TEAM NOTES

4-0

- > BYU has started 4-0 for the second consecutive year, just the second time in program history for back-to-back 4-0 starts. Kalani Sitake has both of them (2024, 2025 and 2020 and 2021)
- > BYU now has 12 4-0 starts in school history

COMPETING AS A RANKED TEAM

- > BYU moves to 30-9 when competing as a ranked team in the Associated Press Top 25

ADJUSTMENTS

- > After giving up 16 plays for 138 yards (8.7 yards per play) and 14 points in the first quarter, BYU's defense allowed 17 plays for 50 yards (2.9 yards per play) and 0 points in the second quarter.
- > The Cougars also allowed just 19 total yards in the fourth quarter.

CONSECUTIVE QUARTERS

- > BYU scored in every quarter, making it 27 consecutive quarters dating back to last season with a score—a new program record.

YARDAGE/TURNOVER MARGIN

- > BYU outgained its opponent again (387 to 291) to move to 4-0 this season when outgaining its opponent.
- > The Cougars were +1 in the turnover margin for the game, moving to +6 this season at 7-1. BYU's only turnover this season has come on a fumbled punt return, with the offense yet to turn the ball over.

PLAYER NOTES

QB BEAR BACHMEIER

- > Bachmeier finished the game 19 of 27 for 179 yards and 2 touchdowns.
- > He also ran for a career-high 98 yards on 15 carries.
- > Bachmeier is the only BYU QB to have 10 total TDs and 0 turnovers through the first 4 games of a season

LB JACK KELLY

- > Kelly led the team with 6 total tackles, 2 TFL, 1 sack and a QB hurry

WR PARKER KINGSTON

- > Kingston was one off a career-high with 5 receptions and had 38 yards. He also had 2 rushes for 25 yards.
- > He added a 12-yard punt return and threw two passes

K WILL FERRIN

- > Ferrin made 3 PATs tonight to set a new school record with 88 consecutive made PATs (86 Jake Oldroyd).
- > Ferrin extended his school record to 25 consecutive made FGs with a 28-yarder but later missed a 55-yard attempt to end the streak.

WR CODY HAGEN

- > Hagen had a 32-yard rushing TD, his second of the year after a 57-yard rushing score against Portland State.

WR CHASE ROBERTS

- > Roberts had 5 receptions for 49 yards and 2 TDs—the first time he has had 2 receiving TDs in a game.
- > He also passed the 2,000 career receiving yards mark (2,018), becoming the 15th BYU receiver with 2,000.
