HISTORY VS THE OPPOSITION

- Utah Valley and BYU meet for the 58th time on Tuesday. BYU leads the series 50-7, but UVU has beaten the Cougars each of the last two seasons.
- With this game, BYU is now tied for Utah Valley's most-played opponent with former WAC rival Seattle U.
- Utah Valley is looking to make it three straight years with a win over BYU for the first time in program history.
- In the last meeting in Provo, Utah Valley beat the Cougars, 6-4, earning its first road win in the series since 2015.
- BYU won the first meeting of the season, 8-5 in Orem back on March 24.

QUICK HITTERS

- Utah Valley went 3-1 last week, winning a midweek at Weber State and taking two of three from a high-powered UT Arlington team at home.
- While the recipe for success for UVU has been to score first all season (18-2 when doing so), the Wolverines did not score first in any of its games against UTA. UVU has only scored first once in its last nine games (at WSU).
- UVU has scored at least four runs in each of its wins so far this season, good for a 22-6 record when reaching that threshold. One of those six losses came against BYU on March 24.
- 2B **Tatum Hall** has been the catalyst for the Wolverine offense for the last month, and even moreso this past week. Hall went 10-for-14 with 2 HRs, 4 2Bs, 14 RBIs, and 7 runs scored. 13 of those RBIs came between Tuesday's win at WSU and Friday's DH vs UTA, the most in any 3-game span in program history.
- **Tatum Hall's** 4 2Bs, 10 hits, 14 RBIs, and 20 total bases each were the most in the NCAA over the last week.
- IF **Britney Moreno** was the prototypical leadoff woman this week, reaching base in all but one plate appearance. Moreno went 10-for-11 with 2 doubles, 3 RBIs, 3 BBs, 3 SBs, and 11 runs scored. Moreno reached in 11-straight PA's across Tuesday's and Friday's games, the longest such streak in the nation this season (based on data available from NCAA).
- IF/DP **Bailey Marvin** contributed in a big way last week after going hitless her previous 7 games. Marvin went 8-for-12 with a HR, a 2B, 3 BBs, and 10 RBIs to provide Hall some protection out of the cleanup spot. Marvin is tied for 2nd on the team with 28 RBIs behind Hall's 41.

MORENO CHASING ANOTHER TRIPLES RECORD

On March 21 vs Utah Tech, Moreno made program history by breaking UVU's D-I era triples record with the 12th of her career. Entering this week, Moreno ranks t-7th nationally with 5 triples this season, as well as t-13th among active D-I players for their career. With her next triple, Moreno would match the single-season record of 6, set by Chris Jimenez in 2005, and move into the top 10 all-time in WAC history.

HALL'S UNPRECEDENTED SUCCESS FROM THE LEFT SIDE

With 13 games still left in the regular season, Tatum Hall has already put up arguably the best offensive season by a left-handed batter in program history. Her 9 home runs are the most in a single season by a LHB in the team's full-status D-I era (since 2010), and is five RBIs away from posting the most in program history by a LHB (record: 45, Kalena Shepherd, 2022; Heidi Stocks, 2008). Her .827 SLG% is on pace to break the overall single-season record by any batter.

KEEPING IT .400

Entering this week, Utah Valley has two hitters hitting .400 or better in Tatum Hall (.439) and Britney Moreno (.425). Since becoming full-status D-I members in 2010, Utah Valley has had just one hitter hit .400 or better for a full season, Madison Carr in 2022. Carr set the single-season hits record with 82 en route to a .453 batting average.

STERZER NAMED MID-MAJOR FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

OF Megan Sterzer was named the Mid-Major Freshman of the Week by D1Softball on Feb. 24 following an impressive weekend at the Rebel Classic. Sterzer went 8-for-13 with a HR, 2B, 8 RBIs, and 4 walks that weekend, with the home run being the first of her collegiate career and a grand slam.

BUT CAN SHE GET ON BASE?

Britney Moreno has embodied everything you look for in a leadoff hitter for the Wolverines this season. The senior has reached base in all but three games (vs. St. Thomas, Utah, and Pacific G2), and enters Tuesday on a 16-game reached base streak, her second of 15 games or more this season. Her .493 OBP is also on pace to set the full-season record.

THOMSON SECURES WIN NO. 100

Utah Valley head coach Cody Thomson earned win #100 on March 10 against Sacramento State. Thomson is the second head coach in the team's Division I era to reach the milestone, joining former head coach Todd Fairbourne, whose D-I record was 165-249-2 from 2005-12. Thomson is the fastest to reach that mark.

SWIPERS KEEP SWIPING

Utah Valley stole its 38th base of the season on March 17th against WSU to surpass the team's totals from each of the last three seasons. Entering Tuesday, the Wolverines have 47 stolen bases, their most since swiping 61 in 2022, and already the 7th-most for a full season in program history.

THRICE AS NICE

In 2026, UVU has 11 triples from six different players, the 34th-most in the nation and tied for second most in the WAC. In 2025, Utah Valley had 14 triples, the team's second-most in a season since becoming full-status D-I members in 2010 (most: 16, 2021). The Wolverines also had eight different players with at least one triple, the most since 2005 when the team had nine different players with a triple.

THOMSON ADDS TOP-LEVEL EXPERIENCE TO STAFF

Head coach Cody Thomson added two former college stars to his staff for this season. Former Utah star Haley Denning Brown joins the coaching ranks after finishing her stellar collegiate career in 2024. Brown was a 4-time All-PAC-12 and 3-time All-Region honoree, and helped lead the Utes to the WCWS in 2023. Brown is the Utes' all-time leader in hits, runs scored, at-bats, and career batting average.

Thomson also tabbed former BYU standout Marissa Chavez to join his staff. Chavez was a 3-time All-WCC selection for the Cougars. Chavez graduated from BYU in 2022, and was an assistant at WAC rival Utah Tech the last two seasons.

WOLVERINE SOFTBALL HISTORY

Utah Valley first fielded a softball team in 1980 and quickly rose to be one of the top junior college programs in the country. The Wolverines won eight SWAC and four region titles from 1980-2003 and won the school's first and only team national championship to date, the 2000 NJCAA National Title. Since becoming full-status D-I members in 2010, Utah Valley has won one conference title, the 2014 WAC Tournament, becoming the first UVU team to reach the NCAA Tournament.

CODY THOMSON

Head Coach | 5th Season
Overall Record: 106-135

Cody Thomson is in his fifth season as the head coach at Utah Valley University. Thomson is the program's sixth head coach during its NCAA Division I era. In his four seasons at Utah Valley, Thomson has produced six All-WAC selections in Linnah Rebolledo, Madison Carr, Megan Gibbs (twice), Halle Morris, and Britney Moreno. Rebolledo has also gone on to join the Mexican National Softball Team and plays professionally with Charros de Jalisco in the Liga Mexicana de Softbol. He has also produced two All-Region honorees in Morris (first team) and Avery Sapp (third team). His teams have also seen tremendous success in the classroom, including 36 Easton/NFCA Scholar-Athletes, 31 Academic All-WAC honorees, and 12 CSC Academic All-District recipients.

Thomson has spent multiple coaching stints with USA Softball in a variety of roles. In July 2024, Thomson traveled to Japan with the US Women's Elite team for the Japan All-Star Series. Thomson also joined the USA Softball coaching staff for the 2023 Pan-American Games in Santiago, Chile as the team's pitching coach, where the team won gold. Thomson had previously joined the Team USA Softball support staff in the summer of 2023 as the team's batting practice pitcher. Thomson traveled to Florida for the U.S. Women's Fast Pitch Camp in June 2023, then joined Team USA in Ireland for the pool play of the WBSC World Cup in Dublin in July 2023.

Prior to Utah Valley, Thomson was on staff at Utah from 2005-2021 and was part of the program's transition into the Pac-12. Thomson worked with all facets of the Utah program and was part of a staff that was named the National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) Regional Coaching Staff of the Year in 2017 after earning the No. 11 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

Several players experienced tremendous success during Thomson's time at Utah, including two-time Pac 12 POTY Hannah Flippen (2016 & 2017), who also was named an NFCA First-Team All-American. He helped coach 32 All-Pac 12 players during his time in Salt Lake City. At Utah, Thomson also coached 15 NFCA All-Pacific Region players, a three-time All-American, and members of the USA, Mexican, and British National Teams. That list includes three-time All-Pac 12 honoree Anissa Urtez, who was on UVU's coaching staff in 2019.

Thomson also had a long and storied 14-year playing career in fastpitch softball as a pitcher including a stint as a member of USA Men's National Team. He helped the team to a second-place finish at the ISF Men's World Cup in Prague, going 2-0 with 18 strikeouts in the circle. He was also named Best Pitcher at the NAFA World Series in 2006 and was a four-time ASA All-American.

Thomson is married to the former Amanda Tuft and has four children: Mikaela, Chase, Cayden and Quinley. Mikaela finished her collegiate softball career with the Wolverines in 2022, and was an All-WAC selection at Utah Tech in 2021. Thomson's niece, Madison Carr, was also an All-WAC selection at UVU in 2022.

ASSISTANT COACHES



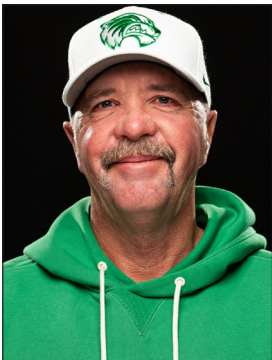
MARISSA CHAVEZ - ASSISTANT COACH, 1ST SEASON

- Joins UVU coaching staff after spending the last two seasons at WAC rival Utah Tech.
- In 2025, coached the Trailblazers to one of the most potent offenses in the WAC, with 8 players hitting .300 or better and averaging 5.16 runs/game.
- Began coaching career as a GA at D-III Fairleigh-Dickinson Florham in 2023.
- Graduated from BYU in 2022, where she had a successful five-year career from 2018-22.
- Was a three-time All-WCC selection — twice as first team and once as second team.
- Posted a career .306 batting average with 12 HRs, 24 doubles, and 65 RBIs.



HALEY DENNING BROWN - ASSISTANT COACH, 1ST SEASON

- Entering first year coaching at the collegiate level after finishing her playing career in 2024. Was a five-year starter at Utah, earning All-PAC-12 honors in each completed season and All-Pacific Region accolades in three of those.
- Concluded her illustrious playing career as the Utes' all-time leader in hits, runs scored, at-bats, and career batting average.
- Member of 2023 PAC-12 championship and WCWS Utah softball team. Played a pivotal part in that team's postseason run, posting at least one hit in each of the Utes' final 10 games that season.
- Played first three collegiate seasons under Thomson at Utah (2019-21).



CHAD BLACKHURST - ASST. COACH/RECRUITING COORD., 2ND SEASON

- Entering second season on staff at UVU after spending seven seasons coaching at local JUCO USU-Eastern (2017-23).
- Prior to USUE, was an assistant at Pleasant Grove HS just north of Orem for four seasons, where he coached two of his daughters and three of his nieces. Helped revitalize the PGHS program, guiding them to the state tournament in each of those seasons.
- Played 15 years in various men's fastpitch leagues, including a handful of seasons playing both with and against Cody Thomson.
- Graduated from UVU in 1997.

One of the most scenic settings in all of college softball, Wolverine Softball Field has been Utah Valley's home turf for 30 years. The field, which originally opened in 1996, offers spectators views of the Wasatch Mountains to the south and east, and Utah Lake and the Lake Mountains to the west.

Recent renovations have improved the player and fan experience dramatically. Prior to the 2026 season, UVU athletics installed a brand-new video board above the right-center fence and renovated the team locker room. In 2022, UVU installed a new state-of-the-art lighting system with customizable LED lights, allowing home night games to be played for the first time in the program's nearly 50-year history. A turf outfield and warning track was installed in 2020. Further renovations, including padded walls, a press box, and grandstand, are planned for the near future. Entering 2026, the Wolverines are 35-34 at home under Cody Thomson.

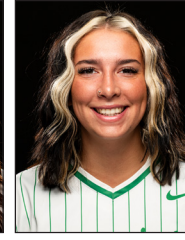

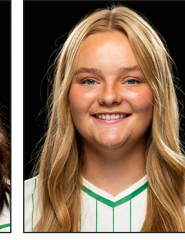
