This week's slate vs. No. 25 Oklahoma State and No. 17 Oklahoma mark the program's first conference matches as a Big 12 member. Conference play includes seven contests, with four at home and three on the road.

Sooner State Foes

The Cowboys and Sooners are fresh off NCAA Tournament appearances last season as both advanced to the round of 32. BYU hasn't played Oklahoma State since 2004 and Okla-Jonathan Sanchez homa since 2001.

The Cougars' 10 consecutive victories marks the longest streak since an 11-match run from Indoor Courts - Directly east of South Field Jan. 26-March 16, 2019.


