

BYU STORYLINES

• Last meeting. BYU last met Texas in Provo Sept. 7, 2013. The Cougars pulled off a 40-21 victory after a two-hour storm delay

- BYU vs. Big 12. The Cougars have recorded 16 wins against Big 12 opponents, the last coming in 2013 against Texas.
- Young starters. BYU started three freshmen last week-two on offense (center Tejan Koroma and left tackle Ului Lapuaho) and one on defense (boundary corner Jordan Preator).
- Leading the way. Junior quarterback Taysom Hill scored a career-high five touchdowns against UConn (three passing and two rushing). He finished the game 28-36 with 308 passing yards, his third career game with 300 or more passing yards. He also set a personal best with a 177.1 pass-efficiency rating. The junior led the team with 97 rushing yards and two scores, earning College Football Performance Awards Quarterback of the Week Honorable Mention and FBS Independent Offensive Player of the Week.
- The "Bomb Squad." Nine different receivers caught a pass against UConn, including Colby Pearson, Jordan Leslie, Mitch Mathews, Terenn Houk, Algernon Brown, Adam Hine, Paul Lasike, Devin Mahina and Mitchell Juergens.
- 10 seasons. Bronco Mendenhall began his 10th season as head coach of the Cougars with the season opener at UConn. Mendenhall has an 83-34 record entering his 10th year. BYU ranks 12th in total wins during his tenure. (Texas has 89 wins to rank sixth.) With the win against UConn, BYU improves to 7-3 in season openers, including 3-2 on the road, in the Bronco Mendenhall era. Mendenhall is 6-3 in the second game of the season.

LAST GAME/OPPONENT OUTLOOK-3

BYU VS. UCONN

BYU recorded its first win of the 2014 season, defeating Connecticut 35-10 at Rentschler Field Friday night with the help of quarterback Taysom Hill's five touchdowns.

Hill was 28 for 36 with 308 yards in the air and added another 97 rushing yards on 12 carries. He spread the wealth around, with nine BYU players catching at least one pass.

The 35 points scored marks the most by the Cougars under Mendenhall in a season opener on the road. It also marks the largest margin of victory in the first game of the season in that time period.

The Cougar defense forced a turnover on each of the first two UConn possessions. This game marks 11 consecutive games BYU has intercepted at least one pass.

- Senior linebacker Zac Stout set a new career high (and tied for a team high) with 10 tackles. His previous high was six against Nevada in 2010. He also added one sack and 1.5 tackles for loss.
- Junior receiver Mitch Mathews tied a personal high with five receptions against UConn. He finished the night with 62 yards and one touchdown, a 26-yard catch to put BYU ahead 14-0 in the first quarter.

 Junior linebacker Jherremya Leuta-Douyere recorded a personal best with five tackles while also added a forced fumble. He forced the fumble on UConn's first play from scrimmage to help set up a BYU touchdown.



TEXAS VS. NORTH TEXAS

Texas' defense picked off four passes and allowed just 94 yards of total offense and the No. NR/24 Football team collected its 15th-consecutive season-opening win to open the Charlie Strong era in style with a dominant 38-7 victory over North Texas Saturday night at Darrell K. Royal-Texas Memorial Stadium.

Wide receiver John Harris set career highs with seven receptions and 110 yards, and Texas used a balanced offensive attack to control the game. Quarterback David Ash was 19-of-34 for 190 yards and a TD, while running backs Johnathan Gray and Malcolm Brown (two TD's) contributed 84 and 65 rushing yards, respectively, in Strong's debut as Longhorn head coach.

The Longhorn defense registered a touchdown via an interception return by linebacker Demarco Cobbs and tallied seven tackles for loss and four sacks.

TEXAS PLAYER HIGHLIGHTS

- David Ash made his 22nd career start (15-7 record) and completed 19 of 34 passes for 190 yards.
- Malcolm Brown rushed for 65 yards on 13 carries. He scored multiple rushing TDs for the 10th time. He now has 20 career rushing touchdowns. Brown also moved from No. 17 to No. 16 on the UT career rushing list (2,035), passing Marty Atkins (1973-75; 2,020).
- Adrian Colbert made his first career start, opening the game at safety. He posted his first career interception in the second quarter.
- Johnathan Gray rushed for 82 yards on 16 carries. His 42-yard second-quarter rush to set up David Ash's 1-yard TD run was the longest of his career. He moved from No. 28 to No. 26 on the UT career rushing list (1,563), passing Richard Ochoa (1950-52; 1,494) and James Saxton (1959-61; 1,524).
- Dylan Haines saw his first ever action as a Longhorn, playing as a reserve safety. He posted his first career interception in the first half.
- John Harris posted a career-high seven receptions for 110 yards and one touchdown. He had five receptions all of 2013.
- Jordan Hicks posted his first career interception in the second quarter which set up David Ash's 1-yard TD run.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR FOUR

The 12-game independent slate features teams from 10 states and seven conferences, including the American Athletic, Atlantic Coast, Big 12, Pac-12, Conference USA, Mountain West and Mid-Eastern Athletic.

The Cougars will play six home games and six road contests in 2014. BYU will face teams that hail from Connecticut, Virginia, Florida, Georgia, Tennessee, Texas, Utah, Idaho, Nevada and California, including seven programs—Texas, Houston, Utah State, Central Florida, Boise State, Middle Tennessee and UNLV—that gualified for a bowl game last season.

FLAG BEARERS

BYU has a tradition of selecting a player before each game to run the team flag and alumni flag. The team selects a former Cougar to carry out the alumni flag, along with the chosen current player who runs out with the current team flag. The team flag has been signed by each member of the team, while the alumni flag has been signed by each member of the team, while the alumni flag has been signed by former BYU payers. LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 30,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 64,045 after refurbishing the middle of the east section. The capacity now sits at 63,470 due to accomodations for wheelchair access. For the 2012 season the stadium featured new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands. BYU's 2012 average attendance of 61,161 ranked No. 3 in the West behind only USC (87,945) and UCLA (68,481).

MISSIONS

Seventy-five percent of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 18 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years or 18 months for women and couples—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

Eighty-eight members of the 2014 team have served church missions. Members of the team have served in 28 countries and six of the seven continents around the globe.

FIRESIDES

The BYU football team will participate in hour-long devotionals prior or team service activities the night before each game this season. The team will conduct devotionals before eight games. These devotionals are referred to as "firesides" and are intended to help players, coaches and those who attend strengthen or gain a knowledge of our purpose here on earth. Firesides typically include a musical number from members of the team and talks from selected players, along with coach Bronco Mendenhall.

The Texas fireside will be held Friday, Sept. 5 at 7 p.m. CDT at the Round Rock Stake Center, 8140 Racine-Trail Austin, Texas.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- At the end of the 2013 season, quarterback Taysom Hill ranked No. 10 in the country with an average of 329.4 yards per game of total offense. Hill earned the No. 1 all-time spot among BYU quarterbacks with 1,680 career rushing yards. Then a sophomore, he also ranked No. 19 in the FBS in rushing yards with 1,344 on the year. Hill is one of eight quarterbacks in NCAA history to throw for 400+ yards and run for 100+ yards in the same game. In the win at Houston, he tallied 417 yards through the air and 128 on the ground. Versus the Huskies, Hill threw for 308 yards and three touchdowns while also rushing for 97 yards and two more scores.
- · Balanced offensive attack. Last week against UConn, BYU scored five touchdowns--three through the air and two on the ground. The numbers were similar in 2013. The Cougars scored 43 touchdowns on offense last season. Nineteen of those TDs came through the air and 24 on the ground. Of the receivers returning to the team, Mitch Mathews recorded four TDs and Ross Apo three. Taysom Hill rushed for a team-high 10 scores, followed by Jamaal Williams (seven), Michael Alisa (three--but moves to LB this year) and Algernon Brown (two). Paul Lasike and Adam Hine each contributed one touchdown in 2013.
- . Go fast, go hard has been the mantra of offensive coordinator Robert Anae. Last year with a new offense, the Cougars averaged 89.9 plays per game, the second most of any team in the country only behind Texas Tech. Comparatively, BYU ran 79.2 plays per game in 2012.
- Hill made history with his performance against Notre Dame. He became the first BYU player to ever throw and run for 1,000 yards in the same season. He's also the 23rd guarterback in FBS history to achieve 2,000 passing yards and 1,000 rushing yards in a year.
- BYU has not been shut out for 125 consecutive games. The last time the Cougars failed to score was in 2003 in a 3-0 loss to Utah. That loss was the only time BYU has not produced points since 1975. BYU has scored in the last 483 of 484 games since 1975.

#44 Remington Peck, DL, Jr.

A junior defensive end, Peck is the only starter from last season's D-line to return to the starting lineup (Manumaleuna-NFL, Kaufusi-linebacker). He was named a team captain by his peers for the 2014 season.

#42 Michael Alisa, LB, Sr.

Originally recruited as a linebacker, Alisa played that position as a freshman before switching to running back as a sophomore and junior. He tallied four tackles, including one TFL vs. UConn. #2 Dallin Leavitt, DB, So.

As a true freshman, Leavitt saw time in all 13 games last season and even started one. He earned the starting nod to replace three-year starter Daniel Sorensen (now with the Kansas City Chiefs) at the KAT position.

#15 Michael Davis, DB, So.

Originally recruited to BYU as a wide receiver, Davis made the switch to defense last year He played WR in spring but was switched back to DB in fall camp. Davis is the fastest player on the team, running a 4.4 40-yard dash. He started at field corner against UConn and made eight tackles (seven solo).

#47 Zac Stout, LB, Sr.

Alani Fua and Zac Stout both prepped at Oaks Christian High in California and reunited as teammates for their senior seasons at BYU. Stout was on the BYU roster from 2010-2012. He led the team with 10 total tackles against UConn. #91 Travis Tuiloma, DL, So.

Tuiloma, a sophomore nose tackle, recently returned from an LDS mission in Samoa but has earned playing time. He played in all 13 games in 2011 and registered two tackles last game.

#92 Graham Rowley, DL, Jr.


Rowley played in all 13 games, and started three in 2011 as a sophomore before leaving BYU to serve an LDS mission in Chicago. A native of Hawaii, Rowley earned a starting spot on the defensive line after not being on a roster since 2011.

DEFENSIVE NOTES-10

2014 BYU FOOTBALL

THE BYU DEFENSE

- The BYU defense likes to get off the field, a lot. The defensive unit forced 5.42 three-and-outs per game to tie for 11th nationally with Wisconsin in that category last year. Of the 182 opponent drives last season, the defense got off the field in three plays or less 65 times, meaning that the defense has either forced a punt after three plays or has caused a turnover before the opposing team recorded a first down of any kind (36.9 percent). At the same time, BYU has forced 7.4 punts per game to rank tied for second in that category and 89 punts to tie for fourth overall in that category.
- Four BYU players from 2013 participated in the NFL combine this past February-only three college programs had more defensive players invited. Although the Cougars need to replace those high-caliber players, head coach Bronco Mendenhall has a proven record of maintaining a nationally ranked defense with the players who suit up on Saturdays. His teams especially excel at keeping opponents out of the end zone, averaging a No. 20 scoring-defense ranking over the past eight seasons.
- Lengthening the field. For the 2013 season, BYU allowed opponents 154 plays of 10 yards or more to rank No. 19 in the country. That means that opponents were tallying 11.84 such plays per game. The defense allowed just 4.8 yards per play, good for 20th in the FBS.
- Points per game and per play. The BYU defense allowed an average of 22.8 points per game to rank No. 24 nationally. It also allowed .289 points per play on the season to rank No. 14 in that category. So far this season, the Cougars are allowing .127 points per play and 10 points per game.



HEAD COACH BRONCO MENDENHALL YEARS AT BYU

10th year as head coach, 12th at BYU YEARS OVERALL 26th year

Entering his tenth season as head coach at Brigham Young University, Bronco Mendenhall has restored the Cougars' reputation as one of the nation's top college football programs. Taking over a BYU team that in 2005 was coming off three consecutive losing seasons, Mendenhall has guided his teams to nine straight bowl appearances, two outright conference championships before football independence in 2011, and regular national top-25 rankings.

Under Mendenhall's leadership, BYU has earned an 83-34 record to rank 12th in total wins among all FBS teams since 2005. Mendenhall also ranks 12th in winning percentage at .709 among active coaches with at least five years of FBS experience.

The Cougars finished the 2013 season with an 8-5 record after playing one of the toughest schedules in school history. BYU earned six of its eight wins over bowl teams, including then-No. 15 Texas, and faced nine bowl teams overall. Under Mendenhall BYU is one of only 12 programs to earn a bowl invitation each of the past nine years. Only Florida State (7) has achieved more than BYU's six bowl victories over that timeframe.

The Cougars set a program record with four consecutive bowl wins from 2009-12, helping Mendenhall become the first BYU head coach to win six bowls in a seven-year span. The Cougars received nine straight bowl invitations for the first time since a string of 17 consecutive bowl bids under Hall of Fame coach LaVell Edwards from 1978 through 1994. Mendenhall is the only coach in BYU football history to take his first nine teams to a bowl game, and is winning at the same pace as the legendary Edwards. Through his 116 games as BYU head coach, Mendenhall has a record of 82-34—almost identical to Edwards' 116-game mark of 83-32-1.

In 2006, Mendenhall was named the American Football Coaches Association Region IV Coach of the Year following an 11-2 season In addition, the Football Writers Association

an 11-2 season. In addition, the Football Writers Association of America named Mendenhall one of nine finalists for the prestigious Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year Award.

He has also served as the defensive coordinator for much of his tenure as the head coach. BYU has consistently fielded one of the nation's strongest defenses under Mendenhall's direction. Mendenhall's defense excels at keeping opponents out of the end zone, averaging a No. 20 national ranking in scoring defense over the past eight seasons, including three top-10 ratings. In 2012, the Cougars featured one of the greatest defenses in school history, allowing just 266.1 yards, including 86.9 rushing yards, and 14.0 points per game. Ranked No. 3 in total defense, No. 3 in scoring defense and No. 2 in rushing defense, the Mendenhall-coached unit held its first six opponents under 300 total yards (part of a streak of 12 consecutive such games dating back to 2011) and kept opposing offenses without a touchdown six times during the year. Adjusting to the team's up-tempo offense in 2013, BYU's defense ranked No. 12 in yards per play allowed despite defending more plays than all but four teams nationally. Only two teams that defended as many plays ranked better than the Cougars at defending their turf.

Another hallmark of Mendenhall's program has been the emphasis on balance and priorities in the many other facets of life outside of football. Reflecting that emphasis, BYU consistently received the most academic all-conference honorees each season as a conference member, while six Cougar student-athletes have earned seven Academic All-America citations under Mendenhall. Only four programs have had more Academic All-America citations during Mendenhal's tenure. In addition, BYU tops all FBS programs for the most selections to the NFF Hampshire Honor Society (3.2 GPA over college career) since the program began in 2007.

Mendenhall was elected in 2013 to the American Football Coaches Association Board of Trustees as the District 8 Representative and also serves on the Ethics Committee. He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at his alma mater, Oregon State. He later coached at Snow College, Northern Arizona, became the youngest defensive coordinator in the Pac-10 at Oregon State, then went to Louisiana Tech and New Mexico before coming to BYU as a defensive coordinator in 2003.
