MEET PREVIEW

PROVO, Utah - For the second consecutive week, No. 11 BYU gymnastics will compete in the Smith Fieldhouse, hosting No. 22 Utah State on Friday, Feb. 26, at 7 p.m. MST.

The MRGC rivals last faced on Utah State's home turf in Logan, Utah, on Jan. 29. There, the Cougars snagged their first win of the season, topping the Aggies, 196.425-195.175.

Prior to this battle, the teams faced off in West Valley City, Utah, on Jan. 9 at the second annual Rio Tinto Best of Utah NCAA Gymnastics Meet. BYU placed second (195.700.) in the event behind No. 4 Utah (196.900) while Utah State earned third (194.350), topping Southern Utah (194.325.)

THE COUGARS. On Friday, BYU's score of 196.975 to trump Boise State (196.900) and Air Force Academy (192.650) in the Smith Fieldhouse. There, the Cougars celebrated a new season-high score on vault, a 49.225. Additionally, senior Avery Bennett achieved careerhigh scores on both vault (9.900) and floor (9.850), claiming MRGC Vault Specialist of the Week. Freshman Sophia McClelland and senior Abby Boden-Stainton both boasted scores of 9.925 on beam, becoming the MRGC Beam Specialists of the Week. Lastly, junior Brittney Vitkauskas finished the meet on a high note, earning a 9.925 on floor and snagging MRGC Floor Specialist of the Week.

THE AGGIES. The No. 22 ranked team currently holds a season-high tally of 196.225. Last Friday, Utah State faced Southern Utah in Cedar City. Even in a loss, the Ággies total score of 195.975 pushed the team one spot higher in the rankings. A strong point for the Aggies is their beam lineup, notching total scores of 49 or higher in their last five meets. Individually, Autumn DeHarde ranks first in the conference and 12th in the nation on beam. For the third time this season, the MRGC honored the senior with MRGC Beam Specialist of the Week for her 9.925 performance.

NO. 11 BYU EXCELS IN TRI-MEET VICTORY

PROVO, Utah – No. 11 BYU scored a 196.975 Friday night to defeat No. 21 Boise State (196.900) and Air Force Academy (192.650) at the Smith Fieldhouse.

BYU last faced Boise State back in January, losing by a mere .075. On Friday the Cougars redeemed themselves, celebrating four career-high scores and a new season-high vault score.

"It was a really long meet, but I think it was a good experience for the girls to compete at a meet that long," said head coach Guard Young. "It's nice to be back home and in front of our families. I'm super proud of the girls, and it was neat seeing Sophia McClelland do a floor routine for the first time."

Starting off the meet, Boise State led the pack after an impressive score of 49.350 on the uneven bars. Meanwhile, the Cougars notched a 49.225 on vault, their highest score of the season on the apparatus. Senior Haley Pitou maintained her season-high score of 9.800. Up next, sophomore Lexi Griffith stuck her landing, trumping her previous career-high score by an entire point, contributing a 9.875. Senior Avery Bennett instantly screamed with joy after performing a 9.900-worthy routine. This would be another career-high score for the Cougars and vault title for Bennett. Senior Abbey Miner-Alder finished out the lineup by matching her career high of 9.875.


Trailing the Broncos by .125, BYU headed to the uneven bars. Victor of the uneven bars amongst the three teams, junior Abby Beeston tied her career-high score of 9.900, followed by a 9.875 by sophomore Anyssa Alvarado. Pitou celebrated her highest score of the season on the apparatus, earning a 9.850. The Cougars remained consistent, achieving a solid 49.225. This score would gain ground on Boise State, closing the gap to 98.625-98.450. BYU held a 2.050 lead over Air Force.

The Cougars would make their comeback in the third rotation with their second-highest beam score of the season, a 49.300. This would kick Boise State out of first place. Freshman Sophia McClelland notched a new career-high score of 9.925. Stainton would match the score, her highest of the season. This would earn the pair the beam title for the night. Alder followed close behind her season-high score of 9.875. This created a margin of .275 over the Broncos heading into the final rotation.

Known for their crowd-pleasing routines, BYU did not disappoint and solidified its win with its second-highest floor score of the season, a 49.325. Bennett would garner yet another career high, snagging a 9.850 on floor. For the second consecutive week, junior Brittney Vitkauskas achieved her career-high score of 9.925, taking home first place in the event. Alder would carry the Cougars home, snagging second place behind Vitkauskas with her 9.900.

Next week, the Cougars will host Utah State on Friday, Feb. 26 at 7 p.m. MST in the Smith Fieldhouse.


Guard YOUNG BYU Head Coach 2015-Present

A former BYU national champion gymnast and Olympic silver medal winner, Young returned to his alma mater in May 2015 to take the helm of the BYU gymnastics program.

A member of the BYU Athletic Hall of Fame, Young returne to Provo from the University of Oklahoma, where he was an assistant men's gymnastics coach from 2000-05 and 2011-15. In nine seasons at OU, Young was part of four NCAA championship teams (2002, 2003, 2005, 2015) and five NCAA runner-up teams (2001, 2004, 2012, 2013, 2014).

Young's passion for gymnastics is equaled by his love for BYU. From 1996 to 2000, he was a member of the BYU men's gymnastics team, winning six All-America awards and two NCAA National Championships on the vault (1999, 2000). As a senior, Young was also the runner-up for the individual all-around at the 2000 NCAA Championships. He was inducted into the BYU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2010.

From 2000 to 2004, Young was a member of the USA Senior National Gymnastics Team, winning a team silver medal at the 2001 World Championships in Ghent, Belgium, and a team silver medal the 2004 Olympic Games in Athens, Greece.



Young graduated from BYU in 2001 with a Bachelor of Arts in communications with an emphasis in broadcast journalism. He and his wife, Alisha, have two boys and one daughter (Tyler, Jaxson and Hadley).

His father, Wayne Young, was a BYU gymnast from 1970-1975 and captained the 1976 USA Olympic team. Wayne later became the Cougars men's gymnastics coach from 1979-87 and was inducted into the BYU Athletic Hall of Fame in 1986. In addition, Guard's sister, Jessica Young Wycherly, was a gymnast at BYU from 1995-98.
