

BYU-UTAH STATE STORYLINES

- This is the 82nd meeting between BYU and Utah State. Playing nearly every year since 1922, The Cougars and Aggies are poised for another classic after last year's dramatic 27-24 BYU comeback victory. Head coach Bronco Mendenhall is 4-1 against Utah State.
- BYU has five homegrown coaches, returning to coach at their alma mater. Assistant head coach/ tight ends coach Lance Reynolds, offensive coordinator/QB coach Brandon Doman, wide receivers coach Ben Cahoon, defensive line coach Steve Kaufusi and outside linebackers coach Kelly Poppinga all eanred degrees at BYU. Utah State has two USU alumni coaches in offensive coordinator/QB coach Matt Wells and defensive line coach Frank Maile.
- BYU quarterback Riley Nelson played for Utah State in 2006. Nelson was a team captain and started seven games for Utah State that year. He passed for 925 yards and six touchdowns while rushing for 290 vards
- · Utah State is playing its final year in the Western Athletic Conference and will join the Mountain West in 2013, both former homes of BYU. BYU was a member of the WAC from 1962-1998 and put together a 189-71-2 record, winning 19 conference titles. BYU then played in the Mountain West from 1999-2010 and had a record of 64-26, winning championships four times.
- BYU wide receiver Cody Hoffman has a caught a pass in 24 straight games, tied for the 10th longest streak in the nation. He has caught a pass in 30 of 31 career games. Utah State has two players with a streak of five games, Chuck Jacobs and Kellen Bartlett.

2012 BYU FOOTBALL LAST GAME/OPPONENT OUTLOOK

FRESHMEN LEAD BYU TO 47-0 SHUTOUT OF HAWAI'I

PROVO, Utah - True freshmen Taysom Hill and Jamaal Williams shined in BYU's 47-0 shutout over University of Hawai'i that featured a 396-yard rushing attack Friday at LaVell Edwards Stadium.

Hill started under center for the Cougars (3-2) and secured the first victory in BYU history for a true freshman and only the second by any freshman starting his first game. Hill finished the night completing 12 of 21 for 112 yards, two touchdowns and one interception. Hill added another score on his feet and gained 143 yards rushing on 15 attempts, the most rushing yards by a BYU quarterback since 164 from Brandon Doman in 2001.

Williams tallied 155 yards on 15 attempts and two touchdowns. The last time BYU had two 100-yard rushers was Oct. 21, 2006 against UNLV when Curtis Brown and Mike Hague rushed for 148 yards and 123 yards, respectively.

Sophomore Paul Lasike, a former BYU rugby player, also had an offensive presence with 10 touches for 40 yards and two touchdowns. Sophomore receiver Ross Apo had three receptions for 27 yards and scored his first touchdown of the year.

Senior Brandon Ogletree led a stout defensive effort with seven tackles, two tackles for loss, one pass breakup and one quarterback hurry. Senior Preston Hadley contributed with six tackles, two pass breakups, one sack and one tackle for loss. Junior Kyle Van Noy added two sacks and one quarterback hurry. Hadley and Van Noy each had a forced fumble.

BYU outgained Hawai'i (1-3) 540 to 149 total yards. The 149 yards marked for the 11th consecutive game the Cougars have held their opponent to under 300 total yards and are the lowest during the streak. BYU's 396 rushing yards are the most under Mendenhall and the most since racking up 410 yards on the ground in a 56-34 win over Colorado State in 2001.

The Cougars lost running back Michael Alisa on the first drive of the game when he broke his right forearm on a 7-yard run to the Hawai'i 2-yard line to set up BYU's first touchdown.

OPPONENT OUTLOOK

UTAH STATE'S LAST GAME

LOGAN, Utah - Career nights from senior running back Kerwynn Williams and sophomore quarterback Chuckie Keeton led Utah State to a 35-13 Homecoming win over UNLV Saturday night at a spirited Merlin Olsen Field at Romney Stadium.

In a white out by the fans and team, USU wore all white uniforms, pants and helmets at home, while the near-capacity crowd was mostly decked out in white. With the win, the Aggies improve to 4-1 on the year, their best start since 1978, by amassing 564 total yards, the second-most this season and 17th-best in school history.

With career-highs of seven catches for 147 yards with one TD catch, Williams amassed the most receiving yards by a non-wide receiver since Tom Larscheid who had 172 receiving yards in 1959. The current Aggie senior added 20 rushes for 113 yards to also became the first USU player with 100 yards rushing and 100 yards receiving in the same game since former teammate Robert Turbin with 116 yards receiving and 104 rushing against Southern Utah in 2009.

Keeton threw for a career-best 402 yards on 20of-33 passing with four TD's, one to Williams for 74 yards. The 402 passing yards is the 10th-most in school history and the most since Jose Fuentes



threw for 426 against Middle Tennessee in 2002.

Two of Keeton's TD tosses went to senior wide receiver Chuck Jacobs, who finished with four receptions for 101 yards, scoring on a 50-yard pass play and a 17-yard catch. The 100-yard receiving tandem of Williams and Jacobs are the first pair of Aggies with 100-yards receiving since 2002 when Chris Cooley (5-105) and Kevin Curtis (13-177) accomplished the feat against Middle Tennessee in the same game of Fuentes' mark.

The stout Aggie defense was led by the linebacker tandem of junior Jake Doughty and sophomore Zach Vigil, as Doughty had a career-high 13 tackles and Vigil tied his career-high with 10. Sophomore safety Brian Suite added eight tackles while senior linebacker Bojay Filimoeatu and senior cornerback Will Davis added seven stops each.

NOTES FROM BYU'S LAST GAME

BYU's defense shut out the Warriors and the offense rolled in a 47-0 route of Hawai'i.

- The defense held its 11th opponent in a row under 300 total yards. BYU held the Warriors to just 149 total yards in the game, the lowest yards allowed during the streak. The 149 yards allowed is the lowest number since a 144-yard effort vs. UNLV in 2010.
- BYU pitched its first shutout since a 52-0 win over Wyoming in 2009. BYU has shut out a Norm Chow offense two out of their last three meetings. (Beat UCLA 59-0 in 2009 with Chow as Bruin's offensive coordinator and lost to Utah 54-10 with Chow as Ute's offensive coordinator in 2011.) It was the first time Hawai'l was shut out since 1998.
- With true freshman Taysom Hill leading BYU to a win it marks the first time a true freshman quarterback won his first start as a Cougar. It was just the second time a BYU freshman won his first start, along with Ty Detmer as a redshirt freshman in 1988.
- Quarterback Taysom Hill put together the third best rushing performance by a quarterback in the NCAA this year with 143 rushing yards. Denard Robinson of Michigan ran for 218 yards vs. Air Force and Ohio State's Braxton Miller ran for 161 vs. Miami (OH). The last time a BYU quarterback rushed for over 100 yards was current offensive coordinator Brandon Doman with 164 vs. Colorado State in 2001.
- Both Taysom Hill (143) and Jamaal Williams (155) ran for at least 100 yards. It was the first time two Cougars ran for 100 yards in a game since Curtis Brown and Mike Hague in 2006 vs. UNLV.
- BYU's 396 rushing yards are the most since racking up 410 yards on the ground in a 56-34 win over Colorado State in 2001.

2012 BYU FOOTBALL TEAM NOTES

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR TWO

2011 was the Cougars inaugural year as an independent. BYU went 10-3 and won its fifth bowl game in six years. The team played teams from the SEC, Pac-12, Big 12, Conference USA, Western Athletic Conference and Mountain West. The Cougars had all 13 games televised, including 12 to a national audience, 11 of which were featured on the ESPN family of networks. BYU had five on ESPN, four on ESPN2 and two on ESPNU. In 2012, BYU ups the ante with a more difficult schedule, featuring a road game at fellow independent Notre Dame along with three teams from the Pac-12 and matchups against the ACC, WAC and MW. To date BYU has five games scheduled to air on the ESPN family of networks along with one on NBC and another on BYUtv, all nationally televised games. The Cougars have future games scheduled with Wisconsin, West Virginia, Nebraska, Notre Dame, East Carolina, Georgia Tech, Texas, UCF, Houston, Washington State, Boise State, Utah and Hawai'i.

FLAG BEARERS

BYU has a tradition of selecting a player before each game to run the team flag onto the field. In 2008, the team implemented a new tradition - the alumni flag. The team selects a former Cougar to carry out the alumni flag, along with the chosen current player who runs out with the current team flag. Both flags are white with a blue "Y" logo. The team flag has been signed by each member of the team, while the alumni flag has been signed by former BYU payers. In 2011, the team added a special teams flag, donned by a vintage BYU logo adopted by the special teams, following the same protocol as the team flag with an exemplary special teams player being chosen to carry it each week.

TEAM CAPTAINS

Selected by their peers, quarterback Riley Nelson, linebacker Brandon Ogletree and running back David Foote have been named as team captains for the 2012 season. The three seniors are all new captains for the 2012 season. Nelson will serve as the offense's captain, Ogletree for the defense and Foote for special teams. Nelson has 838 total yards of offense passed for 5 touchdowns this year. Ogletree has 42 total tackles to lead the team. Foote has 19 rushes for 81 yards and also has 3 tackles on special teams and blocked a punt.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 45,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 64,045 after refurbishing the middle of the east section. The capacity now sits at 63,470 due to accomidations for wheelchair access. For the 2012 season the stadium will feature new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates 347 missions around the world in 145 nations speaking 164 languages. More than 53,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 330 missions around the world. Seventy-five percent of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 19 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years or 18 months for women and couples—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

There are currently 38 missionaries from the football team serving in 17 different countries. Members of the current team cover six of the seven continents around the globe and speak six different languages.

FIRESIDES

The BYU football team participates in hour-long devotionals prior to eight games this season. These devotionals are referred to as "firesides" and are intended to help players, coaches and those who attend strengthen or gain a knowledge of our purpose here on earth. Firesides typically include a musical number from members of the team and talks from selected players, along with Holly and Bronco Mendenhall.

BYU OFFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

Taysom Hill has rushed for four touchdowns this season, the most on the team. He scored two vs. Weber State and one at Boise State. The freshman picked up the longest rush of the year on a 68-yard TD run vs. Hawai'i.

BYU averaged 7.3 yards per carry in the rushing attack vs. Hawai'i. The Cougar ground game rushed 54 times for 396 yards and five touchdowns against the Warriors.

Nine BYU freshmen running backs have rushed for over 100 yards with Jamaal Williams being the ninth. The others include Fahu Tahi, Mike Hague, Ronnie Jenkins, Mark Atuaia, Josh Quezada, Curtis Brown, Jamal Willis and Harvey Unga.

Wideout Cody Hoffman has recorded a reception in 24 straight games. BYU's career leader in receiving yards Austin Collie had a career-best streak of 22 games with at least one reception. Hoffman's 24 games is the No. 10 streak nationally.

Quarterback Taysom Hill rushed for 143 yards vs. Hawai'i, the most by a BYU quarterback since current offensive coordinator Brandon Doman in 2001 (164 vs. CSU).

THE BYU OFFENSE

- True freshman and 17-year old Jamaal Williams has shined in his first five games as a Cougar. Williams scored his first collegiate touchdown at Utah on a seven-yard run in the fourth quarter. Last week with Michael Alisa breaking his arm, Williams seized the day, picking up 155 yards and two scores on just 15 carries vs. Hawai'i. He's now second on the team in rushing with 238 yards. He is averaging a team-high (min. 15 attempts) 7.2 yards per carry.
- The tight end position has made a strong comeback with Kaneakua Friel. Friel leads the tight ends with 15 receptions for 195 yards and a team-leading four touchdowns. He is second on the team in receiving yards and total receptions. BYU's other tight ends have eight catches for 120 yards and one touchdown. He has caught a team-high four touchdown passes, good for No. 21 nationally.
- · Wideout Cody Hoffman leads BYU in receiving so far in 2012, just as he did in 2011. Hoffman currently has 23 receptions, 318 yards and two scores. Hoffman has had back-to-back 100-yard games vs. Weber State and at Utah. His 318 receiving yards are No. 69 nationally. He is averaging 63.6 yards per game and 13.8 vards per reception.
- Freshman dual-threat quarterback Taysom Hill has impressed in his young career. The Pocatello, Idaho product won his first start vs. Hawai'i, becoming the first true freshman to do so, completing 12 of 21 passes for 112 yards and two touchdowns. Hill did most of his damage with his legs, rushing for 143 yards on 15 carries and one touchdown, a 68-yard run for a score, the longest BYU run of the year. He leads the team in rushing yards (256) and rushing scores (4).
- BYU has had two scoring drives of 90-yards or more this year. The first was vs. Weber State, a nineplay 90-yard touchdown drive. The Cougars also had an 11-play 95-yard scoring drive, the longest of the year at Boise State in the fourth quarter.
- The Cougars are winning all four quarters now. BYU has outscored opponents 21-7 in the first quarter and dominated the second and fourth quarters, 51-6 and 41-7, respectively. They were losing the third quarter battle 30-16 until the Hawai'i game before outscoring the Warriors 20-0 out of the locker room to give the team a 36-30 advantage in the third frame.
- Ten different players have scored touchdowns this year. Hill and Friel lead with four apiece and the rest go Williams (3), Hoffman (2), Lasike (2) and then Lark, Alisa, Apo, Ridley and Mahina all with 1 each.

DEFENSIVE NOTES 2012 BYU FOOTBALL

BYU DEFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

The dominant Cougar defense is No. 1 in red zone conversions with a rate of 37.50%. Opponents have reached the red zone eight times against BYU and have only scored three times. The Cougars kept the Warriors from ever reaching the red zone.

After going two games without forcing a turnover the BYU defense had three takeaways vs. Hawai'i. Daniel Sorensen had an interception, Kyle Van Noy and Preston each forced a fumble and Bronson Kaufusi and Spencer Hadley recovered them.

The Cougars moved up to No. 5 in total defense after week 5. BYU has held its opponents to an average of 226.6 yards per game. The Cougar rushing defense is No. 2 only giving up 63.2 yards per game while their passing defense comes in at No. 11 (163.4).

The defense held its last 11 opponents under 300 total yards. The Cougars held the Warriors to just 149 total yards in the game, the lowest yards allowed during the streak. The 149 yards allowed is the lowest number since a 144-yard effort vs. UNLV in 2010.

BYU pitched its first shutout since a 52-0 win over Wyoming in 2009. BYU has shut out a Norm Chow offense two out of their last three meetings. It was the first time Hawai'i was shut out since 1998, ending its 182 game scoring streak.

#6 Jordan Johnson, DB

Johnson made waves in his starting game at field corner vs. WSU. Johnson picked off a pass and returned it for 64 yards. He continues to be a threat in the backfield, totaling five tackles in a shut out over Hawai'i.

#1 Joe Sampson, DB

Sampson, a 5-foot-10, 203 pounder, had a career night against Weber St. Sampson finished the game with career highs in total tackles (6), solo tackles (4) and assisted tackles (2). The senior tacked on two pass breakups against Hawai'i.

#4 Uona Kaveinga, LB

Named to 2012 Butkus Award Watch List, Kaveinga is an asset to the No. 5 defensive unit. The senior recorded his first career interception in BYU's season opener. In the Cougars' next game against Weber State, the USC transfer recovered a fumble for 23 yards.

#47 Ezekiel Ansah, LB/DL

One of the most amazing athletes to come through the program, Ansah continues to prove to be a serious threat as a pass rusher. The former 200-meter track athlete, with his 6-foot-6, 270-pound frame, led the defensive unit against Boise State with career highs in total tackles (7), sacks (1) and tackles for loss (2.5). The senior had five tackles, 0.5 tackles for loss, one pass breakup and one quarterback hurry against Hawai'i.

#52 Russell Tialavea. DL

The 6-foot-3, 265 pounder returns to the Cougar squad after a mission for his senior season. Tialavea has blocked a PAT (Weber St.) and a field goal (Utah) so far this season.

#20 Craig Bills, DB

Bills earned letterman honors as a true freshman and saw action in all 13 games. After returning from a mission, Bills has contributed 13 tackles this season.

#17 Matt Hadley, DB


Hadley, a true freshman, saw action the first time this season against Hawai'i and put up 4 total tackles, including 3 solo tackles and 0.5 TFL.

2012 BYU FOOTBALL **DEFENSIVE NOTES**

THE BYU DEFENSE

• BYU is No. 5 nationally in total defense. With seven returning starts from the No. 13 defensive unit in 2011, the Cougars continue to climb the national defensive rankings each week. BYU has help opponents to an average of 226.6 yards, good for the 5th-best mark nationally. The powerhouse defense holds eight top-10 defensive rankings, including No. 1 red zone defense. Bronco's Boys have also shut out opposing offenses in nine consecutive quarters.

- For BYU, a low jersey number on defense means business. The numbers 1-9 on defense are all significant contributors. No. 1 Joe Sampson may start at free safety or as the fifth defensive back in the nickel formation. No.'s 2, 3, 4 are three of the four possible starters at linebacker with No. 2 Spencer Hadley and No. 3 Kyle Van Noy on the outside and No. 4 Uona Kaveinga on the inside. No. 5, Alani Fua brings more athleticism to the outside backer position and No. 6 and No. 7, Jordan Johnson and Preston Hadley, respectively, will lock down the corner positions with No. 9 Daniel Sorensen will man the KAT safety position. The group combined for 30 tackles, four tackles for loss, four pass breakups, three sacks, two quarterback hurries, two forced fumbles, one fumble recovery and one interception against Hawai'i.
- Ezekiel Ansah has come a long way since 2010 when he had to be taught how to put football pads on. The defensive lineman/linebacker hybrid had one of his best games as a Cougar, wreaking havoc in the backfield for the Boise State defense. Ansah finished with career highs in tackles (7), tackles for loss (2.5) and picked up his first career sack. The sack was the first allowed by the Broncos this season. The 6-foot-6, 270-pound frame also batted down a pass and snuffed out a 4th down attempt from Boise State. The former 200-meter track athlete continued the trend, helping shut out the Warriors for the first time since 1998.
- Behind enemy lines. BYU continued its streak of recording at least 5.0 TFL to nine games against Hawai'i, dating back to November 2011 against Idaho. The Cougars have tallied at least 7.0 TFL in the first five games of 2012 with a season-best 11.0 TFL for a loss fo 42 yards against Utah. Brandon Ogletree and Kyle Van Noy led the defensive attack against Hawai'i with 2.0 TFL each while five other players also made their mark. BYU is tied for sixth nationally in TFL with 41.
- The Kyle Van Noy Show is back. After being the only Division I player to record a statistic in each of the major defensive categories in 2011, the 6-foot-3, 235 pounder is back at it again in 2012. The Bednarik Award, Nagurski Trophy, Lombardi Award watchlist candidate has top defensive marks for the Cougars in four categories, including tackles for loss (9.5), sacks (6.5), quarterback hurries (5) and forced fumbles (3). The proven defensive threat was named the National Linebacker of week three for his performance against Utah. The junior playmaker is tied for 2nd nationally in forced fumbles and third in sacks, and holds the 7th best mark in TFL. Van Noy's defensive presence is a solid asset to the No. 5 defense.
- Stopping the run is often a theme and BYU is pretty good at it. The Cougars finished the 2011 season ranked No. 19 in rushing defense and held opponents under 100 total yards rushing eight times on the season. BYU's run-stopping effort continues to be a trend in 2012. BYU held WSU's offense to -5 total yards rushing, the second time in three years allowing a team to negative rushing yards. After allowing only 41 yards against Hawai'i, BYU is holds the 2nd-best mark nationally in rushing defense, averaging 63.2 yards per game.

Punt returner JD Falslev has an average of 13.2 yards per punt return, good for No. 26 in the nation. The junior has nine punt returns for 119 yards in 2012.

The Cougars have returned seven kickoffs for an average of 27.7 yards. BYU has had three different kickoff returners this season in Cody Hoffman, Mike Hague and Joe Sampson. Sampson holds the team-high with his 44-yard return.

Punter Riley Stephenson unloaded a season-high punt of 61 yards against Hawai'i. The senior's career high is 67 yards which he booted against UCF in 2011.

Dating back to 2010, BYU had made 70 consecutive PATs, a new school record. The 70 was a combination of Mitch Payne, Justin Sorensen and Riley Stephenson. The record came to an end with a blocked PAT vs. Hawai'i.

A distant relative of legendary utility player, Paul Hornung, Reed has been BYU's deep snapper for the past two seasons and looks to cap off his senior year with another consistent effort in 2012. Originally from Minnesota, Hornung came from Snow College and has handled all the snapping duties since his sophomore season. Along with snapping, Hornung made a big play in the 2011 Armed Forces Bowl on punt coverage, distrupting Tulsa's punt returner just enough to cause a fumble. On the ensuing play the Cougar offense scored a touchdown with just seconds remaining before the half. BYU would go on to win on another last second touchdown. A former walk-on player, Hornung has two tackles on special teams this year.



During his seven seasons as the head coach at Brigham Young University, Bronco Mendenhall has returned the Cougars to the ranks of the nation's top teams. Taking over a BYU program in 2005 that was coming off three losing seasons, Mendenhall has guided his teams to seven straight bowl invitations, two outright conference championships and regular national top-25 rankings. The Cougars finished their first season as a football independent in 2011 with a 10-3 record and No. 25 final ranking to finish nationally ranked for the fifth time in the last six seasons.

Under his leadership, BYU has earned a 69-26 (.726) record to date to rank No. 15 in total wins among all teams in the nation during that span. The Cougars have received seven straight bowl invitations for the first time since a string of 17 consecutive bowls invitations from 1978 through 1994. Mendenhall is the only coach in BYU football history to take his first seven teams to a bowl game.

Mendenhall has led BYU to bowl wins in five of the last six seasons to become the first Cougar teams to ever win five bowls in a six-year span. Nationally, BYU is one of only seven programs to win five bowl games in the last six seasons. The Cougars have also won 10 or more games in five of the past six seasons and five of Mendenhall's seven seasons overall. In fact, only four programs have had more 10-win seasons over the past seven years.



Another hallmark of Mendenhall's program has been the emphasis on balance and priorities in the many other facets of life outside of football. Reflecting that emphasis, BYU consistently received the most academic all-conference honorees each season as a conference member is tied for third nationally for Academic All-America recipients over Mendenhall's seven seasons at the helm. Seven Cougar student-athletes have been named ESPN Academic All-Americans in that span. Among all FBS schools only Penn State and Nebraska have had more during that period.

Mendenhall also serves as the team's defensive coordinator. The Cougars had the nation's No. 13 defense in 2011 to help BYU become one of only 11 programs to receive a final Top 25 overall team ranking in at least one of the two major polls during five of the past six seasons. BYU is one of only nine teams to do so in the USA Today Coaches Poll.
