BYU STORYLINES

- **BYU and Boise State meet for the fourth time Friday.** BYU is looking for its first win against the Broncos after losing 7-6 in 2012 in Boise.
- **BYU is 273-161-13 vs. Mountain West teams.** BYU's last game vs. a Mountain West opponent resulted in a 31-14 road victory vs. Utah State Oct. 4.
- **BYU ranks No. 14 in the nation in rushing offense** with 263.4 yards per game earned on the ground. Boise State ranks 20th in rushing yards with 224 per game.
- **BYU is also No. 14 in total offense with 503 yards per game**, while Boise State is No. 18 with 494.4.
- **BYU has two players ranked in the top 25 nationally for rushing yards per game**--Taysom Hill (16th) with 110.3 and Jamaal Williams (22nd) with 104.3.
- **Cody Hoffman had seven receptions vs. Houston and became the career receptions leader** at BYU with 228, passing All-American Dennis Pitta. He is tied for No. 1 at BYU for all-time career touchdown receptions with Austin Collie (30). He needs two more 100-yard receiving games to pass Collie in that category.
- **BYU's defense has eight players with 30 or more tackles in 2013**, led by Uani 'Unga's 69.
- **Kyle Van Noy has 26 career sacks, which is the second most nationally among active players.** The senior needs eight more sacks this season to pass the career sack record at BYU (33).
- **October is National Breast Cancer Awareness month.** BYU players and coaches will be wearing pink as part of their uniform attire during Friday's game in support of breast cancer awareness.

A postgame press conference will be conducted in the LaVell Edwards Stadium press room, located on the southeast end of the stadium next to the BYU locker room. At the discretion of the visiting team, opponent interviews will be conducted in the Blue Zone, near the opponent's locker room located on northwest end of the stadium. Coach Mendenhall and select players will be available following the NCAA mandatory cooling off period. BYU DEFEATS HOUSTON

HOUSTON - Taysom Hill hit Skyler Ridley for a touchdown with just over a minute left in the fourth quarter to give BYU a 47-46 win over Houston at Reliant Stadium on Saturday afternoon.

BYU received the ball with 1:50 left at midfield. Hill hit Skyler Ridley for 28 yards down the left sideline on the first play of the drive. After two rushing plays, Hill hit Ridley again for an 11-yard touchdown to put BYU up 47-46 with 1:08 left in the fourth quarter. The blue Cougars tried a two-point conversion, but were stopped short of the goal line.

Alani Fua sealed the win with an interception in his second straight game. Hill ran for a first down to run the clock out to preserve the win.

BYU (5-2) gained 683 yards of total offense and set school records with 41 first downs and 115 total plays. The 115 plays tie an FBS single game record as well. Houston (5-1) lost for the first time this season.

The game turned into a track meet in the first half as Houston led 38-34. Both teams combined for 102 plays,

701 yards and 38 first downs.

For the second straight game, BYU intercepted its opponent's first pass of the game. Spencer Hadley dropped back into coverage, read the quarterback's eyes and jumped in front of the receiver and picked off the pass.

Cody Hoffman caught a pass from Hill for 13-yards to become BYU's all-time career receptions leader. Another 13-yard connection from Hill to Hoffman set up Williams' 15-yard touchdown run to put BYU up 7-0 with just over 14 minutes left in the opening quarter.

BYU increased its lead when Justin Sorensen hit a season-long 41-yard field goal to go up 10-0 with just over 10 minutes left in the quarter. Hill hit Mitch Mathews for 36 yards to move the ball into the "blue zone". BYU gained two yards before a penalty and two incomplections set up Sorensen's kick.

In the fourth quarter, BYU retook the lead on Hoffman's school record-tying TD grab to go back up 41-40.

Houston scored with 5:20 left in the fourth quarter to go up 46-41 over BYU late in the game. After scoring, Houston went for two but was unable to convert.

NOTES FROM BYU'S LAST GAME

- **BYU ran 115 offensive plays, the most in a game in school history and tying for the most in FBS history.** The Cougars also converted a school-best 41 first downs.
- **Houston's 46 points are the most given up by BYU** this season and the most since 2011.
- **With seven catches for 156 yards, senior** Cody Hoffman passed Dennis Pitta as the all-time receptions leader at BYU with 228. Hoffman's fourth-quarter TD grab ties him with Austin Collier for the school record 30 receiving touchdowns. His 53-yard TD catch was his longest reception of the season.
- **Quarterback Taysom Hill threw for 417 yards** on 29 completions and four touchdowns, all personal bests. His 545 total yards of offense rank No. 9 all-time at BYU.
- **Hill also ran for 128 yards to become the third** leading QB rusher at BYU, passing Steve Young (1,084) with 1,108. He trails just Virgil Carter (1,225) and Eldon Fortie (1,624).
- **Skyler Ridley's late score was his first of 2013** and second of his career. His 90 receiving yards on seven catches are both career highs.
- **Spencer Hadley, Daniel Sorensen and Alani Fua** each got interceptions vs. Houston.
- **Both Mike Hague and Robertson Daniel** got their first career sacks against Houston.

OPPONENT OUTLOOK

BOISE STATE'S LAST GAME

BOISE, Idaho (AP) - Boise State running back Jay Ajayi ran for a career-high 222 yards on 24 carries with three touchdowns to lead the Broncos to a 34-17 win over Nevada.

Backup quarterback Grant Hedrick threw for 150 yards and ran for 115 more.

Hedrick, a junior who had only attempted 36 passes in his career, took over when starting quarterback Joe Southwick injured his right foot on the Broncos' first offensive play from scrimmage. He finished 18-of-21 passing. He is also the first Bronco quarterback to rush for over 100 yards since Jared Zabranski rushed for 123 against Hawaii in 2004.

Boise State (5-2, 3-1 Mountain West) won its eighth straight game at home against Nevada.

Nevada (3-4, 2-2), which led at halftime against Boise State for the first time since 1997, lost its fifth straight on the road dating back to last season.

Boise State's defense, which yielded 246 yards of offense in the first half, held Nevada to 127 yards in the second half.

Trailing 17-7 at halftime, the Boise State offense also found its rhythm in the second half.



On their first possession of the second half, the Broncos drove 64 yards in eight plays, scoring on a 4-yard touchdown run by Ajayi. A missed extra point left Nevada with a 17-13 lead.

On Boise State's next possession, Ajayi raced 71 yards for a touchdown on the first play from scrimmage. With the extra point, Boise State took its first lead at 20-17 with 9:31 left in the third quarter.

Boise State added two more touchdowns to secure the victory.

Nevada receiver Brandon Wimberly led the Wolfpack with 11 catches for 121 yards. However, his streak of five straight games with a touchdown reception was snapped.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR THREE

BYU's 2013 schedule may be the toughest in program history. The 12-game schedule with six road games and six home games includes fellow independent Notre Dame and teams from eight different conferences, including the Atlantic Coast, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12, American Athletic, Conference USA, Mountain West and Big Sky.

FLAG BEARERS

BYU has a tradition of selecting a player before each game to run the team flag and alumni flag. The team selects a former Cougar to carry out the alumni flag, along with the chosen current player who runs out with the current team flag. The team flag has been signed by each member of the team, while the alumni flag has been signed by former BYU payers. In 2011, the team added a special teams flag, donned by a vintage BYU logo adopted by the special teams, following the same protocol as the team flag with an exemplary special teams player being chosen to carry it each week.

TEAM CAPTAINS

Selected by their peers, wide receiver Skyler Ridley, slot receiver JD Falslev, linebacker Uani 'Unga and safety Daniel Sorensen have been named team captains for the 2013 season. Three of the four captains started their BYU careers as walk-ons.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 64,045 after refurbishing the middle of the east section. The capacity now sits at 63,470 due to accommodations for wheelchair access. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's 2012 average attendance of 61,161 ranked No. 3 in the West behind only USC (87,945) and UCLA (68,481).

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates 405 missions around the world in 145 nations speaking 164 languages. More than 75,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 330 missions around the world. Seventy-five percent of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years or 18 months for women and couples—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

There are 73 returned missionaries on the 2013 team. There are 57 missionaries from the football team currently serving in 18 different countries. Members of the team cover five of the seven continents around the globe.

FIRESIDES

The BYU football team will participate in hour-long devotionals prior or team service activities the night before each game this season. The team will conduct devotionals before eight games. These devotionals are referred to as "firesides" and are intended to help players, coaches and those who attend strengthen or gain a knowledge of our purpose here on earth. Firesides typically include a musical number from members of the team and talks from selected players, along with Bronco Mendenhall.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- **Quarterback Taysom Hill ranks No. 16 in the country** in rushing yards per game with 110.2 per contest. His seven rushing touchdowns are tied for the second most among quarterbacks this season. Hill is currently No. 3 all-time at BYU among quarterbacks with 1,108 career rushing yards. The sophomore also ranks No. 8 in the FBS with an average of 350.3 yards per game of total offense.
- **Five different Cougars scored in last week's game against Houston.** Both Ross Apo and Jamaal Williams found the end zone twice in the first half. Cody Hoffman caught his school-record tying 30th career touchdown on a 25-yard pass from Taysom Hill in the fourth quarter. Senior captain Skyler Ridley hauled in the go-ahead score with just over a minute remaining in the game, his first touchdown of the season.
- **Sophomore Jamaal Williams rushed for a career-high 182** rushing yards against Texas in Week 2. After an 83-yard output against Houston, the sophomore ranks No. 18 at BYU for career rushing yards with 1,401 yards. He needs just 104 yards to jump to the top-15 in BYU history. Williams ranks 22nd nationally with 104.3 yards per game.
- **Keep an eye out for The Hoff Show.** Wideout Cody Hoffman has an opportunity to end his Cougar career as possibly the best receiver in BYU history. The senior now stands No. 1 in career receptions with 228. He enters this week needing just 71 yards and one touchdown to take the top spot among the all-time leaders in both categories. As of now, Hoffman has amassed 3,185 yards and 30 receiving touchdowns in his career. Hoffman holds the record for receiving touchdowns in a game (5) and needs two more 100-yard receiving games to have the most in program history.
- **Go fast, go hard** has been the mantra of coach Anae. With coach Anae leading the offense again, he's brought the credo of "Go fast, go hard" to the team. The Cougars average a play every 18.8 seconds, the second fastest of any team in the country.
- **BYU has not been shut out for 119 consecutive games.** The last time the Cougars failed to score was in 2003 in a 3-0 loss to Utah. That loss was the only time BYU has not produced points since 1975. BYU has scored in the last 481 of 482 games since 1975.

- 3** The defense has allowed only three rushing touchdowns this season and never more than one in a game. Over the past two seasons, only two opponents have scored two or more rushing touchdowns against BYU, Weber State (2) and Oregon State (2).
- 6** Senior strong safety Daniel Sorensen is tied for sixth nationally with nine pass breakups on the season. The season record at BYU since the NCAA started tracking defensive stats in 2000 is 15 and is held by Jordan Johnson.
- 10** The defense is ranked 10th in the nation in plays allowed of 10 yards or more. It has given up 72 such plays or 10.3 plays of 10+ yards per game.
- 26** 2013 All-America candidate Kyle Van Noy has 26 career sacks, good for second nationally among active players. The senior is tied for fourth place overall at BYU and needs eight more sacks this season to pass the career sack record at BYU (33).
- 29** The BYU defense is ranked 29th in scoring defense, allowing an average of 21.4 points per game. For the season, the unit allows opponents only .273 points per play.

THE BYU DEFENSE

- **BYU defense likes to get off the field, a lot.** The defensive unit has forced 5.86 three and outs per game to rank tied for eighth nationally in that category. Of the 113 opponent drives this season, the defense has gotten off the field in three plays or less 41 times, meaning that the defense has either forced a punt after three plays or has caused a turnover before the opposing team recorded a first down of any kind. At the same time, BYU has forced 9.1 punts per game and 61 punts overall to lead both categories nationally.
- **The Kyle Van Noy Show.** The 2013 All-America candidate, who is also on the Bednarik Award, Nagurski Trophy, Butkus Award, Lombardi Award, Lott Impact Trophy, Maxwell Award and Walter Camp Award watch lists, is second nationally among active players with 26 career sacks and tied for fourth all-time at BYU with Jim Herrmann. The senior was named to the Phil Steele Midseason All-America First Team, the Chuck Bednarik Player of the Week for his game against Georgia Tech and the FBS Independent Defensive Player of the Week two times. Currently, Van Noy is second on the team with 44 tackles, first on the team in tackles for loss with 11.0, first on the team with four sacks, tied for second with one interception and first on the team with 11 quarterback hurries. After being the only FBS player to record a stat in every defensive category the past two seasons, Van Noy needs to cause a fumble, recover a fumble and block a kick to do it for a third straight year.
- **Making a name for themselves.** A strong fall camp earned Alani Fua a starting role at outside linebacker. Currently Fua is tied for the team lead with two interceptions, seventh on the team in tackles with 32, tied for fifth on the team with 2.5 tackles for loss and tied for second with two sacks. He recorded his first career touchdown on an interception that he ran back 51 yards against Georgia Tech. Senior Spencer Hadley has returned from a suspension and has 24 tackles, 2.5 tackles for loss, one sack, one interception, two pass breakups and one fumble recovery.
- **A large defensive line will help anchor the defense.** Eathyn Manumaleuna returns to the field after suffering a season-ending knee injury last year and receiving a medical redshirt. The fifth-year senior and Outland Trophy candidate has played in 50 games over his five-year career at both defensive end and defensive tackle. True sophomore and Ted Hendricks candidate Bronson Kaufusi and redshirt sophomore Remington Peck join Manumaleuna on the line, as defensive ends. In the mix for extensive playing time is junior Marques Johnson who redshirted last season. Combined, the four average a commanding 6-foot-4 and 283 pounds, and will look to wreck havoc in opposing backfields all year long. The quartet has helped limit opposing offenses to just 136 rushing yards per game and just three rushing touchdowns.
- **Behind enemy lines.** In five games this season, the defense has averaged 5.86 tackles for loss per game, ranked T-No. 65 nationally. Overall, the unit has recorded 41 TFL this season to rank T-49 nationally. Since last season, the defense has recorded 5.0 TFL in 17 of 20 games. Eathyn Manumaleuna, Uani 'Unga, Alani Fua, Daniel Sorensen, Tyler Beck, Remington Peck and Kyle Van Noy each have recorded 2.0 TFL or more with Van Noy tallying 11.0 to rank T-No. 8 nationally.
- **Defensive stalwarts.** On the defensive side of the ball, there are six players who have played in more than 40 games in their careers including Mike Hague (44), Spencer Hadley (41), Austen Jorgensen (44) Daniel Sorensen (45), Kyle Van Noy (46) and Eathyn Manumaleuna (50). Combined the six players have played in 270 games and have 133 starts. Manumaleuna has started in 44 games, and Sorensen and Van Noy have each started in 33 games.

HEAD COACH**BRONCO MENDENHALL****YEARS AT BYU**

Entering 9th year as head coach, 11th at BYU

YEARS OVERALL

Entering 25th year

In his first eight seasons as head coach at Brigham Young University, Bronco Mendenhall has restored tradition to the Cougars as one of the nation's top teams. Taking over a BYU program in 2005 that was coming off three losing seasons, Mendenhall has guided his teams to eight straight bowl invitations, two outright conference championships and regular national top-25 rankings. The Cougars finished the 2012 regular season 8-5, with a program-record fourth consecutive bowl victory, won four of their last five games and had the No. 3-ranked total defense in the nation.

Under his leadership, BYU has earned a 79-31 (.718) record to date to rank No. 12 in total wins among all teams in the nation since 2005. The Cougars have received eight straight bowl invitations for the first time since a string of 17 consecutive bowls invitations from 1978 through 1994. Mendenhall is the only coach in BYU football history that took his first eight teams to a bowl game and has the highest winning percentage of any coach in school history. He also has more wins in his first 100 contests at BYU than Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards.

Mendenhall has led BYU to bowl wins in six of the last seven seasons to become the first Cougar teams to ever win six bowls in a seven-year span and win four in a row. Nationally, no one has won more bowl games over the past eight years and BYU is one of only seven programs to win six bowl games in the last eight seasons. The Cougars have won 10 or more games in five of Mendenhall's eight seasons overall.

BYU's success under Mendenhall is also evident in the national rankings and NCAA statistics. BYU has finished ranked in the top 25 in the various national statistical categories 127 times in his eight seasons (47 offense, 58 defense, 20 special teams, 2 misc.). The Cougars have achieved 78 top-15 statistical rankings, 58 top-10 rankings and 27 top-5 rankings in that span. The Cougars have also been ranked in the top-25 polls during seven of the past eight seasons and finished ranked in five seasons, including No. 12 following the 2009 season -- the program's highest final ranking since finishing No. 5 in 1996.

Another hallmark of Mendenhall's program has been the emphasis on balance and priorities in the many other facets of life outside of football. Reflecting that emphasis, BYU consistently received the most academic all-conference honorees each season as a conference member, while six Cougar student-athletes have earned seven Academic All-America citations under Mendenhall. Only three teams have had more Academic All-America citations during Mendenhall's tenure. BYU has led all FBS programs three of the last four years for the most selections to the NFF Hampshire Honor Society (3.2 GPA over college career.)

He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at his alma mater, Oregon State. He later coached at Snow College, Northern Arizona, became the youngest defensive coordinator in the Pac-10 at Oregon State and went to Louisiana Tech and New Mexico before coming to BYU as a defensive coordinator in 2003.

Hailing from Alpine, Utah, Mendenhall is married to Holly Johnston of Missoula, Mont. They have three sons, Cutter, Breaker and Raeder.

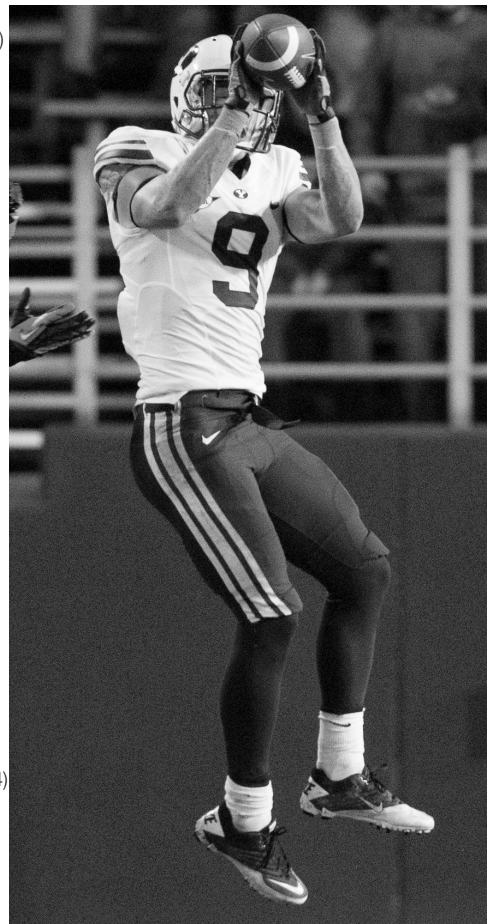
