### **Does God exist?**

- # Atheist = there is no God
- # Agnostic = doesn't know whether there is a God or not
- # Polytheist = there are many gods
- # Pantheist = impersonal; everything is god
- # Materialist = no need for God

#### Indicators of God's existence

- Ontological = most cultures believe in a superior being
- Cosmological = "cause and effect"
- ➤ <u>Teleological</u> = where there is a design there must be a designer

#### Is there a God?

- Ultimately a matter of faith either way
- Pascal's wager:
- a. It's impossible to prove or disprove the existence of God
- b. If we <u>do</u> live the Christian life and there is no God = no loss
- c. If we don't live the Christian life and there is no God = good fun
- d. If we do live the Christian life and there is God = eternal reward
- e. If we don't live the Christian life and there is God = eternal punishment

#### What can we know about God?

- 1. There is only one God (Deut 6:4-9)
- 2. This one God exists as three Persons
- 3. The three are one (essence) yet the three are different (person)
- 4. God is unity

(Essence = being, what you are

Person = who you are, distinct)

## The Bible says...

- ✓ The Father is God (Phil 1:2)
- ✓ Jesus is God (Titus 2:13)
- ✓ The Holy Spirit is God (Acts 5:3-4)

There are many verses in the Bible where all three are mentioned together

**NOTE** the word "Trinity" does not occur in the Bible

## **Each Person is fully God**


#### The Trinity is **NOT**

- ≠ Like a pie cut into three pieces
- Like the three parts of an egg
- ≠ Appearing in three different forms

Best explained relationally rather than in physical terms

God IS three in one! Complex & mysterious!

God as Trinity:
not a concept
but a real
person living
amongst us.
