COUGAR NOTABLES

• No. 18 BYU women's volleyball will host a tournament for the second-straight weekend, welcoming Northern Colorado, Wichita State and Incarnate Word to the Smith Fieldhouse for the BYU Nike Invitational.

• The Cougars (3-0, 0-0 Big 12) moved up a spot to No. 18 in this week's AVCA poll after winning their doTERRA Classic last weekend, dropping just one set with wins against FDU, Central Michigan and High Point.

• BYU hit .288 as a team while holding its opponents to a .091 clip, out-blocking them 28-20 and recording 19 more aces than them, at 28-nine. Outside hitters Claire Little Chambers and Suli Davis led the way with 38 kills apiece, hitting .419 and .305, respectively. Opposite hitter Sophia Callahan had 21 kills on a .311 clip, while middle blocker Brielle Kemavor had 18, hitting .387.

• Setter Alex Bower tallied 106 assists on the weekend, finishing with a 35 assist-12 dig double-double against High Point on Saturday. The Nampa, Idaho native had 11 double-doubles last season. Bower totaled 25 digs across the trio of matches, while libero Emma Barbero had 23.

• Kemavor paced the Cougars at the net with 14 blocks. Fellow middle Mia Lee added 13, with Bower also contributing nine. Callahan and Little Chambers both downed seven aces. Libero Hannah Billeter, Bower, Barbero and Lee each posted three.

• After opening weekend, BYU ranks in the top 15 nationally in three statistical categories: aces per set (No. 9, 2.80), total service aces (No. 12, 28) and opponent hitting percentage (No. 12, .087).

• Individually, Bower's 10.6 assists per set rank 31st in the country, with Callahan and Little Chambers aces at 46th and aces per set at 47th. Kemavor averaged 1.5 blocks per set, which ranks 49th.

• Concluding a six-match homestand to open the season, the Cougars will meet Northern Colorado and Incarnate Word for the first time and Wichita State for the first time since 2019.

• The Cougars will head to Los Angeles next week for the LMU Invitational. BYU will face No. 22 USC, former WCC-foe LMU and Western Michigan at the tournament.

STORYLINES

HOME SWEET HOME

BYU opened the season 3-0 at home last week. The Cougars were 12-4 (.750) at home last season and are 28-6 (.824) in the Smith Fieldhouse since becoming members of the Big 12 Conference. BYU head coach Heather Olmstead is 141-13 (.916) in Provo during her tenure. Through three matches, the Cougars rank No. 7 nationally in cumulative attendance (8,472) and No. 12 in average attendance (2,824).

FRESH FACES

The Cougars faced FDU and Central Michigan last week, both teams that head coach Heather Olmstead had yet to face previously in her 10-year tenure. This week, the BYU will meet Northern Colorado and Incarnate Word both for the first time in series history and with Olmstead at the helm. The Cougars are facing five teams that Olmstead has yet to coach against this season, all in the first three weeks of the year.

FIRST SET FEVER

Dating back to the beginning of last season, BYU has won the opening set in 20 of its last 22 wins. The Cougars' two victories when dropping the first set came in a four-set win against High Point and a five-set match against Utah State. BYU was 17-4 when winning the first set in 2024, and is 3-0 when doing so in 2025.

KEEPING CONSTANT

BYU trotted out nine different lineups last season. 12 different Cougars started at least one match, with six different newcomers making their first BYU starts. The Cougars used a primary lineup in just under half (14 of 29) of their games last year, including in 11 of the final 15 games, but opted for a different lineup in the last three, one that was used just five times in 2024. BYU kept its lineup the same for both matches on Friday last week before making one change on Saturday evening.

LIVING ON LITTLE

Outside hitter Claire Little Chambers led the way offensively last season, finishing with double-digit kills in 24 of BYU's 29 matches, hitting .250 or better in 16 of those matches. Little finished tied for the team-lead last week with 38 kills, hitting a team-high .419 on the week. The Temecula, California product posted double-digit kills twice during the doTERRA Classic and hit .353 or better in each of the three matches.

DAZZLING DAVIS

Fellow outside Suli Davis made her freshman debut last week, tying Little Chambers with 38 kills on a .305 clip. She finished with match highs twice on opening day, starting with 13 kills (hitting .478) against FDU and following that up with 19 (hitting .395) against Central Michigan. The Eules, Texas and Hau'ula, Hawai'i native's 19 kills are the most by a BYU freshman since McKenna Miller's 20 against Gonzaga on Nov. 10, 2016.

B.K., HAVE IT YOUR WAY

Middle blocker Brielle Kemavor was a force to be reckoned with last year, leading the Cougars in blocks in 20 matches in 2024. She led BYU in blocks last week, tallying 14 for a 1.4 block per set average and 18 kills on a .387 clip. The Bristow, Virginia product became BYU's seventh middle blocker to record a double-double in the rally-scoring era at BYU last season and tied Rachel Dyer (2007) for the most double-doubles (3) in the same season and career by a Cougar middle in the rally scoring era at BYU.

FRESH THREADS

The Cougars unveiled seven new jerseys prior to the 2023 season, including sleeveless tops and royal bottoms for the first time in recent history. BYU's 2025 record in each jersey was as follows:

A LOOK AT NORTHERN COLORADO (2-1, 0-0 BIG SKY)

- The Bears split their opening weekend matches, beating Washington in five sets before being swept by Colgate.
- UNC beat Colorado State, also in five sets, on Tuesday night.
- Head coach Lyndsey Dates is in her 21st season in Greeley. She is 377-235 (.616) since 2005.
- This is the first matchup all-time between the two teams.

A LOOK AT WICHITA STATE (1-1, 0-0 AAC)

- The Shockers were swept by Kennesaw State to open the year before beating Arkansas in five sets.
- WSU will play Incarnate Word on Friday morning before its Friday night meeting with BYU.
- Chris Lamb is in his 26th season as head coach at Wichita State. He is 527-251 (.677) since 2000.
- BYU leads the all-time series between the two teams, 3-1. They are 1-1 against the Shockers in Provo, and have won the last three matches nine sets to three.

A LOOK AT INCARNATE WORD (2-1, 0-0 SOUTHLAND)

- The Cardinals lost to Oklahoma to open the season before picking up wins over Abilene Christian and Missouri State, 3-2 and 3-1.
- IUW plays Wichita State and Northern Colorado on Friday before facing BYU in the concluding match of the tournament.
- Head coach Gabryel Ordning is in year three in San Antonio. He is 34-28 (.548) since 2023.
- This is the first matchup all-time between the two teams.

A WINNING TRADITION

BYU COACHING HISTORY
Three BYU coaches are found among the winningest in the history of NCAA women's volleyball. BYU is the only program with three coaches posting a winning percentage of .800 or higher.

Elaine Michaelis led the Cougars from 1969-2001, going 886-219-5 (.800). Shawn Olmstead, now the head coach of the BYU men's volleyball team, had a 103-25 (.805) record during his time.

Current head coach Heather Olmstead is 260-46. Her .850 win percentage is the second-highest by any active NCAA DI head coach.

NCAA WINNINGEST PROGRAMS
Heading into the 2025 season, the Cougars rank second on the NCAA's all-time wins list, with 1,420. Surpassing UCLA during the 2023 campaign, they sit behind Nebraska's 1,499 but ahead of Penn State's 1,414, UCLA's 1,411 and Texas' 1,390.

BYU has an all-time program win percentage of .784, which ranks sixth behind Penn State (.851), Nebraska (.844), Hawai'i (.839), Florida (.821) and Stanford (.814).

Over the last five seasons, the Cougars rank 11th in win percentage (.801), behind Texas, Louisville, Western Kentucky, Pittsburgh, Wisconsin, Creighton, Nebraska, Towson, Dayton and Florida Gulf Coast. BYU's 113 wins (113-28 record) since 2020 are tied for the 15-most with Wright State and Purdue.

In the last five years, the Cougars sit behind Pittsburgh, Western Kentucky, Louisville, Nebraska, Creighton, Wisconsin, Texas, Dayton, Stephen F. Austin, Florida Gulf Coast, Texas State, Oregon, Penn State and Kentucky for most wins.

AVCA POLLS
The Cougars rank among the top-10 of programs most ranked in the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) poll, sitting at ninth-most all-time.

BYU has been ranked in 492 of the organization's 646 total polls, seeing its name in 76% of all AVCA rankings since 1982.

Entering her 11th season, Heather Olmstead's squads have been ranked in the Top 25 for all but two weeks since taking over the program in 2015.

Dating back to October 7, 2013, BYU had been ranked in the AVCA Top 25 for 180-consecutive polls before it dropped out of the polls in week 14 of last season.

POSTSEASON REGULARS
BYU has appeared in 37 of 44 NCAA postseasons since the tournament began in 1981, including each of the last 13 seasons since 2012.

In the last 13 seasons, BYU has finished in the top half of its conference, posted a .655 winning percentage or better, played in the NCAA Tournament (including advancing to the Sweet 16 or further nine times) and been ranked inside the Top 25 during the year.

OLMSTEAD AT A GLANCE

Olmstead has guided the Cougars to annual national contenders in her 10 seasons at the helm.

The 2018 AVCA National Coach of the Year, Olmstead and her staff's development of players has led to 14 different All-Americans, 19 different All-Region honorees, five different All-Big 12 honorees and 22 different All-WCC honorees in addition to a national player of the year candidate, the 2018 AVCA National Freshman of the Year, and multiple West Coast Conference awardees.

Olmstead led the 2018 team to one of the greatest seasons in program history, ranking No. 1 for 11-consecutive weeks as they won their first 27 matches, including against then-No. 1 Stanford. BYU was awarded its highest-ever NCAA Tournament seed at No. 4, then reeled off wins against Stony Brook, Utah, Florida and Texas in front of standing-room-only crowds at the Smith Fieldhouse to advance to the Final Four before falling to eventual champion Stanford in the national semifinal.

BYU's 31-2 (.939) record in 2021 led to the highest win percentage in program history and a No. 4 final national ranking. Other program records included six All-Americans, six All-Region citations, five All-WCC honorees, three Academic All-District awardees and one Academic All-American in addition to national coach and freshman of the year awards and sweeps of the region and conference awards. The Cougars finished the season ranked No. 1 in defensive hitting percentage and No. 3 in hitting percentage after ranking first most of the season.

Olmstead led BYU to Sweet 16 appearances six times as well as six WCC titles. The Cougars have won at least 19 matches each year (17 during COVID-19) during her time as head coach. Olmstead has also contributed internationally, including serving as head coach of the U.S. Women's U21 National Team that won gold at both the 2025 NORCECA Pan American Cup and the 2024 NORCECA Women's Continental Championship, the U.S. Collegiate National Team in Japan in May 2019 and as the assistant coach on the U.S. team that won gold at the 2015 Pan American Games.

The Carpinteria, California, native was named head coach in June 2015 after serving four years as an assistant coach at BYU from 2011-14. After reaching the Sweet 16 in 2012 and 2013, Olmstead helped the Cougars reach the 2014 national championship match as an unseeded team, the highest finish in program history. She was an assistant coach for eight seasons before coming to BYU, first at Utah State from 2003-05 and then Utah from 2006-10.

As a player, Olmstead was a libero for four seasons at Utah State from 1998-01, helping the Aggies finish in the Top 25 and reach the NCAA Tournament each of her last two seasons while setting the school's single season digs record her senior year. She then played professionally for two seasons before returning to USU as an assistant coach. Olmstead has a bachelor's degree from Utah State in family and consumer science.
