BYU Game Notes

In the Rankings

The Cougars dropped one spot to No. 7 in Week 4 of the 2025 AVCA National Collegiate MVB Poll. Overall, BYU has been ranked in the top-10 since February 6, 2023 for a total of 34 consecutive weeks in a row.

Cougars vs. Eagles

The Cougars will face the Eagles for their first conference matchup of the 2025 season. CUI has only defeated BYU twice in men's volleyball history, with CUI's last win occurring in Irvine in a five-match set in 2019. The first year the two teams appeared in a match was 2017. BYU is currently on a 11-game winning streak against CUI.

Latest Action from the Cougs

BYU swept No. 15 UC Santa Barbara in back-to-back matches in the Smith Fieldhouse, bouncing back after a four-game losing streak. Keoni Thiim led all players in kills with 18 over the weekend, including two aces.

Teon Taylor led BYU's defensive efforts with 12 blocks, earning himself the title of MPSF Defensive Player of the Week after a season-high 11 blocks in Saturday's matchup. This was the third POW honor for the Cougars in 2025. Overall, it's Taylor's sixth career honor.

New Lineup

Last weekend, the Cougars debuted a new starting lineup, including Luke Benson on the right side and Tyler Herget as the setter. This season, BYU has had seven different starting lineups.

Teon Taylor in the Record Books

Junior Teon Taylor currently has 33 solo blocks throughout his career, recently putting himself at No. 5 all-time in the BYU MVB rally scoring era for career solo blocks. The fourth-most is set by Michael Burke (2003-05) with 42 career solo blocks.

From Honolulu to Provo: Keoni Thiim

Senior opposite Keoni Thiim joins BYU's roster this season, after transferring from Hawaii with one year of eligibility under his belt. Thiim leads the NCAA in kills with 178, averaging 3.79 kills per set. He has the fifth-most aces in the NCAA with 23. Thiim played for Hawaii from 2022-2024, totaling 189 kills, 144 digs, 71 aces and 35 total blocks. In the 2024 season, Thiim appeared in all 30 of Hawaii's matches, with 14 starts at outside hitter. From 2022-2023, Thiim appeared in 57 matches for the Rainbow Warriors primarily as a serving specialist.

BYU Game Notes continued

Senior Impact

This season, BYU has five seniors: Luke Benson, Noa Haine, Teon Taylor, Miks Ramanis and Keoni Thiim. This year's seniors accounted for 54.6% of all kills for BYU during the 2024 season, excluding transfer Keoni Thiim. In 2024, Benson was named to the All-MPSF First Team, Ramanis was named to the All-MPSF Second Team and Taylor received an Honorable Mention.

Slated Schedule for the Cougars

"I really believe this is one of the tougher schedules in men's volleyball," said BYU head coach Shawn Olmstead. "It's not a walk in the park. I think our [2025] schedule is going to be tougher than most. It's important that I put our guys in a position where we as a team are playing our best volleyball at the end of the season. I want to be tested on the road. I like it. We put ourselves in a position to see what we are made of."

BYU has appeared in 10 top-15 matchups this season, including six top-10 matchups. BYU's only losses this season have been against top-5 ranked teams, with two losses against No. 2 UC Irvine and two against No. 4 Hawaii.

BYU under Head Coach Shawn Olmstead

Since becoming the BYU men's volleyball head coach in 2016, Shawn Olmstead has coached the Cougars to four 20-win seasons and three MPSF Tournament Championships, with the most recent title occurring in 2021 where the Cougars reached the NCAA National Championship match. He is one win away from 175 career wins.

Preseason Competition

In the fall, the Cougars competed in a scrimmage against UC Irvine on Nov. 16, 2024 and fell to the Anteaters 3-1 in St. George, Utah. The teams competed at Snow Canyon HS in front of a packed crowd.

Brazil Representation

This season, the Cougars have three people from Brazil on their staff: Assistant Coach Otavio Souza, junior libero Bernardo Adam and junior outside hitter Lucas Torres. BYU has recruited many players from Brazil, such as All-Americans Felipe de Brito Ferreira (2018-21), Fernando Pessoa (2001-04) and Carlos Moreno (2002-04). Junior libero Jackson Fife also has a connection to Brazil, serving a church mission there in São Paulo in 2019.

2024 Season Recap

The Cougars finished with a 16-9 overall record, concluding their season at 7th in the country in the AVCA coaches poll and 3rd in the MPSF.

Miks Ramanis and Luke Benson were named AVCA Honorable Mention All-Americans. It was Benson's first recognition and Ramanis' second.

In total, four Cougars brought home All-MPSF honors. Luke Benson was named to the All-MPSF First Team, Miks Ramanis was on the All-MPSF Second Team, Kupo-no Browne was on the All-MPSF Second Team and Teon Taylor was given an Honorable Mention.

The team finished with 1,197 kills, totaling 1,128 assists, 798 digs, 137 aces and 199 blocks.

The Cougars outthit their opponents, with a .300 hitting percentage compared to a combined .265 clip.

The Smith Fieldhouse drew in a season-high of 5,024 fans against the no. 1 seeded UCLA on 2/24/24. BYU men's volleyball averaged the second-highest attendance in the nation, with an average attendance of 3,606 fans in the Smith Fieldhouse per game.

All of BYU's five losses at home were against teams that reached the 2024 NCAA Tournament: two against the then ranked No. 7 UC Irvine (who reached the semifinals of the 2024 NCAA Tournament), two against No. 2 GCU (MPSF Champions and also reached the semifinals of the 2024 NCAA Tournament), and one loss against the then ranked No. 4 UCLA (2024 National Champs)

BYU defeated No. 1 UCLA in five sets at home on Friday, February 23, the only team to defeat the Bruins during regular-season conference play. UCLA was 11-1 in conference play, falling only to BYU

BYU's 18-game home win streak was snapped after a 3-1 loss to No. 7 UC Irvine on Friday night at the Smith Fieldhouse. The 18-game win streak, spanning from January 6, 2023 to January 25, 2024, is the second-most consecutive wins in the Smith Fieldhouse in the BYU men's volleyball rally scoring era

Luke Benson was named AVCA National Player of the Week on March 26, 2024. Luke Benson was also named MPSF Offensive Player of the Week twice: January 8 and March 25. It was the first time a Cougar was named NPOW in over three years, with the last title given to four-time All-American Gabi G. Fernandez on Feb. 9, 2021 when BYU was ranked No. 1 in the country.

SHAWN OLMSTEAD

Shawn Olmstead has been the head coach of the BYU Men's Volleyball program since 2015, with the 2016 season being his first. Olmstead has advanced BYU to the national championship match of the NCAA Tournament three times so far in his coaching career: 2016, 2017 and 2021. He also helped BYU to three-straight NCAA Final Four appearances for the first time in program history from 2016-2018. Olmstead led BYU to three MPSF regular-season titles in his first three seasons as head coach from 2016-2018 as well. Along with this, he guided BYU to three MPSF Tournament championships in 2016, 2018 and 2021. He is a four-time MPSF Coach of the Year (2016, 2018, 2020, 2021). Nine athletes that he has coached are All-Americans, with a total of 19 AVCA All-America honors. At the end of the 2020 season, his winning percentage of .784 (105-29) was the highest of any active men's volleyball coach in the NCAA Division I-II. Olmstead coached BYU to a winning record for six years in-a-row (2016-2021) at the helm of the program. For the first time since 1996 in BYU Men's Volleyball history, the Cougars finished with a losing record last season in 2022. When asked about the 2022 season, Olmstead said, "I was proud of our team and the way they stayed the course throughout the entire season. It was a difficult season no doubt as it relates to overall wins and losses. Despite this, the team never hung their heads and never shied away from the task at hand. I'm proud of them for that. The amount of gratitude we have as a coaching staff for them and their heart, can't be put into words." Two seasons prior, Olmstead and the Cougars got their magical 2020 season devastatingly cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic. During that time, Olmstead guided BYU to a 17-1 (6-0 MPSF) record and No. 1 national ranking. He also coached the AVCA National Player in 2020 as well, Gabi Garcia Fernandez. Throughout Olmstead's career, he's coached six AVCA First Team All-Americans, namely Gabi Garcia Fernandez (2021, 20), Davide Gardini (2020, 21, 22), Wil Stanley (2020), Brenden Sander (2018, 16), Ben Patch (2016) and Jake Langlois (2017). In his first year with the men's volleyball team, Olmstead coached the squad to the national championship match of the 2016 NCAA Tournament. He led his team to an outright MPSF regular-season and tournament title while being named the 2016 MPSF Coach of the Year. The Cougars finished with a 27-4 (19-3) record in 2016.

BYU Women's Volleyball Era

Olmstead saw his most successful season as head coach of the BYU women's volleyball team in 2014. He coached BYU to the national championship match of the NCAA tournament for its first time in program history. The Cougars became the first unseeded team in tournament history to make it to the final match. To get there, BYU upset No. 11 Arizona, No. 6 Florida State, No. 14 Nebraska and No. 2 Texas. The Cougars also won an outright West Coast Conference title after Olmstead led his squad to a 16-2 league record. Olmstead coached three All-Americans in 2014, including Jennifer Hamson, Alexa Gray and Amy Boswell. In 2012, Olmstead led the Cougars to their first conference title since 2005 and best season record (28-4) since 1998. Olmstead and the Cougars hosted the first two rounds of the 2012 NCAA tournament before losing in the round of 16 to No. 5 seeded Oregon, who went on to play in the natty against Texas. In 2011, Olmstead's first year as head coach and BYU's first year in the WCC, he led the team to a 21-9 record, its first season with 20 or more wins since 2007.

Assistant Coach Devin Young

Former Cougar Devin Young joined the BYU men's volleyball team as an assistant coach ahead of the 2019 season. Young played middle blocker for the Cougars from 2008, 2011-14.

As a player, Young helped the Cougars win the 2013 and 2014 Mountain Pacific Sports Federation regular-season and tournament titles. BYU played in the NCAA tournament both years and advanced to the national championship match in 2013.

Young was named to the All-MPSF Second Team as a senior and made the MPSF All-Tournament Team in both 2013 and 2014. During his career, he averaged 1.38 kills per set as well as 1.09 blocks per set.

After graduating from BYU with a degree in business management, Young moved to Wisconsin where he stayed close to volleyball by coaching high school and club teams. In 2017, he returned to Utah to work for VolleyMetrics, a volleyball analytics company, where he worked with Division I volleyball coaches from across the country.

Young served a mission in Long Beach, California, after redshirting during the 2008 season. He hails from McMurray, Pennsylvania, and is married to Marie. The couple have three children.



Assistant Coach Otavio Souza

Souza came to BYU with three years of experience as the assistant coach for Cal's women's volleyball team, as well as two-year stints at both Saint Mary's College and Missouri Western State. Before that, he also coached at Georgetown. In Souza's first year at SMC in 2018, the Gaels finished the regular season 19-9, their best winning percentage since going 20-8 in 2010. The Gaels also went 2-0 against Pac-12 programs that season and punched their first ticket to the NCAA Tournament since 2012.

Souza wore a BYU jersey from 2009-2011, starting in 22 matches during his senior year, while collecting 119 kills, 94 blocks, 35 digs, 16 assists and seven service aces, with a .431 hitting percentage.

"Playing volleyball in the Smith Fieldhouse in front of thousands of fans at BYU is where I created great memories as a student-athlete," Souza said. "Our program has been competitive for many years. Coming back now as a coach is something really special for me to be a part of."

A Florianópolis, Brazil native, Souza went on to play professionally for Itajai Pro-Volei and Florianopolis Voleibol in Brazil, along with the Florida Wave.

Souza debuted as an assistant coach on January 6th, 2023 for Brigham Young University.
