The series is the first of eight conference sets the teams will play through May 4. The Big 12 Tournament will begin on May 7 at OGE Field at Devon Park in Oklahoma City.

record and winners in eight of their last nine games. The Sun Devils are 15-5 at Farrington Stadium entering the BYU series.

ASU begins conference play second in the Big 12 and 30th in the NCAA with a .334 batting average. They also rank 33rd in the country in slugging at .540 and 35th with a .413 on base percentage. The team scores 5.90 runs per game, and they have hit 26 home runs to place 22nd nationally.

ASU maintains a 3.06 ERA in the circle while ranking 36th in the NCAA with a 1.21 WHIP. Sun Devil pitchers average 7.05 strikeouts per seven innings which has them 27th in the country.

Looking Back

The Sun Devils completed the ASU Invitational with a 5-1 record, winning the first five games to reach eight straight wins overall. This run included a 9-inning comeback win over Seattle U and a run-rule defeat of Yale on Feb. 28.

ASU also won two games on March 1, defeating UTEP 11-4 and Utah State 4-1. They split two games against Oregon State, winning 9-2 on Feb. 27 before falling 6-3 on March 2.

About BYU

BYU will visit Tempe to begin Big 12 play with a 14-4 overall record and winners of five straight and seven of eight. The Cougars are 2-0 in road games, winning at UC San Diego and Sacramento State.

As a team, the Cougars are batting .302 with a .893 OPS and scoring 5.89 runs per game. Ilove'a Brittingham is leading the team with a .397 batting average, 23 hits, five home runs, and 22 RBIs. Lindy Milkowski and Hailey Morrow have added 17 hits apiece. Morrow has added four homers and 13 RBIs.

BYU has been strong in the circle with a Big 12-leading 1.82 ERA. They have a 1.12 WHIP and average 6.18 strikeouts per seven innings. Kaysen Korth is second in the nation with a 0.27 ERA and 17th with her 0.78 WHIP.

Strike First, Finish Strong

ASU has been jumping on teams early in games this season, outscoring the opposition 19-6 in the first inning. They are 6-1 when scoring in the first inning and 8-3 when scoring first overall. In a weird twist, the Sun Devils are also 3-0 when the

opponent scores in the first inning.

And while scoring in the first has been key, ASU has put teams away late. The Sun Devils have outscored their opponents 24-6 in the fifth and 16-6 in the sixth. That 40-12 advantage in the later innings has helped the team go 8-1 when leading after five and 10-0 when leading after six

Long Ball

ASU has used the long ball to its advantage, with 26 home runs on the year. The team ranks second in the Big 12 and 22nd nationally in total homers while hitting 1.24 home runs per game, ranking third in the Big 12 and 28th nationally.

The Sun Devils have homered in 15 games with multiple home runs in a game nine times. They have gone 12-3 in games they hit a homer and 8-1 when hitting multiple.

Youth Movement

One of the youngest teams in the country, ASU has had eight freshmen make at least one appearance so far this season. Those freshmen have combined to make 81 starts, accounting for 43 percent of all starts for the year.

The group has combined to hit 13 home runs – half of the team's total – and drive in 50 while also going 4-3 with 45 strikeouts in the circle.

Milestones in Reach

ASU will take the field on Thursday just six wins shy of 1,900 in the program's history. One of the most successful programs in the country, the team currently holds a record of 1,894-960-2 (.664).

Head Coach Megan Bartlett enters the series needing two wins to reach 200 for her career. Now in her eighth season as a collegiate head coach and third at ASU, Bartlett has a career record of 198-171 (.537).

Hall Pass

Kelsey Hall opened the season in the starting lineup just 277 days after tearing her ACL. Having started all 21 games, Hall leads the team with a .443 batting average, 27 hits, five home runs, and 20 RBIs. She has recorded a hit in 17 games and is on a career-long tying 10-game hitting streak.

This is her sixth season of collegiate softball, Hall is 15th among active players with 136 runs scored, 20th with 303217 total bases, 24th with 132 RBIs and 25th with 35 home runs.

Tanya Time

Tanya Windle has taken over as the starter in center field and is second on the team lead with 26 hits while batting .371. She enters Big 12 play on a six-game hitting streak during which she is 11-for-19 with five multi-hit games. She also has an RBI in five straight contests.

Windle ranks 15th among active NCAA players with 10 triples in her career. Her .398 career batting average is seventh among active players with at least 350 career at-bats.

Brown is Back

After sitting out last season with an injury, Kenzie Brown has been solid in her return to the circle. The senior struck out the first five batters she faced this season and now has 70 strikeouts in 43innings pitched.

Brown went 3-0 with 29 strikeouts during the ASU Invitational, and she became the first Sun Devil since 2020 to post double-digit strikeouts in a game multiple times in the same season. She is 17th in the NCAA in total strikeouts and fifth by averaging 11.4 strikeouts per seven innings. Brown is fourth in the Big 12 with her 0.98 ERA and third with a 0.79 WHIP.

Around the Horn

Tiare Ho-Ching is batting .344 with 22 hits and 15 RBIs while settling in as the team's leadoff hitter. The freshman has the only 4-hit game of the season by a Sun Devil while adding five multi-RBI games.

Samantha Swan has started every game behind the plate and is third on the team with her .356 batting average. She has six multi-hit games and tallied an RBI in four of the six games last week.

AJ Murphy returned to the lineup at GCU after missing the prior six games with an injury. Murphy is batting .316 with three home runs and 11 RBIs. She enters the weekend with five hits in the last three games.

Lillian Holtje has taken over at first base and is tied for the team lead with five home runs in just 39 atbats.

Meika Lauppe leads the team with 10 starts in the circle and 43.1 innings pitched. She has posted a 4-2 record with a 2.26 ERA.

Looking Ahead

ASU takes its first road trip of the season next week with five games in Florida. After a midweek doubleheader at Stetson on March 12, the Sun Devils will play a three-game Big 12 series at UCF on March 14-16.





ALBERTA B. FARRINGTON SOFTBALL STADIUM



Arizona State University will celebrate the 25th anniversary of Alberta B. Farrington Softball Stadium this season, which was unveiled in 2000 as the home of Sun Devil Softball. During its time as one of the premier softball facilities in the country, Farrington Stadium has welcomed over 800,000 spectators to witness ASU

win nearly 700 games, hosting 11 Regionals and nine Super Regionals. Those large crowds have created an amazing home environment known across the country as Club Farrington.

Farrington Stadium features individual seats in the lower section between the dugouts and chair-back bleachers in the upper sections, with a capacity for 1,535 fans. The new Lapan Sunshine Devil Deck will open in 2025 above the clubhouse down the third baseline, and a grass berm located just beyond the first base dugout provides an additional spectator area.

The stadium has several amenities that make it one of the premier softball stadiums in the country. Sunken dugouts are lighted for night games and have recessed, individual bat slots and locker room access. The playing surface and outfield grass were completely replaced during the offseason. In addition, there is a built-in concession stand, a team shop, restrooms and locker rooms for the visiting team and officials.

Upgrades to the Sun Devil clubhouse were completed last spring to give the team a modern locker room and team area. The redesigned space also added new coaches' offices, locker areas, and a new training room.

The Betsy and Kent Bro Softball Hitting Facility, located down the left field line, opened in 2020 and

provides the Sun Devils year-round access to batting cages and the latest technology.

After adding a press box and extending the outfield fences before the 2013 season, Farrington was again upgraded before the beginning of the 2014 season. Solar panels were added above the stands, providing shade to most in the upper deck seats. The facility has also received two major awards for design and excellence in architecture.

Megan Bartlett took over as head coach of the Arizona State softball program in the summer of 2022, becoming the eighth head coach in the program's

With the start of a new season, Bartlett has a 183-165 (.526) career record that includes a 42-57 mark in her two seasons leading the Sun Devils.

With Bartlett at the helm, ASU saw Yanni Acuña be named NFCA All-American, NFCA All-Region, All-Pac-12 Conference, CSC Academic All-American and CSC Academic All-District. Jordan VanHook was also named All-Region, and Kylee Magee was named to the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team.

Bartlett guided the Sun Devils through a roster overhaul to finish 2023 with a 22-26 overall record. That included a series win over Women's College World Series participant Washington and an eightgame winning streak early in the season.

Prior to taking the Sun Devils, Bartlett spent two seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Texas. That followed five seasons in Indiana as a head coach building the Ball State softball program.

As the head coach at Ball State for five seasons (2016-20), Bartlett led the program to a 141-108 overall record (.567) while registering three consecutive 30-win seasons from 2017-19. Over that stretch, she helped guide the Cardinals to the 2018 Mid-American Conference (MAC) West Division title with that season's 37 victories marking the fourth-most wins in a single season in program history.

Bartlett began her coaching career as a graduate assistant coach at Loyola University Chicago (2005-07), where she was part of the 2007 Horizon League Coaching Staff of the Year while helping her squad to the league's regular season title.

From there, she moved on to become an assistant coach at Northern Illinois (2007-12), working with infielders and outfielders while also serving as the recruiting coordinator, offensive coordinator and camp coordinator

After spending a single campaign at DePaul as a volunteer assistant coach for the 2014 Big East regular season and tournament champions (44-11), Bartlett moved on to become an assistant coach at Purdue (2014-15).

Bartlett was a four-year letter winner at Notre Dame (2002-05) under her maiden name Megan Ciolli, helping power the Irish to four NCAA Regional appearances, four Big East regular season championships and two Big East Tournament titles. A two-time NFCA All-American (2004, 2005), she captained the 2005 squad to a 46-15 mark while helping secure the program's first-ever NCAA Regional home contests.

The 2004 Big East Player of the Year, Bartlett completed her playing career at Notre Dame as the program's leader in hits (284) and stolen bases (76) while finishing in the top five in batting average (second .368) and runs scored (second – 161). She also finished ranked in the UND career top 10 in doubles (ninth - 37), triples (seventh - 9), HRs (ninth - 13) and RBIs (10th - 101).

Bartlett graduated from the University of Notre Dame with a bachelor's degree of business administration in managerial consulting in 2005. She completed her master's of business administration in healthcare administration at Loyola University Chicago in 2007 and went on to earn a juris doctor from Northern Illinois in 2012.

A licensed attorney in the state of Illinois, she is married to Mike Bartlett, a former professional hockey player, and they have two daughters, Vivian and Maren.
