- **THE SERIES.** BYU and Georgia Southern are meeting for the first time. It is just the fourth game BYU has played in the state of Georgia. The Cougars have played in Atlanta twice and once in Athens.
- **INTERIM HEAD COACHES.** Facing off against Kevin Whitley will be BYU's second time facing an interim head coach with a team in transition. The Cougars played Washington State with an interim head coach and will face USC next week in the same situation. To add an additional unique layer, Georgia Southern's new coaching hire is Clay Helton, the former USC head coach who was relieved of his duties earlier this year with the Trojans. Though Helton won't be coaching in the game, he is actively recruiting for Georgia Southern as he prepares to take the reigns for the 2022 season.
- **SUN BELT FUN BELT.** BYU is playing a member of the Sun Belt Conference for the fourth time. BYU met up with three Sun Belt teams last season, beating Troy and Texas State before falling to Coastal Carolina.
- **BIG 12.** On Friday, Sept. 10, 2021, BYU accepted an official invitation to join the Big 12 Conference in all sports. The Cougars joined Cincinnati, Houston and UCF as the four new members. BYU is expected to play its first season in the Power 5 conference in 2023. The Cougars have a record of 86-50 since becoming an independent in 2011. ([Read more](#))
- **CFP TOP 25.** BYU is ranked No. 14 in the latest College Football Playoff poll (released Tuesdays). The Cougars are also No. 14 in the latest AP Top 25 and No. 15 in the AFCA Coaches Poll. BYU is 16-4 under Kalani Sitake when playing as a ranked team. Georgia Southern has faced two ranked teams already this season, dropping contests to No. 20 Arkansas and No. 21 Coastal Carolina.
- **BOWL ELIGIBLE.** BYU is bowl eligible for the 16th time in 17 seasons, and fifth in six seasons under Sitake. BYU is 3-1 under Sitake in bowl games.

Baylor Romney led a fast start to the offense with 21 straight points to start the game and BYU outlasted the USF Bulls 35-27. Romney threw for 305 yards while Gunner Romney and Puka Nacua both posted 100-yard receiving games.

Tyler Allgeier ran for 218 yards and three touchdowns as the ground game pounded Utah State all night and the Cougars ran to a 34-20 win. BYU's defense allowed just 22 rushing yards to a USU team averaging 213.5 rushing yards coming in.

Three fumbles, an interception and two turnovers on downs doomed the Cougars in their first loss of the 2021 season. BYU couldn't finish enough drives to stay in front of fell to Boise State 26-17 in a wet and rainy game.

Baylor was able to bottle up the Cougars' run game and ran past BYU 38-24 in a preview of future Big 12 matchups. Jaren Hall threw for a career-best 342 yards and Puka Nacua caught five passes for 168 yards and his first Cougar touchdown.

The ground game was the answer again at WSU as Tyler Allgeier ran for a career-high 32 carries and 191 yards and two scores. Leading by two points with 4 minutes left, BYU ran Allgeier seven times in a row for three first downs to run out the clock and win.

BYU's offense racked up 734 yards and beat Virginia in a wild 66-49 shootout to spoil Bronco Mendenhall's return to Provo. Tyler Allgeier ran for 266 yards and five touchdowns to tie the single-game record at BYU.

Idaho State comes south from Pocatello for a game against the Cougars after visiting LaVell Edwards Stadium in 2019. BYU is 6-0 against the FCS opponent and won the last meeting by a score of 42-10.

BYU and Georgia Southern will meet for the first time. The Cougars trip to Georgia will be just the fourth trip to the Peach State. BYU has played in Atlanta twice (Georgia Tech) and once against Georgia in Athens.

After defeating the Trojans in Provo in 2019, BYU returns to the Coliseum for the first time since 2003. The last time the Cougars visited USC, Matt Leinart and Reggie Bush were leading the offensive attack for the Trojans.

**INDEPENDENCE: YEAR ELEVEN**

After finishing the 2020 season 11-1, BYU enters its 11th season as an independent. This season, the Cougars play seven teams from Power 5 conferences, including three to start the year. BYU will face five teams from the Pac-12 in Arizona, Utah, Arizona State, Washington State and USC. The Cougars will also match up with Baylor of the Big 12 and Virginia of the ACC. In addition to those Power 5 matchups, BYU also plays in-state foe Utah State along with Mountain West power Boise State. The Cougars will host USF of the American and Idaho State from the FCS.

**LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM**

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 63,470 after various refurbishments. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's winning percentage at LaVell Edwards Stadium is ranked No. 1 among teams playing in their current stadium.

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates more than 400 missions around the world in over 150 nations speaking more than 160 languages. More than 53,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions around the world. Most of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours — seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples) — teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

About 65 percent of the current team has served a mission. Members of the team have served in 28 different countries and six of the seven continents around the globe. More than 30 members of the team (previous signees or on roster) are currently serving in the mission field.

**HONOR CODE**

BYU's Honor Code helps maintain this learning environment. Initiated by students in 1949, the Honor Code emphasizes being honest, living a chaste and virtuous life, abstaining from alcohol and tobacco, using clean language, and following other values in line with the doctrines of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.

**POLYNESIAN PIPELINE**

The Polynesian Islands have become a hotbed for recruiting in recent years, but BYU has been one of the pioneers in bringing these players from Tonga, Samoa, the Hawaiian Islands and all of Polynesia to the forefront of college football since the early 1950s. About 40 members of the current roster are of Polynesian descent.

Some of BYU's most celebrated and decorated players have come from the Pacific islands, including All-Americans, national record holders, players who have gone on to compete in the NFL and now, several members of BYU's current coaching and support staff.

Kalani Sitake was named BYU's 14th head coach on Dec. 19, 2015, becoming the first Tongan head football coach in the NCAA. His staff includes Polynesians Ilaisa Tuiaki, Fesi Sitake Harvey Unga, Nu'u Tafisi, Jack Damuni, Jasen Ah You, Al Pupunu and Vince Feula.

**FORMER PLAYERS ON STAFF**

There are 15 former BYU football players on the football and athletic administration staff. Members of the staff were part of Cougar teams that won the 1980 "Miracle Bowl," the 1984 National Championship, 1996 Cotton Bowl along with many other accolades.

- 1** Running back Tyler Allgeier is tied for No. 1 in the nation in rushing touchdowns with 17. Allgeier has multiple touchdowns in four games this year and a rushing score in 8 of 10 games. He is No. 4 nationally in total touchdowns scored and tied for No. 7 in scoring at 10.2 points per game.
- 7** BYU's offense is ranked in the top 30 in six different categories. BYU is No. 4 in fewest passes intercepted (3), No. 10 in third down conversions (47.9), No. 12 pass efficiency (160.72), No. 19 in total offense, No. 20 in sacks allowed per game (1.30) No. 26 in completion percentage (65.9) and No. 28 in total first downs (233).
- 19.74** Puka Nacua ranks No. 14 nationally with 19.74 yards per reception. The big-play threat has a 35-yard reception in 5 of 9 games played and now leads the team in receiving yards with 671.
- 266** Allgeier's 266 rushing yards vs. Virginia were the third-most in a single game in BYU history and most against a P5 opponent. - 700+** BYU put up 734 yards of total offense on Virginia, including 385 rushing and 349 passing. The 385 rushing yards ranked No. 12 at BYU as well, and the most under Sitake.
- 1,000x2** Allgeier went over 1,000 yards for the second consecutive season after his 266-yard performance against Virginia. He finished with 1,130 yards in 2020, making him just the fifth BYU player to have multiple 1,000-yard seasons. He joins current RB coach Harvey Unga (3), Jamaal Williams (2), Curtis Brown (2) and Jamal Willis (2).

**THE BYU OFFENSE**

• **COACHING EXPERIENCE.** The BYU offensive staff has nearly 100 years of coaching experience. Offensive line coach Darrell Funk has the most with more than 30 years. Tight ends coach Steve Clark has been coaching since 1994 and passing game coordinator Aaron Roderick has 22 years in the profession. Funk, Roderick, Clark and wide receivers coach Fesi Sitake have all been coordinators at the college level.

• **BROTHERS DON'T SHAKE HANDS, BROTHERS GET YARDS...** Receivers Samson Nacua and Puka Nacua both had big nights against Virginia. The older of the two brothers, Samson set the tone with a 52-yard reception on BYU's first offensive play and finished the game with three receptions for 107 yards and one touchdown. Puka Nacua, who also finished with an identical 107 receiving yards, set a career-high with eight receptions and caught a 26-yard touchdown. Samson added a seven-yard rush while Puka had 28 yards on the ground. It was the first time in school history a set of brothers had 100 receiving yards in the same game. Both brothers have three receiving touchdowns apiece.

• **TWO BY TWO.** BYU features a pair of tight ends, a pair of running backs, and a pair of receivers poised to make a huge impact. Tight ends Isaac Rex and Dallin Holker could be a matchup nightmare. Rex, the 6-foot-6, 247-pound red zone threat caught 12 touchdowns last season while the speedy Holker caught 19 passes for 235 yards as a true freshman before a church mission. Rex and Holker have combined for 27 catches and 318 yards and four touchdowns this year. Running backs Tyler Allgeier and Lopini Katoa have combined for more than 3,800 rushing yards and have 48 rushing touchdowns. Wideouts Gunner Romney and Nei'l Pau'u have posted more than 3,100 receiving yards and 22 touchdowns.

Kalani Sitake (pronounced kah-lah-nee see-tah-kay) enters his sixth season overseeing the BYU football program in 2021.

This year he has been named a finalist for entry into the Polynesian Football Hall of Fame.

A former Cougar running back (1994, 1997-2000), Sitake is the 14th head coach in BYU history and just the fourth since 1972, when Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards took over the program. Sitake is the first former player under Edwards to be named head coach at BYU.

Named BYU's head coach on December 19, 2015, Sitake returned to his alma mater with 15 years of coaching experience, including seven seasons as a defensive coordinator and four years as an assistant head coach. He came to BYU from Oregon State, where he served as assistant head coach and defensive coordinator in 2015 under head coach Gary Andersen. Sitake spent the prior 10 seasons at the University of Utah under head coach Kyle Whittingham. He started at Utah in 2005 as the linebackers coach and was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 before also being named assistant head coach in 2012. He coached 12 all-conference honorees at Utah, including Morris Trophy winners Star Lotulelei (2011) and Nate Orchard (2014).

During his career, Sitake has helped mentor 28 NFL Draft picks, including No. 2 overall pick Zach Wilson in the 2021 NFL Draft by the New York Jets. Sitake also coached BYU linebackers Sione Takitaki and Fred Warner and running back Jamaal Williams. Takitaki was a third-round pick of the Cleveland Browns in this year's draft and Warner was one of the league's top rookies after being taken in the third round in 2018 by the San Francisco 49ers.

Sitake has coached in 12 bowl games during his career and has been on the winning side in 10 of those 12 contests, including a 3-1 mark as a head coach. BYU is coming off a 49-23 win in the 2020 Boca Raton Bowl over UCF.

Sitake began his coaching career in 2001 as the defensive backs and special teams coach at Eastern Arizona before becoming a defensive graduate assistant at BYU in 2002 under Gary Crowton. Sitake then joined the staff at Southern Utah where he coached running backs, tight ends and offensive line during the 2003 and 2004 seasons.

He began his BYU playing career in 1994 prior to serving a two-year mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Oakland, California. After returning and redshirting in 1997, Sitake was a three-year starter at fullback for the Cougars from 1998-2000 under Edwards. A team captain as a senior, Sitake's last game as a player was also the last game coached by the legendary Edwards, who was a great mentor for Sitake.

Born in Nuku'alofa, Tonga, and raised in Laie, Hawai'i and Provo, Utah, Sitake is the nation's first FBS head football coach of Tongan descent. He graduated from BYU in 2000 with a bachelor's degree in English. Sitake and his wife Timberly have three children, Skye, Sadie and Kelaokalani (KK).
