# The Journey

#### The Sea, the Snake & the Saviour

- Sea: 27:1-44 (11 nautical terms; companions; stopovers; change of ships; warning; storm; shipwreck)
- Snake: 28:1-10 (Malta; snake-bite; miraculous healings)
- Saviour: 28:11-31 (<u>Discipling</u>: preaching & writing –
   Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians & Philemon)

Acts 28:31 "Proclaiming the kingdom of God and teaching the things concerning the Lord Jesus Christ with full boldness and without hindrance."

#### What Happened to Paul?

- Uncertain
- □ Paul wrote several of his letters whilst in Rome
- □ Tradition says he was beheaded & died a martyr
- ☐ Great fire in Rome in AD 64
- Nero was in charge and blamed the Christians for this

#### Blessings in Discipleship

- √ Sharing life with others (people focussed)
- √ Being an ambassador for Christ
- √ Seeing God at work in people's lives (mine too)
- ✓ Seeing the impact of the Gospel in changed lives

### **Difficulties in Ministry** (2 Cor 11:23-28)

I have worked much harder, been in prison more frequently, been flogged more severely, and been exposed to death again and again. <sup>24</sup> Five times I received from the Jews the forty lashes minus one. <sup>25</sup> Three times I was beaten with rods, once I was pelted with stones, three times I was shipwrecked, I spent a night and a day in the open sea, <sup>26</sup> I have been constantly on the move. I have been in danger from rivers, in danger from bandits, in danger from my fellow Jews, in danger from Gentiles; in danger in the city, in danger in the country, in danger at sea; and in danger from false believers. <sup>27</sup> I have labored and toiled and have often gone without sleep; I have known hunger and thirst and have often gone without food; I have been cold and naked. <sup>28</sup> Besides everything else, I face daily the pressure of my concern for all the churches.

#### Paul the Disciple

- ☑ He went, he baptised, he taught obedience
- ☑ Prayer was natural & assumed
- ☑ Expected God to work miraculous involvement
- Sometimes wavered in his faith
- Focussed on the Great Commission

#### My Discipleship Response to Acts

- ✓ We go, baptise & teach obedience to Jesus' commands
- ✓ God is calling you to something...what?
- ✓ Expect God to work get in and have a go
- ✓ Commitment to ¹one service, ²one EFG & ³one ministry
- √ Speak to someone pastor, Church Council, etc.
