TIPOFF

• The Kansas Jayhawks welcome Big 12 newcomer BYU to Allen Fieldhouse for the first time on Wednesday, Jan. 31.

• Tipoff is set for 6:30 p.m. CT and the game will be televised on Big 12 NOW on ESPN+ with Josh Klingler (play-by-play) and Wayne Simien (analyst) on the call. Fans can also listen to the game on the Jayhawk Radio Network from Learfield, with Steven Davis and David Lawrence calling the action.

• Kansas enters its final game in January with an overall record of 10-10, which includes a 3-6 mark through the first half of Big 12 Conference play. The Jayhawks were defeated 60-55 on Jan. 27 at Oklahoma in their last game, falling to 0-5 on the road during league play.

• KU has been a much better team at home all season, holding an 8-1 record this season at Allen Fieldhouse. The Jayhawks are 3-1 at home in league play, including wins over then-No. 4 Baylor on Jan. 10 and Iowa State, who was receiving votes in the AP Top 25, on Jan. 24. Kansas also defeated Nebraska at home on Dec. 20 to close out non-conference play.

• The Jayhawks have faced six nationally ranked opponents this season and KU holds the No. 2 Strength of Schedule in the country, according to the latest NET Rankings through games of Jan. 28. Kansas is 1-5 against ranked opponents, highlighted by an 87-66 victory over then-No. 4 Baylor on Jan. 10. The win was KU's first league win of the season and the Jayhawks' first win over a top-five opponent since 2009.

• Wednesday's game will be the first all-time meeting between Kansas and BYU in women's basketball. The Cougars are one of four new schools in the Big 12 this season, and the first one that Kansas has faced this season.

• BYU comes to Lawrence with a record of 12-9 (2-6 Big 12) following a 67-65 loss at then-No. 4 Kansas State on Jan. 27. The Cougars, who rank No. 2 in the league in three-point percentage (37.6%) are 1-7 in true road games this season.

• During Wednesday night's game, Kansas Athletics will honor Vickie Adkins as part of the Marian E. Washington Trailblazer Series. Adkins competed at KU from 1983-86 and still ranks No. 6 in career scoring and No. 7 in career rebounding at Kansas. The Trailblazer Series was started in 2020 to recognize notable accomplishments of African American Jayhawks during Black History Month.

KANSAS NOTES

• Wyvette Mayberry poured in a season-high 21 points in her home state on Jan. 27 as KU fell 60-55 at Oklahoma. It was her ninth game scoring in double figures this season and fifth 20-point game during her two seasons at Kansas. Mayberry has started all 20 games this year and ranks fifth on the team with 9.9 points per game.

• S'Mya Nichols has remained consistent throughout her freshman season, most recently scoring 15 points on Saturday at OU. Nichols has scored in double figures 17 times this season, including eight-straight games, and her scoring average of 14.1 points per game is the highest of any freshman at Kansas in head coach Brandon Schneider's tenure.

• Zakiyah Franklin extended her streak of scoring in double figures to six-straight games after totaling 13 points at Oklahoma. Franklin is second on the team at 11.6 points per game, while ranking No. 9 in program history with 1,767 career points and No. 4 with 472 career assists.

• Taiyanna Jackson had four blocked shots and a game-high 14 rebounds at OU, her second-highest total of the season. Jackson is averaging just shy of a double-double with 11.3 points and 9.4 rebounds per game, which is second in the conference. Jackson is No. 5 in school history with 885 career rebounds and No. 2 with 253 blocked shots.

UP NEXT

• Kansas opens play in February with a road trip to Fort Worth, Texas to face TCU. Tipoff from Schollmaier Arena is set for 6 p.m. CT and the game will be broadcast on Big 12 NOW on ESPN+.

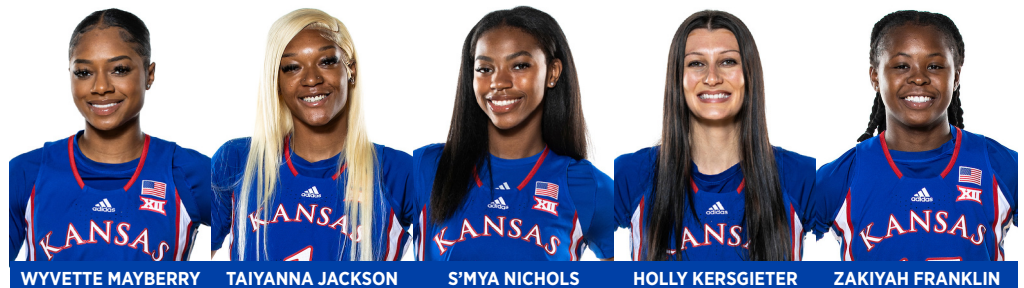

Taiyanna Jackson is in her third and final season at Kansas, where she is ranked second on the all-time Kansas blocks list. Jackson has broken the single-season blocks record in each of her first two seasons at KU and is fourth in career double-doubles, recording her 35th against Baylor on Jan. 10.



Zakiyah Franklin played her school-record 140th career game on Jan. 24 against Iowa State after becoming the program leader in career minutes played against Northwestern State on Nov. 8. She ranks No. 9 on KU's career scoring list and is now No. 10 in school history for three-pointers made.



Holly Kersgieter broke KU's career record for three-pointers made after hitting three at Texas Tech on Jan. 6. She surpassed the record of 237 career threes, which had been held by Angie Halbleib since 1997. Kersgieter is also No. 7 on the career scoring list and No. 9 in free throws made at Kansas.

ABOUT THE JAYHAWKS

• Kansas is 10-10 on the season and 3-6 in Big 12 play following its 60-55 loss at Oklahoma. The Jayhawks are 8-1 at home this year and 3-1 in Big 12 play, including wins over Iowa State, Oklahoma State and No. 4 Baylor. KU's 87-66 win over Baylor on Jan. 10 was the Jayhawks first win over Baylor since 2014 and the program's first win over a top-five opponent since 2009. Kansas is 1-5 against nationally ranked opponents this season.

• Kansas has faced the No. 2 NET Strength of Schedule in the country this season and is currently ranked No. 50 in the latest NET rankings, which takes into account games played through Jan. 28. The Jayhawks moved up 10 spots in the NET following their win over Baylor. The NET rankings are based off of game results, winning percentage and adjusted win percentage. KU is the eighth-highest ranked team from the Big 12, which has 13 members ranked in the Top 100.

• Kansas returned four starters from 2022-23, including Preseason All-Big 12 selections Taiyanna Jackson, Zakiyah Franklin and Holly Kersgieter. Jackson earned a unanimous selection, while Franklin was on the preseason team and Kersgieter received honorable mention.

• Kansas entered the 2023-24 season after claiming the 2023 WNIT Championship with a 66-59 victory over Columbia in front of a crowd of 11,701 fans at Allen Fieldhouse on April 1. Jackson was named the WNIT Most Valuable Player after posting 17 points and 21 rebounds in the finale. Jackson set the tournament record for most rebounds (78) and most offensive rebounds (33) in the WNIT.

FIVE-STAR FRESHMAN

• S'Mya Nichols came to KU as one of the highest-ranked recruits in program history when she signed to become a Jayhawk, and early in her career she has lived up to the billing.

• Nichols has scored in double figures in eight-straight games and 17 times in her freshman season, including three 20-point contests. Nichols has led the Jayhawks in scoring eight games, and she set a new career-high in scoring in back-to-back games, scoring 20 points in KU's win over Houston Christian (Dec. 6), before going for 23 points in the win at Wichita State (Dec. 10).

• At her current team-high scoring pace of 14.1 points per game, Nichols would become the third-highest scoring freshman in Kansas Women's Basketball history and the highest scoring freshman at KU under head coach Brandon Schneider.

• Nichols is now a two-time Big 12 Freshman of the Week, earning the honor on Dec. 11 and Jan. 15. She is only the third KU player to earn the league's weekly freshman honor on multiple occasions.

• A five-star prospect from Shawnee Mission West HS in Overland Park, Kansas, Nichols was ranked No. 5 at her position and No. 22 in the country by Collegiate Girls Basketball Report. As a member of the 2022 Team USA U18 National Team, she won a gold medal at the FIBA U18 Americas Championship.

TWIN

• Hailing from East Chicago, Indiana, Taiyanna Jackson is in her third season at Kansas and she has broken the single-season blocks record in both of her previous seasons. She burst on to the scene with 95 blocks in her first season at KU, then surpassed that record with 109 blocks in 2022-23.

• In KU's 87-66 win over No. 4 Baylor on Jan. 10, Jackson had one of her best games as a Jayhawk, scoring a career-high 27 points with a season-high 19 rebounds. In the game, Jackson also became the 32nd player in program history to surpass 1,000 points as a Jayhawk and the fifth player on KU's current roster with 1,000 points in their careers.

• Jackson is nearly averaging a double-double, ranking third on the team with 11.6 points per game while leading the Jayhawks with 9.4 rebounds per game. She is also averaging 2.6 blocks per game this season and now has 253 blocked shots for her career, needing 17 to break KU's career record. She had a season-high six blocks in KU's win at Wichita State on Dec. 10.

• Prior to the start of the 2023-24 season, Jackson was named to the Naismith Player of the Year Watch List, which recognizes the best overall player in NCAA Division I women's basketball. She is one of 50 selections to the list.

• Entering the 2023-24 season, Jackson earned a unanimous selection on the Preseason All-Big 12 Team. She has earned this recognition after being named to the All-Big 12 First Team and the All-Big 12 Defensive Team, both unanimously, and a two-time Big 12 Player of the Week in 2022-23.

• Jackson is also one of 20 players named to the Lisa Leslie Preseason Award Watch List. Jackson finished the 2022-23 campaign posting 23 double-doubles, the third-most in a single-season in Kansas history, and ranked second in KU history with a field goal percentage of 66.1, which ranked fourth nationally.

PRESEASON WATCH LISTS

• Zakiyah Franklin and Taiyanna Jackson were named to award watch lists before the season.

• Franklin was one of 20 players selected to the Nancy Liberman Preseason Award Watch List, which recognizes the top point guard in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. Franklin led the Jayhawks in scoring with 15.7 points per game last season.

• Jackson earned a spot on two watch lists, being recognized as one of 20 candidates for the Lisa Leslie Award, which recognizes the best center in college basketball, and one of 50 for the Naismith Player of the Year Award.

KANSAS NOTES

• Zakiyah Franklin has played in more games than any other players in Kansas Women's Basketball history with 141, surpassing the record of 139 games held by legendary Jayhawk Lynette Woodard. Franklin has also played more minutes than any other player in program history and ranks No. 9 on the all-time scoring list with 1,767 career points.

• Holly Kersgieter became Kansas Women's Basketball's all-time leader in three-pointers made when she knocked down three at Texas Tech on Jan. 6. Kersgieter has now hit 246 career threes, surpassing the previous record of 237, which was held by Angie Halbleib (1994-97).

• Two current Jayhawks rank in the Top 10 for all-time scoring in Kansas. Kersgieter moved to No. 7 on the list with 12 points at Kansas State on Jan. 20. With 1,776 career points, the next player ahead of Kersgieter on the list is Vickie Adkins, who scored 1,786 points from 1982-86. Franklin is not far behind at No. 9 with 1,767 points, needing 8 to pass Lynn Pride for eighth.

• KU has had three players surpass the 1,000-point career milestone this season. Wyvette Mayberry, who started her career at Tulsa, reached the

- Taiyanna Jackson became the fifth current Jayhawk to reach the 1,000-point milestone, scoring her 1,000th career point in KU's win over Baylor on Jan. 10. Kansas is one of four teams in NCAA Division I Women's Basketball with five active 1,000-point scorers.

ABOUT THE OPPONENT

- From Provo, Utah, the BYU Cougars come into Allen Fieldhouse with an overall record of 12-9 and 2-6 in the conference through their first season in the Big 12. BYU is coming off a two-point road loss at then-No. 4 Kansas State, the undefeated Big 12 conference leader.

- BYU is led by senior forward Lauren Gustin, who is the only player in the Big 12 averaging a double-double, with 16.0 points a game while leading the conference with 15.4 rebounds a game.

- Amber Whiting is in her second season as a head coach and has compiled a 28-26 record. She led the Cougars to the 2023 semifinals of the West Coast Conference Tournament in her first season as a head coach.

- Adkins is No. 6 in career scoring at Kansas and No. 7 in career rebounds after starring for the Jayhawks from 1983-86. She left a great mark on the program during her time as a player and her legacy includes several family members also involved with Kansas Basketball.

- Other members of Adkins' family who competed at Kansas include her sister, Barbara (Adkins) Henry, brother-in-law, Carl Henry, and nephews, CJ and Xavier Henry.

THE NEWCOMERS

- KU welcomed six newcomers to the squad, highlighted by five-star guard S'Mya Nichols out of Overland Park, Kansas.

- The most experienced of the group is Alabama transfer Ryan Cobbins as she enters her fifth season of college basketball. Along with Nichols and Cobbins, Skyler Gill transferred from North Alabama.

- The squad also welcomes three more freshmen in guard Laia Conesa, center Paris Gaines and guard McKenzie Smith.

- Kansas Head Coach Brandon Schneider announced the addition of three student-athletes on Nov. 8 as **Zoe Canfield**, **Carla Osmá** and **Regan Williams** signed with the Jayhawks on the first day of the early signing period.

Brandon Schneider is in his ninth season at the helm of the Kansas Women's Basketball program. He was named the sixth head coach to lead the Jayhawks on April 20, 2015, and he signed a new four-year contract on March 9, 2022, that will keep him in Lawrence through the 2025-26 season.

Schneider has led the Jayhawks to the postseason in each of the past two seasons. The 2022-23 season saw Kansas finish with a 25-11 record after winning the WNIT with a 66-59 victory over Columbia in front of a crowd of 11,701 fans at Allen Fieldhouse. The Jayhawks played all six of its WNIT games at home and averaged 3,481 per game for the season, marking a 122 percent increase in home attendance from the 2021-22 season.

KU finished with 25 wins for just the sixth time in program history, and the first since 1996-97. The Jayhawks have now won 20 or more games in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2012 and 2013. For his efforts, Schneider was named the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association (KBCA) Women's Four-Year College Coach of the Year in 2023, his third time earning the honor after also claiming in 2006 and 2010 as the head coach at Emporia State. During the 2022-23 season, Schneider became the 33rd active Division I coach to reach 500 career victories, picking up win No. 500 on Feb. 26, 2023, with a 66-57 win over Oklahoma State.

Schneider guided the Jayhawks to a breakthrough campaign in 2021-22. Kansas finished the season with a record of 21-10, marking the program's first 20-win season since 2012-13, and the Jayhawks had 20 wins during the regular season for the first time since 1999-2000. Schneider was named the 2022 Big 12 Coach of the Year after guiding the Jayhawks to a fifth-place finish with 11 conference victories, the most by a KU team since 1999-2000.

Schneider guided Kansas to the 2022 NCAA Tournament, earning a No. 8 seed in the Spokane Regional. The Jayhawks defeated No. 9-seed Georgia Tech, 77-58, in the opening round before falling to eventual regional champion Stanford in the second round. The tournament bid was the 14th in program history for the Jayhawks and first since 2013.

During his tenure at Kansas, Schneider has coached 11 players who earned All-Big 12 postseason recognition. The Jayhawks have also had two players named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team and two named to the Big 12 All-Defensive Team along with six Big 12 Players of the Week and three Freshman of the Week. Schneider has also coached 37 players who received Academic All-Big 12 recognition, including a program-best seven student-athletes earning a spot on the team in both 2022 and 2023. Additionally, Schneider's program set a new team-record with a 3.44 Team GPA in the 2021 fall semester.

Schneider increased the Jayhawks win total in each of his first five seasons in Lawrence, which culminated with a 15-14 record in 2019-20. That year, the Jayhawks finished with a winning record for the first time in seven seasons and were set to play in a postseason tournament prior to the COVID-19 pandemic cancelling the Big 12 Tournament and beyond.

Prior to Kansas, Schneider had a five-year stint at Stephen F. Austin, where he returned SFA to the top of the Southland Conference. Schneider guided SFA to three 20-win seasons and the Ladyjacks won back-to-back league titles in 2013-14 and 2014-15. SFA made three postseason appearances under Schneider, including the WNIT in 2015 after he was named the Southland Conference Coach of the Year. As head coach at Stephen F. Austin, Schneider was 95-66 overall in five years and 57-29 in Southland Conference play.

Schneider was named head coach of the Ladyjacks on April 20, 2010. Recognized as one of the top names at the NCAA Division II level, Schneider went to Nacogdoches after a highly successful 12-year stint at Emporia State.

The Canyon, Texas native is the second all-time winningest head coach at the NCAA Division II level. At Emporia State, Schneider guided the Lady Hornets to a 306-72 (.810) record, and the 2010 NCAA Division II National Championship. The school's all-time leader in wins and winning percentage, Schneider ranks among the all-time top 10 in fastest coaches to 100 victories, and third fastest among women's basketball coaches.

Schneider spent 12 seasons at ESU guiding the Lady Hornets to 11 NCAA Tournament appearances. During that stretch, Schneider's teams recorded two 30-win seasons and nine 20-win campaigns. Along with the 2010 national championship, Schneider coached ESU to four NCAA Division II South Central Regional titles, two Final Four appearances, six regular-season conference crowns and three league tournament titles.

Schneider was the first MIAA rookie head coach to win both the MIAA regular-season and tournament titles. In 2006 and 2010, the Kansas Basketball Coaches Association of four-year colleges voted Schneider as its coach of the year. He was also a three-time MIAA Coach of the Year.

The 2010 Bulletin Women's Basketball National Coach of the Year and the WBCA South Central Region Coach of the Year, Schneider's players have reaped the rewards of his guidance. He coached seven All-Americans, including two NCAA Division II Players of the Year, eight conference MVPs and seven players who have gone on to play professionally, including one in the WNBA.

A 1995 honors graduate of Wayland Baptist, Schneider was a four-year letterman in men's basketball for the Pioneers and the school's first-ever Academic All-American, capturing the honor three times.

Schneider was raised in a coaching family. His father, Bob, was a member of the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Class of 2022 following a 40-year coaching career at the high school and collegiate levels. Bob Schneider was one of the most successful women's coaches at the NCAA Division II level, having served as the head coach at West Texas A&M from 1981-2006. They became the first father/son combination to take teams to the Elite Eight. In addition, Schneider's brother, Brett, is currently the head women's basketball coach at Frank Phillips College in Borger, Texas.

Schneider and his wife Ali, have two sons, Cash and Cole.
