BACK TO BIG 12 PLAY. After five-straight nonconference games, including a series May 2-4 at perennial power Miami, BYU baseball returns home for the season's final home series versus Cincinnati May 9-11.

DATES & TIMES. Thursday and Friday games are set for 6 p.m. MT, with the Saturday game scheduled for 11:30 a.m. MT. All three games will air live on Big 12 Now on ESPN+, and can also be heard on the BYU Radio App and locally on BYU Radio 107.9 FM.

WINS AT MIAMI & UTAH VALLEY. Third baseman Easton Jones has two home runs and 5 RBI in consecutive games as BYU left Miami with an 8-2 win on May 4 followed by a 4-2 defeat of Utah Valley on May 7.

BYU's Saturday win over Miami came on the strength of four different Cougars who recorded a home run. BYU was trailing 2-0 to start the sixth when Kuhio Aloy came to the plate and sparked a scoring spurt with a lead-off single. Aloy scored a few moments later on the first of four BYU bombs, this one courtesy Collin Reuter. With the game then tied 2-2, BYU seized momentum and didn't relent with six more runs to close the contest on an 8-0 run.

Jones drove in each of the Cougars' four runs in its crosstown win at Utah Valley on Tuesday. After two scoreless innings, Jones put BYU up 3-0 with a three-run homer that scored Ryker Schow and Luke Anderson. Jones tacked on another RBI with a triple in the top of the fifth that scored Schow and extended the BYU lead to 4-1. Stone Cushing earned his ninth save of the season on Tuesday with Cooper Vest and Reuter combining for a game-sealing double play in the bottom of the ninth.

SCOUTING THE BEARCATS. BYU and Cincinnati meet for the first time in baseball this week.

First-year head coach Jordan Bischel joined the Bearcats in 2023-24 after going 177-80 in five seasons at Central Michigan. Cincinnati went 24-33 (10-14) and finished fifth in the American Athletic Conference in 2023. Bischel has the Bearcats at fifth in the Big 12 standings with a 27-21 (13-11) season record. BYU and Cincinnati were tied for last in the league's preseason coaches poll.

The Bearcats arrive in Provo having won their last three-straight Big 12 series and seven of their last 12 games. Cincinnati has 2-1 series wins over West Virginia (4-5, 10-4, 8-2) on May 3-5, UCF (9-4, 2-5, 8-2) on April 26-28 and Houston (6-4, 5-4, 5-8) April 19-21.

Outfielder Josh Hegemann leads the Bearcats in hitting at .354 while utility player Kerrington Cross leads the team in runs (53) and infielder Josh Kross in RBI (56). Cincinnati pitcher Nathan Taylor is tied for the Big 12 lead with seven wins on the season and is one of five in the league to record a complete game in 2024.

### **SEASON HIGHLIGHTS | STATS**

- **NEWCOMER OF THE WEEK.** Designated hitter Kuhio Aloy picked up BYU's first weekly Big 12 baseball honor with the league's Newcomer of the Week award on May 6. Aloy totaled 10 hits on 17 at bats (.588), two RBI, two home runs and four runs scored, with multiple hits in each of the Cougars' four games a week ago. The Maui, Hawaii native leads BYU in batting at .301 with 24 runs scored on 50 hits, seven doubles, a triple, eight home runs and a team-leading 36.
- **COUGAR CLOSER.** With his ninth save of the season at Utah Valley, Stone Cushing moves into a tie for eighth nationally in the category. Cushing is now tied for third all-time at BYU in single-season saves with Mason Marshall (2012) and Ryan Hancock (1992). Nine also ties Cushing for fifth in career saves at BYU with Drew Zimmerman (2018-21). The junior from Salem, Utah registered his first-career win in a 5-4 defeat of Utah then found himself on the NCBWA's Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List with its April 24 release.
- SUPER SOPHOMORE. Third baseman Easton Jones continues to compile impressive offensive numbers. Jones co-leads BYU in average (.301), hits (53), total bases (107), home runs (14) and slugging percentage (.608). The sophomore from Lehi, Utah also has a team-high 17 multiple-hit games and is tied with Collin Reuter for the team-lead in multiple-RBI games with 10.

Ten of Jones' 14 homers on the season have come in Big 12 play, giving him the conference's second-leading spot in home runs versus Big 12 competition.

- BYU BACKSTOP. Catcher Collin Reuter has the team's longest reached base streak with 29 games and is tied with Jones for a team-high 10 multiple-RBI games. Defensively, Reuter ranks third in the Big 12 with 11 runners caught stealing.
- **YOUNG GUNS.** Seven of BYU's nine batters in the lineup are underclassmen, with Aloy, Ryker Schow and Crew McChesney true freshmen. Schow has come on strong over the last half of the season with 19 runs on 20 hits, two homers and eight RBI with at least one run scored in 10 of the last 14 games and six multi-hit games.
- **CONFERENCE LEADERS.** Several BYU players are among the top 15 in various Big 12 season statistical categories.

### **COUGAR COACHING STAFF**

**TRENT PRATT** was named BYU's head baseball coach on June 8, 2022. Prior to his appointment, Pratt served as the interim head coach of the Cougars for the final 25 games of the 2022 season, where he guided BYU to an overall record of 16-9 (.640) and was 10-6 (.626) in WCC games.

Pratt had been an integral part of the BYU baseball staff over the previous 10 years where he helped BYU claim WCC regular season championships in 2016, 2017 and 2019. As a player, Pratt played two years at Arizona State and two at Auburn, earning All-SEC honors as a senior catcher in 2002. He was drafted three times in MLB Draft, eventually going in the 12th round to the Philadelphia Phillies, where he played four seasons as part of their organization.

- ABE ALVAREZ was hired as the BYU pitching coach in July 2022. Prior to joining the BYU baseball staff, he spent the previous four seasons as an assistant coach at Nevada. Alvarez was an All-American at Long Beach State where he posted a 23–5 record with a 2.56 ERA over three seasons (2001-03). Following his junior season, Alvarez was drafted in the second round by the Boston Red Sox. He made the quickest trip from single-A ball to the big leagues in Boston history, making his MLB appearance in July 2004 and was the youngest member of the team to win a World Series ring in 2004. He spent six seasons with the Red Sox organization before retiring in 2009.
- ADAM LAW is a former Cougar infielder (2009-13) and returns to BYU after five years as the Los Angeles Dodgers' international operations and mental performance coach. Law is the son of former BYU head baseball coach Vance Law (2000–12) and former Cougar assistant coach Vern Law (1969-78). Vance played 12 seasons of Major League Baseball from 1980-91 and was an All-Star in 1988. Vern pitched for the Pittsburgh Pirates from 1950-1951, 1954–1967, with a stint in the military from 1951-54. A two-time All-Star, Vern led the Pirates to the 1960 World Series title and was awarded the Cy Young Award.
- TYLER COOLBAUGH came to Provo following two years as the University of Arizona director of player development as well as two seasons on staff with the Texas Rangers and Abilene Christian. He played three years as an infielder with the Orioles organization before retiring in 2019. His father, Scott Coolbaugh, played third base for the Texas Rangers, San Diego Padres and St. Louis Cardinals (1989-94). He is currently the assistant hitting coach for Padres
