• **THE GAUNTLET CONTINUES:** Texas plays its third contest of a four-game stretch against AP Top 25 opponents. This four-game stretch includes matchups against No. 9/9 Baylor (W, 75-73), at No. 11/13 Oklahoma (W, 75-60), at No. 21/19 BYU (Saturday) and home vs. No. 4 Houston (Monday).

• **DISU SEES DOUBLE:** Graduate F Dylan Disu registered his first double-double of the year with 19 points (6-10 FG, 2-3 threes, 5-6 FT), a season-high 10 boards and four assists in 35 minutes at No. 11/13 Oklahoma on Tuesday.

• **WEAVER PROVIDES SPARK:** Sophomore G Chendall Weaver set a season high with 11 points (4-8 FG, 3-4 FT), four rebounds (three offensive), one block and one steal in a season-best 27 minutes during Tuesday's victory at No. 11/13 Oklahoma.

Head Coach: Rodney Terry, 36-13 at Texas (2nd year); 199-169 overall (12th year)

BYU SERIES INFO

- Saturday's contest marks the **seventh** meeting between Texas and BYU and first since the 2013-14 season.
- The Cougars hold a 4-2 lead in the all-time series that dates back to a 63-50 BYU victory in Provo on Dec. 6, 1967.
- The Longhorns earned a 76-73 win in double overtime in Austin on Dec. 20, 1969.
- BYU claimed an 80-72 victory in Provo in the 1974-75 season opener for both teams (Nov. 29, 1974).
- The Cougars added a 91-86 overtime win in the opening round of the Kiwanis Tournament in Norfolk, Va., on Dec. 29, 1975.
- The Longhorns posted a 96-57 victory in Austin on Dec. 1, 1978.
- In the most recent matchup between the two schools (Nov. 25, 2013), BYU tallied an 86-82 win in the semifinals of the CBE Hall of Fame Classic in Kansas City, Mo.

IN THE POLLS

- Texas is not ranked in the latest AP poll (Jan. 22) and not ranked in the latest USA TODAY Sports Coaches poll (Jan. 22).
- Prior to the Jan. 15th poll release, the Longhorns had been ranked in the top 25 of The AP poll for **36** consecutive weeks, dating back to the rankings on Jan. 31, 2022.
- Texas began the 2023-24 season ranked No. 18 in the preseason AP poll and No. 18 in the preseason USA TODAY Sports Coaches poll.

DEFENSE WINS

- In Texas' 14 victories this season, the Longhorns have held their opponents to an average of 62.5 ppg on a combined 38.9-percent FG shooting including a 31.9-percent mark from three-point range.
- During UT's five losses this year, the Longhorns have allowed 79.6 ppg on 49.5-percent FG shooting including a 38.5-percent mark from three-point range.

OKLAHOMA RECAP

- Texas has now won six straight and seven of the last eight meetings against the Sooners.
- The Longhorns have claimed wins in each of their last five trips to Norman.
- Texas converted 50-percent (26-52) from the floor, including an 8-of-18 (.444) mark from three-point range, on the night.
- UT registered a plus-16 (40-24) rebound margin.
- The contest was tied at 52-52 at the 12:05 mark of the second half. The Longhorns closed the game on a 23-8 run over the final 12 minutes.
- Texas posted a 43-27 scoring margin in the second half. The Longhorns converted 54.5-percent (12-22) from the floor, including a 5-of-8 (.625) mark from three-point range, and 14-of-17 (.824) free throws during the final 20 minutes. OU was limited to 38.5-percent (10-26) shooting from the floor, including a 2-of-9 (.222) mark from beyond the arc, in the second half.

- UT hit just 1-of-1 free throw in the first half before connecting on 14-of-17 (.824) from the free throw line in the second half.
- **Max Abmas** topped the 20-point mark (game-high 22 points) for the sixth time this season (19 games) and 73rd time in his career (142 games). He reached double figures in scoring for the 19th time this year and 131st time in his career. Abmas has reached double figures in scoring in 41 consecutive contests. He registered a team-best plus-minus total of plus-21 in 36 minutes played.
- **Dylan Disu** recorded a double-double (19 points, 10 rebounds) for the first time this season (10 games) and 16th of his career (121 games). He reached double figures in scoring for the sixth time this year and 52nd time in his career. Disu set his season high in rebounds. He reached double digits in rebounds for the first time this season and 20th time in his career.
- **Dillon Mitchell** tied his career high in rebounds (13). He reached double digits in rebounds for the ninth time this season (19 games) and 11th time in his career (57 games).
- **Chendall Weaver** set his season high in scoring (11 points) and minutes (27). He reached double figures in scoring for the second time this year (19 games) and 17th time in his career (51 games). He tied his season highs in field goals made (4-8) and free throws made (3-4).

CARDIAC HORNS

- Texas has converted a game-winning basket in the closing seconds in **three** of its first 19 contests this season.
- During the 75-73 home win over No. 9/9 Baylor (Jan. 20), Tyrese Hunter converted the game-winning layup with no time remaining in the contest. This marked the first true game-winning "buzzer beater" (no time remaining after a made shot) in program history since Javan Felix hit a 16-foot jumper as time expired to lift the Longhorns to a 74-72 victory over No. 3/3 North Carolina in the Frank Erwin Center on Dec. 12, 2015.
- Max Abmas hit a jumper from the right baseline with 6.2 seconds left to help Texas earn a 74-73 win at Cincinnati (Jan. 9).
- Max Abmas also knocked down the winning jumper from the right elbow with 0.4 seconds remaining to top Louisville 81-80 (Nov. 19) in Madison Square Garden.

TEXAS IN THE BIG DANCE

- Texas has made a total of **37** all-time appearances in the NCAA Tournament (39-40 overall record).
- Texas is one of **six** schools to appear in at least 29 of the last 34 NCAA tourneys.
- UT is one of **seven** schools to appear in at least 21 of the last 24 NCAA tourneys.
- The Longhorns have advanced to the Final Four three times in program history (1943, 1947 and 2003), the Elite Eight a total of eight times and the Sweet 16 a total of 14 times.

OUR GUY, RT - YEAR TWO

- **Rodney Terry** was named the 26th head coach in Men's Basketball program history at The University of Texas on his 55th birthday - March 27, 2023. Terry was tabbed Acting Head Coach a few hours prior to the Dec. 12, 2022 home game against Rice. He was named Interim Head Coach for the remainder of the 2022-23 season on Jan. 5.
- A former head coach at Fresno State and UTEP for a combined 10 years, he sports an overall head coaching record of **199-169** (.541) in **12** seasons.
- Terry was tabbed the 2023 Sporting News National Coach of the Year, becoming the first coach in program history to earn the prestigious honor. He also was named the Clarence "Big House" Gaines College Basketball Division I Coach of the Year by the National Sports Media Association (NSMA).
- Terry, who has 28 years of collegiate coaching experience including nine as an assistant previously with the Longhorns from 2002-11, was in his second year as Associate Head Coach at Texas prior to being named Interim Head Coach.
- He spent three years (2018-21) as head coach at UTEP and posted a 37-48 (.435) mark, including a 29-27 record in his final two seasons. In his second year in El Paso (2019-20), the Miners went 17-15 to post their first winning season in four years and claim nine more wins than the previous season.
- Terry worked for seven years (2011-18) as the head coach at Fresno State, guiding the Bulldogs to a 126-108 (.538) mark. He posted 20-win seasons in four of his last five years and double-digit win totals in Mountain West Conference play in each of his last four years.

- During the 2015-16 season, Terry led the Bulldogs to a 25-10 record and the MWC Tournament title. Fresno State advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2001, and the 25 wins marked the third-most in school history.
- Terry spent nine seasons (2002-11) as an assistant coach under Rick Barnes at The University of Texas. The Longhorns posted an overall record of **232-80** (.744) and made nine NCAA Tournament appearances, including four trips to the Sweet 16 (2003, 2004, 2006 and 2008), three Elite Eights (2003, 2006 and 2008) and one Final Four (2003). Texas also claimed two Big 12 Conference regular-season titles (2006 and 2008).
- A total of 10 McDonald's All-Americans made their way to the UT campus during Terry's time. Texas' five-man freshman class in 2004 featured three McDonald's All-Americans and was tabbed the No. 1 class in the nation by Hoop Scoop.
- The Longhorns claimed two National Player of the Year winners (T.J. Ford in 2003 and Kevin Durant in 2007) and 13 players drafted by the NBA in the nine years under Terry, including nine first-round selections and five lottery picks.

TERRY AT TEXAS

- Now in his second year as the head coach at Texas, **Rodney Terry** has guided the Longhorns to a **36-13** (.735) record.
- Texas is **11-2** under Terry in games decided by five points or less OR in overtime.
- Terry is **10-8** against AP Top 25 opponents while at Texas.

HEAD COACHING EXPERIENCE ON THE STAFF

- **FOUR** members of the Texas coaching staff have a combined **46** years of **Division I collegiate head coaching** experience.
- Head Coach **Rodney Terry** has **11-plus** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at UTEP for three years (2018-21) and head coach at Fresno State for seven seasons (2011-18) in addition to his one previous year at Texas.
- Assistant Coach **Frank Haith** has **18** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at Miami (Fla.) for seven seasons (2004-11), Missouri for three years (2011-14) and Tulsa for eight seasons (2014-22).
- Assistant Coach **Steve McClain** has **14** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) for five years (2010-15) and head coach at Wyoming for nine seasons (1998-2007).
- General Manager **Chris Ogden** has **three** years of Division I head coaching experience. Ogden served as the head coach at UTA for three seasons (2018-21).

GET OLD AND STAY OLD

- The 2023-24 Texas roster includes **five** players who have already earned their undergraduate degrees: Max Abmas, Brock Cunningham, Dylan Disu, Ithiel Horton and Kadin Shedrick.
- **Seven** individuals have played in at least **78** career games and **four** players have started at least **89** career contests.
- **Three** players have already surpassed the **1,000-career point mark**: **Max Abmas** (2,902 points), **Ithiel Horton** (1,318 points) and **Dylan Disu** (1,059 points).
- The **12** players who brought previous collegiate experience to this year's roster have combined career totals of **929** games played (**591** starts).

EFFICIENT OFFENSE

- Texas is averaging 77.1 ppg this season while hitting at a **48.5-percent** (535-1104) clip from the floor, including a **37.8-percent** (146-386) mark from three-point range.
- The Longhorns have converted **at least 50-percent** from the floor in nine of their first 19 contests, including four of their first six Big 12 league games.
- Four UT players are averaging in double figures in scoring.
- **Nine** different Longhorns have reached double figures in scoring this year, while **five** UT players have recorded at least **21** points in a contest.
- Texas has reached double digits in three-point field goals made a total of **six** times in their first 19 games this year (5-1 record).
- UT hit 50-percent (26-52) from the floor, including an 8-of-18 (.444) mark from three-point range, and 15-of-18 (.833) free throws in the victory at No. 11/13 Oklahoma (Jan. 23).
- The Longhorns converted 51.9-percent (27-52) from the field, including a 9-of-19 (.474) mark from three-point range, during the home win over No. 9/9 Baylor (Jan. 20). Texas hit 9-of-11 (.818) from three-point range in the first half, **marking its top 3-point percentage in a half since UT went 5-of-5 from beyond the arc in the first half against Baylor on Feb. 14, 2006.**
- UT hit 50.9-percent (29-57) from the floor during its 74-73 victory at Cincinnati (Jan. 9).
- Texas recorded a season-high 96 points while converting 54.2-percent (32-59) from the floor, including a 50-percent (10-20) mark from three-point range, and 22-of-25 (.880) free throws in the 96-85 win over LSU (Dec. 16) in Houston.
- UT hit 55.7-percent (34-61) from the floor in the 86-63 victory against Wyoming (Nov. 26).
- The Longhorns converted 60.4-percent (29-48) from the floor, including a 45.5-percent mark (10-22) from three-point range, in their 80-64 win over Rice (Nov. 15).

SUCCESS AT THE STRIPE

- The Longhorns have converted **74.0-percent** (248-335) from the free throw line through their first 19 contests this season.
- UT converted 15-of-18 (.833) from the free throw line in the win at No. 11/13 Oklahoma (Jan. 23). Texas went 14-of-17 (.824) from the line in the second half.
- The Longhorns were 9-of-10 (.900) from the free throw line in the win at Cincinnati (Jan. 9).

- During the win over LSU (Dec. 16) in Houston, Texas hit 88.0-percent (22-25) from the free throw line. **The Longhorns went 12-of-12 from the stripe in the second half.** This marked the 11th time in program history (since the 1965-66 season) that Texas was perfect from the line in a half while attempting at least 10 free throws.
- UT converted a season-high 92.3-percent (12-13) from the free throw line in the victory against Wyoming (Nov. 26).

MID-COURT MAX

Graduate G **Max Abmas** (pronounced: ACE-miss) has played and started **142** career games during his five years at Oral Roberts and Texas. He owns five-year collegiate totals of **2,902** points, **479** assists, **465** rebounds and **156** steals. Abmas has reached double figures in scoring **131** times, topped the 20-point mark **73** times, eclipsed the 30-point mark **19** times and topped the 40-point mark **twice** in his career. He has reached double digits in points in **41** consecutive games.

- In his first 19 contests at Texas, Abmas leads the team in scoring (17.9 ppg), assists (83, 4.4 apg) and minutes (34.8 mpg). Abmas has hit 45.9-percent (117-255) from the floor, including a **41.2-percent** (61-148) mark from three-point range, and **90-percent** (45-50) from the free throw line. He also sports a **1.80-to-1** (83-46) assist-to-turnover ratio.
- He registered a game-high 22 points (8-14 FG, 4-8 threes), four rebounds and three assists in 36 minutes in the victory at No. 11/13 Oklahoma (Jan. 23). He had a team-best plus-minus total of plus-21 on the night.
- Abmas posted 15 points (5-13 FG, 3-8 threes), seven assists against one turnover and five rebounds in 39 minutes during the home win over No. 9/9 Baylor (Jan. 20).
- He recorded a season-high 32 points (9-17 FG, 7-13 threes, 7-8 FT), three assists and three steals in 37 minutes at West Virginia (Jan. 13). He earned **Big 12 Newcomer of the Week honors** (Jan. 15) for his efforts in the games against Cincinnati and WVU.
- Abmas registered 15 points (3-7 threes), five assists and three rebounds in 35 minutes at Cincinnati (Jan. 9). He hit the **game-winning jumper** from the right baseline with 6.2 seconds left.
- He tallied 18 points (6-12 FG, 4-7 threes), five assists, four boards and one steal in 37 minutes against Texas Tech (Jan. 6).
- Abmas posted a game-high 18 points (5-5 FT), seven assists, one steal and one block in 37 minutes against UTA (Jan. 1).
- He tallied a team-high 20 points (6-13 FG, 4-9 threes, 4-4 FT), seven assists and a season-high six rebounds in 35 minutes against LSU in Houston (Dec. 16). Abmas earned **Big 12 Newcomer of the Week honors** (Dec. 18) for his efforts in the victory.
- Abmas posted a game-high 16 points (7-12 FG), seven assists against just one turnover in 30 minutes against Houston Christian (Dec. 9).
- He recorded a team-high 25 points (10-19 FG, 3-8 threes, 2-2 FT) and two steals in 38 minutes at No. 8/7 Marquette (Dec. 6).
- Abmas tallied a game-high 26 points (9-18 FG, 5-12 threes) and six assists against one turnover in 38 minutes against Texas State (Nov. 30).
- He registered a game-high 23 points (8-14 FG, 3-6 threes), three assists and four boards in 32 minutes vs. Wyoming (Nov. 26).
- Abmas posted 10 points and five assists against one turnover in 35 minutes against No. 5/4 UConn (Nov. 20).

- He recorded 14 points in 38 minutes against Louisville (Nov. 19). Abmas knocked down the **game-winning jumper** from the right elbow with 0.4 seconds left.
- Abmas tallied 13 points (5-9 FG, 3-6 threes), five boards and four assists in 27 minutes against Rice (Nov. 15).
- He had a team-high 19 points (6-12 FG, 4-8 threes, 3-3 FT) and five assists in 35 minutes against Delaware St. (Nov. 10).
- Abmas posted 12 points (5-10 FG, 2-4 threes), five rebounds, three assists and one steal in 30 minutes during his Texas debut against UIW (Nov. 6).
- Abmas earned his BS in Mathematics from Oral Roberts in Spring 2023 and is pursuing a graduate certificate in Strategic Communication.

DISU'S DOMAIN

Graduate F **Dylan Disu** has played in **121** career games (**89** starts) during his five seasons at Vanderbilt and Texas. He has registered career totals of **1,059** points, **619** rebounds and **129** blocked shots. In his career, Disu has reached double figures in scoring **52** times, including **five** 20-point performances, and double digits in rebounds **20** times. He has tallied **16** career double-doubles.

- In his first 10 games (five starts) this year since returning from injury (missed the first nine contests, left foot surgery), he ranks second on the team in scoring (15.1 ppg), third in rebounding (4.0 rpg) and fourth in blocks (11) in 23.9 mpg. He has converted **17-of-30 (.567)** threes and 24-of-30 (.800) free throws.
- Disu had his first double-double of the year with 19 points (6-10 FG, 2-3 threes, 5-6 FT), a season-high 10 rebounds and four assists in 35 minutes in the win at No. 11/13 Oklahoma (Jan. 23).
- He posted 19 points (7-11 FG, 2-3 threes, 3-5 FT) and two steals in 24 minutes in the home win over No. 9/9 Baylor (Jan. 20).
- Disu tallied 18 points (7-12 FG, 2-4 threes, 2-3 FT), six rebounds and two steals in 27 minutes at West Virginia (Jan. 13). He topped the **1,000-point mark** in his collegiate career with a turnaround jumper at the 17:55 mark of the second half.
- In his first start of the year, he registered a **collegiate career-high 33 points** (13-23 FG, 4-10 threes, 3-4 FT), six rebounds, four steals and one block in 34 minutes at Cincinnati (Jan. 9). His previous career high was 29 points (while at Vanderbilt) against Kentucky (Feb. 17, 2021).
- Disu returned to the court vs. LSU (Dec. 16) for the first time since he played two minutes against Xavier in last year's NCAA Sweet 16 (March 24, 2023) - **a span of over eight months**. He posted 17 points (4-8 FG, career-high 9-9 FT), a career-best five assists without a turnover, four boards and one block in 20:23 of game action. He had a team-best plus-minus total of plus-16.
- As a senior at Texas in 2022-23, Disu played and started 36 games and led the squad and ranked second in the Big 12 in blocks (46, 1.3 bpg). He ranked second on the team in rebounding (4.4 rpg) and fifth in scoring (8.8 ppg) in 19.0 mpg.
- In the 2023 NCAA First and Second Round games, Disu averaged 22.5 points and 10.0 rebounds in 26.3 mpg while hitting 71.0-percent (22-31) from the floor. During UT's five postseason games in which he was healthy, he averaged a team-best 17.8 ppg and 9.0 rpg in 25.8 mpg.
- He tallied a season-high 28 points (14-20 FG) and 10 rebounds in 31 minutes against Penn State (Mar. 18) in the Second Round. Disu set the UT NCAA Tournament single-game record for most field goals made (14). His 28 points was the highest single-game scoring output by a Longhorn in a NCAA tourney contest since Kevin Durant had 30 in a Round of 32 loss to USC in 2007.

- Disu claimed **Most Outstanding Player** honors at the 2023 **Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship**. He averaged a team-best 14.7 ppg and 8.3 rpg in 25.5 mpg while hitting 73.9-percent (17-23) from the floor and 10-of-12 (.833) free throws in the three games.
- Disu earned his BA in Human Dimensions of Organizations in Spring 2023 and is currently in the Sport Management Graduate Program.

Sophomore F **Dillon Mitchell** is in his second season in the UT program and has played and started all **57** games. Mitchell has reached double figures in scoring **16** times, double digits in rebounds **11** times and posted **seven** career double-doubles.

Junior G **Tyrese Hunter** has played and started **91** career games during his three seasons at Iowa State and Texas. He has registered career totals of **996** points, **341** assists and **121** steals. Hunter has reached double figures in scoring **53** times, including **nine** 20-point efforts in his career. The 2022 Big 12 Freshman of the Year at Iowa State, he guided the Cyclones to the NCAA Sweet 16 as a freshman in 2021-22 and Texas to the NCAA Elite Eight last season.

- In his first 18 contests this year, he ranks second on the team in assists (73, 4.1 apg) and steals (19) and third in scoring (12.2 ppg) and minutes (29.9 mpg). He has converted **48.2**-percent (82-170) from the floor this season.

He has career totals of **1,318** points, **367** rebounds, **177** assists and **115** steals. Horton has reached double figures in scoring **68** times, topped the 20-point mark **14** times and eclipsed the 30-point plateau **two** times in his career.

- In his first 19 games (seven starts) at Texas, Horton is sixth on the team in scoring (7.4 ppg) and fifth in assists (19) in 20.6 mpg. He has hit **38.1**-percent (24-63) from three-point range this season.

- In his first 16 games (three starts) at Texas, he is third on the team in blocks (14) while averaging 4.3 ppg and 3.0 rpg in 12.0 mpg. He has converted 56.0-percent (28-50) from the floor this season.
- Onyema registered a season-high eight rebounds, four points (2-2 FT) and one block in 13 minutes at West Virginia (Jan. 13).
- He tied his career high with three blocks to go along with seven boards (three offensive) and four points in 12 minutes against Wyoming (Nov. 26).

He played his junior year of high school at PSAT-XEA Academy in Houston and was tabbed No. 21 in the state of Texas, No. 45 among all small forwards and No. 209 nationally by 247 Sports in the final Class of 2023 rankings.

IMPRESSIVE THREE-POINT STREAK

- The last time Texas did NOT convert a 3-pointer in a contest came on Dec. 18, 1990, in an 87-84 overtime victory at UC Santa Barbara. The Horns were 0-of-2 from beyond the arc that day.
- **The Longhorns enter Saturday's contest having hit at least one 3-pointer in 1,111 consecutive games.**
- UT has converted at least one 3-pointer in 1,239 of 1,247 games since the 3-pointer was introduced prior to the 1986-87 season.
- The Horns have failed to ATTEMPT at least one 3-pointer just one time in school history (Feb. 24, 1988 in a 69-55 win at TCU).

HORNS IN THE NBA

A total of 11 former University of Texas players appeared on NBA rosters when the league opened the 2023-24 regular season.

- Texas ranked in a tie for **FIFTH** nationally in most players on 2023-24 NBA opening-night rosters.
- In addition to the 11 former Longhorns on NBA rosters, Royal Ivey is an assistant coach for the Houston Rockets.

STAFF INKS IMPRESSIVE FALL SIGNING CLASS

A trio of top-45 national recruits signed National Letters of Intent during the fall signing period. **Tre Johnson, Cam Scott** and **Nic Codie** will join the Longhorns for the 2024-25 season. The three-man class is currently No. 4 nationally in the Class of 2024 team rankings by 247 Sports Composite.

- **Tre Johnson** (6-6, 190), a guard from Dallas, Texas, who plays at Link Academy (Branson, Mo.), is ranked as the No. 4 prospect in the nation by ESPN, No. 4 by Rivals, No. 4 by 247 Sports and No. 4 by 247 Sports Composite. He played at Lake Highlands HS in Dallas during his freshman through junior seasons. As a junior in 2022-23, Johnson averaged 21.8 points, 6.4 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game while leading Lake Highlands to a 34-3 record and the UIL Class 6A state championship. The National Junior of the Year by MaxPreps and Mr. Basketball in the state of Texas last year, he converted 53-percent from the floor, including a 42-percent mark from three-point range, and 91-percent from the free throw line as a junior. Johnson surpassed the 2,000-career point mark during the quarterfinals of the state tourney last year and recorded a game-high 29 points in his team's 55-44 victory over Beaumont United HS in the Class 6A state title game. Lake Highlands won its first state championship since 1968. Johnson was recently named to the roster for the **2024 McDonald's All-American Game**.
- **Cam Scott** (6-5, 185), a guard from Lexington, S.C., who plays at Lexington HS, is ranked as the No. 24 prospect in the nation by ESPN, No. 27 by 247 Sports Composite, No. 29 by On3, No. 30 by Rivals and No. 37 by 247 Sports. In his junior year in 2022-23, he averaged 19.2 points, 6.1 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 2.4 steals per game while leading Lexington to a 20-7 record and a trip to the Class AAAAA state semifinals. Scott was named the South Carolina Gatorade Player of the Year following his junior season. He earned co-MVP honors in June at the Pangos All-American Camp in Las Vegas after averaging 24.6 points per game while hitting 57-percent from three-point range.
- **Nic Codie** (6-8, 200), a forward from Carrollton, Texas who plays at Newman Smith HS, is ranked as the No. 40 prospect in the nation by On3, No. 41 by Rivals, No. 45 by 247 Sports Composite and No. 46 by 247 Sports. The top-ranked player in the state of Texas in the Class of 2024, Codie averaged 16 points and nine rebounds per game as a junior in 2022-23 while leading Newman Smith to a 22-8 record and the District 9-5A championship.

- **Cole Bott** chose to come to Texas because of the opportunity to play basketball while pursuing his MBA with an interest in the stock market.
- **Brock Cunningham's** father, Ed Cunningham, was a football offensive lineman at The University of Texas (1985-89) who earned All-America honors in 1989. Brock graduated in May 2022 with a bachelor's degree in Advertising and he is on pace to earn his master's degree in Advertising in Spring 2024.
- **Dylan Disu's** mother, Michelle Anderson, played basketball and volleyball at William Penn University (Oskaloosa, Iowa). His father, Rodney Anderson, football at Texas A&I University (now Texas A&M-Kingsville). Dylan earned his BA in Human Dimensions of Organizations in Spring 2023 and is currently in the Sport Management Graduate Program.
- **Ithiel Horton** is the first player in UT program history to wear jersey No. 9. In Hebrew, the name "Ithiel" means "God is with me." His mother, Hattie, is an evangelist, and his father, Kevin, plays the organ in church. His uncle, Lenny Horton, played basketball at Georgia Tech. - **Tyrese Hunter** lost both his father and mother during his childhood. His father, Brian, passed from sudden cardiac arrest when Tyrese was six years old. His mother, Ida, died of kidney failure when Tyrese was 13. Tyrese is the third-youngest of 12 children in the family (eight brothers and three sisters). He credits his grandmother, Annie Williams, and his oldest brother, Brian Jr., with raising him after the loss of his parents. Annie passed away this spring. Tyrese wears jersey No. 4 to honor his mom's birthdate (born on August 4, 1971).
- **Ze'Rik Onyema** has previously lived in Savannah, Ga.; Houston, Texas; Germany; El Paso, Texas; San Antonio, Texas; and Hawaii. His father, Kingsley, is a native of Owerri, Nigeria. Kingsley works in logistics for the U.S. Army and is based at the Pentagon. His mother, Mary, is an eighth-grade teacher. He wears jersey No. 21 to pay tribute to his mother's birthday (April 21) and his parents' anniversary (June 21).
- **Gavin Perryman's** father, Brandy Perryman, was a four-year letterwinner in basketball at Texas (1995-98) and finished his career as UT's all-time most accurate free throw shooter (89.7-percent, 183-204). His mother, Mandie Perryman, worked in the Texas Basketball office as a student assistant.
- **Kadin Shedrick** has a younger sister, Kari, who plays softball at Radford University (Radford, Va.). He played baseball as his primary sport until the age of 15. Kadin grew from 6-2 to 6-8 between his freshman and sophomore year of high school. His mother, Cindy, competed for the club Rowing team at the University of Cincinnati.
- **Chendall Weaver** wears jersey No. 2 to honor the memory of his best friend, Nevaeh Lopez who passed in 2020 (she attended Mansfield Timberview HS and wore jersey No. 2). His older sister, Chennedy Carter, played basketball at Texas A&M (2016-19) and was the No. 4 pick of the 2020 WNBA Draft by the Atlanta Dream. She played two seasons with the Atlanta Dream (2020-21) and one season with the Los Angeles Sparks (2022).

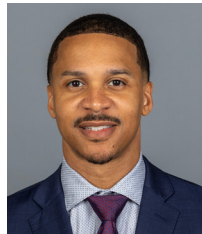
