Bark Terminator-V

User's Manual

Description:

The Terminator-V first applies a warning tone followed by progressively increasing tone and Vibration as your dogs barking persists. It will enter the ileep state automatically after Vibrate your dog Several times, if your dog is quiet for 60s or more, the collar resets to the mildest correction level. In this ray, your pet needs only to experience the higher Vibration levels a few times before learning that the mild sound and Vibration stimulus is a warning of tronger corrections to come. Your pet will quickly learn to SHUT UP at the mild correction without having to suffer the more intense stimulus. We have ound this technique of progressively increasing sound and Vibration is not only more humane, It's more EFFECTIVE in breaking the barking habit than conventional Vibration bark control collars.

Features:

- 1. Humane uses painless tone followed by Vibration only if barking persists.
- 2. Automatically increases tone and Vibration stimuli as barking persists.
- 3. Microprocessor controlled.
- Operates on a standard 6 volt battery.
- 5. Voice Recognition feature minimizes false triggering.
- 6. Extremely small and light weight.
- 7. Operates on a single long life,6 volt alkaline battery.
- 8. Effective on dogs from 2 pounds to 100 pounds.
- 9. Effective on dogs weight as much as 150 pounds or more.
- 10. APSD-Automatic Power Saving Mode. More than 2000 times Vibration, and stand by more than 45 days.

Operating Instructions:

Use of your new Bark Terminator-V is almost completely automatic. There is not electronic control to adjust. Just install a 6 volt alkaline battery, adjust the strap to the size of your dog's neck and the Unit automatically begins doing its job.

Getting Started:

Before putting your Bark Terminator on your pet there are a few things about the unit with which you should become familiar. The Bark terminator-V uses a microphone to sense your dog's bark. The microphone is located at the center of the unit underneath the strap as shown easily sense the sound of your dog's bark right through the strap Vibration is delivered by the two probes. You will also notice a small hole on the side of the unit. This is the location of the speaker which sounds the correction tones.


Purchasing a New Battery:

Your Bark Terminator is battery operated so, it will be necessary to purchase a standard 6 volt alkaline battery Standard 6 volt.

Installing/Replacing the Battery:

To access the battery compartment firmly push down on the engraved area of the plastic case and slide the battery door open as shown in the diagram below.

Install the new battery between the "clip" and "spring" contacts. Note that "spring" contact is for the negative end and the "clip" contact is for the positive end as shown below.






Replace the battery door. When slid into place it should snap shut. Normal battery life is three til four months. Replace the battery when the tone becomes notably softer or stops all together.

How It Works:

- 1. After installing the battery, you will hear a beep , now, the collar is in standby
- 2. How the collar work:
- The Mic of collar receive dog barking first time, it will beep short and the red LED flash
- The Mic of collar receive dog barking second time, it will beep longer and the red LED flash
- The Mic of collar receive dog barking 3rd time, it will beep and the red LED flash, then, it start Vibrate 2 seconds.
- If the mic of collar receive the dog barking continuously, it will vibrate continuously.
- 5. Red light flashing when the battery is low.

you could bark at the microphone of collar sense, It will begin to Vibrate after receiving the signal 3 times continuously.

Putting the Bark Terminator-V on Your Dog:

Place the unit around your dog's neck and adjust the collar length using the slide buckle arrangement provides with the strap. The unit should fit snugly underneath your dog's neck. Make sure that electrodes are in direct contact with your dog's skin, Hair between the electrodes and skin will severely diminish the Vibration effect.

Caution Notes:

- 1. This device is made up of plastic and electronic components that are not digestible.
- 2. Although its microprocessor is designed to differentiate your dog's individual bark from stray environmental noises, the unit may occasionally be activated by other vibrations or sounds. This is normal but, it should not happen so often as to be confusing to you pet. If the unit is falsely triggered by excessive scratching, shaking of the head or rolling on the ground, your pet may be suffering from fleas or ear mites. If these activities are evident, have your pet checked by a Veterinarian for parasites.
- 3. The Bare Terminator is designed to be water resistant. But it is not fully soggy. It's okay to let your dog wear the unit in the rain but, be sure to remove it before bathing your pet or allowing it to swim. If the device gets very wet or submerged in water, remove the battery and allow the unit to dry completely for at least a couple of days. And then install a new one before using it.
