The Cougars fell to 2-3 on the season when making less than 10 3-pointers in a game.

The Road Trip

With tonight's setback to Oklahoma, BYU has yet to win back-to-back road games in the same season since February 2021.

All Tied Up

For the first time this season and sixth time under fifth-year head coach Mark Pope, BYU was tied at halftime after Miles Uzan's layup in the final seconds to make it 34-all.

PLAYERS NOTES

First Half Fouss

Fousseyni Traore finished with 11 points in the first half marking the first time in his career he has scored in double figures in consecutive first halves in his career. The junior finished with a game-high 21 points, marking the first time in his career that he has scored 20-plus in back-to-back games.

Rebound Machine

Traore recorded his 600th rebound of his career with his first rebound of the game. The junior also had two offensive rebounds giving him 210 for his career which is tied for the eighth-most in program history with former All-American Gary Trost (1987-88, 90-93).

Homecoming

Robinson extended his team-high 3-point streak to nine games with a corner three at the 11:42 mark in the first half. The senior finished with eight points in his first game in his home state.

Shooter Spencer

With his two 3-pointers, Spencer Johnson has now hit 127 triples during his time in Provo moving into a tie for 16th on the all-time 3-point list with Terrell Lyday (1999-01).

Trevin Knell had a career-high three steals in 23 minutes of action.
