- Travelled approximately: 2,400 kms walking plus 2,000 kms by sea
- ➢ From Antioch, through Syria and...
- Cilicia, Derbe, Lystra Phyrgia & Galatia, Troas, Philippi
- > Thessalonica, Berea, Athens
- Corinth (1.5 years) Ephesus Caesarea
- Returned to Syrian Antioch

1. Context

A compelling motivation (16)

- A clear strategy
- Strategic places where people gathered
- Synagogue (2, 10, 17)
- "Speakers corner Areopagus (19)

2. Content

Scriptures (2, 11, 13, 17) Jesus Christ (3, 7, 18, 24ff)

3. Challenge

✤ Reasoned (2, 17) Explained (3) \Rightarrow Proved (3) Persuaded (4) Preached (13) Debated (18)

4. Consequence

17:6 "turned the world upside down" (OR right side up?)
Some were persuaded & believed (4, 12)
Some violently rejected (5-9, 13)
Sneering, believing, pondering (32-34)

Lessons learned (22-38)

- ✓ <u>Search for significance</u>: why do people experience emptiness?
- ✓ <u>Beginnings</u>: why is there something rather than nothing?
- \checkmark <u>Purpose of life</u>: is there more to life?
- ✓ <u>After life</u>: what happens when I die?

Lessons learned (22-38)

<u>Emptiness</u>: People looking in wrong places (22-23)
 <u>Beginnings</u>: God created the world (24)
 <u>Purpose of life</u>: God still wants to connect (26-27)
 <u>After life</u>: everyone will face God, ensure you are ready – repent (30)
