- This is the 11th meeting between BYU and Oregon State. The series is tied 5-5, with the Cougars winning last year's meeting in Corvallis 38-28. Oregon State won the last matchup in Provo with a 10-7 victory in 1986.
- Bronco Mendenhall played and coached for the Beavers. A two-year starter at safety and linebacker (86-87) and team captain in '87, Mendenhall was part of Oregon State's 10-7 win over BYU in 1986. He went on to work as a graduate assistant (89-90), defensive line coach ('95), secondary coach and defensive coordinator ('96) for the Beavers.
- BYU has not defeated a ranked team since it beat No. 18 Oregon State 44-20 in 2009 in the Las Vegas Bowl. The 2012 Beavers, ranked No. 10 in the AP Poll and No. 14 in the USA Today Coaches Poll will be the first ranked opponent the Cougars have faced this season. BYU will also have its first opportunity to beat a top 10 team since 2009 as well when the Cougars took down No. 3 Oklahoma 14-13 in 2009.
- Oregon State is the last team to have over 300 total yards on BYU's defense, a span of 12 games. In 2011's 38-28 BYU win, the Beavers totaled 365 yards, including 306 passing and 59 rushing yards. The Cougars' defense has held teams to an average of 246.75 yards per game during the streak.
- During the Mendenhall era, BYU has had just 13 games (out of 96) allowing 300 passing yards, including last year's 306 to the Beavers. The Cougars are 7-6 since 2005 when allowing 300 yards in the air.
- BYU wide receiver Cody Hoffman has a caught a pass in 25 straight games, tied for the 10th longest streak in the nation. He has caught a pass in 31 of 32 career games. Oregon State's Markus Wheaton has caught a pass in 28 straight, tied for No. 7 nationally.
- BYÜ linebacker Uani 'Ünga transferred from Oregon State. 'Unga's twin brother Feti 'Unga (Tau-moepeau) is still at Oregon State, both play middle linebacker and both wear jersey No. 41. Feti is wearing Taumoepeau on his jersey this season to honor their mother with Taumoepeau being her maiden name.

2012 BYU FOOTBALL LAST GAME/OPPONENT OUTLOOK

DEFENSE ON DISPLAY IN 6-3 VICTORY

PROVO, Utah - One BYU touchdown on a 25-second scoring drive and stellar defense was enough to overpower Utah State, 6-3, in a defensive battle Friday night at LaVell Edwards Stadium.

After a first half dominated by defense, the Cougars (4-2) scored the first touchdown of the game with three seconds left before the break. Getting the ball back with 28 seconds on the clock, Taysom Hill moved BYU down field through the air with three back-to-back passes to Cody Hoffman for gains of 8 yards, 28 yards and 22 yards. JD Falslev grabbed a 3-yard toss in the end zone to complete the 4-play, 61-yard scoring drive. After missing the PAT attempt, BYU headed into the locker room with a 6-3 lead and the only touchdown of the game. The scoring drive took 25 seconds, the quickest scoring drive for BYU on the year.

BYU outgained Utah State (4-2) 380 to 243 total yards. The game marks the 12th consecutive opponent the Cougars have held under 300 yards. The No. 5 defense hasn't allowed an offensive touchdown in 13 quarters and just three total points. BYU held Utah State to 41 yards rushing and limited the Aggies on third downs, who converted 4 of 14 attempts.

Ezekiel Ansah caused problems early and often for the Aggies with three tackles for loss in the first half, including two sacks. The senior also finished with five total tackles and two quarterback hurries. Senior captain Brandon Ogletree led the defensive effort with seven total tackles and one pass breakup. Defensive back Preston Hadley also came up big with six tackles, one pass breakup and intercepted a Utah State pass in front of the goal line to save a touchdown.

Freshman quarterback Hill completed 24 of 36 attempts for 235 yards, one touchdown and one interception in his second career start. The signal caller added 80 yards on the ground on 19 carries.

Junior wideout Cody Hoffman extended his streak to 25 games with a reception, catching eight passes for 114 yards. Hoffman's catches included a 28-yard jumping grab in one-on-one coverage. Freshman Jamaal Williams rushed for 71 yards on 17 attempts. His two rushes of 11 yards and 13 yards in the final minute of the game kept the Aggies offense off the field to end the game.

OPPONENT OUTLOOK

OREGON STATE'S LAST GAME

CORVALLIS, Ore. - Senior Jordan Poyer became the first Oregon State player to intercept three passes in a game in almost nine years as the Beavers stymied Washington State on their way to a 19-6 victory Saturday afternoon at Reser Stadium in front of a school-record crowd of 46,579.

The win moves Oregon State to 4-0 (3-0 Pac-12) on the year, the first time it has started a season with four-straight wins since 2002 and only the fifth time in the last 73 years (1939, 1957, 2000, 2002).

Oregon State's defense fed off of that home crowd in keeping the Cougars out of the end zone, forcing five turnovers and holding them to just 20 yards rushing on the day. Fifteen of those 20 yards came on a Carl Winston carry late in the fourth quarter. The last time OSU kept a team from scoring a touchdown in a game was against Pittsburgh in the 2008 Sun Bowl.

For much of the day, that type of defensive effort was necessary as Washington State matched the Beavers blow-for-blow. The Beavers marched the ball in the first quarter, racking up 107 yards of offense to WSU's 22. The only score of the opening quarter, however, came on a Trevor Romaine 30-yard field goal on the Beavers' opening possession.

The teams traded field goals in the second, with Romaine's 24-yarder with 2:51 remaining pushing



the Beavers into a 6-3 halftime advantage after the teams traded turnovers on three consecutive possessions within a two-minute span. Senior Rudolf Fifita recovered his first career fumble at the Washington State 34-yard line, but Mannion was picked off three plays later as lineman loane Gauta rumbled 38 yards on the return into OSU territory. But just two plays later, senior safety Anthony Watkins squashed the threat with an interception of his own.

Those two turnovers, combined with Poyer's three picks, combined to give the Beavers five on the day. Poyer now has 10 career interceptions, leaving him just one away from cracking into the school's top-10 list. He wasn't the only star on defense, though. Sophomore defensive end Scott Crichton tallied three sacks, becoming the first Beaver to pull off that feat since Stephen Paea against UCLA on Oct. 31, 2009.

NOTES FROM BYU'S LAST GAME

BYU's defense continued to dominate as the Cougars held on with just one score to defeat Utah State 6-3.

- The BYU defense held its 12th opponent in a row under 300 total yards, holding the Aggies to just 243 total yards. The defense has also kept opposing offenses out of the end zone for 13 consecutive quarters, not allowing an offensive touchdown and just 3 total points.
- The last time BYU won a game scoring six points or fewer was against Wyoming in 1946 when the Cougars also won 6-3.
- Wide receiver Cody Hoffman kept his streak alive, now catching at least one pass in 25 straight games and 31 of 32 career games.
 Hoffman had seven catches for 86 yards in the first half and eight catches for 114 yards for the game. It was his third 100-yard receiving game of the season and ninth of his career
- Preston Hadley recorded six tackles and one pass breakup but his biggest play came when he picked up his first interception as a Cougar right in front of the goal line to protect a score
- BYU scored its only touchdown of the game at the end of the second half in just 25 seconds on a four-play 61-yard drive, the fastest scoring drive of the year. The Cougars couldn't get any other points in the other 59 minutes and 35 seconds but it would be just enough.
- Defensive end Ezekiel Ansah was a menace yet again, racking up five tackles, three tackles for loss, two sacks and two quarterback hurries. The senior totaled three tackles for loss, including two sacks in the first half.
- Freshman quarterback Taysom Hill started his second game and put together a strong performance. Hill set career highs in passing completions (24), attempts (36) and passing yards (235).

2012 BYU FOOTBALL TEAM NOTES

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR TWO

2011 was the Cougars inaugural year as an independent. BYU went 10-3 and won its fifth bowl game in six years. The team played teams from the SEC, Pac-12, Big 12, Conference USA, Western Athletic Conference and Mountain West. The Cougars had all 13 games televised, including 12 to a national audience, 11 of which were featured on the ESPN family of networks. BYU had five on ESPN, four on ESPN2 and two on ESPNU. In 2012, BYU ups the ante with a more difficult schedule, featuring a road game at fellow independent Notre Dame along with three teams from the Pac-12 and matchups against the ACC, WAC and MW. To date BYU has five games scheduled to air on the ESPN family of networks along with games on ABC, NBC and another on BYUtv, all nationally televised games. The Cougars have future games scheduled with Wisconsin, West Virginia, Nebraska, Notre Dame, East Carolina, Georgia Tech, Texas, UCF, Houston, Washington State, Boise State, Middle Tennessee State, Utah and Hawai'i.

FLAG BEARERS

BYU has a tradition of selecting a player before each game to run the team flag onto the field. In 2008, the team implemented a new tradition - the alumni flag. The team selects a former Cougar to carry out the alumni flag, along with the chosen current player who runs out with the current team flag. Both flags are white with a blue "Y" logo. The team flag has been signed by each member of the team, while the alumni flag has been signed by former BYU payers. In 2011, the team added a special teams flag, donned by a vintage BYU logo adopted by the special teams, following the same protocol as the team flag with an exemplary special teams player being chosen to carry it each week.

TEAM CAPTAINS

Selected by their peers, quarterback Riley Nelson, linebacker Brandon Ogletree and running back David Foote have been named as team captains for the 2012 season. The three seniors are all new captains for the 2012 season. Nelson will serve as the offense's captain, Ogletree for the defense and Foote for special teams. Nelson has 838 total yards of offense passed for 5 touchdowns this year. Ogletree has 42 total tackles to lead the team. Foote has 19 rushes for 81 yards and also has 3 tackles on special teams and blocked a punt.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 45,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 64,045 after refurbishing the middle of the east section. The capacity now sits at 63,470 due to accomidations for wheelchair access. For the 2012 season the stadium will feature new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates 347 missions around the world in 145 nations speaking 164 languages. More than 53,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 330 missions around the world. Seventy-five percent of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 25. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years or 18 months for women and couples—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

There are currently 38 missionaries from the football team serving in 17 different countries. Members of the current team cover six of the seven continents around the globe and speak six different languages.

FIRESIDES

The BYU football team participates in hour-long devotionals prior to eight games this season. These devotionals are referred to as "firesides" and are intended to help players, coaches and those who attend strengthen or gain a knowledge of our purpose here on earth. Firesides typically include a musical number from members of the team and talks from selected players, along with Holly and Bronco Mendenhall.

BYU OFFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

The offensive line gave up 0 sacks and 0 tackles for loss against Utah State. It is the first time this season that BYU hasn't allowed any sacks or tackles behind the line of scrimmage.

The BYU ground game is averaging 4.4 yards per carry as a team. Running back Jamaal Williams leads the way, averaging 6.2 yards per carry, followed by quarterback Taysom Hill at 6.1 and running back David Foote at 4.1.

Wideout Cody Hoffman has recorded a reception in 25 straight games. BYU's career leader in receiving yards Austin Collie had a career-best streak of 22 games with at least one reception. Hoffman's 25 games is the No. 10 streak nationally.

The BYU offense has had 88 plays from scrimmage of 10 yards or more. The offense also has 27 of 20 yards or more, six for more than 30 yards, three for 40 or more, two for 50 or more and one play longer than 60 yards.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- True freshman and 17-year old Jamaal Williams has shined in his first six games as a Cougar. Williams scored his first collegiate touchdown at Utah on a seven-yard run in the fourth quarter. Against Hawai'i, Williams seized the day, picking up 155 yards and two scores on just 15 carries. Just nine BYU freshmen running backs have rushed for over 100 yards with Jamaal Williams being the ninth vs. Hawai'i. The others include Fahu Tahi, Mike Hague, Ronnie Jenkins, Mark Atuaia, Josh Quezada, Curtis Brown, Jamal Willis and Harvey Unga. He put up 71 rushing yards vs. Utah State. Williams is second on the team with 309 rushing yards and three touchdowns. He also has six receptions for 54 yards out of the backfield.
- The tight end position has made a strong comeback with Kaneakua Friel. Friel leads the tight ends with 20 receptions for 248 yards and a team-leading four touchdowns. He is second on the team in receiving yards and total receptions. Friel caught five balls for 53 yards vs. Utah State. BYU's other tight ends have nine catches for 127 yards and one touchdown this season. He has caught a team-high four touchdown passes, good for No. 34 nationally.
- Wideout Cody Hoffman leads BYU in receiving so far in 2012, just as he did in 2011. Hoffman currently has 31 receptions, 432 yards and two scores. The junior picked up his third 100-yard receiving game of the season with eight receptions for 114 yards vs. Utah State, inncluding three of the four receptions on the Cougars only touchdown drive. Hoffman has had three 100-yard receiving games this season (Weber State, Utah and Utah State). His 432 receiving yards are No. 43 nationally. He is averaging 72.0 yards per game and 13.9 yards per reception.
- The Cougars are winning all four quarters now. BYU has outscored opponents 21-10 in the first quarter and dominated the second and fourth quarters, 57-6 and 41-7, respectively. They were losing the third quarter battle 30-16 until the Hawai'i game before outscoring the Warriors 20-0 out of the locker room to give the team a 36-30 advantage in the third frame. BYU is outscoring opponents in a gme by an average of 25.8 to 8.8
- Eleven different players have scored touchdowns this year as BYU has been able to spread the ball around in 2012. Hill and Friel lead with four apiece and the rest go Williams (3), Hoffman (2), Lasike (2) and then Lark, Alisa, Apo, Ridley, Falslev and Mahina all with 1 each. No one on the team has a rushing touchdown and a receiving touchdown.

2012 BYU FOOTBALL **DEFENSIVE NOTES**

BYU DEFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

The dominant Cougar defense is No. 1 in red zone conversions with a rate of 40.0% Opponents have reached the red zone 10 times against BYU and have only scored four times. Utah State reached the red zone twice but were held to a field goal.

BYU has recorded 50 tackles for loss, good for a 3rd-place tie in the nation. Kyle Van Noy leads the effort with 10.5 (T-6), along with Ezekiel Ansah 8.5 (T-23), Spencer Hadley 7.0 (T-47) and Brandon Ogletree 6.0 (T-79). The Cougars are tied for 6th in sacks with 20.

The Cougars remain at No. 5 in total defense after week 6. BYU has held its opponents to an average of 229.3 yards per game. The Cougar rushing defense is No. 1, only giving up 59.5 yards per game while their passing defense comes in at No. 12 (169.8).

The defense has kept opposing offenses out of the end zone for 13 consecutive quarters, not allowing an offensive touchdown and just three total points. BYU's scoring defense is No. 3 in the nation holding opponents to 8.8 yards per game.

The defense held its last 12 opponents under 300 total yards. The Cougars held the Aggies to 243 total yards in the game, a season-low. The No. 1 rushing defense (59.5) held Utah State to a season-low 41 yards on the ground, its lowest since 2008.

Named to 2012 Butkus Award Watch List, Kaveinga is an asset to the No. 5 defensive unit. The senior recorded his first career interception in BYU's season opener. In the Cougars' next game against Weber State, the USC transfer recovered a fumble for 23 vards.

#9 Daniel Sorensen, DB

The junior has proven himself as a dominant force in the backfield. Sorensen forced a fumble against Weber State and came up with the recovery before recording an interception against Hawai'i. He is a solid contributor with 30 total tackles, three pass breakups and a tackle for loss.

#52 Russell Tialavea. DL

The 6-foot-3, 265 pounder returns to the Cougar squad after a mission for his senior season. Tialavea has blocked a PAT (Weber St.) and a field goal (Utah). He also recovered a fumble against Utah State.

#20 Craig Bills, DB

Bills earned letterman honors as a true freshman and saw action in all 13 games. After returning from a mission, Bills has contributed 18 tackles.

#90 Bronson Kaufusi

The true freshman has already made a name for himself, posted one sack, one quarterback hurry, a fumble recovery and six total tackles after returning home from a mission just days before fall cap

2012 BYU FOOTBALL DEFENSIVE NOTES

THE BYU DEFENSE

• BYU is No. 5 nationally in total defense. With seven returning starters from the No. 13 defensive unit in 2011, the Cougars continue to climb the national defensive rankings each week. BYU has help opponents to an average of 229.3 yards, good for the 5th-best mark nationally. The powerhouse defense holds eight top-10 defensive rankings, including No. 1 red zone defense and No. 1 rushing defense.

- Protecting their end zone. The Cougars have kept opposing offenses out of the end zone for 13 consecutive quarters, not allowing a touchdown and only giving up three points. Coming off a shut out against Hawai'i, the No. 3 scoring defense held Utah State without a touchdown. The Cougars have held four of their six opponents without an offensive touchdown, including three of college football's greatest offensive minds in Mike Leach, Norm Chow and Chris Petersen.
- Spreading the wealth. Team defense has been a big part of BYU's success so far this season as only two players have recorded double digit tackles in any game. Brandon Ogeltree did against Utah with a career-high 12 tackles and Spencer Hadley finished with 10 the same night. Nine Cougars have 20 or more tackles on the season, with Ogeltree leading the way with 49 total tackles.
- Ezekiel Ansah has come a long way since 2010 when he had to be taught how to put football pads on. The defensive lineman/linebacker hybrid had a break out game against Boise State, finishing with a career-high 8 tackles and 2.5 tackles for loss, while picking up his first career sack. The sack was the first allowed by the Broncos this season. With a 6-foot-6, 270-pound frame, "Ziggy" also batted down a pass and snuffed out a 4th down attempt from Boise State. The former 200-meter track athlete improved on those numbers against Utah State, wreaking havoc in the backfrield for the Aggies defense. Ansah finished with career highs in tackles for loss (3) and sacks (2), and tacked on two quarterback hurries.
- Behind enemy lines. BYU continued its streak of recording at least 5.0 TFL to 10 games against Utah State, dating back to November 2011 against Idaho. The Cougars have tallied at least 7.0 TFL in the first six games of 2012 with a season-best 11.0 TFL for a loss fo 42 yards against Utah. Ezekiel Ansah led the defensive attack against Utah State with 3.0 TFL while six other players also made their mark. BYU is tied for 3rd nationally in TFL with 50.
- The Kyle Van Noy Show is back. After being the only Division I player to record a statistic in each of the major defensive categories in 2011, the 6-foot-3, 235 pounder is back at it again in 2012. The Bednarik Award, Nagurski Trophy and Lombardi Award watchlist candidate has top defensive marks for the Cougars in four categories, including tackles for loss (10.5), sacks (6.5), quarterback hurries (7) and forced fumbles (3). The junior playmaker is T-3rd nationally in forced fumbles, T-5 in sacks and T-6 in tackles for loss. Van Noy's defensive presence is a solid asset to the No. 5 defense.
- Stopping the run is often a theme and BYU is pretty good at it. The Cougars finished the 2011 season ranked No. 19 in rushing defense and their run-stopping effort continues to be a trend in 2012. BYU held WSU's offense to -5 total yards rushing, the second time in three years allowing a team to negative rushing yards. The Cougars have held four of their six opponents under 50 yards rushing to help lift them to the No. 1 spot in rushing defense. BYU is holding its opponents to just 59.5 yards.

A Riley Stephenson has the 4th-best mark nationally in punting with an average distace of 46.48. With 29 punt attempts, the senior kicker has tallied 1,348 yards this season. The Cougars are averaging 45.97 yards for a No. 8 national team ranking.

The Cougars have returned nine kickoffs for an average of 25.7 yards. BYU has had three different kickoff returners this season in Cody Hoffman, Mike Hague and Joe Sampson. Sampson holds the team-high with his 44-yard return.

During his seven seasons as the head coach at Brigham Young University, Bronco Mendenhall has returned the Cougars to the ranks of the nation's top teams. Taking over a BYU program in 2005 that was coming off three losing seasons, Mendenhall has guided his teams to seven straight bowl invitations, two outright conference championships and regular national top-25 rankings. The Cougars finished their first season as a football independent in 2011 with a 10-3 record and No. 25 final ranking to finish nationally ranked for the fifth time in the last six seasons.

Under his leadership, BYU has earned a 70-26 (.729) record to date to rank No. 15 in total wins among all teams in the nation during that span. The Cougars have received seven straight bowl invitations for the first time since a string of 17 consecutive bowls invitations from 1978 through 1994. Mendenhall is the only coach in BYU football history to take his first seven teams to a bowl game.

Mendenhall has led BYU to bowl wins in five of the last six seasons to become the first Cougar teams to ever win five bowls in a six-year span. Nationally, BYU is one of only seven programs to win five bowl games in the last six seasons. The Cougars have also won 10 or more games in five of the past six seasons and five of Mendenhall's seven seasons overall. In fact, only four programs have had more 10-win seasons over the past seven years.

BYU's success under Mendenhall is also evident in the national rankings and NCAA statistics. BYU has finished ranked in the top 25 in the various national statistical categories 88 times in the past seven seasons (46 offense, 32 defense, 9 special teams, 1 misc.). The Cougars have achieved 55 top-15 statistical rankings, 37 top-10 rankings and 19 top-5 rankings in that span. The Cougars have also been ranked in the top-25 polls during each of the past six seasons and finished ranked No. 12 following the 2009 season -- the program's highest final ranking since finishing No. 5 in 1996.

Another hallmark of Mendenhall's program has been the emphasis on balance and priorities in the many other facets of life outside of football. Reflecting that emphasis, BYU consistently received the most academic all-conference honorees each season as a conference member is tied for third nationally for Academic All-America recipients over Mendenhall's seven seasons at the helm. Seven Cougar student-athletes have been named ESPN Academic All-Americans in that span. Among all FBS schools only Penn State and Nebraska have had more during that period.

Mendenhall also serves as the team's defensive coordinator. The Cougars had the nation's No. 13 defense in 2011 to help BYU become one of only 11 programs to receive a final Top 25 overall team ranking in at least one of the two major polls during five of the past six seasons. BYU is one of only nine teams to do so in the USA Today Coaches Poll.
