QUICK HITS

- Senior Noah Hartsock has been BYU's most consistent contributor this season, averaging 16.9 points, 6.3 rebounds, 2.0 assists, 2.4 blocks and 1.0 steals per game. He is shooting .578 from the field, .417 from three and .813 from the free throw line and has scored in double figures and registered at least one block in every game this season.
- Freshman Anson Winder has seen significant playing time at point guard the last five games, including starts in the last four. For the season he's averaging 5.9 points, 4.4 assists and 1.1 steals. He leads the West Coast Conference in assist/turnover ratio at 2.6.
- As of 12/5/11, BYU leads the West Coast Conference in four categories (Scoring Margin, 3-Pt FG %, blocks, assists), is second in the league in six (scoring offense, scoring defense, FG %, rebounding offense, rebound margin, assist/turnover ratio, defensive rebounds) and third in three (FG % defense, steals, turnover margin). BYU is top three in 13 of 21 categories.
- Junior Brock Zylstra caught fire against Northern Arizona, hitting 8 of 10 from the field and 5 of 6 from three for a career-high 23 points. Zylstra is shooting .414 (12 of 29) from downtown.
- Freshman Nate Austin has caught fire as of late, totaling 20 points on 9 of 13 shooting in 27 minutes the last two games. He had a career-best 11 points and four boards vs. Northern Arizona and nine points and a career-high six boards vs. Oregon.
- Dave Rose is one of the most successful coaches in the history of BYU basketball. He is second in program history in wins (165), first in winning percentage (.778) and has led the Cougars to five-straight NCAA Tournament berths and four conference titles. He also earned three Mountain West Conference Coach of the Year awards.

LAST TIME OUT - BYU VS. OREGON

SALT LAKE CITY –The BYU men's basketball team flew past the Oregon Ducks, 79-65 at Energy Solutions Arena behind a career day from forward Noah Hartsock on Saturday.

The Ducks had no answer for Hartsock who set a career high with 23 points and grabbed a season best 12 rebounds, recording his first double-double of the season and fourth of his career. Three players scored in double figures with Hartsock leading the way with his 23 points and Stephen Rogers added 16 with Anson Winder chipping in 10 points. BYU finished the game shooting 39.4 percent and made 10 three-pointers. The Cougars tied a season-low with just 10 turnovers. It was a game of streaks as the Cougars made several runs throughout the game that proved to be the demise of Oregon.

After a lackluster first minute of the second half, the Cougars caught fire. Guard Charles Abouo hit a quick three and Zylstra capped off a 14-0 run with a three-pointer of his own, pushing BYU's lead to 51-33, prompting an Oregon timeout. The Ducks posed little threat throughout the rest of the half, cutting the lead to 14, but not being able to do further damage.

Oregon tried to add pressure with a full court press, but that did not fluster the Cougars. Point guard Anson Winder broke down the full court press flying right past the Ducks defense time after time. At one time Winder raced right by Oregon and dished to Brandon Davies who threw down an emphatic dunk.

While BYU cruised to an easy win, the Cougars struggled mightily in the opening minutes of the game. Oregon started out red-hot jumping out to an 8-0 lead. The Cougars had several open shots but struggled to connect from anywhere on the floor. The first points for BYU went to Davies who caught the ball in low and made a nice move to the bucket. After Stephen Rogers was fouled hitting a three from the corner, he put in the free throw to cap a 14-1 run, pushing BYU ahead 16-11.

The first half was a half of runs as the Cougars added two 8-0 runs after grabbing the lead at 12-11. Reserve forward Nate Austin continued to be a contributor with nine points in the first half. Austin hit from everywhere on the court, up close, mid-range jumpers, and a deep three.

GOING GREEK

BYU men's basketball went on a 10-day, four-game tour of Greece in August. The Cougars won their first two games against the Athens All-Stars (88-56) and ASE Doukas (114-45) while also playing a friendly game against US Navy personnel on a base in Crete. While in Greece, BYU was invited to participate in the Acropolis of Athens Tournament against the Greek and Italian National Teams, both ranked among the top 10 in the world by FIBA. Against Greece, Stephen Rogers led BYU with 20 points in an 83-54 loss. Brock Zylstra exploded for 26 points and four 3-pointers in BYU's 102-63 loss to an Italian team that featured three NBA stars.

NEW HOME

In 2011-12, BYU men's basketball enters its first season as a member of the West Coast Conference. The Cougars have played each member of the league at least twice all time. Last season, BYU defeated St. Mary's 74-73 in the South Padre Island Invitational championship game and Gonzaga 89-67 in the third round of the NCAA Tournament to advance to the Sweet 16. For the second-straight season there was a change to the coaching staff. Former associate head coach Dave Rice, who had been with the staff since Rose became the head coach in 2005, left to take the head job at his alma mater, UNLV. Rose hired Mark Pope as an assistant coach in May 2011. Pope comes to BYU after one season as an assistant at Wake Forest. 
