Ezekiel Overview

- Section 1 Chapters 1-24: Challenges the over-confident Judeans about God's presence in the temple and certain judgement against the city and its temple.
- Section 2 Chapters 25-32: Are announcements of judgement on Israel, the nearby nations and on Jerusalem.
- Section 3 Chapters 33-48: Are announcements of hope, for Israel, for the nations and for all creation.

Ezekiel Chapter 1 Verses 25-28

 "Then there came a voice from the vault over their heads as they stood with lowered wings. Above the vault over their heads was what looked like a throne lapis lazuli, and high above on the throne was a figure like that of a man. I saw that, from what appeared to be his waist up, he looked like glowing metal, as if full of fire, and a brilliant light surrounded him. Like the appearance of a rainbow in the clouds on a rainy day, so was the radiance around him. This was the appearance of the likeness of the glory of the Lord. When I saw it I fell face down, and I heard the voice of one speaking"..

Ezekiel Chapter 3 Verses 16-19

 At the end of seven days the word of the Lord came to me: Son of man, I have made you a watchman for the people of Israel, so hear the word I speak and give them warning from me. When I say to a wicked person, 'you will surely die' and you do not warn them or speak out to dissuade them from their evil ways to save their life, that wicked person will die for their sin, and I will hold you accountable for their blood. But if you warn the wicked person and they do not turn from their evil ways, they will die for their sin; but you will have saved yourself".

Ezekiel Chapter 8 Verses 5-6

 "And he said to me, 'Son of man, look toward the north. So I looked, and in the entrance north of the gate of the alter I saw this idol of jealousy. And he said to me, son of man, do you see what they are doing-the utterly detestable things the Israelites are doing here, things that will drive me far from my sanctuary? But you will see things that are even more detestable".

Ezekiel Chapter 11 Verses 16-19

"Therefore say, this is what the sovereign Lord says 'I sent them far away among the nations and scattered them among the countries, yet for a little while I have been a sanctuary for them in the countries where they have gone. Therefore say, this is what the sovereign Lord says; I will gather you from the nations and bring you back from the countries where you have been scattered and I will give you back the land of Israel again. They will return to it and remove all the vile images and detestable idols. I will give them an undivided heart and put a new spirit in them. I will remove from them their heart of stone and give them a heart of flesh"

Ezekiel Chapter 36 Verse 22

 Therefore say to the Israelites, this is what the Sovereign Lord says: It is not for your sake, people of Israel, that I am going to do these things, but for the sake of my holy name, which you have profaned among the nations where you have gone. I will show the holiness of my great name, which has been profaned among the nations, the name you have profaned among them. Then the nations will know that I am the Lord, declares the Sovereign Lord, when I am proved holy through you before their eyes".

Ezekiel Chapter 37 Verses 4-10

"Then he said to me prophesy to these bones and say to them, dry bones, hear the word of the Lord! This is what the sovereign Lord says to these bones; I will make breath enter you, and you will come to life.

• I will attach tendons to you and make flesh come upon you and cover you with skin; I will put breath into you and you will come to life. Then you will know I am the Lord.

• "So I prophesied as I was commanded. And as I was prophesying, there was a noise, a rattling sound, and the bones came together, bone to bone. I looked and tendons and flesh appeared on them, but there was no breath in them. Then he said to me, prophesy to the breath; prophesy son of man and say to it "this is what the sovereign Lord says 'come breath from the four winds and breathe into these slain, that they may live. So I prophesied as he commanded me, and breath entered them, they came to life and stood on their feet, a vast army".
