LAST GAME vs. Arizona State

TEMPE, Arizona - In the highly anticipated season opener for the Southern Utah Thunderbirds, fans were treated to a thrilling contest that saw the T-Birds fall just shy of history with a final score of 24-21 in favor of Arizona State. The game featured exciting plays, key turnovers, and impressive performances on both sides of the ball for Southern Utah.

The Sun Devils wasted no time getting on the board, with Cam Skattebo rushing for a 6-yard touchdown with 9 minutes left in the first quarter. ASU drove 68 yards in just under 2 minutes to take a 7-0 lead.

Southern Utah responded in the second quarter when Targhee Lambson rushed for a 1-yard touchdown, capping off an 11-play, 62-yard drive. The game was tied at 7-7. The touchdown marked the first points of the season for SUU and Lambson's first score in a Thunderbird uniform.

The Sun Devils quickly regained their lead with two impressive touchdown passes from Jaden Rashada. The first was a 47-yard connection to Xavier Guillory in a fourth down and eight situation. The second was a 3-yard pass to Troy Omeire. ASU entered halftime with a 21-7 advantage.

Just as the Thunderbirds were preparing to return for the second half, Officials delayed the game due to lightning in the area. The delay would turn halftime into a two-and-a-half-hour break while lightning flashed all around the stadium.

When Play was finally resumed in the third quarter, The Thunderbirds immediately made a big defensive stop and forced the Sun Devils to punt. Southern Utah's Justin Miller then connected with Isaiah Wooden for a huge 52-yard play to set up Zach Mitchell for a 17-yard touchdown pass. The score closed the gap to 21-14.

Arizona State's defense held strong in the final quarter, preventing Southern Utah from mounting a comeback. Dario Longhetto added a 38-yard field goal to extend ASU's lead to 24-14. However, the Thunderbirds weren't done yet.

With 7 minutes and 50 seconds remaining, Jordan Washington broke through on an ASU punt blocking the kick. The ball was then collected by George Ramirez who returned it 47 yards for a touchdown. With the score at 21-24, Southern Utah had a chance to tie or take the lead, but ASU's defense held firm for the win.

In the closely contested football game between Southern Utah and Arizona State, individual performances played a crucial role in keeping the Thunderbirds in the game until the very end. Despite falling short, several Thunderbird players showcased their impressive skill on the field.

Justin Miller had a solid performance, completing 8 of 17 passes for 123 yards and throwing one touchdown. His completion percentage was 47%, and he had a passer rating of 127.2.

Zach Mitchell was one of the standout performers for the Thunderbirds. He caught 4 passes for 52 yards, including a crucial 17-yard touchdown reception. Mitchell demonstrated his reliability as a target, with a catch rate of 67%.

Isaiah Wooden made a significant contribution with 52 receiving yards on a single reception, showcasing his big-play ability. Despite not scoring a touchdown, his 52-yard catch was a highlight for the Thunderbirds.

Braedon Wissler was the force behind the Thunderbirds' ground game, rushing for 45 yards on 15 attempts. Wissler had the long run of the game, an impressive 21-yard dash early in the third quarter. Targhee Lambson added 23 yards on 7 attempts. He found the endzone in the first quarter for the first rushing touchdown of the 2023 season.

George Ramirez was named the player of the game for his efforts on defense. Ramirez totaled seven tackles and two pass break-ups. Ramirez had a game-changing moment with a 47-yard punt return for a touchdown, bringing the Thunderbirds within striking distance in the fourth quarter.

Alyas Vigil had a strong debut performance as the new punter for the T-Birds, averaging 42.4 yards per punt and pinning ASU inside their 20-yard line three times.

PRESEASON HONORS

The 2023 Preseason All-UAC Team, presented by The Bluebloods, has been revealed, featuring 66 skilled athletes from nine conference teams. Southern Utah players, including linebacker Kohner Cullimore and defensive lineman Payton Payne, earned spots on the First and Second Team Defense. Quarterback Justin Miller secured a place on the Second Team Offense. This recognition reflects the dedication of Southern Utah Athletes in the UAC.

Isaiah Wooden and Robert Horsey of Southern Utah Football have been named to the Reese's Senior Bowl watchlist. Coach DeLane Fitzgerald praised their hard work, versatility, and on-field performance. Wooden stood out for impressive rushing and receiving stats, while Horsey's defensive skills gained attention. Both players' selections highlight their talent and commitment.

Lyle Santos from Southern Utah also gained recognition, being named to the United Athletic Conference Preseason All-UAC team, further showcasing Southern Utah's presence in the conference.

PRESEASON POLLS

When the UAC Conference polls were revealed in early August the Thunderbirds were tabbed in a tie for seventh of nine teams in the conference.

This is the Thunderbirds first season in the newly minted UAC having oficially joined the rest of the WAC in the merger. Southern Utah will open conference play with University of Central Arkansas on September 30th.

The UAC Coaches poll has Eastern Kentucky as the odds on favorite to win the conference title this year and the Thunderbirds will not meet up with them on the field this season having played a close game with the Colonels last season.

TOP RETURNERS

On the offensive side of the ball the Thunderbirds bring back only a few starters. Justin Miller is back as the field general and is joined by some of his top receivers in Isaiah Wooden, Tim Patrick, and Ethan Bolingbrook. Lyle Santos is back to anchor the offensive line allongside Collin Gardner and Kyle Sfarcioc.

Miller Passed for 2,821 yards last season including 20 touchdown passes. One of his top recievers Wooden caught 40 passes for just over 800 yards and six of touchdowns.

On the Defensive side of the ball the T-Birds return Kohner Cullimore who was a Freshman All-American. Linebacker Aubrey Nellems, and Defensive lineman Payton Payne and Rylen Sua-Filo aslo return for Southern Utah.

Cullimore had 76 total tackles last season. Nellems added 52 tackles and 10 tackles for a loss for the Thunderbirds last season.

OPPONENT PREVIEW: BYU

CEDAR CITY, Utah - The showdown between Southern Utah University and Brigham Young University on September 8th, 2023, promises to be an exciting matchup at LaVell Edwards Stadium, kicking off at 1 p.m. MT. Both teams are coming off contrasting results in their previous games, setting the stage for an intriguing clash.

Coach DeLane Fitzgerald Said

"The BYU Alumni... is in a little bit of a panic because of how they played on Saturday night, but we don't expect that same team to show up against us on Saturday, they have good coaches who are going to fix some problems and they will play better."

"College football programs that are coached well, and BYU is, make their biggest jump of the year from week one to week two, and we are going to make a jump as well... Offense, defense, and special teams are all going to improve."

"We will be ready, they will be ready, and it should be a fun football game on Saturday."

The Game

BYU is coming off a dominant, albeit understated, 14-0 shutout victory against Sam Houston State. In that game, the BYU defense proved to be formidable, holding their opponents to zero points and just 38 rushing yards. The BYU offense managed to score two touchdowns and displayed a balanced attack with 112 rushing yards and 145 passing yards.

On the other hand, the Thunderbirds are coming off a hard-fought 24-21 loss to Arizona State. While they fell short, the Thunderbirds showed their resilience and competitiveness outlasting a more than two-hour weather delay. Their offense generated 87 rushing yards and 139 passing yards in the game. The defense held the Power 5 program to just three second-half points.

Key T-Birds to Watch:

Southern Utah has several players who could be impactful in this game. Quarterback Justin Miller has demonstrated his abilities with 123 passing yards, one touchdown, and no interceptions so far this season. He has been a pivotal figure in the team's offensive strategy for years and is on the verge of several program records for the T-Birds.

In the rushing department, Braedon Wissler has been a standout performer, amassing 46 yards in the season opener. Targhee Lambson was productive in his debut, gaining 23 rushing yards and a touchdown. In the receiving game, Zach Mitchell has contributed significantly with 52 yards on four receptions, including one touchdown. Isaiah Wooden picked up 52 yards in his lone reception of the game. These players collectively form a strong offensive core for the Southern Utah Thunderbirds.

The T-Bird defense will look to its returning linebackers to once again lead the charge. Kohner Cullimore and Aubrey Nellems are back on the field for SUU. Each raked up an impressive number of tackles last season and will look to do the same this year. Cornerback Jehvonn Lewis and linebacker George Ramirez led the team last week amassing seven tackles each in the game with the Sun Devils. Ramirez also scored late in the game returning a punt that was blocked by Jordan Washington, 47 yards for the touchdown.

Checking In with The Cougars

BYU's 2023 campaign kicked off with a victory over Sam Houston State, largely thanks to their stellar defense. The Cougars intercepted the opposition three times, showcasing their ability to create turnovers. They held Sam Houston State to a mere 38 rushing yards, highlighting their control of the line of scrimmage. Consistently applying pressure on the opposing quarterback is a vital component of their defensive strategy.

BYU's offensive game plan tilted towards a strong rushing attack. In the game with the Bearcats, the Cougars relied heavily on their running game, amassing 112 rushing yards. While they didn't score through the air in their previous game, the Cougars maintain a potent passing game with several productive targets.

Special teams played a pivotal role in field position and momentum during week one. BYU excels in placing kicks and punts strategically, affecting field position. Punter Rehkow averaged over 50 yards per punt and pinned Sam Houston deep in its own territory four times.

AROUND THE WAC: Get to know the teams

The ASUN Conference and Western Athletic Conference (WAC) football collaboration has evolved into the United Athletic Conference, marking its third year as a football partnership and its first as a consolidated entity. This newly formed conference operates with an independent budget, distinct policies, and its own governing documents. Effective from the 2023 football season onwards, the United Athletic Conference will name its own league champion and automatic qualifier for the FCS playoffs.

Comprising nine institutions—Abilene Christian University, Austin Peay State University, University of Central Arkansas, Eastern Kentucky University, University of North Alabama, Southern Utah University, Stephen F. Austin State University, Tarleton State University, and Utah Tech University—the United Athletic Conference will welcome the University of Texas Rio Grande Valley (UTRGV) in 2025 for football sponsorship.

Dr. James Hurley from Tarleton State University and Dr. David McFaddin from Eastern Kentucky University serve as co-chairs of the Council of Presidents, overseeing the governance of the United Athletic Conference. Executive Director Oliver Luck, WAC Commissioner Brian Thornton, and outgoing ASUN Commissioner Ted Gumbart, with incoming ASUN Commissioner Jeff Bacon joining upon Gumbart's retirement, complete the leadership team.

The 2023 United Athletic Conference football schedule will consist of six conference games among the nine member institutions. Moving forward to 2024, the schedule will expand to an eight-game single round-robin format. The conference champion and FCS playoffs automatic qualifier will be determined based on the team with the best conference record, with tiebreakers applied if necessary.

2023 THUNDERBIRD COACHES



Head Coach Delane Fitzgerald Second Season as Head Coach 91-56 Overall, 0-0 WAC 1st Season @ Southern Utah

In his first season at the helm of the Thunderbirds, Fitzgerald led SUU to a 5-6 overall record with a 2-3 mark in Western Athletic Conference play. The five victories were the most wins in a single season for Southern Utah since 2017.

The new leader of the Thunderbirds brings 22 years of college football coaching experience with him to Cedar City, including 13 years as a head coach, and a proven track record of building programs by implementing a winning culture. Fitzgerald comes to Southern Utah by way of Frostburg State University in Maryland, where he was the head football coach for the past eight seasons.

After eight seasons with the Bobcats, Fitzgerald leaves Frostburg State as the winningest coach in program history with a total of 62 victories. In 2014, Fitzgerald inherited an FSU program coming off its eighth-consecutive losing season with just 18 wins in eight years. After recording a 4-6 record in his first season as head coach, Fitzgerald led the Bobcats to winning seasons every year, including double-digit wins four times.

Frostburg State won New Jersey Athletic Conference championships in 2016 and 2018 under Fitzgerald's leadership and made NCAA Division III playoff appearances in 2017 and 2018. The Bobcats also won a Division III bowl game in 2016. After the 2018 season, Fitzgerald led Frostburg State's transition to NCAA Division II membership and quickly found success in the form of a Mountain East Conference championship in 2021 with a record of 10-1. Fitzgerald was also a three-time conference coach of the year honoree at FSU.

Before his historic run at Frostburg State, Fitzgerald spent five years as the head coach at Southern Virginia University in Buena Vista, Virginia. His teams at SVU progressed every season after going 3-8 in his first year, and finishing with an 8-2 record and No. 1 ranking in the USCAA Coaches Poll in 2013. The Knights have not achieved a winning season since Fitzgerald departed for Frostburg State.

Before taking over as head coach in February of 2009, Fitzgerald spent three seasons as the offensive coordinator and offensive line coach at Southern Virginia. Prior to his time in Buena Vista, Fitzgerald spent one season as the offensive coordinator at Bethel College in McKenzie, Tennessee. He also spent two years as the special teams coordinator at Tennessee-Martin.

Fitzgerald played football at Potomac State College before transferring and playing his final seasons as a fullback at James Madison University. After leading his team to an Atlantic 10 Conference championship in 1999, Fitzgerald began his coaching career at Bridgton Academy in Maine in 2000 before returning to James Madison as a defensive assistant in 2001.

SUU's coach holds a master's degree in education from Bethel College, a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from James Madison and an associate degree in physical education from Potomac State College.

Joining Fitzgerald in Cedar City is his wife, Kim. The couple has three daughters named Mattie, Afton and Laila.
