BYU STORYLINES

- **Last meeting.** Saturday's game is the first between BYU and Savannah State
- **BYU vs. MEAC.** This is BYU's first meeting with an MEAC team in football.
- **10 seasons.** Bronco Mendenhall is now in his 10th season as head coach of the Cougars. Mendenhall has an 87-38 record, and BYU ranks 12th in total wins nationally during his tenure.
- **Beating the best.** Since 2003, BYU has 17 wins against Power 5 schools, which ranks second among non-Power 5 schools behind fellow independent Navy. BYU has the longest season streak, with nine straight seasons with a Power 5 win.
- **Ray Guy Award Semifinalist.** BYU punter Scott Arellano recorded the longest punt in BYU history and in the NCAA this season with an 81-yarder vs. Middle Tennessee. He broke former NFL punter Lee Johnson's BYU record set in 1983 vs. Wyoming. Arellano also has the third longest punt (76 yards) in the NCAA this season.
- **11 weeks in the spotlight.** BYU's game Saturday will be its 11th straight on a network available nationally. BYU has been on ESPN six times, ESPN2 once, ESPN once, Fox Sports 1 once and CBS Sports Network once. Saturday's game will be the Cougars' only live game on BYUtv this season.
- **Senior Day.** Saturday's game is BYU's Senior Day. Senior players will be honored prior to the game.
- **10 Bowls.** BYU has accepted an invitation to the Miami Beach Bowl on Dec. 22. This is the 10th straight bowl game for Bronco Mendenhall and the Cougars, who have a 6-3 bowl record.

POSTGAME MEDIA AVAILABILITY

After home games, postgame press conference will be conducted in the LaVell Edwards Stadium press room, located on the southeast end of the stadium next to the BYU locker room. At the discretion of the visiting team, opponent interviews will be conducted in the Blue Zone, near the opponent's locker room located on northwest end of the stadium. Coach Mendenhall and select players will be available following the NCAA mandatory cooling off period. Members of the media are invited to move from the press box down to the field and to the press room four minutes prior to the ending of the game. A direct video feed will also be sent to the press box from the BYU postgame press conference. A basic transcript of Mendenhall's comments from the postgame press conference will be provided. For road games, BYU will conduct interviews outside the locker room or in a location designated by the host school.

BYU VS. UNLV

Paul Lasike recorded a career-high three touchdowns while leading BYU football to a 42-23 blowout win over UNLV Saturday at Lavell Edwards Stadium.

Lasike totaled 70 yards and two touchdowns on the ground along with one reception for 26 yards and a touchdown. Christian Stewart passed for 325 yards and three touchdowns, completing 18 of 32 passes. Mitch Mathews led all receivers with six catches for 120 yards and a touchdown.

The Cougars broke the game wide open in the third quarter, scoring three touchdowns. The first score came on BYU's opening drive capped by a 15-yard touchdown pass from Stewart to Devin Mahina.

Later in the quarter, Lasike scored his third touchdown of the game when Stewart faked a handoff in the backfield and found Lasike down the seam for a 26-yard scoring strike to extend the Cougar lead to 35-16.

Mathews scored BYU's third touchdown of the quarter on an 8-yard reception from Stewart that was set up one play earlier by a 35-yard pass to Jordan Leslie.

BYU PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- **Senior quarterback Christian Stewart** ended the game with 325 yards through the air on 18-of-32 passing and three touchdowns. He also ran for 38 yards on six attempts.
- **Junior linebacker Bronson Kaufusi** registered career highs in total tackles (nine), solo tackles (eight) and tied career highs in tackles for loss (three) and sacks (two). He has at least one sack in each of the past three games.
- **Senior running back Paul Lasike** carried the ball eight times for 70 yards with two touchdowns while also adding a career-long 26-yard touchdown reception. He recorded his longest run of the season on the Cougars' first drive of the second half with a 39-yard burst up the field. At 5:42 left in the third, he hauled in his touchdown catch for his career-high third TD of the game. It was also a career-long reception.
- **Junior receiver Mitch Mathews** ended the game with 120 yards on six receptions with one touchdown catch—his sixth of the season. He eclipsed the 100-yard receiving mark for the third time this season. On the second BYU scoring drive of the game, Mathews caught a 48-yard pass, the longest pass of his career.
- **Senior punter Scott Arellano** recorded three punts inside the 20-yard line with an average of 41 yards on seven punts. He landed his 20th punt inside the 20-yard line of the season and a 38-yard punt downed at the 1-yard line.



SAVANNAH STATE VS. N.C. A&T

North Carolina A&T's Tarik Cohen ran for 115 yards and three third-quarter touchdowns to lead the Aggies to a 34-0 victory over Savannah State in a Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference game Saturday at T.A. Wright Stadium.

A crowd of 1,656 watched as SSU was shut out for the first time since Sept. 8, 2012, when it lost 55-0 to Florida State in Tallahassee, Fla. It also marked the first time the Tigers were shut out by a MEAC team since becoming an official member of the conference in 2011.

SSU (0-11 overall, 0-8 MEAC) trailed 10-0 at halftime but N.C. A&T (9-2, 6-1 MEAC) reeled off three touchdown runs of 17, 2 and 54 yards, all by Cohen, in the third quarter to seal its victory and take over sole possession of first place in the MEAC.

With the game scoreless and 12:17 left in the second quarter, SSU's John Barron attempted a 32-yard field goal but it was blocked by N.C. A&T. On its ensuing possession N.C. A&T capped a 10-play, 80-yard drive with a 17-yard touchdown pass with 7:07 left before halftime. Cody Jones kicked the first of his four extra points for a 7-0 lead.

SSU PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- **SSU's Prunty, who started the game at** quarterback, finished 11-of-30 passing for 119 yards. He was intercepted twice by D'Vonte Grant (game-high 11 tackles, including three sacks) and Donald Mattocks. Prunty lost one fumble, which was recovered by Ragland.
- **SSU's Tino Smith finished 7-of-12 passing for** 54 yards without an interception.
- **SSU finished the game with 32 carries for** minus-8 yards, while N.C. A&T ran for 224 yards on 39 carries. Leonardo Myers made a team-high nine tackles for SSU.
- **N.C. A&T made it 34-0 thank to Jones' 27-** yard field goal with 9:55 to play in the game, the final home game for SSU's seniors.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR FOUR

The 12-game independent slate features teams from 10 states and seven conferences, including the American Athletic, Atlantic Coast, Big 12, Pac-12, Conference USA, Mountain West and Mid-Eastern Athletic.

The Cougars will play six home games and six road contests in 2014. BYU will face teams that hail from Connecticut, Virginia, Florida, Georgia, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Idaho, Nevada and California, including seven programs—Texas, Houston, Utah State, Central Florida, Boise State, Middle Tennessee and UNLV—that qualified for a bowl game last season.

FLAG BEARERS

BYU has a tradition of selecting a player before each game to run the team flag and alumni flag. The team selects a former Cougar to carry out the alumni flag, along with the chosen current player who runs out with the current team flag. The team flag has been signed by each member of the team, while the alumni flag has been signed by former BYU payers. In 2011, the team added a special teams flag, donned by a vintage BYU logo adopted by the special teams, following the same protocol as the team flag with an exemplary special teams player being chosen to carry it each week.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 64,045 after refurbishing the middle of the east section. The capacity now sits at 63,470 due to accommodations for wheelchair access. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's 2012 average attendance of 61,161 ranked No. 3 in the West behind only USC (87,945) and UCLA (68,481).

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates missions around the world in 145 nations speaking 164 languages. More than 88,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 406 missions around the world. Seventy-five percent of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples)—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

Eighty-eight members of the 2014 team have served church missions. Members of the team have served in 28 countries and six of the seven continents around the globe.

FIRESIDES

The BYU football team will participate in hour-long devotionals prior or team service activities the night before each game this season. The team will conduct devotionals before eight games. These devotionals are referred to as "firesides" and are intended to help players, coaches and those who attend strengthen or gain a knowledge of our purpose here on earth. Firesides typically include a musical number from members of the team and talks from selected players, along with coach Bronco Mendenhall.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- **Go fast, go hard** has been the mantra of offensive coordinator Robert Anae. In 2014 the team is averaging one play every 20.4 seconds and 80 plays per game. Last year with a new offense, the Cougars averaged 89.9 plays per game, the second most of any team in the country only behind Texas Tech. Comparatively, BYU ran 79.2 plays per game in 2012.
- **BYU has not been shut out for 134 consecutive games.** The last time the Cougars failed to score was in 2003 in a 3-0 loss to Utah. That loss was the only time BYU has not produced points since 1975. BYU has scored in the last 491 of 492 games since 1975.
- **First downs.** BYU's offense is averaging 25.2 first downs per game, tying it for No. 15 in the nation.
- **C-Stew measuring up.** Christian Stewart has thrown for over 250 yards in four of his five starts. With his 15 touchdowns (13 passing, 2 rushing) he is tied with Taysom Hill (7 passing, 8 rushing) in the number of touchdowns he is responsible for.
- **Total offense.** BYU's offense totaled 592 yards for the second-highest amount this season. It was the first time since the home win against Houston that the ground attack registered over 200 yards.

THE BYU DEFENSE

- **BYU's run defense has been dominant.** At 121.4 rushing yards allowed per game, BYU ranks No. 18 in the country.
- **In the past nine seasons, BYU has finished ranked in the top 25 in various national statistical categories 61 times on defense.** Currently, BYU ranks in the top 25 in defensive rushing yards per game and in opponent rushing yards per attempt and total pass breakups.
- **Lengthening the field.** The Cougars have allowed 30 rushing plays of 10 or more yards this season, ranking them in a tie at No. 4 in the nation. For the 2013 season, BYU allowed opponents 54 run plays of 10 yards or more to rank No. 26 in the country.
- **Pass Defense.** The Cougar defense registered nine pass breakups in the win over UNLV, tying a season-high that was set against Nevada.
- **Sacks.** Bronson Kaufusi recorded two sacks in the win over UNLV and has at least one sack in each of the past three games. He is tied for No. 22 in the nation in sacks per game with 0.75.

HEAD COACH**BRONCO MENDENHALL****YEARS AT BYU**

10th year as head coach, 12th at BYU

YEARS OVERALL

26th year

Entering his tenth season as head coach at Brigham Young University, Bronco Mendenhall has restored the Cougars' reputation as one of the nation's top college football programs. Taking over a BYU team that in 2005 was coming off three consecutive losing seasons, Mendenhall has guided his teams to nine straight bowl appearances, two outright conference championships before football independence in 2011, and regular national top-25 rankings.

Under Mendenhall's leadership, BYU has earned an 88-38 record to rank 12th in total wins among all FBS teams since 2005. Mendenhall also ranks 12th in winning percentage at .698 among active coaches with at least five years of FBS experience.

The Cougars finished the 2013 season with an 8-5 record after playing one of the toughest schedules in school history. BYU earned six of its eight wins over bowl teams, including then-No. 15 Texas, and faced nine bowl teams overall. Under Mendenhall BYU is one of only 12 programs to earn a bowl invitation each of the past nine years. Only Florida State (7) has achieved more than BYU's six bowl victories over that timeframe.

The Cougars set a program record with four consecutive bowl wins from 2009-12, helping Mendenhall become the first BYU head coach to win six bowls in a seven-year span. The Cougars received nine straight bowl invitations for the first time since a string of 17 consecutive bowl bids under Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards from 1978 through 1994. Mendenhall is the only coach in BYU football history to take his first nine teams to a bowl game, and is winning at the same pace as the legendary Edwards. Through his 116 games as BYU head coach, Mendenhall has a record of 82-34—almost identical to Edwards' 116-game mark of 83-32-1.

In 2006, Mendenhall was named the American Football Coaches Association Region IV Coach of the Year following an 11-2 season. In addition, the Football Writers Association of America named Mendenhall one of nine finalists for the prestigious Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year Award.

He has also served as the defensive coordinator for much of his tenure as the head coach. BYU has consistently fielded one of the nation's strongest defenses under Mendenhall's direction. Mendenhall's defense excels at keeping opponents out of the end zone, averaging a No. 20 national ranking in scoring defense over the past eight seasons, including three top-10 ratings. In 2012, the Cougars featured one of the greatest defenses in school history, allowing just 266.1 yards, including 86.9 rushing yards, and 14.0 points per game. Ranked No. 3 in total defense, No. 3 in scoring defense and No. 2 in rushing defense, the Mendenhall-coached unit held its first six opponents under 300 total yards (part of a streak of 12 consecutive such games dating back to 2011) and kept opposing offenses without a touchdown six times during the year. Adjusting to the team's up-tempo offense in 2013, BYU's defense ranked No. 12 in yards per play allowed despite defending more plays than all but four teams nationally. Only two teams that defended as many plays ranked better than the Cougars at defending their turf.

Another hallmark of Mendenhall's program has been the emphasis on balance and priorities in the many other facets of life outside of football. Reflecting that emphasis, BYU consistently received the most academic all-conference honorees each season as a conference member, while six Cougar student-athletes have earned seven Academic All-America citations under Mendenhall. Only four programs have had more Academic All-America citations during Mendenhall's tenure. In addition, BYU tops all FBS programs for the most selections to the NFF Hampshire Honor Society (3.2 GPA over college career) since the program began in 2007.

Mendenhall was elected in 2013 to the American Football Coaches Association Board of Trustees as the District 8 Representative and also serves on the Ethics Committee. He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at his alma mater, Oregon State. He later coached at Snow College, Northern Arizona, became the youngest defensive coordinator in the Pac-10 at Oregon State, then went to Louisiana Tech and New Mexico before coming to BYU as a defensive coordinator in 2003.
