## TEAM NOTES

### TALE OF TWO FIRST HALVES

BYU trailed by 23 points at halftime against the Buffs when they faced off in Boulder two weeks ago. On Saturday, the Cougars led 32-30 going into the break and outrebounded Colorado 23-19. BYU lost the rebounding battle 32-10 in the first half in Boulder.

### FOURTH QUARTER EXPLOSION

The first three minutes of the fourth saw the Cougar defense force five Buffalo turnovers, which jump-started an 18-0 run in the quarter. That 18-0 rally marked the longest run BYU has had in conference play.

### PUTTING ON THE CLAMPS

The Cougars outscored Colorado 27-6 in the frame, notching the fewest points given up to any opponent this season since allowing six points in a quarter to Fresno State on November 15th. To close the game, the Buffaloes were held to one of their last 12 from the floor.

### TRIPLES ON TRIPLES ON TRIPLES

With six made threes in the win, BYU has now knocked down a triple in 824 consecutive games, the second-longest active streak in NCAA Division I women's basketball.

### THREE'S A CROWD

With Saturday's win over Colorado, the Cougars have won three-consecutive Big 12 games for the first time this season. The three-straight wins at Utah, at Arizona State and over Colorado also mark the first 3-game win streak in conference play since February of 2024 when BYU beat No. 18 Baylor, Cincinnati and UCF during the 2023-24 season.

## PLAYER NOTES

### DIME DROPPERS GALORE

Sydney Bennally and Delaney Gibb recorded five and seven dimes, respectively, versus the Buffs. The last time two different Cougars posted five or more assists in the same game was against Iowa State when Marya Hudgins joined Bennally in distributing five assists each.

### NEXT COUG UP

Bolanle Yussuf matched a career-high 13 points to go along with 2 blocks as Lara Rohkohl spent much of Saturday in foul trouble.

### THE SECOND-HALF ASSASSIN

Delaney Gibb scored 15 of her 26 points in the fourth in the midst of a 27-6 onslaught for BYU in the quarter. The sophomore shot 3-of-6 from the field, 2-of-3 from beyond the arc and 7-of-10 from the charity stripe in the frame.

In the past four games, Gibb has scored 79 points in the second half alone, good for 19.8 points per game after halftime. She went for 15 against Cincinnati, dropped 27 in the second half of a 37-point performance against Utah, 18 in the second half to erase a 13-point halftime deficit against ASU and 19 in the final 20 minutes to come back from eight down in the final quarter against Colorado.

### LIV'N ON A PRAYER

Olivia Hamlin has been a constant force for the Cougars over the past six games, scoring in double-figures in all six. The freshman has also knocked down at least one triple in each game during that stretch, hitting two in 5-of-6 games.

Hamlin went for 13 points on 5-of-11 shooting, three rebounds, an assist and a steal tonight. She also was the beneficiary of back-to-back fast-break buckets to help BYU keep the lead heading into halftime.

## HEAD COACH LEE CUMMARD QUOTES

### OPENING STATEMENT ...
