• **THE SERIES.** BYU and Boise State are playing for the 12th time in the series, with the Broncos leading 7-4 overall. The Cougars won the last two matchups, including last year's first win on the blue turf with a 51-17 victory. In the last game in Provo in 2019, Baylor Romney made his first career start and led BYU to a 28-25 victory over No. 14 Boise State. It was the Broncos only loss of the 2019 season. The Cougars hold a 3-2 advantage in the series in Provo and are 2-3 overall under Kalani Sitake.

• **HOMECOMING.** This week is Homecoming week for the Cougars. BYU is 4-1 under Sitake in the annual game. Additional activities for BYU's Homecoming festivities can be found at [homecoming.byu.edu](https://homecoming.byu.edu)

• **IN THE TOP 10.** Highlighted by three Pac-12 wins, including two wins over ranked teams, BYU came in at No. 10 in the AP Top 25 and No. 10 in the Coaches Poll this week. The Cougars are 14-2 under Kalani Sitake when ranked. BYU made an appearance in the top 10 last season after starting 9-0, climbing as high as No. 8 before finishing at No. 11 in the final polls.

• **BIG 12.** On Friday, Sept. 10, 2021, BYU accepted an official invitation to join the Big 12 Conference in all sports. The Cougars joined Cincinnati, Houston and UCF as the four new members. BYU is expected to play its first season in the Power 5 conference in 2023. The Cougars have a record of 85-48 since becoming an independent in 2011. ([Read more](#))

• **TURNOVERS.** The Cougars are +8 in turnovers through five games, picking up 10 and giving up only two. BYU has won 19 consecutive games when even or ahead in the turnover battle. Under head coach Kalani Sitake, BYU is 38-10 when even or ahead in turnovers. The Cougars have had zero giveaways in four of five games in 2021.

• **WINNING.** BYU is 16-1 since the beginning of the 2020 season. Only No. 1 Alabama has more wins (17) since 2020. BYU is one of 17 remaining undefeated FBS teams. BYU is on a seven-game winning streak, with two wins to end the 2020 season and a 5-0 start to 2021. The Cougars have opened 5-0 in back-to-back seasons for the first time in program history. BYU is attempting to go 6-0 for just the sixth time in program history (1979, 1984, 2001, 2008, 2020).

• **STAYING IN FRONT.** BYU is one of 4 teams who have yet to trail at any time in a game to start the 2021 season (Alabama, Georgia, Michigan). The Cougars have scored first in every game and have been tied only once after their first score (7-7, ASU). BYU is 27-6 under Kalani Sitake when scoring first.

BYU beat Arizona for the third time in six years in the season opener with a 24-16 win at Allegiant Stadium in Las Vegas. Neil Pau'u caught eight passes for 126 yards for two touchdowns while linebacker Keenan Pili had 17 total tackles.

The Cougars owned the trenches and powered their way to their first win in the series since 2009 with a 26-17 triumph over the Utes at LaVell Edwards Stadium. BYU led from start to finish and did not turn the ball over while forcing two against Utah.

BYU forced four turnovers and cashed in on several Arizona State mistakes to beat the Sun Devils 27-17 in front of another big crowd at LaVell Edwards Stadium. Jaren Hall threw two touchdown passes in the win.

Baylor Romney led a fast start to the offense with 21 straight points to start the game and BYU outlasted the USF Bulls 35-27. Romney threw for 305 yards while Gunner Romney and Puka Nacua both posted 100-yard receiving games.

Tyler Allgeier ran for 218 yards and three touchdowns as the ground game pounded Utah State all night and the Cougars ran to a 34-20 win. BYU's defense allowed just 22 rushing yards to a USU team averaging 213.5 rushing yards coming in.			
10/9	Boise State (2-3)	1:30 p.m.	ABC
BYU and Zach Wilson dismantled the Broncos on the blue turf last season with a 51-17 drubbing. The Cougars also edged Boise State in 2019 with a 28-25 win in Provo. BYU has never won three in a row against the Broncos.

The last time BYU played Baylor was amidst the Cougars' 1984 National Championship season when BYU defeated the Bears 47-13 in Provo. The Cougars visited Waco in 1983 but lost 40-36.

BYU travels to face Washington State in the Cougars' first trip to Pullman. The two teams have met four times previously, with three in Provo and one in the 1981 Holiday Bowl, where BYU won 38-36.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR ELEVEN

After finishing the 2020 season 11-1, BYU enters its 11th season as an independent. This season, the Cougars play seven teams from Power 5 conferences, including three to start the year. BYU will face five teams from the Pac-12 in Arizona, Utah, Arizona State, Washington State and USC. The Cougars will also match up with Baylor of the Big 12 and Virginia of the ACC. In addition to those Power 5 matchups, BYU also plays in-state foe Utah State along with Mountain West power Boise State. The Cougars will host USF of the American and Idaho State from the FCS.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's winning percentage at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 14 among teams playing in their current stadium.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates more than 400 missions around the world in over 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. More than 53,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 65 percent of the current team has served a mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. More than 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) are currently serving in the mission field.

HONOR CODE

BYU's Honor Code helps maintain this learning environment. Initiated by students in 1949, the Honor Code emphasizes being honest, living a chaste and virtuous life, abstaining from alcohol and tobacco, using clean language, and following other values in line with the doctrines of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.

POLYNESIAN PIPELINE

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. About 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Fesi Sitake Harvey Unga, Nu'u Tafisi, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You, Al Pupunu and Vince Feula.

FORMER PLAYERS ON STAFF

There are 15 former BYU football players on the football and athletic administration staff. Members of the staff were part of Cougar teams that won the 1980 "Miracle Bowl," the 1984 National Championship, 1996 Cotton Bowl along with many other accolades.



## THE BYU OFFENSE

• **COACHING EXPERIENCE.** The BYU offensive staff has nearly 100 years of coaching experience. Offensive line coach Darrell Funk has the most with more than 30 years. Tight ends coach Steve Clark has been coaching since 1994 and passing game coordinator Aaron Roderick has 22 years in the profession. Funk, Roderick, Clark and wide receivers coach Fesi Sitake have all been coordinators at the college level.

• **TWO BY TWO.** BYU features a pair of tight ends, a pair of running backs, and a pair of receivers poised to make a huge impact. Tight ends Isaac Rex and Dallin Holker could be a matchup nightmare. Rex, the 6-foot-6, 247-pound red zone threat caught 12 touchdowns last season while the speedy Holker caught 19 passes for 235 yards as a true freshman before a church mission. Running backs Tyler Allgeier and Lopini Katoa have combined for more than 3,200 rushing yards and have 37 rushing touchdowns. Wideouts Gunner Romney and Nei'I Pau'u have posted more than 2,800 receiving yards and 20 touchdowns.

• **HERBSTREIT'S TOP PLAYERS.** Tyler Allgeier was listed at No. 5 on ESPN College Football Analyst Kirk Herbstreit's top performances for week five. Allgeier's 218 rushing yards and three touchdowns set career marks. The 218-yard performance is the 8th-most rushing yards in a single game at BYU.

- 83 Against Arizona State, Ryan Rehkow set sail with an 83-yard punt for a new school record. The previous record came in 2014 when Scott Arellano booted a kick 81 yards against Middle Tennessee.

## KALANI SITAKE

### HEAD COACH

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) enters his sixth season overseeing the BYU football program in 2021.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program. Sitake is the first former player under Edwards to be named head coach at BYU.

Named BYU's head coach on December 19, 2015, Sitake returned to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven seasons a defensive coordinator and four years as an assistant head coach. He came to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in 2015 under head coach Gary Andersen. Sitake spent the prior 10 seasons at the University of Utah under head coach Kyle Whittingham. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012. He coached 12 all-conference honorees at Utah, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014).

During his career, Sitake has helped mentor 28 NFL Draft picks, including No. 2 overall pick Zach Wilson in the 2021 NFL Draft by the New York Jets. Sitake also coached BYU linebackers Sione Takitaki and Fred Warner and running back Jamaal Williams. Takitaki was a third-round pick of the Cleveland Browns in this year's draft and Warner was one of the league's top rookies after being taken in the third round in 2018 by the San Francisco 49ers.

Sitake has coached in 12 bowl games during his career and has been on the winning side in 10 of those 12 contests, including a 3-1 mark as a head coach. BYU is coming off a 49-23 win in the 2020 Boca Raton Bowl over UCF.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002 under Gary Crowton. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

He began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards. A team captain as a senior, Sitake's last game as a player was also the last game coached by the legendary Edwards, who was a great mentor for Sitake.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake is the nation's first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. Sitake and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).

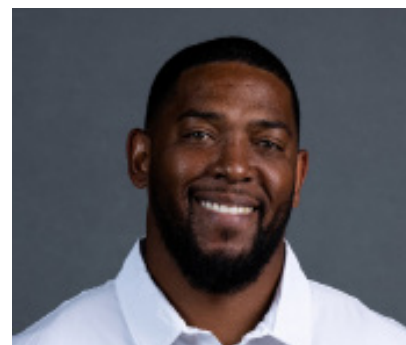
