU, Young was part of four NCAA championship teams (2002, 2003, 2005, 2015) and five NCAA runner-up teams (2001, 2004, 2012, 2013, 2014).

Young's passion for gymnastics is equaled by his love for BYU. From 1996 to 2000, he was a member of the BYU men's gymnastics team, winning six All-America awards and two NCAA National Championships on the vault (1999, 2000). As a senior, Young was also the runner-up for the individual all-around at the 2000 NCAA Championships. He was inducted into the BYU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2010.

From 2000 to 2004, Young was a member of the USA Senior National Gymnastics Team, winning a team silver medal at the 2001 World Championships in Ghent, Belgium, and a team silver medal the 2004 Olympic Games in Athens, Greece.



Young graduated from BYU in 2001 with a Bachelor of Arts in communications with an emphasis in broadcast journalism. He and his wife, Alisha, have two boys and one daughter (Tyler, Jaxson and Hadley).

His father, Wayne Young, was a BYU gymnast from 1970-1975 and captained the 1976 USA Olympic team. Wayne later became the Cougars men's gymnastics coach from 1979-87 and was inducted into the BYU Athletic Hall of Fame in 1986. In addition, Guard's sister, Jessica Young Wycherly, was a gymnast at BYU from 1995-98.
