BY THE NUMBERS

Dave Rose and the Cougars have the second-longest current streak of consecutive 25-win campaigns in the country at six (2006-07 to 2011-12). Only Bill Self and Kansas, owners of seven-consecutive 25-win seasons (2005-06 to 2011-12), have a longer current streak. BYU has also advanced to the NCAA Tournament for six-straight seasons.

Brandon Davies picked up where he left off last season, taking 11 charges through 14 games, including a season high of three vs. Tennessee State. He has now taken 42 charges since the beginning of last season. Nate Austin has taken three charges this season after drawing 29 offensive fouls lasts season.

Brandon Davies has four double-doubles this season, with 22 points and 10 rebounds vs. UTSA, 21 points and 10 rebounds vs. Montana, 26 points and 17 rebounds at Baylor and 27 points and 10 rebounds vs Northern Arizona. He now has 17 career double-doubles, including nine last season.

The number of points Tyler Haws scored against Virginia Tech, a career high and the most scored by an individual in NCAA Division I basketball this season. The 42 points are also a BYU sophomore record and tied for the eighth most in program history. Haws also broke the family record of 40 set by his father Marty Haws in 1989.

Dave Rose (2005 to present) is second all-time in BYU basketball history with 195 career victories, behind only the great Stan Watts, who coached the Cougars to 371 wins from 1949 to 1972 and was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in 1986.

HAWS NAMED WCC, SI.COM, NBC SPORTS PLAYER OF THE WEEK - DEC. 31, 2012

Tyler Haws was named the player of the week by the WCC, Sl.com and NBC Sports after leading BYU to a 2-0 record with wins over Northern Arizona (84-54) and Virginia Tech (97-71). Haws averaged 28.5 points, 3.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 2.0 steals while shooting .543 (19-35) from the field, .750 (9-12) from three and .909 (10-11) from the free throw line. Haws had a monster performance against the Hokies, scoring a career-high 42 points. Haws' effort marked the single-highest scoring output by a Division I player so far this season.

DAVIES NAMED WCC PLAYER OF THE WEEK - DEC. 17, 2012

The West Coast Conference has named BYU senior forward Brandon Davies its Men's Basketball Player of the Week award-winner for Dec. 17, 2012. Davies scored a career-high 33 points and added eight rebounds and one block to lead BYU to its first road win of the season, a 78-68 victory at Weber State. The win ended Weber State's 20-game home winning streak, the fourth-longest home streak in the nation. Davies hit 14 of 17 from the field and 5 of 6 from the free throw line in the Cougars' victory.

LAST TIME OUT - HAWS SCORES 42 POINTS AS BYU TOPPLES VIRGINIA TECH 97-71

SALT LAKE CITY — Tyler Haws scored a career-high 42 points and led the BYU men's basketball team to a 97-71 handling of Virginia Tech at EnergySolutions Arena on Saturday afternoon. The Cougars are now 10-4 while the Hokies fall in 9-3

Haws made 14 of 25 shots, including a career-best six of eight 3-pointers. The sophomore had 29 first-half points and finished with three rebounds, two steals and one assist.

Haws' 42 points in a game are tied for the eighth most by a BYU player. The former Lone Peak star also owns the family scoring record now, topping his father Marty Haws who scored a career-best 40 points against Siena in 1989 for the Cougars.

BYU shot 46.5 percent from the field and limited the Hokies to 38.1 percent, including just 2 of 20 from behind the arc. Brandon Davies added 17 points, four rebounds, four assists and one steal while Josh Sharp added 10 points. Haws started the game with back-to-back threes and Davies made three foul shots to lead 9-0 before the Hokies picked up their first bucket with 17:49 left in the first half.

Haws continued his hot shooting in the opening minutes, knocking down four 3-pointers in the first six minutes of the game, helping the Cougars to a 22-12 lead.

Anson Winder and Davies got the crowd going with a Winder to Davies alley-oop dunk on an inbound pass. Davies followed it up with another layup shortly after to add to the Cougar lead at 26-14 with just over 12 minutes until halftime.

The 3-point barrage from Haws continued when he knocked down his fifth of the game, a career-high, during a 7-0 BYU run, pushing the lead to 33-17 with 10 minutes still to play in the first half.

After Haws got a 65-second breather he checked back in and proceeded to can another trey. Raul Delgado added another 3-pointer on the next possession to push the score to 43-25 with less than seven minutes remaining in the

The Cougars continued to roll into halftime, building a 25-point lead at the break, up 56-31. Haws had 29 points in the half on 9 of 13 shooting, including six of eight from 3-point land. The 29 first half points are the most in a half by a BYU player since Jimmer Fredette scored 33 in the first half against New Mexico in the 2011 Mountain West Conference Tournament. Fredette finished that game with a BYU record 52 points.

After Davies picked up an offensive board with 16:32 in the second half he dished it back to Haws for score and a chance at a 3-point play. Haws drained the free throw to give BYU a 30-point lead at 67-37.

The Cougars and Hokies traded baskets over the next six minutes but Virginia Tech went on a 12-0 run to cut the lead down to 78-60 with 7:33 left in the game. Haws finally ended the run with two to end a string of 0 for 8 shooting by the Cougars.

Sharp pushed BYU's lead back to 25 with a one-handed dunk and a made free throw for a 3-point play, giving the Cougars an 87-62 lead with just under six minutes remaining. The Cougars cruised the rest of the way to a 97-71 victory.

2012-13 STORYLINES AND NOTES

Player and team notes

- Senior Brandon Davies has played his best basketball over the last five games, averaging 24.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, 2.4 assists, 1.0 blocks and 1.6 steals while shooting .652 from the field and .778 from the free throw line.
- The Cougars posted a season-high 15 steals against Northern Arizona with Brandon Davies and Brock Zylstra registering three apiece and Tyler Haws, Matt Carlino and Craig Cusick each adding two. BYU forced 24 turnovers, a season high for a Cougar opponent.
- Tyler Haws hit 10 of 10 from the free throw line vs. Weber State, his third game this season shooting 100 percent from the line while attempting at least 10 free throws. Haws has four such games in his career, tied for the most in BYU history with Jimmer Fredette. Haws is tied with Russell Larson (1993-94) and Roberts (1994-95) for most perfect days from the line (minimum of 10 attempts) in a season with three. Danny Ainge, Lee Cummard, Larson and Roberts are tied for second on the career list with three.

Two averaging 20 in the top 20

Tyler Haws (20.9 points per game) and Brandon Davies (20.1 points per game) are ranked No. 11 and 17, respectively, in scoring in the NCAA. BYU is the only team in the NCAA with two players in the top 20 in scoring and the only program with two players averaging 20-plus points per game. BYU is also one of only four teams with two players in the top 50 in scoring (Cal State Fullerton, Central Connecticut and Iona are the others).

Haws's big day

On Dec. 29, Tyler Haws scored a career-high 42 points against Virginia Tech as he hit 14 of 25 from the field, 6 of 8 from three and 8 of 9 from the free throw line. See below for some of the records Haws set in his breakout game:

- Most points scored by a BYU sophomore
- Tied for eighth-most points scored by an individual in BYU history
- Most points scored by a BYU player not named Jimmer Fredette since 1961 (Bob Skousen, 47 vs. UCLA)
- Most points scored by an individual in NCAA Division I men's basketball this season
- Gives BYU a father-son duo in the 40-point club (Haws's father Marty scored 40 vs. Siena in 1989)

Haws the closer

Tyler Haws has played some of his best basketball in the final five minutes of games this season. Against Cal State Northridge, BYU trailed 74-73 with less than four minutes remaining. Haws hit a jumper with 3:44 to go to give BYU the lead and had 10 of the Cougars' final 14 points to help secure the 87-75 win. Against Utah BYU trailed 58-56 before Haws completed a three-point play with 2:47 to go. He added two free throws with 16 seconds remaining to secure the 61-58 win. After struggling from the field the first 35 minutes at Weber State, Haws scored nine points in the last five minutes on 3 of 3 shooting from the field and 2 of 2 from the free throw line. For the season, Haws is 14 of 17 from the field, 2 of 3 from three and 13 of 14 from the free throw line in the last five minutes of games.

Fast start for Tyler Haws

Tyler Haws opened 2012-13 with six-straight 20-point games, the second best such streak in program history. Only Devin Durrant started a season with more consecutive 20-point games, seven in 1983-84.

Davies does it all

Brandon Davies has stuffed the stat sheet this season, averaging 20.1 points, 7.9 rebounds, 2.6 assists, 1.6 blocks and 1.5 steals through 14 games. Last season he became the second Cougar in program history to average at least one of everything (points, rebounds, assists, steals and blocks). Russell Larson is the only other BYU player to produce a 'one of everything' season and did so twice, in 1993-94 and 1994-95 (blocks and steals were not tracked until the 1977-78 season).

Dave Rose

BYU head coach Dave Rose has led BYU to its most successful eight-year run since taking over in 2005. His career record of 195-58 ranks him second in BYU history in total victories and first in winning percentage (.771). Rose has been named conference coach of the year three times, district coach of the year twice and has guided the Cougars to four conference titles, six NCAA Tournament appearances and six 25-win seasons. In 2010 he led BYU to its first NCAA Tournament win in 17 years and the Cougars have also won at least one tournament game in the two seasons since, including a trip to the Sweet 16 in 2011.
