2014 BYU FOOTBALL LAST GAME/OPPONENT OUTLOOK-3



NO. 21/23 BYU VS. VIRGINIA

Juniors Adam Hine and Taysom Hill electrified the crowd as No. 21/23 BYU overcame an early deficit to notch a win over Virginia, 41-33 at LaVell Edwards Stadium Saturday afternoon.

Hine's 132 kickoff return yards, including a 99-yard return for a score in the fourth quarter, proved to be a necessary buffer to preserve the victory.

With 10:45 left in the third quarter, the Cougar offense manufactured a 49-yard drive to take the lead for the first time in the game. On second down and 11 yards to go, Hill rushed to the right side, stiff-arming his way around and dragging a Virginia defender into the end zone for the 20-16 lead.

The Cougar defense forced a Virginia turnover on downs to take over possession at 5:53 left in the game. The offense was forced to punt, and Arellano pinned the Cavaliers at the 2-yard line and inside the 20-yard line for the fourth time in the game

After Virginia scored to cut the lead to 41-33, BYU secured the win when Fua successfully held onto the onside kick.

BYU PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- Junior quarterback Taysom Hill scored three touchdowns (two pass, one rush) while throwing for 187 yards and rushing for 72 yards with a passer efficiency rating of 153.5, his second best of the season.
- Senior wide receiver Jordan Leslie caught his first touchdown as a Cougar. He finished the game with a team-high four receptions and 41 yards.
- Junior receiver Devon Blackmon caught two passes, including a 56-yard catch from Taysom Hill, the longest pass play for BYU this season. He also added a 25-yard punt return.
- Sophomore receiver Mitchell Juergens scored his first touchdown at BYU on a 50-yard reception in the fourth quarter.
- Junior running back/kickoff returner Adam Hine scored a 99-yard touchdown on a kickoff return in the fourth quarter his first score as a return man.
- Senior defensive back Robertson Daniel recorded his first interception of the season. He added two pass breakups and four tackles.
- Senior safety Craig Bills notched a season- and team-high 10 tackles, while adding one pass breakup and 0.5 tackles for loss.
- Senior punter Scott Arellano tied his career high with four punts inside the 20-yard line. He notched five total punts for 275 yards with a long of 65, averaging 55 yards per punt, also a career high. It's the first time in his career that Arellano has had three 60+ yard punts.



UTAH STATE VS. ARKANSAS STATE

Utah State had a 38-yard field goal blocked at the end of regulation and failed to score in overtime as it lost on the road to Arkansas State, 21-14, here Saturday night. Both teams are now 2-2 on the season.

Utah State had a chance to win the game in regulation as the Aggies' defense forced its fourth turnover of the game late in the fourth quarter as junior LB LT Filiaga recovered his second fumble of the night at the Arkansas State 38-yard line with 0:47 second remaining in the game. USU then drove the ball down to the ASU 21-yard line and called timeout with 0:03 seconds to play, but had its 38-yard field goal blocked to send the game into overtime.

During the extra period, Arkansas State had the ball first and scored on its second play from scrimmage on a 24-yard pass from Fredi Knighten to Dijon Paschal for the Red Wolves first lead of the game. USU then got the ball and had a fourth-and-seven at the ASU 22-yard line and was unable to pick up the first down.

Utah State finished the game with 413 yards of total offense (268-passing, 145-rushing).

UTAH ST. PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- Sophomore LB Nick Vigil forced his second fumble of the season and his career.
- Senior LB Zach Vigil recorded his first two sacks of the season and now has 9.5 sacks in his career. Vigil also had a career-high 14 tackles for his 13th career double-digit tackling outing. Vigil also tied his career-high with 3.0 TFL's and tied his career-high with 2.0 sacks. Vigil now has 270 career tackles to move ahead of Shawn Miller (259) to rank 19th all-time in school history.
- Junior LB LT Filiaga recovered his first two career fumbles and tied his career-high with 10 tackles. Filiaga also had his second career TFL.
- Sophomore S Devin Centers recorded his third sack of the season and his career. Centers also recovered his second fumble of the season and of his career, both in his last two games. Centers also had a career-high 11 tackles for his second-career double-digit tackle outing. Centers also had a career-high 2.5 TFL's.
- Junior DT John Taylor had a career-high two tackles.
- Sophomore QB Darell Garretson's 81-yard TD pass to junior WR Hunter Sharp is a career-long pass for Garretson and a career-long reception for Sharp. Garretson had two TD passes tonight giving him three this year and 13 in his career. Garretson also had a career-high 47 pass attempts.
- Junior WR Hunter Sharp had 130 receiving yards for his second-straight 100-yard receiving game.

2014 BYU FOOTBALL TEAM NOTES-4

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR FOUR

The 12-game independent slate features teams from 10 states and seven conferences, including the American Athletic, Atlantic Coast, Big 12, Pac-12, Conference USA, Mountain West and Mid-Eastern Athletic.

The Cougars will play six home games and six road contests in 2014. BYU will face teams that hail from Connecticut, Virginia, Florida, Georgia, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Idaho, Nevada and California, including seven programs—Texas, Houston, Utah State, Central Florida, Boise State, Middle Tennessee and UNLV—that qualified for a bowl game last season.

FLAG BEARERS

BYU has a tradition of selecting a player before each game to run the team flag and alumni flag. The team selects a former Cougar to carry out the alumni flag, along with the chosen current player who runs out with the current team flag. The team flag has been signed by each member of the team, while the alumni flag has been signed by former BYU payers. In 2011, the team added a special teams flag, donned by a vintage BYU logo adopted by the special teams, following the same protocol as the team flag with an exemplary special teams player being chosen to carry it each week.

Selected by their peers, quarterback Taysom Hill, running back Paul Lasike, safety Craig Bills and defensive lineman Remington Peck have been named team captains for the 2014 season.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 64,045 after refurbishing the middle of the east section. The capacity now sits at 63,470 due to accomodations for wheelchair access. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's 2012 average attendance of 61,161 ranked No. 3 in the West behind only USC (87,945) and UCLA (68,481).

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates missions around the world in 145 nations speaking 164 languages. More than 83,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 406 missions around the world. Seventy-five percent of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years (or 18 months for women and couples)—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

Eighty-eight members of the 2014 team have served church missions. Members of the team have served in 28 countries and six of the seven continents around the globe.

FIRESIDES

The BYU football team will participate in hour-long devotionals prior or team service activities the night before each game this season. The team will conduct devotionals before eight games. These devotionals are referred to as "firesides" and are intended to help players, coaches and those who attend strengthen or gain a knowledge of our purpose here on earth. Firesides typically include a musical number from members of the team and talks from selected players, along with coach Bronco Mendenhall.



MCMAHON'S BYU JERSEY TO BE RETIRED

BYU will honor former BYU consensus All-American and NFL quarterback Jim McMahon by retiring his No. 9 jersey during a halftime ceremony at the BYU vs. Utah State football game on Friday, Oct. 3. McMahon will also be inducted into the BYU Athletic Hall of Fame as part of the 2014 class on Thursday, Oct. 2.

As part of the ceremony, a banner with McMahon's name and number will be unveiled and permanently displayed on the press box at LaVell Edwards Stadium. Throughout the history of BYU football, dating back to 1922, just five jerseys have been retired — Eldon "The Phantom" Fortie (No. 40), Marion Probert (No. 81), Steve Young (No. 8) and Gifford Nielsen and Ty Detmer (both No. 14).

BYU Career

Recognized as one of the outstanding collegiate quarterbacks of all time, McMahon finished his BYU football career in 1981 with an astonishing 70 NCAA records. From 1977-81, he completed 653 passes for 9,536 yards and 84 touchdowns, with a career passing efficiency of 156.9.

In his final two seasons as a Cougar, McMahon threw for 8,126 yards and 77 touchdowns. He led the nation in numerous offensive categories both years, including passing yards, total offense and touchdown passes. He received All-America honorable mention in 1978 as a sophomore and earned first-team All-America honors as a junior in 1980 before becoming a consensus choice as a senior in 1981.

At the conclusion of his senior season, McMahon won the inaugural Davey O'Brien National Quarterback Award and the Sammy Baugh Trophy. He was named NCAA Co-Offensive Player of the Year along with Marcus Allen of USC and finished third in the voting for the Heisman Trophy. From 1977-81 he was part of five consecutive WAC championship teams (redshirting in 1979) and was a threetime All-WAC First Team quarterback in 1978, 1980 and 1981.

McMahon will forever be known as the quarterback who led the Cougars to 21 points in the last 2:33 minutes of the 1980 Holiday Bowl to defeat SMU 46-45, and give BYU its first bowl victory. Mc-Mahon was named Offensive MVP of the 1980 and 1981 Holiday Bowls.

NFL Career

Following a historic career at BYU, McMahon was the fifth player selected in the first round of the 1982 NFL Draft — the highest Cougar ever taken. McMahon was drafted by the Bears and played seven seasons in Chicago, leading them to the Super Bowl title in 1986. He played 16 seasons in the NFL for seven teams and won two Super Bowl rings. After retiring from pro football, McMahon was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame in 1998.

Charity Work

He has also been very active in civic service with the Jim McMahon Foundation; Children's Miracle Network; Jim McMahon Ronald McDonald House Golf Tournament; Juvenile Diabetes Fund; American Cancer Society; Society for the Prevention of Blindness; Think First Foundation for Children; and BYU Y-Quarterback Weekend. In 2006, he traveled to Iraq with the USO Supporting Freedom program to visit American forces in the field.

Personal

McMahon, who came to BYU from Roy, Utah, completed a Bachelor of Arts degree in communications from BYU. He lives in Scottsdale, Arizona, and has four children — Ashley, Sean, Zach and Alexis.

Beginning in 1948, BYU and Utah State have battled for the Old Wagon Wheel. The Cougars' 31-14 win over the Aggies at Romney Stadium on Oct. 4, 2013, was the 83rd meeting between the two schools. BYU leads the overall series 46-34-3 and has played the Aggies almost every season since 1922, taking a break during WWII from 1943-1945 and from 2003-2005. Only the University of Utah has played more games (89) against BYU than Utah State. The trophy is a wheel from a pioneer covered wagon that has traveled between the two schools since 1948.

BYU OFFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

Taysom Hill is tied for No. 12 in the nation with 17 plays of 10+ rushing yards and No. 19 with five plays of 20+ rushing yards.

Taysom Hill became the 14th player in NCAA history to surpass 4,000 passing yards and 2,000 rushing yards before his senior year.

Senior receiver Jordan Leslie has caught a pass in 32 consecutive games-tied for the seventh best active streak in the country.

BYU is scoring on 94.7 percent (18 of 19) of its blue-zone trips this year with 13 bluezone touchdowns. Comparatively, the offense scored on 78.9 percent last year with eight touchdowns.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- BYU is successful when it strikes first. The Cougars are on an nine-game winning streak when they are the first team to score. Last season, they finished 6-1 when scoring before their opponent. In the Bronco Mendenhall era, BYU is 64-8.
- Go fast, go hard has been the mantra of offensive coordinator Robert Anae. Against Texas, BYU ran 96 offensive plays. Last year with a new offense, the Cougars averaged 89.9 plays per game, the second most of any team in the country only behind Texas Tech. Comparatively, BYU ran 79.2 plays per game in 2012.
- BYU has not been shut out for 128 consecutive games. The last time the Cougars failed to score was in 2003 in a 3-0 loss to Utah. That loss was the only time BYU has not produced points since 1975. BYU has scored in the last 485 of 486 games since 1975.
- Only three active quarterbacks in the nation have recorded more games with 100+ rushing yards than Taysom Hill's eight such games (Braxton Miller-Ohio State, Kennan Reynolds-Navy, Cody Fajarado-Nevada). Against Texas, he ran for 99 yards (after accounting for yards lost from sacks). Versus the Huskies, Hill threw for 308 yards and three touchdowns while also rushing for 97 yards and two more scores.
- With seven rushing touchdowns through four weeks, Hill is tied for first among all FBS quarterbacks in touchdowns scored and is ninth among all players in that category.
- At the end of the 2013 season, **Hill ranked No. 10 in the country** with an average of 329.4 yards per game of total offense. Hill earned the No. 1 all-time spot among BYU quarterbacks with 1,680 career rushing yards. Then a sophomore, he also ranked No. 19 in the FBS in rushing yards with 1,344 on the year.

THE BYU DEFENSE

- BYU's run defense has been dominant. The defense has allowed only 17 rushing touchdowns dating back to 2012. It allowed just five in 2012, nine in 2013 and three so far in 2014. At 88.75 rushing yards per game, BYU ranks No. 12 in the country.
- In the past nine seasons, BYU has finished ranked in the top 25 in various national statistical categories 61 times on defense. Currently, BYU ranks in the top 25 in defensive rushing yards per game and scoring defense.
- Lengthening the field. The Cougars have allowed just seven rushing plays of 10 or more yards this season, tied with Alabama for No. 1 in the nation. For the 2013 season, BYU allowed opponents 154 plays of 10 yards or more to rank No. 19 in the country.
- Points per game. So far this season, the Cougars are allowing 18.8 points per game for the 25th-ranked scoring defense in the nation. They finished No. 14 nationally in 2013 for points per play and No. 24 for points per game.
- Shutting down the offense. The defense is tied for 19th nationally in opponent blue zone touchdown conversions with a 43.75 percentage. BYU is also tied for No. 27 in the nation for yards allowed per play with 4.65.

HEAD COACH **BRONCO MENDENHALL**

YEARS AT BYU

10th year as head coach, 12th at BYU YEARS OVERALL

Entering his tenth season as head coach at Brigham Young University, Bronco Mendenhall has restored the Cougars' reputation as one of the nation's top college football programs. Taking over a BYU team that in 2005 was coming off three consecutive losing seasons, Mendenhall has guided his teams to nine straight bowl appearances, two outright conference champion-ships before football independence in 2011, and regular national

Under Mendenhall's leadership, BYU has earned an 86-34 record to rank 12th in total wins among all FBS teams since 2005. Mendenhall also ranks 12th in winning percentage at .717 among active coaches with at least five years of FBS experience.

The Cougars finished the 2013 season with an 8-5 record after playing one of the toughest schedules in school history. BYU earned six of its eight wins over bowl teams, including then-No. 15 Texas, and faced nine bowl teams overall. Under Mendenhall BYU is one of only 12 programs to earn a bowl invitation each of the past nine years. Only Florida State (7) has achieved more than BYU's six bowl victories over that timeframe.

The Cougars set a program record with four consecutive bowl wins from 2009-12, helping Mendenhall become the first BYU head coach to win six bowls in a seven-year span. The Cougars received nine straight bowl invitations for the first time since a string of 17 consecutive bowl bids under Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards from 1978 through 1994. Mendenhall is the only coach in BYU football history to take his first nine teams to a bowl game, and is winning at the same pace as the legendary Edwards. Through his 116 games as BYU head coach, Mendenhall has a record of 82-34-almost identical to Edwards' 116-game mark of 83-32-1.

In 2006, Mendenhall was named the American Football Coaches Association Region IV Coach of the Year following an 11-2 season. In addition, the Football Writers Association of America named Mendenhall one of nine finalists for the prestigious Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year Award.

He has also served as the defensive coordinator for much of his tenure as the head coach. BYU has consistently fielded one of the nation's strongest defenses under Mendenhall's direction. Mendenhall's defense excels at keeping opponents out of the end zone, averaging a No. 20 national ranking in scoring defense over the past eight seasons, including three top-10 ratings. In 2012, the Cougars featured one of the greatest defenses in school history, allowing just 266.1 yards, including 86.9 rushing yards, and 14.0 points per game. Ranked No. 3 in total defense, No. 3 in scoring defense and No. 2 in rushing defense, the Mendenhall-coached unit held its first six opponents under 300 total yards (part of a streak of 12 consecutive such games dating back to 2011) and kept opposing offenses without a touchdown six times during the year. Adjusting to the team's up-tempo offense in 2013, BYU's defense ranked No. 12 in yards per play allowed despite defending more plays than all but four teams

Another hallmark of Mendenhall's program has been the emphasis on balance and priorities in the many other facets of life outside of football. Reflecting that emphasis, BYU consistently received the most academic all-conference honorees each season as a conference member, while six Cougar student-athletes have earned seven Academic All-America citations under Mendenhall. Only four programs have had more Academic All-America citations during Mendenhall's tenure. In addition, BYU tops all FBS programs for the most selections to the NFF Hampshire Honor Society (3.2 GPA over college career) since the program began in 2007.

Mendenhall was elected in 2013 to the American Football Coaches Association Board of Trustees as the District 8 Representative and also serves on the Ethics Committee. He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at his alma mater, Oregon State. He later coached at Snow College, Northern Arizona, became the youngest defensive coordinator in the Pac-10 at Oregon State, then went to Louisiana Tech and New Mexico before coming to BYU as a defensive coordinator in 2003.
