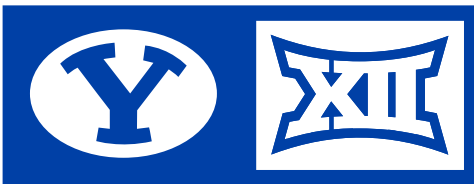

The 2024 campaign marks BYU's first year in the Big 12 as the program joined the conference on July 1, 2023.

Sweep Streak

BYU's four consecutive victories have all been in dominant fashion, with 7-0 home wins over Omaha and Montana State and two 4-0 sweeps at UC Riverside.

Leading the Pack

The Nevada Wolf Pack are coached by Sylvain Malroux, who is in his ninth season with an 83-87 record. He recently led the program to 2022 Mountain West regular season and tournament titles and a subsequent NCAA Tournament appearance.

On Fire

At No. 2 singles, Wally Thayne has won six straight for a 6-1 overall record. The junior has also won five straight with doubles teammate Zach Fuchs. The duo is 5-1 in 2024.

12th Meeting

BYU and Nevada have met 11 times, with BYU holding a 10-1 series advantage.

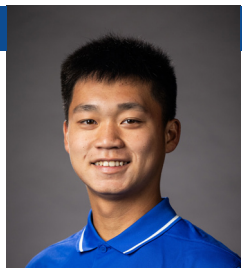

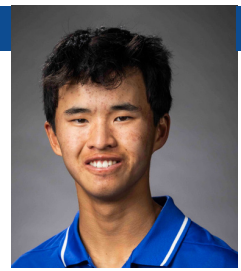
