- SEASON REVIEW. BYU is off to an 11-8 start in 2025 and is 1-2 in Big 12 play. The Cougars hosted UCF at Miller Park last weekend, winning game two 8-7 while dropping the bookend games of the three-game series 9-8 and 7-6. After splitting the opening series of the year at Fresno State (2-2), BYU won three-straight series, including two on the road at CSUN (2-1) and Gonzaga (3-0), before winning its first home series over Stetson (3-1). BYU now leaves Provo for its first Big 12 road seires of the season at Cincinnati. Game two of the series in the Queen City will mark Trent Pratt's 150th as BYU head coach.
- **CONFERENCE LEADERS.** As a team BYU is top five in the Big 12 in several statistical categories including, home runs (4th, 28), doubles (4th, 46) and total bases (5th, 335). Defensively the Cougars lead the conference in double plays (17).
- OFFENSIVE LEADERS: BYU first baseman Cooper Vest continues to lead the Cougars in several offensive categories and is among the top 10 in the Big 12 in total bases (2nd, 58), home runs (3rd, 7), doubles (T3rd, 8), runs scored (6th, 19), RBI (7th, 24) and slugging (10th, .725). The week two Big 12 Player of the Week also leads the Big 12 defensively in chances (180), putouts (167) and double plays (17). Vest is hitting .313 and leads BYU in nine offensive categories including at bats, runs, doubles, triples, home runs, RBI, total bases, slugging and hit by pitch.

BYU outfielder Bryker Hurdsman is leading BYU in batting average (.393) and stolen bases (6) and is second in slugging (.661), runs (18) and on base percentage (.485). Leadoff hitter Crew McChesney is top three on the team in several offensive categories including batting average (.354), hits (23), doubles (2), RBI (16), walks (12), on base percentage (.449) and stolen bases (4).

Luke Anderson is also top three in several categories for the Cougars including batting average (.346), at bats (78), hits (27), total bases (44), slugging (.564) and walks (10). Anderson has also played three different positions for the Cougars in 2025, manning left field, right field and second base while posting a perfect fielding percentage (1.000) with 31 put outs, three assists and one double play.

- **OUT OF THE PEN:** The Cougars top four relievers have combined for 40.1 innings and have surrendered 13 earned runs. Left hander Justis Reiser has eight appearances with 13.1 innings in relief and is holding opponents to a .167 average, while striking out 15 with one save and a win. Nolan Ficklin has logged eight innings in nine relief appearances, good for T3rd in the Big 12. The lefty also has seven strikeouts. Right hander Cayson Bell has logged 9.2 innings in four appearances with six strikeouts.
- CLOSE THE DOOR: BYU preseason first-team All-American closer Stone Cushing has one save and a win in eight appearances with six strikeouts in 7.2 innings. He currently has 11 career saves and is tied for fourth all-time at BYU with Jordan Muir (2006-09).

KNOW THE FOE: Cincinnati headman Jordan Bischel led the Bearcats to a fifth-place finish in their first season in the Big 12 in 2024 with a 32-25 (17-13) record. Despite posting three returners on the Preseason All-Big 12 Team and leading the league in returning production (62 percent), Cincinnati was picked to finish 10th in 2025.

Through 18 games, the Bearcats are 11-9 overall and 0-3 in Big 12 play after being swept by Arizona (3-8, 2-14, 1-11) in their conference-opening series. After starting the season with wins in two of three games at then-No. 11 Duke (8-3, 5-6, 19-5), Cincinnati fell to 3-5 in their next eight during a road trip at UNLV and UC San Diego. The Bearcats enter the BYU series having won six straight at home in non-conference matchups with Toledo, Canisius and Miami (OH).

Preseason All-Big 12 infielder Kerrington Cross leads Cincinnati with a season average of .381 along with 18 runs scored and 9 RBI. Outfielder Landyn Vidourek holds a team-high 20 RBI while batting .323 with four doubles and six home runs. Vidourek also leads the Big 12 in stolen bases with 16. As a team, the Bearcats share the Big 12 lead and rank 19th nationally with 48 stolen bases on 54 attempts.

Cincinnati's pitching staff boasts preseason all-conference starter Nathan Taylor and his 1.50 ERA. Taylor is 2-0 on the season with 35 strikeouts and 24 innings pitched in four appearances.

BYU/CINCINNATI SERIES HISTORY

The Cougars and Bearcats had never met in baseball until a season ago when the two Big 12 new-comers matched up in Provo on May 9-11, 2024. Cincinnati took a 3-0 lead in the young series as it swept BYU (9-5, 4-2, 12-5). Despite the string of losses for the Cougars, a true freshman centerfielder-Crew McChesney made an early impression in his BYU career with starts in each of the three games. McChesney batted .600 for the series with three doubles, two runs, an RBI and three walks while slugging .900 and posting an on-base percentage of .692 to just one strikeout.

COUGAR COACHING STAFF

TRENT PRATT was named BYU's head baseball coach on June 8, 2022. Prior to his appointment, Pratt served as the interim head coach of the Cougars for the final 25 games of the 2022 season, where he guided BYU to an overall record of 16-9 (.640) and was 10-6 (.626) in WCC games.

Pratt had been an integral part of the BYU baseball staff over the previous 10 years where he helped BYU claim WCC regular season championships in 2016, 2017 and 2019. As a player, Pratt played two years at Arizona State and two at Auburn, earning All-SEC honors as a senior catcher in 2002. He was drafted three times in MLB Draft, eventually going in the 12th round to the Philadelphia Phillies, where he played four seasons as part of their organization.

- ABE ALVAREZ was hired as the BYU pitching coach in July 2022. Prior to joining the BYU baseball staff, he spent the previous four seasons as an assistant coach at Nevada. Alvarez was an All-American at Long Beach State where he posted a 23–5 record with a 2.56 ERA over three seasons (2001-03). Following his junior season, Alvarez was drafted in the second round by the Boston Red Sox. He made the quickest trip from single-A ball to the big leagues in Boston history, making his MLB appearance in July 2004 and was the youngest member of the team to win a World Series ring in 2004. He spent six seasons with the Red Sox organization before retiring in 2009.
- ADAM LAW is a former Cougar infielder (2009-13) and returns to BYU after five years as the Los Angeles Dodgers' international operations and mental performance coach. Law is the son of former BYU head baseball coach Vance Law (2000–12) and former Cougar assistant coach Vern Law (1969-78). Vance played 12 seasons of Major League Baseball from 1980-91 and was an All-Star in 1988. Vern pitched for the Pittsburgh Pirates from 1950-1951, 1954–1967, with a stint in the military from 1951-54. A two-time All-Star, Vern led the Pirates to the 1960 World Series title and was awarded the Cy Young Award.
- BRYCEN CAMPBELL arrived in Provo in January 2025 and will serve as the Cougars' hitting coacn and recruiting coordinator. Campbell comes to BYU from UC San Diego where he was an assistant in 2024 following two seasons as Director of Operations at Washington State (2022-23). Campbell's first coaching experience came at Point Loma Nazarene (2020-21) and Riverside City College (2018-19) along with a student assistant role at New Mexico State (2016-17) where he starred as an outfielder in 2015 following two seasons at Eastern Arizona Junior College.
