## TEAM NOTES

### OUT AND RUNNING EARLY

From the 8:21 mark to the end of the first quarter, the Cougars went on a 25-2 run on the Tigers Monday night. Part of that 25-2 run was a 16-0 run for the last 5:21 of the quarter.

### MAKING AN EARLY STATEMENT

The 28-7 first-quarter lead by BYU over Missouri was the largest first-quarter lead of the season. The Cougars are 18-3 when leading after the first, while the Tigers are 4-16 when trailing after the first.

### HALLELUJAH, IT'S RAINING THREES

The Cougars got it going early and often from beyond the arc against the Tigers, shooting 8-of-18 from three in the first half. BYU finished the game with a season-high 14 made threes, including 10 from Delaney Gibb and Olivia Hamlin alone.

### HALFTIME'S CRYSTAL BALL

After going up 48-27 at halftime Monday night, BYU held a 20-point lead at the break for the third time this season. The Cougars 21-point advantage is the third-largest lead at halftime for the Cougars this season, behind a 28-point lead against UTEP and a 23-point advantage over Omaha.

### SCORING IN BUNCHES

The Cougars scored their second-most points of the season in the 93-75 win over Missouri. BYU's 93 points are the most points scored against a power four school this season, and most since scoring 91 in an overtime road loss to Oklahoma on Dec. 10, 2021. BYU's previous best this season was 86 points at Utah earlier this season, that included a career-high 37 points from Delaney Gibb.

### THE PROTEGE HAS BECOME THE MASTER

With the win over Missouri, Lee Cummard tied BYU's all-time winningest coach, Jeff Judkins for the most wins by a first-year head coach in program history (24).

## PLAYER NOTES

### I'M NO LONGER SURPRISED...

Delaney Gibb continues to make history as she became the 34th member of the BYU women's basketball 1,000-point club by scoring 29 points against the Tigers on Monday. With 1,007 points in her first 57 games, the sophomore became the third fastest in program history to hit the 1,000-point mark, behind just 1980 National player of the Year Tina Gunn Robison (45 Games) and Scarlett Overly (54 Games).

### DOUBLE-TROUBLE

Kambree Barber notched her second double-double of the season, and third of her career with 12 points and 11 rebounds in the win against Missouri. Barber also chipped in two blocks on the night.

### THE NUMBER OF PERFECTION...7

As part of her 29 points, Delaney Gibb knocked down a career-high seven triple sin the win over Missouri, besting her previous mark of five that occurred three times.

### BACKCOURT FIREPOWER

Delaney Gibb and Olivia Hamlin have been sensational for the Cougars this year, averaging 29.7 points, 8.1 rebounds, 5.9 assists and 3.8 steals per game on the season.

Tonight they one-upped themselves by combining for 52 points on 19-of-34 shooting, a 55.9-percent clip. The roommates also contributed a combined nine rebounds, seven assists, four steals and a block to race past Mizzou.

## HEAD COACH LEE CUMMARD QUOTES

### OPENING STATEMENT ...

"That was a good game for us. It was really fun to see the aggressiveness coming out from the jump, because it was something we emphasized leading into the game. The crowd was great tonight. Right from the jump, the energy was in the building, and it really played into how our team performed."

### ON GETTING OUT IN TRANSITION ...

"We just wanted to be really aggressive defensively and let that fuel us offensively. I thought our guards were pushing it when they had opportunities, and that's scary when that's happening because we space the floor."

### ON KAMBREE BARBER ...

"I think Kambree had her best game of the season. She cleaned up almost everything defensively rebounding-wise."

### ON GIBB'S MINDSET ENTERING THE GAME ...

"She definitely was ready to score some baskets tonight."

### ON HOW FAR THIS TEAM CAN GO ...

"This group is not ready to be done playing, and you can see it in the way they play and practice. It's fun to have them get rewarded for their work."

### ON TYING JEFF JUDKINS FOR MOST WINS BY A 1ST-YEAR HEAD COACH ...

"It's awesome. He is women's basketball at BYU. I'll deflect because we have a great group. They've been completely all in from the beginning. To be compared with coach Judkins is a tremendous honor."

## MISSOURI HEAD COACH KELLIE HARPER

### OPENING STATEMENT ...

"You never want to see your season come to an end. That's a really good team, and we knew it was a really good team when we came over here. They do such a great job playing hard, passing the ball, shooting the ball, and playing with some toughness defensively. I think they played with great pace as well."

### ON WHAT MAKES DELANEY GIBB HARD TO GUARD ...

"She's so active, and she's very athletic. I think one of the toughest things about guarding her is the fact that she can pass. She's hard to double-team, because she can pass the ball and shoot the ball. You're left guarding her one-on-one a lot of times, and she does a really good job of reading screens. She's explosive when she puts the ball on the floor and then she knocks down shots."

### GIBB ON BYU'S HOT START ...

"It was maybe the best start that we've had all year, and I think that started with our intensity on defense. Our transition offense was really the key to the game."

### GIBB ON SCORING 1,000 CAREER POINTS ...

"I didn't really want to think about it. I knew there was a possibility I could break it in this game, but today was such an overall success as a team. It's fun to be able to achieve that on a night where we felt connected together."

### GIBB ON PLAYING IN THE WBIT ...

"We hoped to make the NCAA tournament and that didn't happen. It's kind of like a revenge tour in a way. Obviously, these are great teams that we're playing, and we want to prove and showcase what we can do. I feel like none of us are taking it for granted. We really enjoy being here and being able to have home games has been incredible."
