STARTING FIVE

- 1) The Wildcats' **20-0 start** to the season is its best since starting 21-0 in 2013-14. Arizona is one of three undefeated teams in the country (as of Jan. 25), and the third team in Big 12 history to start 20-0.
- 2) The 20 consecutive wins mark just the third time in program history - since 1904-05 - that Arizona has won 20 straight games. The school record is 22 from 1914-17.
- 3) Under head coach Tommy Lloyd, Arizona is **26-13** against Top 25 opponents. The .667 winning percentage is second in the country since 2021-22 (UConn - .674).
- 4) Over the last three games, **Motiejus Krivas** is averaging 15.0 points, 11.0 rebounds and shooting 69.6% from the floor (2-2 3FG) and 84% at the free throw line.
- 5) Arizona's 32 **road wins** since the start of the 2021-22 season are third-most in the country among major conference teams. (Duke - 36, UConn - 33).

SERIES HISTORY VS. BYU

- Arizona leads the all-time series, 21-20, after the teams split two meetings last season.
- The Wildcats are 5-14 in Provo, but have won the last two meetings (1998, 2025).

TEAM NOTES

- Arizona is 8-0 in Quad 1 games this season, tied with Duke for the most Q1 wins in the country.
- In Big 12 play, UA leads the league in FG% (.508), FG% defense (.391), 3FG% defense (.286), and assist/turnover ratio (2.03).
- As a team, the Wildcats rank among the **nation's best** in rebound margin (2nd), scoring margin (5th), FG pct. (7th), fastbreak points (10th).
- The Wildcats have **MADE 391 FT** this season. Opponents have **ATTEMPTED 343 FT**.
- Arizona has shot 50% or better from the floor in **23 of 40** halves and 12 of 20 games this year.
- Arizona is **2nd in the country** in points in the paint/game (45.9) via CBBAAnalytics
- When it comes to "Kill Shots" - a run of 10-0 or greater, Arizona has 24 and has allowed just one (via EvanMiya)
- Assuming Arizona stays at No. 1 in the AP Poll that's released Jan. 26, it will mark the seventh straight poll

PLAYER NOTES

- Only once this season has the same player led Arizona in scoring in back-to-back games.
- Seven different players have scored 20 or more points in a game this season.
- **Brayden Burries** leads Arizona with six 20-point games this season after a 22-point effort against WVU. He also had 7 assists and 0 turnovers in the game; he is shooting 59% on 2-point FG this season.
- **Koa Peat** leads UA in scoring in Big 12 games (15.7ppg) and has four double-doubles this season. He had 17 points, seven rebounds, two blocks against WVU on Saturday.
- **Tobe Awaka** leads the country in offensive rebounds/40 minutes (7.8). He scored a career-high 25 points against Arizona State on Jan. 14 and is nearly averaging a double-double in Big 12 play -- 11.4p, 9.1r.
- **Jaden Bradley** is 9 of 13 from the floor (69%) in clutch time this season, according to CBBAAnalytics;
- **Ivan Kharchenkov** is second on the team with 33 steals this season; he's averaging 10ppg in Big 12 play.
- Junior **Motiejus Krivas** has 35 blocks this season; he leads Arizona in fouls drawn with 75.

NOTING THE WILDCATS (CONT.)

- eighth straight week - at the top. The Wildcats a unanimous No. 1 team for the first time ever on Jan. 19.

• With a 72-6 record at home under Tommy Lloyd, tied for third-most home wins in the country over that span.

• The seven straight weeks at No. 1 in the AP poll is the longest streak for UA since 2013-14 season (8 weeks).

• Arizona is ranked No. 1 in the Associated Press poll this week, the eighth straight week holding down the top spot. The Wildcats have been ranked No. 1 a total of 47 times since the AP poll began in 1949 - the seventh-most of any team in the country.

• Arizona head coach **Tommy Lloyd** is in his fifth season as the head coach at Arizona and has a record of 132-33 (.800). It's the second-best winning percentage among active D-1 head coaches that are in at least their fifth season at the Division I level (Mark Few - Gonzaga).

• Against Abilene Christian on Dec. 16, Arizona shot 66.7% (30-45) from the floor for the game, the team's best since shooting 71.7% against Nicholls on Nov. 7, 2022.

• Since the start of the 2021-22 season, Arizona has amassed 3,022 assists as a team. That is 180 more assists than any other team (UConn - 2,862).

• According to KenPom.com, the average height of Arizona's regular rotation players is 79.1 inches, which is the eighth-tallest in the country.

• The **Wooden Award** Midseason Top 25 list for the top player in the country came out in early January and Arizona had two players on it - Jaden Bradley and Koa Peat.

• Bradley is on the Oscar Robertson Trophy Midseason Watch List while **Koa Peat** and **Brayden Burries** were both included on the Wayman Tisdale Award Watch List for the top freshman in the nation.

• **Anthony Dell'Orso** dropped 12 points on 4 of 8 shooting against WVU, breaking out of an 0 for 14 shooting slump over the previous three games.

• Freshman wing **Dwayne Aristode** is 24 of 50 from behind the 3-point line this season. Against WVU, he finished with six points and a season-high three steals. His season high in scoring is a 17-point effort against Denver (Nov. 24).

TO THREE OR NOT TO THREE?

Arizona takes an average of 17.2 3FG attempts per game, an average that ranks 352nd in Division I.

Just 27.6% of Arizona's overall field goal attempts come from behind the 3-point line, a percentage that ranks 362nd out of 365 teams on KenPom.

But when Arizona does shoot 3-pointers, they connect at a 36.4% clip, which is good for 55th best in the country.

RIM PROTECTION

Junior **Motiejus Krivas** has improved his rim protection this season, already recording 35 blocked shots this season, including a career-high six blocks against South Dakota State (12/22).

In his first 44 career games, he had 25 blocked shots.

HISTORIC NON-CONFERENCE

Arizona picked up five wins against AP Top 25 opponents in non-conference play, tying the school record set in 1987-88. The last time that any team in the country reached that threshold was UMass in 1995-96 when they won seven against Top 25 teams in non-conference play.

RECORD-LOW TURNOVERS

In the 21-point win against No. 12 Alabama in Birmingham, Arizona only committed four turnovers. That matched the program record for fewest turnovers in a game, set three times previously.

MR. ARIZONA VS FLORIDA

In the season opener against No. 3 Florida, Koa Peat etched his name into the record books with his 30 points, seven rebounds, five assists and three steals.

- *Second-most points by a Arizona freshman in their debut (Eric Money - 37; 1972)*
- *First Big 12 player ever to record 30 points and five assists in their debut*
- *First player in the last 25 years - and possibly longer - to ever post that stat line in his debut*

FREE THROW STREAK

Senior Anthony Dell'Orso finished the 2024-25 season making his last 21 consecutive free throws. He made his first 19 free throws of the 2025-26 season to run his streak to 40 makes before he missed against Norfolk State on Nov. 29. The Arizona single-season record for consecutive free throws made is 39 by Salim Stoudamire from Nov. 17, 2001 through Jan. 23, 2002.

ELITE COMPANY

Freshman **Ivan Kharchenkov** became the fifth Arizona freshman to post a double-double in his debut, tallying 12 points and 10 rebounds against No. 3 Florida. He joins Bob Elliott, Frank Smith, Aaron Gordon and Deandre Ayton as the only Wildcats on that list.

Kharchenkov is second on the team in steals (31).

BACK HOME

Graduate student Evan Nelson earned his degree from Harvard last spring, but still had one year of college eligibility remaining. He chose to transfer to his hometown and play for the Wildcats.

For his career at Harvard, Nelson averaged 8.2 points, 2.9 rebounds and 2.8 assists while shooting 39% from the 3-point line.

Arizona led the Pac-12 in attendance every year 1984-85 through 2023-24, a streak of 39-consecutive seasons (the 2020-21 season does not count due to COVID-19 pandemic).

In 2024-25, the program's first season in the Big 12 Conference, the Wildcats ranked fourth in average attendance and 18th nationally.

Tommy Lloyd is in his fifth season as the head coach at Arizona after he was named head coach April 14, 2021. He was an assistant coach at Gonzaga for 22 seasons before taking over in Tucson. Since he took over in Tucson, Lloyd and the Wildcats have brought a fast, fun and energetic style of play to the McKale Center, consistently ranking among the national leaders in scoring and assists.

His head coaching career got off to a record-breaking start, compiling a 61-11 record through his first two years to set a new NCAA record for most wins by a coach in their first two seasons. His 88-20 mark through three seasons was the second-most wins in NCAA history for a coach in his first three seasons and the most by a coach in a power conference and his 112 wins through four seasons are also the second-most.

Lloyd is also the first power conference coach to win his conference tournament in his first two seasons after capturing the 2022 and 2023 Pac-12 Tournament titles in Las Vegas.

AT ARIZONA

Lloyd continued his blistering start to his coaching career, needing 158 games to reach 125 wins the fastest in program history.

On Jan. 21 at Oklahoma State, Lloyd picked up his 100th win as a head coach in just his 126th game. He tied Mark Few for the fewest number of games to reach 100 wins at their current school. And the 126 games were the 10th fewest games needed to reach 100 wins by a power conference head coach in NCAA history.

The 2023-24 season saw Lloyd lead the Wildcats to a 27-9 overall record and a 15-5 mark in the Pac-12 to capture the regular season title. Senior guard Caleb Love was named Pac-12 Player of the Year, becoming the 10th Wildcat to receive the honor, after averaging 20.0 points and shooting 37.3% from the 3-point line in conference play. Player development continues to be a strength for Lloyd and his staff, as Oumar Ballo garnered first team all-conference honors for the second straight season. Pelle Larsson, who earned Second Team All Pac-12 honors, was selected 44th overall in the NBA Draft by the Miami Heat, giving Lloyd four draft picks in three seasons.

Year two for Lloyd in Tucson continued to add to the history and tradition of Arizona Basketball, as the Wildcats went 28-7 on the year and finished eighth in the final Associated Press poll of the season and No. 17 in the coaches poll. The Wildcats earned a No. 2 seed in the NCAA Tournament after being pegged as a No. 1 seed the previous season, marking the first time since 2014 and 2015 that Arizona secured a top two seed in back-to-back NCAA Tournaments.

As a team, Arizona finished the 2022-23 season second in the country in assists per game (18.9) and sixth in scoring (81.9). Individually, Azuolas Tubelis was a consensus Second Team All-American and a first team all-conference honoree. He became the seventh player in Pac-12 history to lead the conference in scoring (19.8) and rebounding (9.1) in the same season.

Oumar Ballo was also a first team All Pac-12 honoree after finishing second in the conference in rebounding and third in field goal percentage and earning MVP of Maui Invitational. Courtney Ramey earned Pac-12 honorable mention and Kylan Boswell was on the Pac-12 honorable mention all-freshman team.

In his first season as a head coach in 2021-22, he was named National Coach of the Year by the NABC, USBWA and the Associated Press, becoming the first Arizona men's basketball head coach to win any of those awards. He led Arizona to a 33-4 overall record and a 18-2 mark in Pac-12 play to claim the conference's regular season title by three games over UCLA. The Kelso, Washington native set the Pac-12 record for most wins in his first season as head coach and the Wildcats became the first Pac-12 team to ever win 18 regular season conference games. The 33 wins are the second-most in NCAA history for a head coach in his first-ever season as a head coach, falling one short of UNC's Bill Guthridge mark of 34 in 1998.

Under his guidance in 2021-22, sophomore Benedict Mathurin was named a consensus All-American as well as the Pac-12 Player of the Year and Most Outstanding Player of the Pac-12 Tournament, as he scored 655 points on the season, the ninth-most in Arizona history.

Junior center Christian Koloko was named Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year in addition to Pac-12 Most Improved Player of the Year and tied the Arizona single-season record for blocked shots (102) while also increasing his scoring output from 5.3 points per game as a sophomore to 12.6 as a junior and shooting 63.5% from the floor. Sophomore forward Azuolas Tubelis averaged 13.9 points per game and was named First Team All Pac-12 while Dalen Terry was honorable mention all-conference and ranked 12th nationally with a 2.84 assist-to-turnover ratio. Rounding out the award winners from the season was sophomore Pelle Larsson, who shot 47.8% from the floor and averaged 7.2 points and 3.4 rebounds to earn Pac-12 Sixth Man of the Year accolades.

As a team in 2021-22, Arizona led the country and set a new Arizona single-season record with 726 assists. The Wildcats also set a new program record with 210 blocked shots, a total that ranked second nationally. The fast-paced offensive attack led to Arizona averaging 84.0 points per game - third nationally - and the most by an Arizona team since 2003-04.

The Wildcats were also champions in the classroom during Lloyd's first season, recording a then-record setting 3.04 team GPA in the Fall 2021 semester with four players posting a perfect 4.0 GPA. Then in the Spring 2022 semester, the team GPA improved to an all-time program best 3.14 with eight players posting a 3.5 or higher GPA. Arizona also earned NABC Team Academic Excellence award in 2021-22 for having a team GPA of 3.00 or higher, marking the first time that Wildcats had received the honor since the award began in 2012-13 season.

PRIOR TO ARIZONA

Lloyd, who will turn 50 during the 2024-25 season, served as an administrative assistant at Gonzaga for Few during the 2000-01 season before being promoted to assistant coach prior to the 2001-02 season. In his 20 seasons in Spokane, the Zags posted a record of 578-109 (.841) and reached the NCAA Tournament every year, going as far as the title game twice, the Elite Eight twice and the Sweet 16 four times. Gonzaga was also ranked No. 1 in the country for the first time in program history in 2012-13 and then again ascended to the top spot in 2016-17, 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21.

During his tenure, Lloyd and the Zags won 19 West Coast Conference regular season titles and 15 WCC Tournament championships with the help of 87 all-WCC honorees, including nine newcomers of the year and six defenders of the year.

Coach Lloyd was instrumental in the Zags signing and developing NBA players, including two-time NBA All-Star Domantas Sabonis, Rui Hachimura, Kelly Olynyk, Zach Collins, Adam Morrison, Brandon Clarke, Kyle Wiltjer, Austin Daye, Robert Sacre, Ronny Turiaf, Jeremy Pargo and Elias Harris.

Lloyd has used his knowledge of the European game to help Gonzaga players earn professional contracts overseas while also helping to cultivate recruiting relationships that have led to the signing of international players such as Martynas Arlauskas (Lithuania), Joel Ayayi (France), Oumar Ballo (Mali) and Pavel Zakharov (Russia). Also included among his former players are Japanese National Team member Hachimura; Polish National Team member Przemek Karnowski; Lithuanian National Team member Sabonis (the son of Naismith Hall of Famer Arvydas Sabonis); Canadians Kevin Pangos, Olynyk and Sacre; Germans Harris and Mathis Mönninghoff; JP Baptista of Brazil; Frenchmen Turiaf, Killian Tillie and Mathis Keita; Filip Petrushev of Serbia; Guy Landry Edi of the Ivory Coast; and Addullahi Kuso of Nigeria.

The Zags had one of the most potent offenses in the nation over his 20 years, joining North Carolina and Duke as the only three schools in the country to average more than 80 points per game. Gonzaga also led the country in overall field goal percentage (49.6%) and three-point field goal percentage (37.9%) in that span.

PERSONAL

A 1993 graduate of Kelso High School in Washington, Lloyd went on to attend Walla Walla Community College for two seasons and was an All-Northwest Athletic Association of Community Colleges All-East Region selection in 1995. Following his graduation from WWCC, he finished his career at Whitman College, earning his degree in biology and a secondary teaching credential. He played professionally in Brisbane, Australia in 1997 and Dusseldorf, Germany in 1999.

Lloyd and his wife, Channele, have three children - Liam, Sofia and Maria - and one grandchild, Luka. Liam played basketball two seasons at Grand Canyon University (2020-22) and two seasons at Northern Arizona University (2022-24) before transferring to play at Arizona for his fifth season.
