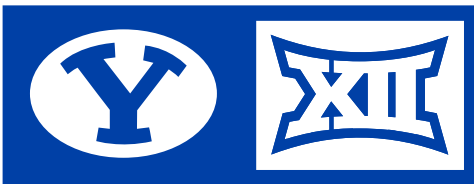

## The Start of Something New

This week's slate vs. No. 25 Oklahoma State and No. 17 Oklahoma mark the program's first conference matches as a Big 12 member. Conference play includes seven contests, with four at home and three on the road.

### Cougars vs. Sooners

Saturday's match will mark just the third all-time meeting between the programs. The series is tied 1-1 as the Cougars won the last outing on January 13, 2001.

### Sooner Success

Oklahoma is off to a 13-2 start and rides a six-match winning streak. The Sooners are fresh off an NCAA Tournament appearance last season, advancing to the round of 32.

### On Fire

At No. 2 singles, Wally Thayne secured a ranked win over Oklahoma State's No. 70 Isaac Becroft on Thursday. Thayne and Redd Owen's 12-2 singles records lead the team. Owen has won six straight while Thayne has racked up four in a row.

### Big Opportunities

BYU has a chance to earn more wins over nationally-ranked opponents Saturday. Oklahoma has two ranked athletes by the ITA: Alex Martinez (No. 20 singles) and Khololwam Montsi (No. 107 singles) as both are also ranked No. 63 together in doubles.

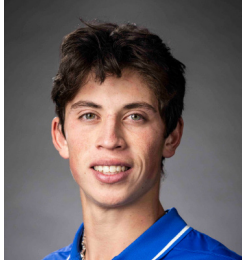
