**NONCONFERENCE PLAY.** BYU breaks from Big 12 play for its 18th, 19th and 20th nonconference games of the season in the weekend series at Miami. BYU is 11-6 on the season versus nonconference foes with four-straight wins, including two over now No. 25-ranked rival Utah.

**DATES & TIMES.** Thursday and Friday games are set for 7 p.m. ET, with the Saturday game scheduled for 12 p.m. ET. All three games will air live on ACC Network Extra and can also be heard on the BYU Radio App and locally on BYU Radio 107.9 FM.

**BYU BASEBALL IN FLORIDA.** BYU and Miami meet for the first time on Thursday. The Cougars are 4-4 all-time in games played in the state of Florida, with each of eight games played at neutral sites. BYU went 2-2 at the Snowbird Classic in Port Arthur on Feb. 18-21, 2022. The Cougars also went 2-2 at the 1994 NCAA Tallahassee Regional. BYU is 1-3 all-time versus teams from Florida with its lone win over Stetson in 1986.

**SCOUTING THE HURRICANES.** Miami's storied baseball history includes four national championships (1982, 85, 99, 2001), two national runner-up campaigns (1974, 1996) and first-year head coach J.D. Arteaga.

Arteaga helped the Hurricanes to four-straight College World Series appearances as a player (1994-97) and maintains a program-record 43 career wins on the mound. Arteaga's first season at the helm in Coral Gables follows 21 years as the Hurricanes' pitching coach.

Miami finished the 2023 season ranked No. 20 in the final D1Baseball.com Top-25. The final ranking followed a 42-21 (18-12) season in which the Hurricanes finished second in the ACC Coastal division and achieved a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament. Texas put a premature end to Miami's season with a game-six upset of the hosts at the Coral Gables Regional.

Arteaga's club was picked to finish fourth in the ACC Coastal in 2024 and currently stands in sixth at 19-24 (8-16) with a 16-12 home record. Miami has dropped five of their last eight games and is coming off a series loss to Georgia Tech (6-4, 4-9, 1-17) on April 26-28. The Hurricanes' 2024 resume is highlighted by wins over now No. 11 Virginia (6-5, 16-12) and No. 12 North Carolina (14-1, 2-1).

BYU becomes Miami's second Big 12 foe of the season after UCF delivered the Hurricanes a 4-3 defeat on Feb. 21. Infielder Daniel Cuvet leads Miami in batting (.337), runs scored (41) and RBI (49). Pitcher Nick Robert holds a team-leading 22 appearances with 4.29 ERA and a 5-3 record.

**BYU RECAP.** The Cougars began the week in the win column with eight runs on 10 hits en route to an 8-6 win over Abilene Christian at Miller Park on Monday. Stone Cushing shut the door on ACU in the ninth with a pair of strikeouts that cemented his Big 12-leading eighth save of the season.

## SEASON HIGHLIGHTS | STATS

BYU's offense used three-run outings in the fourth and fifth to put the Wildcats in an 8-0 hole. Third baseman Easton Jones went 2-for-4 with two RBI while shortstop Brock Watkins scored two runs and recorded an RBI on 1-for-2 from the plate. Second baseman Luke Anderson added 2 RBI and a run with a double.

**COUGAR CLOSER.** With his eighth save of the season versus ACU, Stone Cushing moves into a tie for seventh nationally in the category. Cushing now ranks fifth all-time at BYU in single-season saves, surpassing Jeremy Thomas (1999) and Dan Wheeler (1993). Eight also ties Cushing for sixth in career saves at BYU. The junior from Salem, Utah registered his first-career win in a 5-4 defeat of Utah then found himself on the NCBWA's Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List with its April 24 release.

**SUPER SOPHOMORE.** Third baseman Easton Jones continues to compile impressive offensive numbers. Jones leads BYU in average (.308), hits (48), total bases (93), home runs (12) and slugging percentage (.596). The sophomore from Lehi, Utah also holds team-long streaks in hits (12 games) and multiple hit games with 15 (12 games with 2 hits and 3 with 3).

Ten of Jones' 12 homers on the season have come in Big 12 play. Jones and Texas' Max Belyeu enter the week tied for the league-lead in homers versus Big 12 competition.

**BYU BACKSTOP.** Catcher Collin Reuter has the teams longest reached base streak with 29 games and is second on the team in average (.295), RBI (32) and slugging (.518). Reuter is also tied for the Big 12 lead in base runners caught stealing with 11.

**FABULOUS FRESHMEN.** Designated hitter Kuhio Aloy holds a team-leading 34 RBI with 21 runs on 42 hits, seven doubles and six homers. Leftfielder Ryker Schow has recorded at least one run in eight of the last 10 games. Centerfielder Crew McChesney notched his first-career homer and two RBI in game three at No. 19 Oklahoma State on April 26.

## COUGAR COACHING STAFF

**TRENT PRATT** was named BYU's head baseball coach on June 8, 2022. Prior to his appointment, Pratt served as the interim head coach of the Cougars for the final 25 games of the 2022 season, where he guided BYU to an overall record of 16-9 (.640) and was 10-6 (.626) in WCC games.

Pratt had been an integral part of the BYU baseball staff over the previous 10 years where he helped BYU claim WCC regular season championships in 2016, 2017 and 2019. As a player, Pratt played two years at Arizona State and two at Auburn, earning All-SEC honors as a senior catcher in 2002. He was drafted three times in MLB Draft, eventually going in the 12th round to the Philadelphia Phillies, where he played four seasons as part of their organization.

**ABE ALVAREZ** was hired as the BYU pitching coach in July 2022. Prior to joining the BYU baseball staff, he spent the previous four seasons as an assistant coach at Nevada. Alvarez was an All-American at Long Beach State where he posted a 23-5 record with a 2.56 ERA over three seasons (2001-03). Following his junior season, Alvarez was drafted in the second round by the Boston Red Sox. He made the quickest trip from single-A ball to the big leagues in Boston history, making his MLB appearance in July 2004 and was the youngest member of the team to win a World Series ring in 2004. He spent six seasons with the Red Sox organization before retiring in 2009.

**ADAM LAW** is a former Cougar infielder (2009-13) and returns to BYU after five years as the Los Angeles Dodgers' international operations and mental performance coach. Law is the son of former BYU head baseball coach Vance Law (2000-12) and former Cougar assistant coach Vern Law (1969-78). Vance played 12 seasons of Major League Baseball from 1980-91 and was an All-Star in 1988. Vern pitched for the Pittsburgh Pirates from 1950-1951, 1954-1967, with a stint in the military from 1951-54. A two-time All-Star, Vern led the Pirates to the 1960 World Series title and was awarded the Cy Young Award.

**TYLER COOLBAUGH** came to Provo following two years as the University of Arizona director of player development as well as two seasons on staff with the Texas Rangers and Abilene Christian. He played three years as an infielder with the Orioles organization before retiring in 2019. His father, Scott Coolbaugh, played third base for the Texas Rangers, San Diego Padres and St. Louis Cardinals (1989-94). He is currently the assistant hitting coach for Padres
