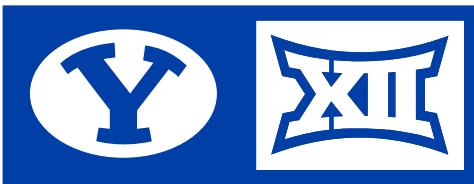

## Big 12 Inaugural Season

The 2024 season marks BYU's first year in the Big 12 as the program joined the conference on July 1, 2023.

### On the Road

BYU begins the season with four contests in the state of California across a 15-day span.

### Against the Aztecs

The Cougars are 28-25 all-time against San Diego State. The schools shared the same conference twice, competing in the Mountain West Conference (1999-2011) and Western Athletic Conference (1978-1999).

### Third outing with the Tritons

Saturday's match at UC San Diego will mark the Cougars' third all-time meeting with the Tritons. BYU is 2-0, with the last team win on March 31, 2022 (4-3). Wally Thayne defeated Daniel Traxler in the No. 1 singles slot with a score of 6-1, 6-4.

### Starpower Duo

Juniors Wally Thayne and Zach Fuchs enter the season ranked No. 35 (doubles) in the ITA's national rankings, released Nov. 15.

### New Faces

Newcomers for 2023-24 include freshmen TJ Wells, David Duong, Tygen Goldammer and sophomore transfer Alex Edmonston. Wells competed during fall season.

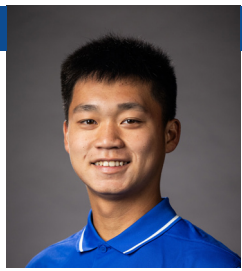

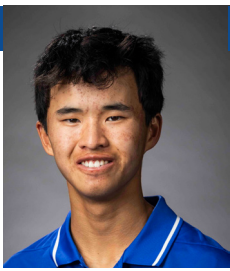
