- 1. Purposes of God
- 2. People (companions!)
- 3. Programmes
- 4. Property

## Paul's Discipleship Method

- 1. Going: Athens Corinth Cenchrea Ephesus Caesarea Antioch
- 2. Practice: Jews first, then Gentiles (13:46; 18:6)
- 3. Frontier: Corinth
  - ☐ Difficult city (1 Corinthians 6:9-11)
  - ☐ Different culture
  - ☐ Arriving without companions alone

### Companions (Networking...)

- Aquila & Priscilla (1-4) Tent-making ministry; discipled by Paul (action-reflection) (see v5)
- Silas & Timothy (5) Travelling companions (17:14 -> 18:5)
- Titius Justus (7) Providing resource
- Crispus (8) New disciple; baptised by Paul (1 Cor 1:14)
- Sosthenes (17) New disciple, Paul's "brother" (1Cor 1:1)
- Apollos (24-28) Discipled by Aquila & Priscilla, became authoritative communicator of the Gospel

## The Supreme Companion (18:9-10)

The Lord said,

"Don't be afraid, but keep on speaking and don't be silent. <sup>10</sup> For I am with you, and no one will lay a hand on you to hurt you, because I have many people in this city."
