Kill Shot

BYU allowed its first 10-0 run this season in the first half when Bryce Hopkins went 1-of-2 from the free throw line to cap off a 10-0 run after BYU had pulled within four.

Owning the Offensive Glass

BYU held a 21-2 advantage on the offensive glass not allowing a Friar offensive rebound until the final two minutes of the contest. The Cougars also had 18 second chance points to Providence's two.

Skewed Scoresheet

BYU had 27 more shot attempts than Providence and lost by 19. The Cougars shot a season-low 33.3 percent from the field and 28.0 percent from 3-point range.

PLAYER NOTES

Knell'd It

Trevin Knell went 3-of-4 from 3-point range marking the 26th time in his career he had connected on three or more 3-pointers which are the eighth-most in program history.

Dawson Baker, Shot Maker

Dawson Baker led the Cougars in scoring for the first time in his career as the redshirt junior finished with 16 points going 7-of-11 from the field and 2-of-3 from three. He has now scored in double figures three times this season and 59 times during his career including four in a Cougar uniform.

14 of his team-high 16 points came in the second half, the second-most he has scored during his BYU career.

First Time for Everything

For the first time in his career, Keba Keita's team lost when he had 10 or more rebounds. He tied a career-high with seven offensive rebounds en route to 10 rebounds, the fourth-time he has had double-digit rebounds this season.

Moving Up The Record Book

With his eight points on Tuesday, Fousseyni Traore moved up to 42nd on the all-time scoring list passing Chase Fischer (2014-16). The senior has now scored 1,127 points in his 100 career appearances.
